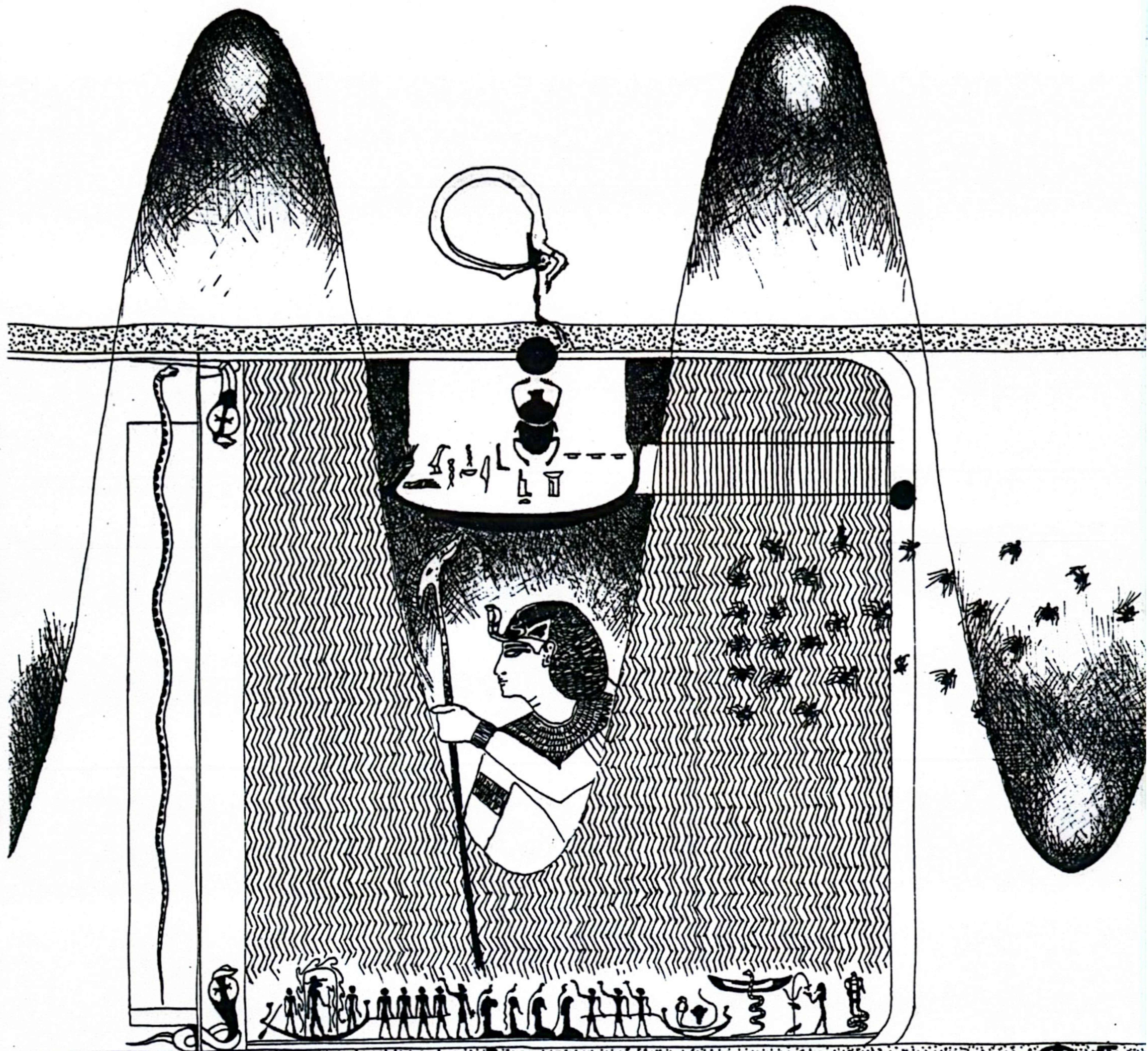

Boy, are we disappointed in those Lodges, Chapters, Camps et





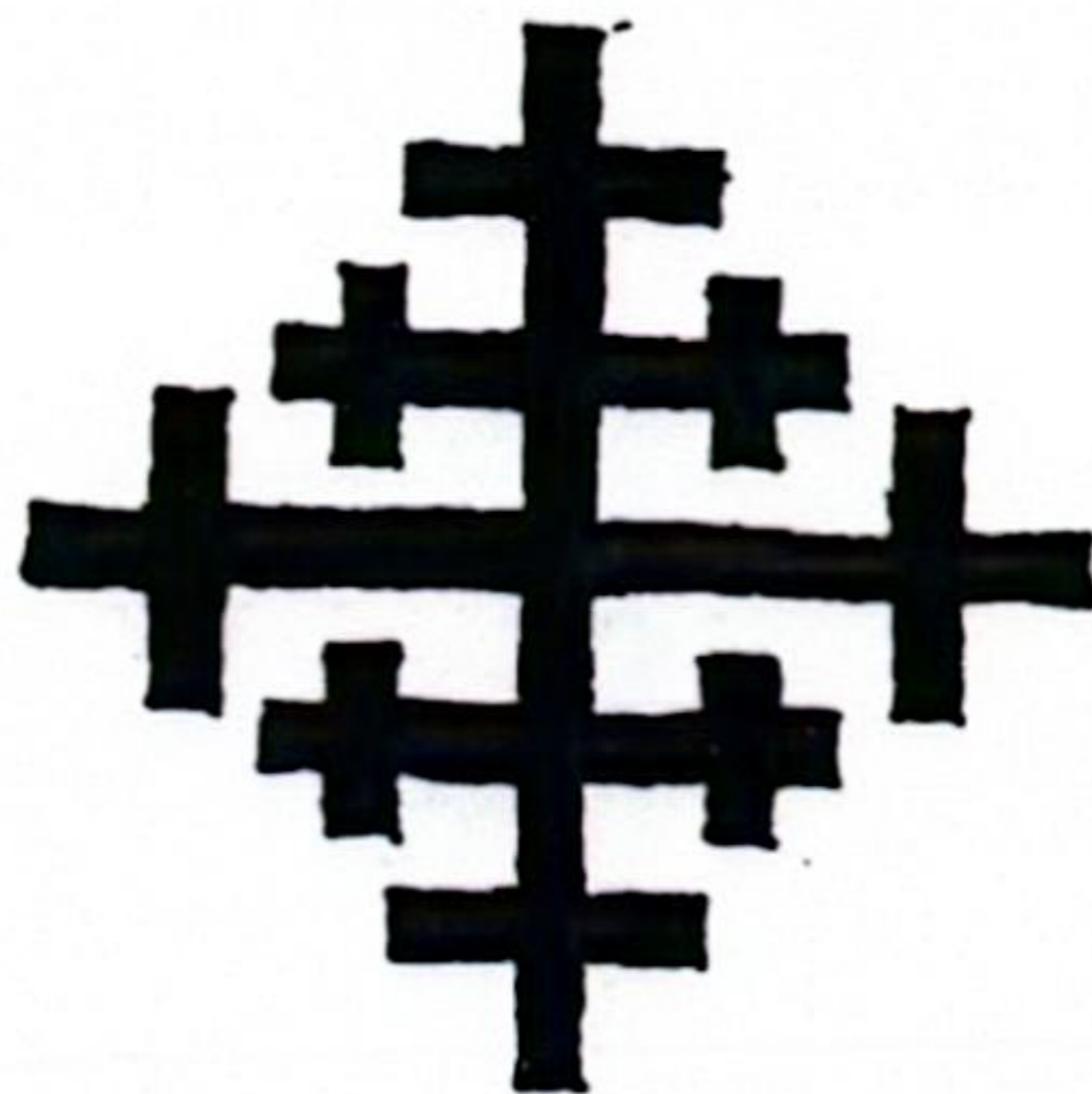

LETTER TO THE EDITORS

Many thanks for Volume 1 #000 of ARACHNY'S WEB. It's an admirable piece of work- the artistry of format/graphics/typeface etc. lends the credibility of professionalism to the straightforward communications of the content.

Only one statement in the whole issue is possibly less than standard relative to the excellence of truth elsewhere in the issue. I speak of WEREWORINGS (sic) on p. 15, 5th paragraph. When you write of the "children of Maat", are you speaking of a group of initiates naming themselves such as an 'order' or group name, or is the term intended to mean those who are of the Priesthood of Maat?

If the latter is intended, then it is NOT true to say "Their background is politically anarchist and feminist, their magickal traditions are those of ceremonial magick, Wicca, and working with the dark 'rituals of the old times'."

The quoted statement applies to the O.A.I. (and whosoever espouses the definitions thereof); it does NOT apply to the Priesthood of Maat. Maat is neither anarchist nor feminist -- LIBER PENNAE PRAENUMBRA channels a viewpoint that can only be called 'humanist' -- and that's only partly true.

Maat is Truth, Tao, That -- feminism is a single aspect among many of humanism. Anarchism is the Heat Death of the Universe, the Entropy Formula. Maat cannot be defined or claimed exclusively by any ISM or OLOGY. That there should be some lack of clarity on this subject is quite understandable in the light of the contemporary practice of Orders etc. attempting control of Power and its vessels/masters.

The O.A.I. is a group of bright and personable people, but there should be a delineation between a certain defined group's philosophy or background and that of the general Aeonc Formula it links with.

I speak from no other authority than that of the thing itself: justice is blind. Maat isn't female any more than it's male -- Truth contains the Pairs of Opposites and cannot be defined by them -- it's false to reason from the particular to the general. So please! The OAI may be feminist-anarchist, but the Priesthood of Maat isn't. Nor do we work with the dark "rituals of the old time".

We work the rituals of the NOW, not of the "old time". Spontaneous improvisation of dancing on the crossroads of spacetime -- you yourselves illustrated the bus & cigarette rite which I use daily with unfailing success -- as have others of my acquaintance. That's a fine example of Maat Magick. So is





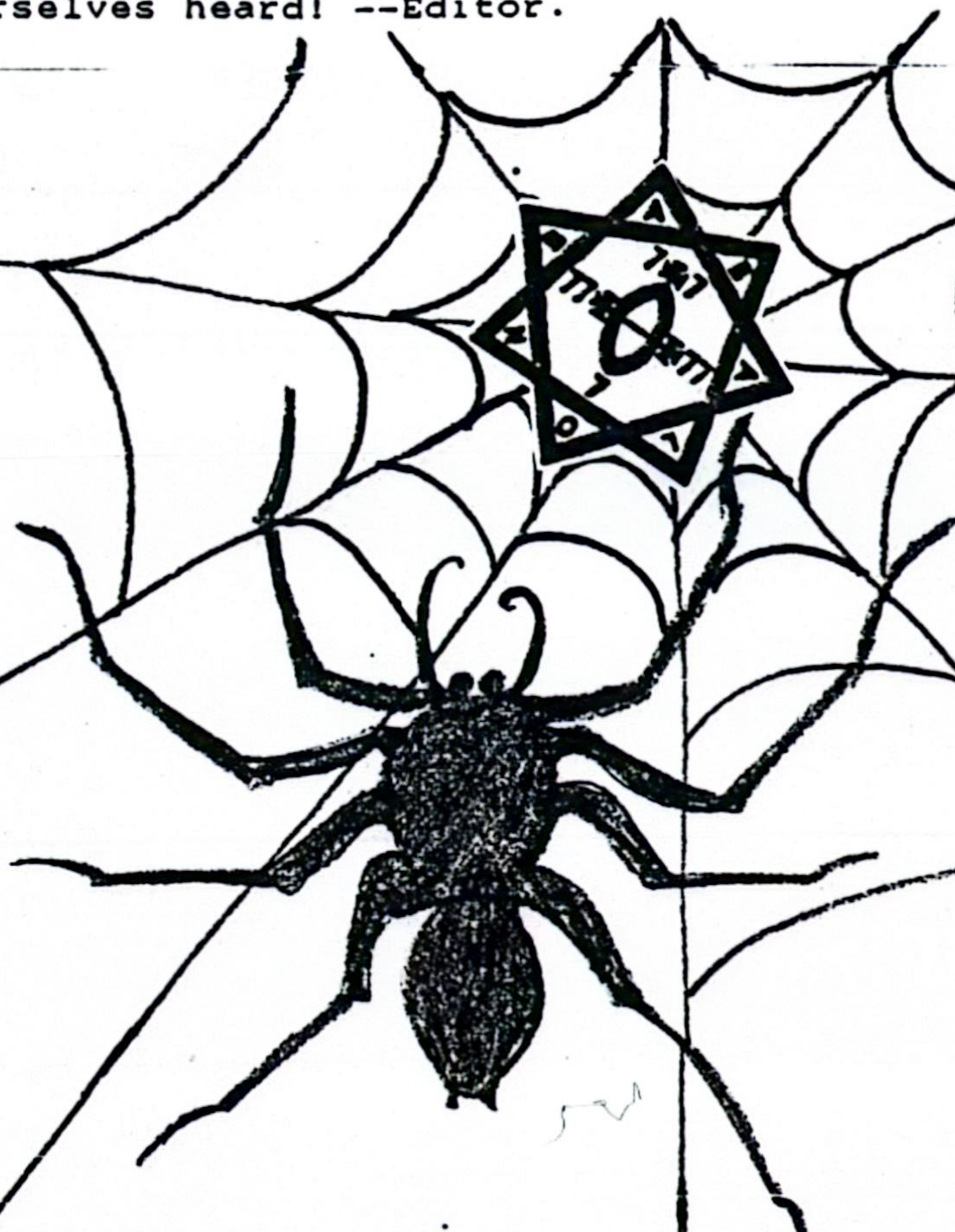
midwifing/ birthing/ becoming Homo veritas --& loading the dice for Homo's survival -- a work of art has the RIGHT to completion on its own terms!

The human race is an artwork of its own working -- we shape ourselves through language, music, images, gods, 'common sense' and all the other Magickal Tools. We're just beginning to get a feel for the medium of ourselves, and in the process, we discover the means of our own extinction. This is positively the last sentence on the subject here: Maat is Air, the Unconfined -- who would attempt to claim It for a cause errs greatly....

Take care, stay warm, Equinox is coming.

# MA'AT QABAL

The Mass or Invocation of the Forgotten Ones and the Elder Gods

## LIBER XI

Do what thou wilt shall be the whole of the Law.

### Introduction

The Ordeal was performed by Sr. Sothis and Fra. Zaegs, on the night of 11th/12th August 1982 after six months of intensive preparation, leading via the paths of the Devil and Death to a unity on Tiphareth, thence via the High Priestess to the threshold of Da'ath, by which means we proposed projecting ourselves in union, to 'Universe B'.

The work involved followed Thelemic practice, modified by an Entity, Ano'in, who clearly indicated the Ma'atian aspect of the work and the absolute control of the Forces generated at Masses worked on lower levels. Further modifications were made from







recommendations by Nema (formerly Andahadna 124 of Bate Cabal, Cincinnati) in private correspondence, thus producing a balanced growth towards the aim of transition between the Illusion and the World. Thanks for reproducing some of the actual Mass are due to the Bate Cabal, who published an article in Issue 3 of the Cincinnati Journal of Ceremonial Magick.

In the experience of Sr. Sothis and Fra. Zaëps the performance of the Ordeal created a cataclysmic realization of the Gynander-nature. (See British Journal of Ma'at No.1). The fragments of Self we call our individuality, and by which means we agree to inhabit the Earth, allow also acceptance of the conventions known as Natural Law, and permit habituation of bodies having sexual identity, but spiritually this is no longer true for us. We wear no Mask, and Initiation becomes a process of continuous unveiling.

The Word 'IPSOS' reaffirms the statement that "...there is no God where I am."; we behold the Divine Unity within ourselves and the Universe we have created. The fusion of spirits produces a condition unknown to those who have not sought to attain it.

#### The Preparation

For twenty-eight days before the Ordeal, three Masses of Ma'at were performed, and the following points were the subject of meditation in preparation for the formation of the Gynander,



should the work prove to be successful and 'Universe B' be achieved.

1. Major events of past life, both good and bad, working from the earliest memory to date. Consideration of each, dismissing it, appreciating each as ultimately beneficial. (Karma)

2. Consider oneself as having been directed to this moment, through Karma, and to the decision to 'rise above' the plane of Earth, to become a 'Planetary Being' or a 'Cosmic Entity' of which one's self is the other half (e.g. the electric or the magnetic).



3. Confirm to oneself that "...there is no God where I am." and have the courage of conviction in the face of scepticism, laughter or worse.

4. Confirm to oneself that one believes in oneself, one's visions, intuitions and instructions as well as one's partner's, and that one will not be tempted off the path.

5. See oneself as a translucent spirit, having dismissed the past, and ready to begin a new kind of life.

6. Understand that being committed to (and one half of) a Gynander, one's aim is to construct an impeccable spiritual, planetary Being, having one Will, and executing it wisely.

7. As such be aware of other spiritual Beings, Entities and Masters, and divine their intentions, friendly or alien. Heed all extra-sensory perceptions and instructions.



8. This is so one, as a Gynander, will assist in bringing Order out of Chaos on all levels.

9. As a Mistress/Master of the Astral Temple, one has this obligation in health and in weakness.

The Key mantras for the preparation were VAM MANI PADMA HUM and LAM AGLA IPSOS.


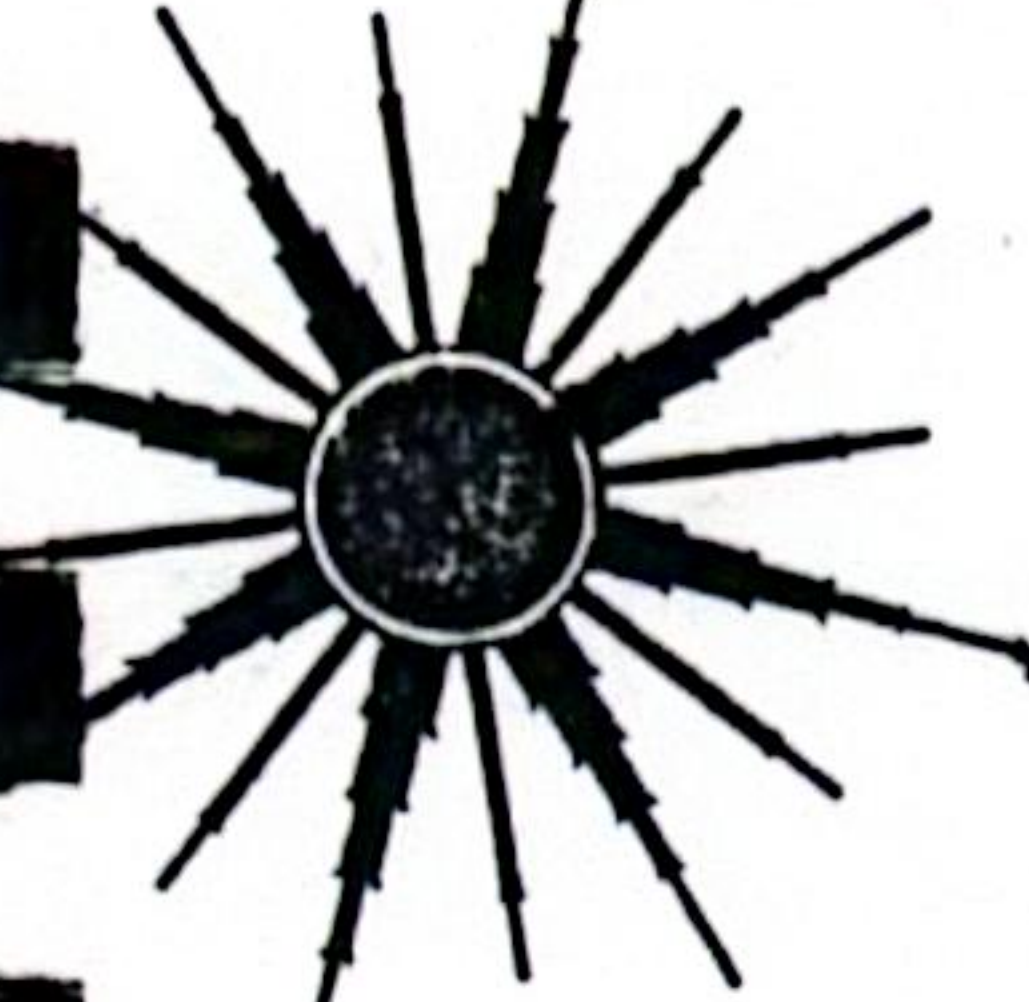
#### Requirements for the Ordeal

Daggers, Wand, Chalice, Pentacle, Wine, Bread, Water, Incense; tobacco, mantra beads, bedroll, black clothing, rainwear with hood, compass, four pegs for Quarters, lantern or torch. Coffee or fruit juice for use if necessary and some food to be taken before the return journey.

Aspirants are required to be sexually abstinent for seven days, and to fast for twelve hours (but not less than six), taking only water or ginseng tea.

The site chosen shall be out of doors in a natural, isolated spot; in a woods, or on the side of a hill or mountain etc.

The Ritual that follows is that of Ma'at Qabal, based on the work of Sr. Nema and modified in the light of our guidance. It is understood by the Aspirants that their life, having performed the Ritual, is offered to Ma'at, and that all they do shall be prefaced by 'astral ritual' and in a 'magickal mind'. They shall



be conscious of their partners at all times since they are irrevokably joined as a Divine Gynander.

### The Ritual

Having observed the requirements listed above, the Aspirants shall, well before sundown, select a suitable place, near a tree if possible, and place a flat stone or log to act as an altar. The Cup and Pentacle are placed upon it. Beside are placed on one side a bowl of water, and on the other the incense bowl or stick.



When the Sun has dropped below the horizon, the Ps (Priestess) shall cast a Circle eleven feet in diameter, the P (Priest) placing pegs at each Quarter.

Ps: "I conjure thee, o Circle of Power, to be a boundary between us and the Forces of the Earth and of the Cosmos, that we shall be protected this night from any denizens of Evil of the Underworld, from Mankind at large, and from Alien Cosmic Entities. In the name of Ma'at, I seal thee."

P : "So be it."

P takes dagger to each Quarter, and banishes as follows: "I banish you foul shades of the East (S,W,N) from this sacred place, in the name of (X), Ruler of this Day. Protect us in our Temple, ye Masters, Lords and Angels of Light, that we may pass unscathed. So be it."

The P and Ps shall then sit and drink wine and smoke if



desired, until it is quite dark. They shall instruct each other and meditate as they wish. It is important to maintain full consciousness at this stage.

When it is quite dark they shall rise and fill the Cup with wine and place two pieces of bread upon the Pentacle. They shall then purify themselves, forehead, mouth and genitals. They then stand facing each other across the altar, P facing East and Ps facing West.

P : "Do what thou wilt shall be the whole of the Law."

Ps: "Love is the law, love under will."

Both: "There is no god where I am."

P : "It is our Will to invoke Ma'at for the evolution and awakening of Mankind."

Ps: "By the same mouth that drinks from the Cup of Babalon shall the Elixir be taken; by the same mouth that swallows the Cosmos shall the breath of Mankind be exhaled."

P : "I invoke Ma'at, She-Who-Moves."

Ps: "I invoke Truth, Justice and Righteousness."


P : "I invoke the Black Flame."

Ps: "I invoke the Crystal Lotus."

Both: "ABRA-HAD-ABRA, IPSOS, MA'AT."

Ps: "Bearer of the Wand, I command thee: enter my House, there to dwell."

Then shall they perform the Alchemy. They shall take the




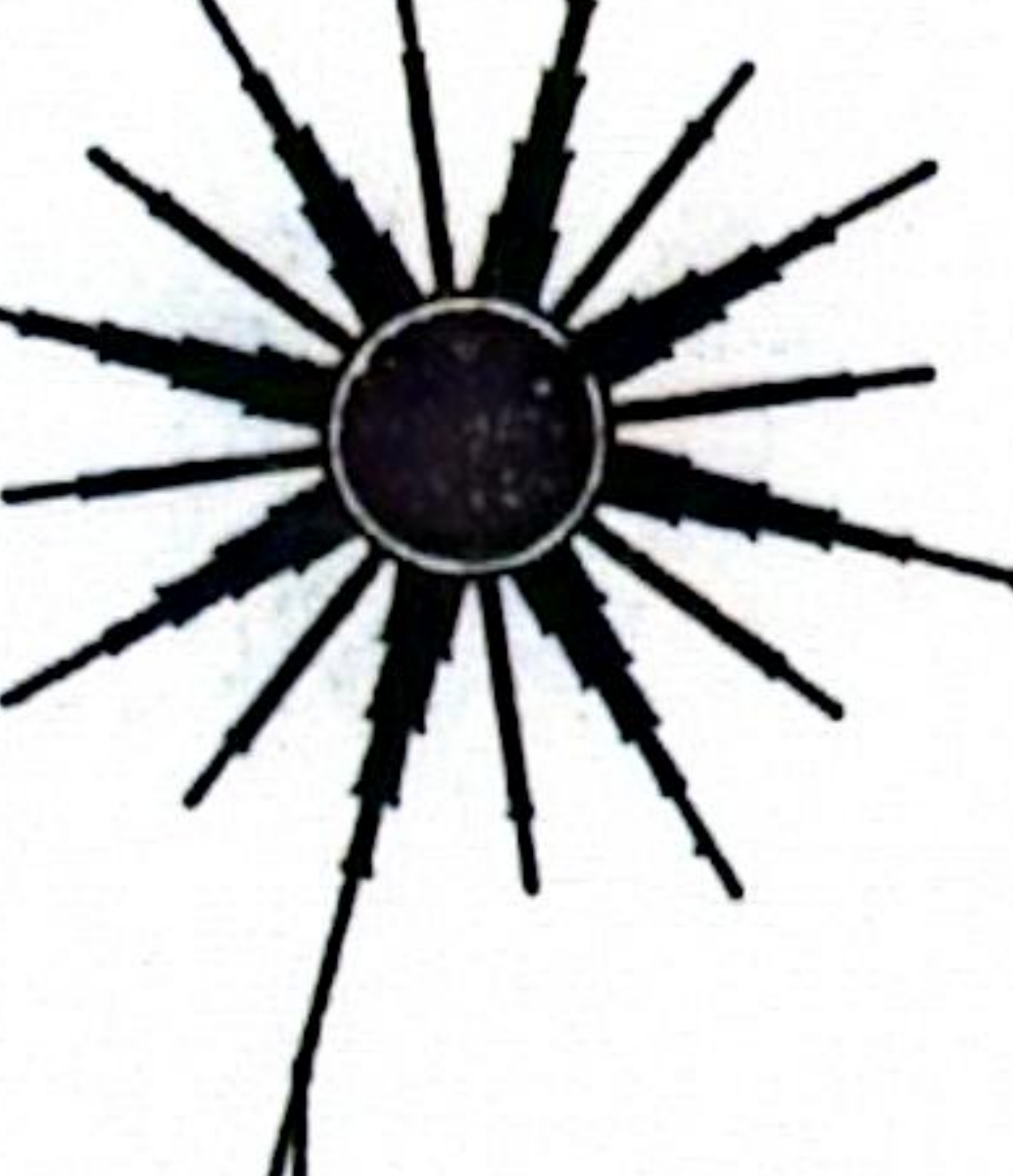
Elixir. P then anoints the wine and the bread, saying: "I anoint thee with the Sacred Elixir."

At this point notes should be taken of any phenomena that may occur.

When ready, they shall stand facing each other across the altar, N-S, and shall intone the mantra LAM AGLA IPSOS eleven times. They shall then kneel on either side of the altar and consume the Elixir Bread and Elixir Wine.

When this is done, they shall put on extra clothes and hood if cold, and enter the bedroll. From this point and for the rest of the night careful vigil shall be kept. They shall plunge their daggers into the earth on either side of themselves, holding the hilt with one hand and joining hands. Thus a complete circuit is formed (with the earth) and must be maintained throughout the night. They shall rest in silent meditation for a while. When ready they shall recite a mantra (AUM) using beads or a counter, but still keeping in contact.

After this one shall lie down and take Prana, whilst the other keeps vigil, meditating or chanting. They shall take turns doing this until the first light of dawn, taking notes during the vigil of any and all relevant thoughts, visions, phenomena, aspirations, clairaudience or automatic writing. They shall drink wine or water, and smoke during their vigil if it be their Will. It will be noted that a trancelike state or semi-consciousness is



obtained during and perhaps throughout the vigil.

At first light, they shall rise, fill the cup and toast the morning; they shall then earth the Power, in the manner which seems best to them. They shall take the Elixir as before.

They then stand before the altar, facing East, and chant:

"Hail Ma'at!

Open the Eye

That destroys the Dream of Slaves.

Hail Shakti!

Hail Shiva!

Hail Kali!

Dilate Time, that we return to your devouring in freedom and strength.

We are one whose name is mankind

Sleeping dust, a god awakened

Turn, thou ancient enemy, we are not prey for your control,

By the same mouth, Gynander-Hive of Earth,

Is hunger cried out, and strength received.

By the same mouth, O Man-Soul made of stars



Is the morning hymn intoned,

and the Word of Will spoken to the Skies.

IPSOS

Do what thou wilt shall be the whole of the Law.

Love is the law, love under will."



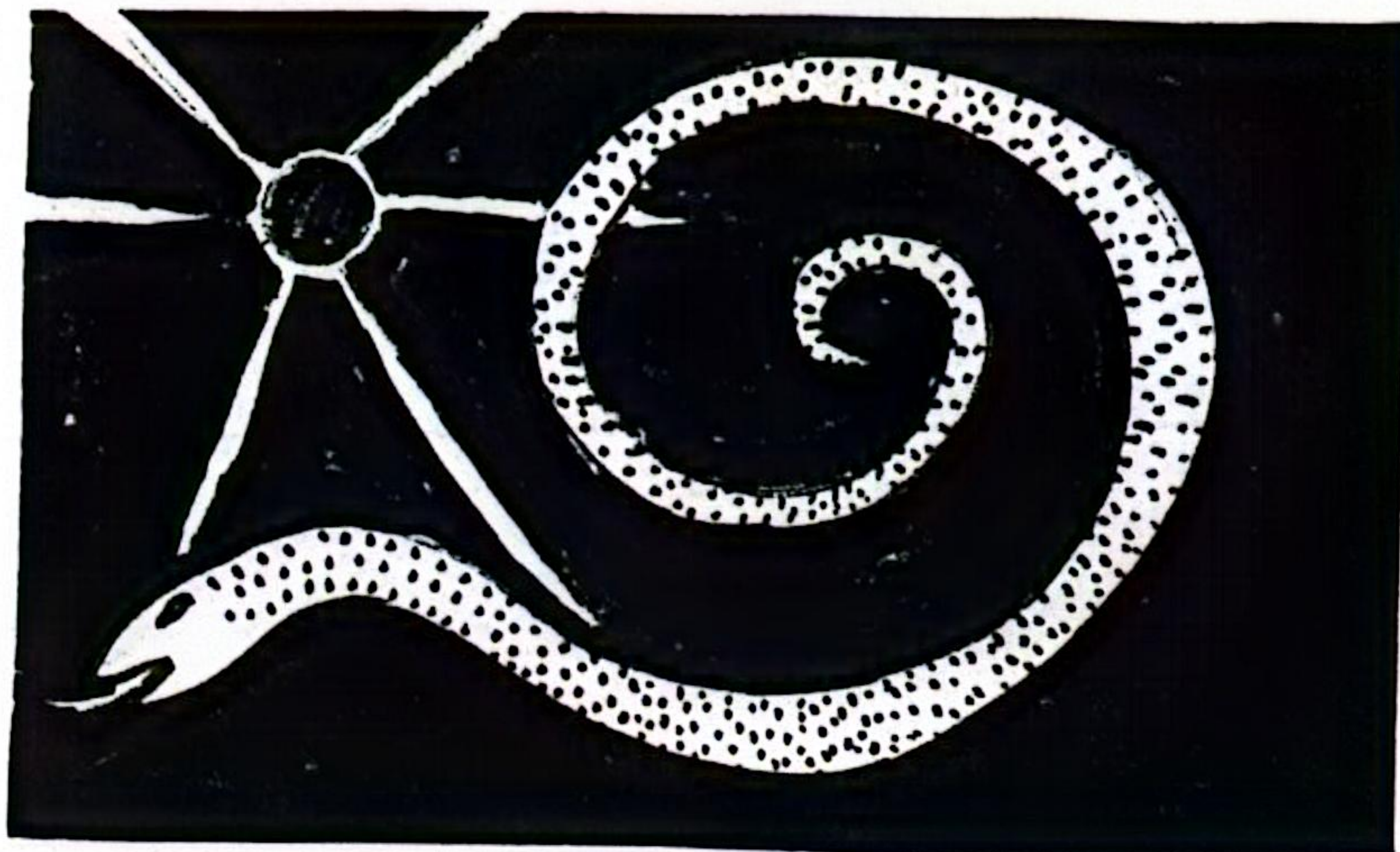


Ps and P embrace, allow their auras to blend, and say: "There is no god where I am."

They shall then open the Circle, collect their equipment and depart. A little food may be taken if desired.

NOTE: At no time after taking the Elixir Wine and Bread shall P and Ps lose physical contact with each other. If toilet is desired during the night, this must be done in the Circle, the other holding both Daggers.

It is permissible to discuss any visions, dreams or other phenomena during vigil, or to express any fear, joy or enlightenment etc.





# Ordo Adeptorum Invisiblum

*'Every man and every woman is a star.'*

A FEAST FOR THE EQUINOX OF THE GODS  
September 29, 1982

"A feast for the Supreme Ritual, and a feast for the Equinox of the Gods." --Liber AL, II:40.


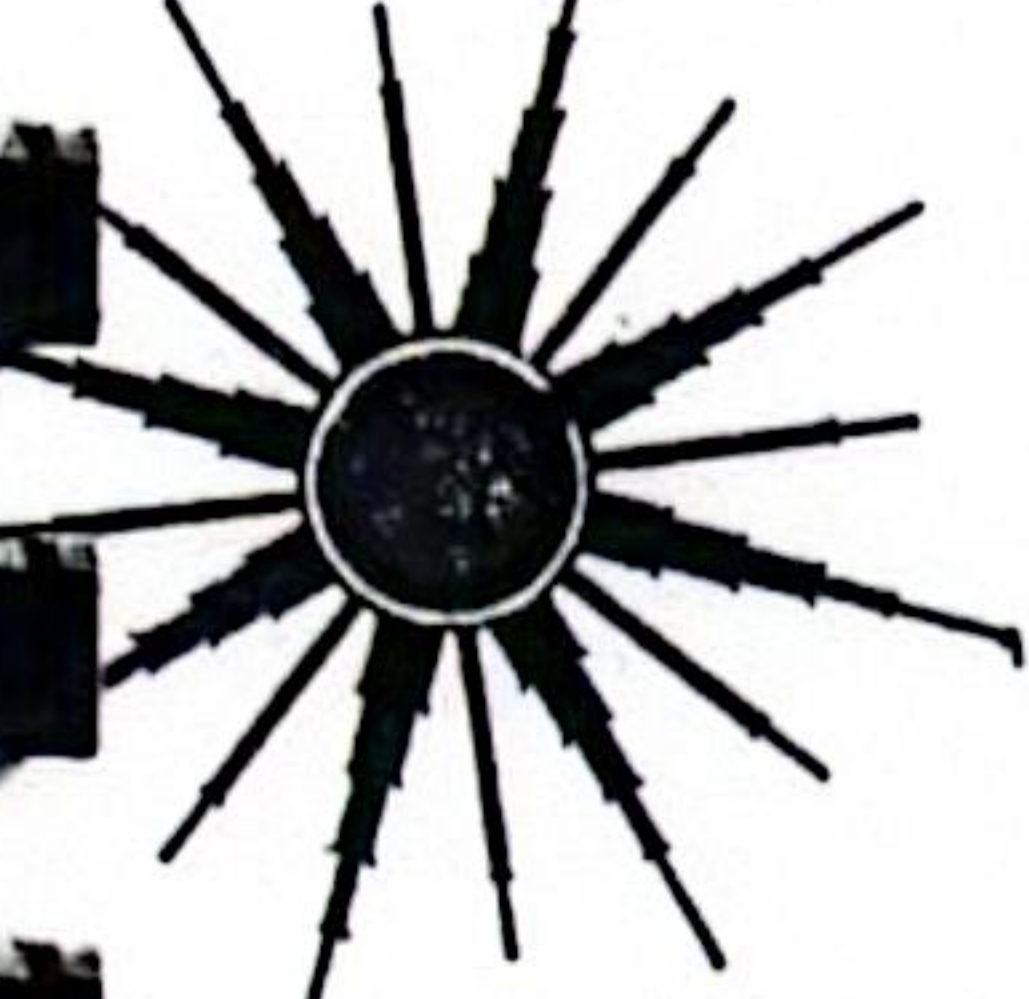
September 29, 1982 marked the anniversary of the founding of the Ordo Adeptorum Invisiblum in England in 1980 and the initiation of the OAI Chicago in 1981.

After all in attendance have taken their places, let a brief period of meditation begin. At the close of this time, all shall repeat the thelemic cross. The words are intoned as the right hand is placed on the points indicated. The palms of both hands are brought together for the final words, over the heart.

Forehead:	DU-NA-MOS
Solar Plexus:	THE-ME-LI-ON
Right Shoulder:	NI-KON
Left Shoulder:	SO-PHI-I
Heart:	As it is said, so let it be done.

## SETTING THE FOUR QUARTERS

All stand. As each quarter is set, all face the persona standing at the quarter being set. If that persona is male, members of the circle should project power from the solar plexus; if female, from the heart. The power is projected as the word of power is intoned.



North: A-GA-PE  
West: DI-KAI-O-SU-MES  
South: THE-LE-MA  
East: E-LI-A-THE-RI-ON

Reading from Liber AL, from the east quarter: II:35-44; I:52  
Response:

Priestess: Do what thou wilt shall be the whole of the Law.  
People: Love is the law, love under will.  
Priestess: The word of the Law is Thelema.  
People: and Every man and every woman is a star.

#### THE BURNING OF THE SIGIL

A sigil indicative of the work of the OAI during the last year shall have been prepared. It shall be presented by the persona in the south to the priest. He shall hold the sigil while simultaneously releasing the past and impressing his will for the next cycle upon the sigil. He shall then pass it to each person present. The last to receive it shall be the priestess, who shall burn the sigil, releasing all that has gone into it.

#### THE GIVING OF THE GIFT

A gift, a visible product of the work of the OAI during the past cycle shall have been prepared before the feast. One gift for each person shall be offered. The gift shall be presented by the persona in the west, who shall explain the nature of the gift. As the gift is presented to each person, the persona shall say, "it is the Law to give." (Liber AL, III:39)

The response:

Priest: Do what thou wilt shall be the whole of the Law.  
People: Love is the law, love under will.  
Priest: The word of the Law is Thelema.  
People: and Every man and every woman is a star.

#### THE ORACLE OF THE NEW CYCLE

In turn each person present shall open the Book of the Law as an oracle for the next cycle. The priestess shall begin and seek an oracle for the OAI. The priest shall then seek an oracle for the Outer Head of the Order. Each person in turn shall find an oracle for her/himself. After all have read, the priest and priestess shall read for themselves.

After the oracles have been received, the working shall be closed as the priestess wills.

Feasting shall follow.

    And unto me all things must return.

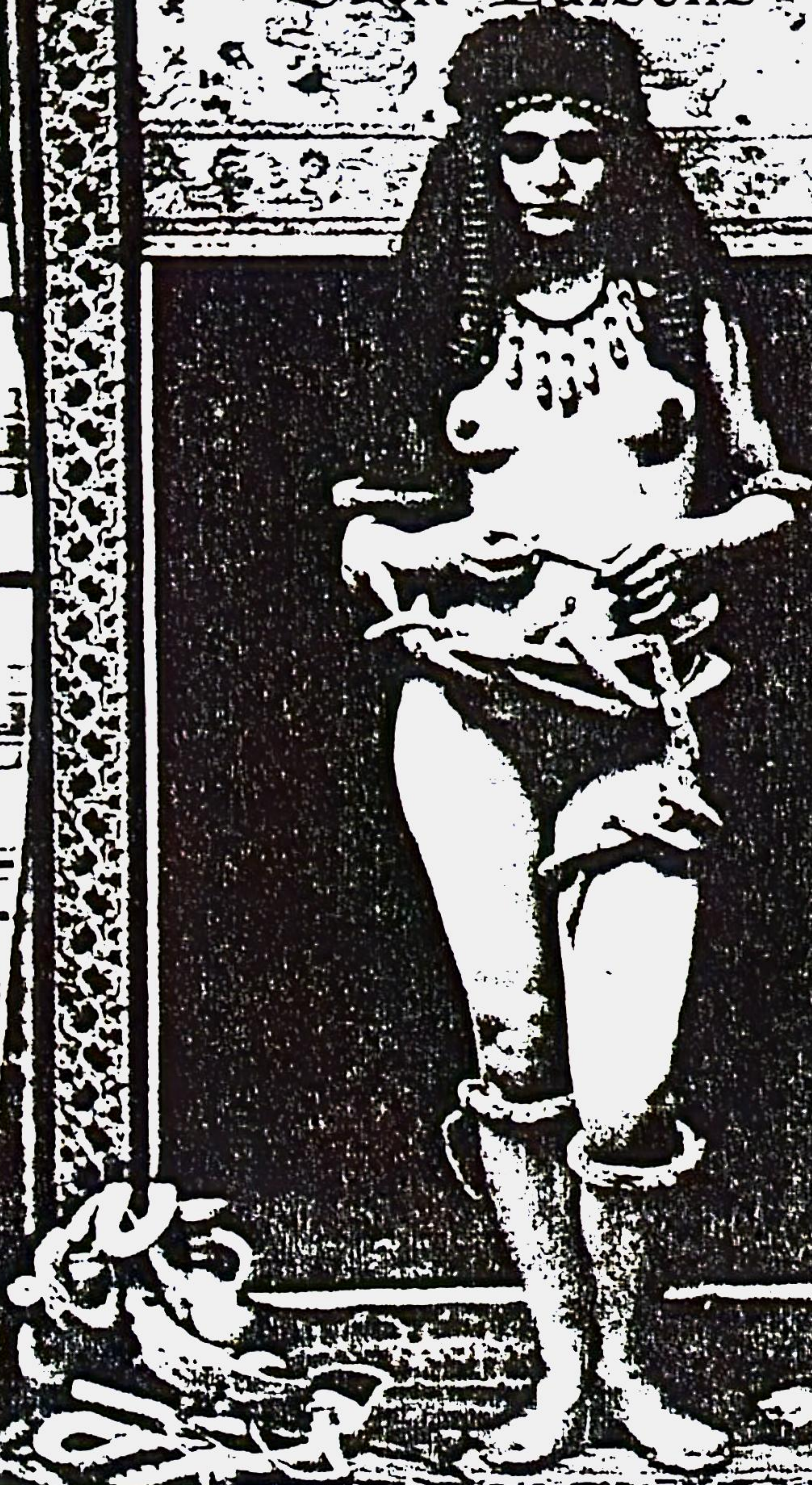
Before my face, beloved of all,

6 He shall receive the power of heaven

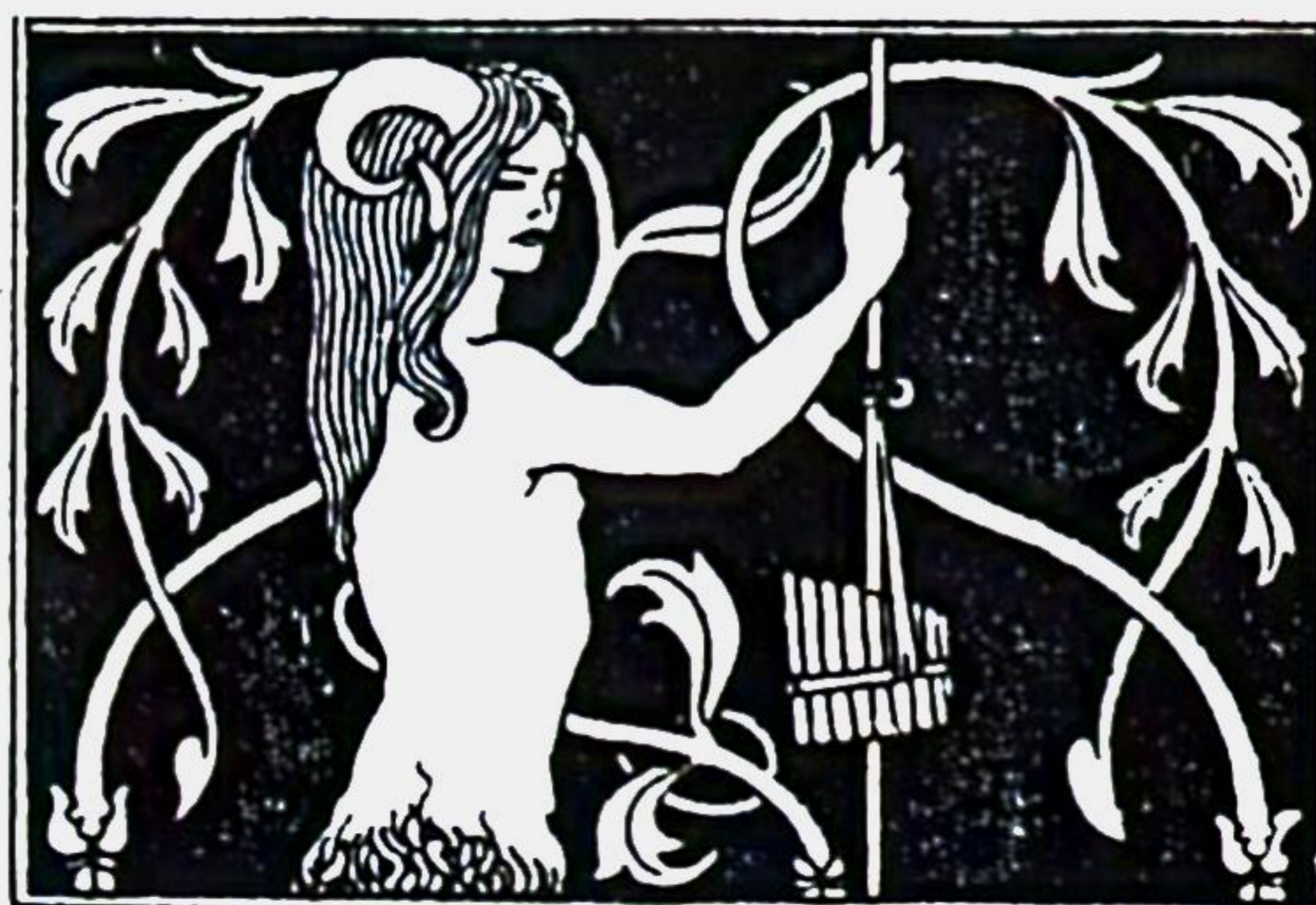
7 He shall worship the shrine and star

PAN TO ARTEMIS: A Thelemic-Wiccan Ritual

Frater BYThOR

Priest of ANAT-SEKHMET-ASHTORETH/Temple of Thelemic-Wicca

(NU-BBLN-MA'AT)

This is a ritual specifically dedicated to the Goddess in her myriad forms from the perspective of the male priest. In this sense the final result of the invocation is a masculinized Goddess force which acts as a feminizing influence upon the priest-Pan.

The text of the ritual consists of two works by Aleister Crowley: "Hymn to Pan" and "Pan to Artemis". The author has used this ritual successfully for almost three years, including a year of weekly use. It has been an excellent vehicle for raising both the male Pan and female Artemis principles in androgynous harmony. The ritual also serves as a New-Aeon formula reconnecting the Craft with Thelemic roots.

The greatest challenge facing the Thelemic-Wiccan priest is that of maintaining a balance between his dual characteristics; work with lunar currents tends to produce astral dreams and accompanying physical hangovers, necessitating appropriate balancing of forces. Thus it is advisable to work with Goddesses containing within themselves masculine traits. Such solar

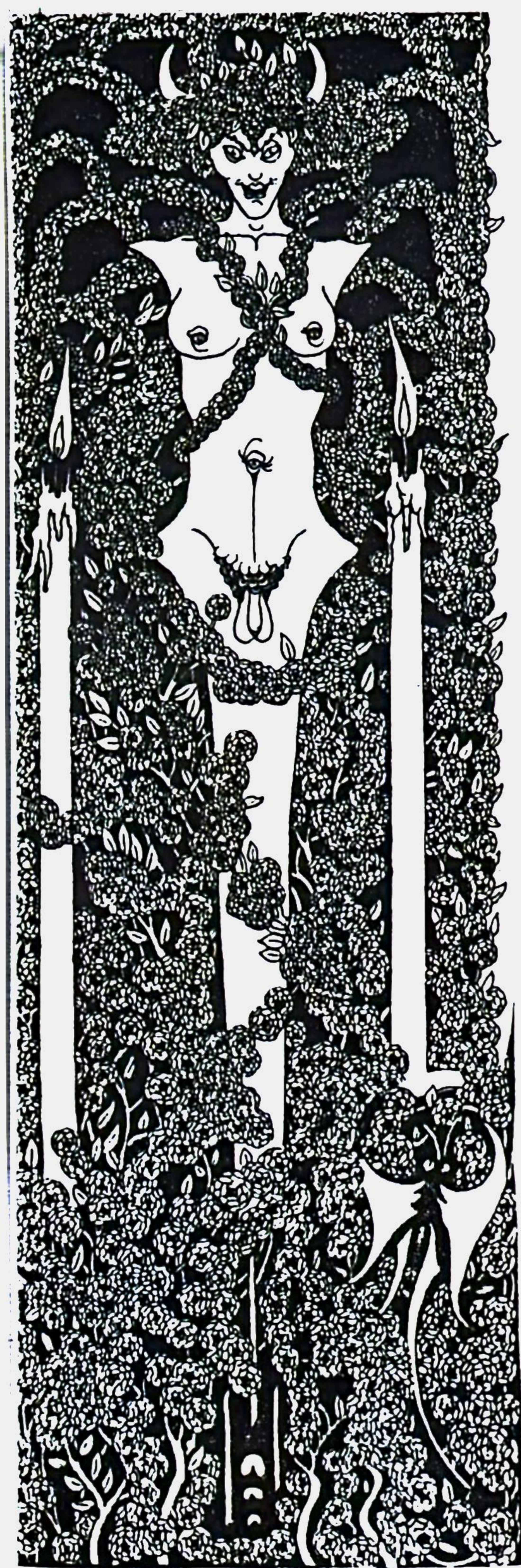
goddesses as Babalon, Sekhet, Anat, Ishtar, and Ashtoreth contain a masculine principle, while Nephthys, Ma'at, Isis, Hathor, Artemis, Selene and Hecate are lunar or chthonian feminine.

Moreover, the priest cannot deny his own 'maleness' even as he sacrifices it to the Goddess. To this end the "Hymn to Pan" invokes this maleness whereupon Pan sacrifices it to Artemis as huntress; the "Fiery Valkyrie" being Anat, Sekhet, Ishtar or Babalon.

The author's initiation into the use of "Pan to Artemis" was on the Vernal Equinox of Anno LXXV. Its first use as a formal ritual was on the Summer Solstice of Anno LXXVI.

## *Hymn to Pan*

Thrill with lissome lust of the light,  
O man! My man!  
Come careering out of the night  
Of Pan! Io Pan!  
Io Pan! Io Pan! Come over the sea  
From Sicily and from Acardy!  
Roaming as Bacchus, with fauns and pards  
And nymphs and satyrs for thy guards,  
On a milk-white ass, come over the sea  
To me, to me,  
Come as Apollo in bridal dress  
(Shepherdess and pythoness)

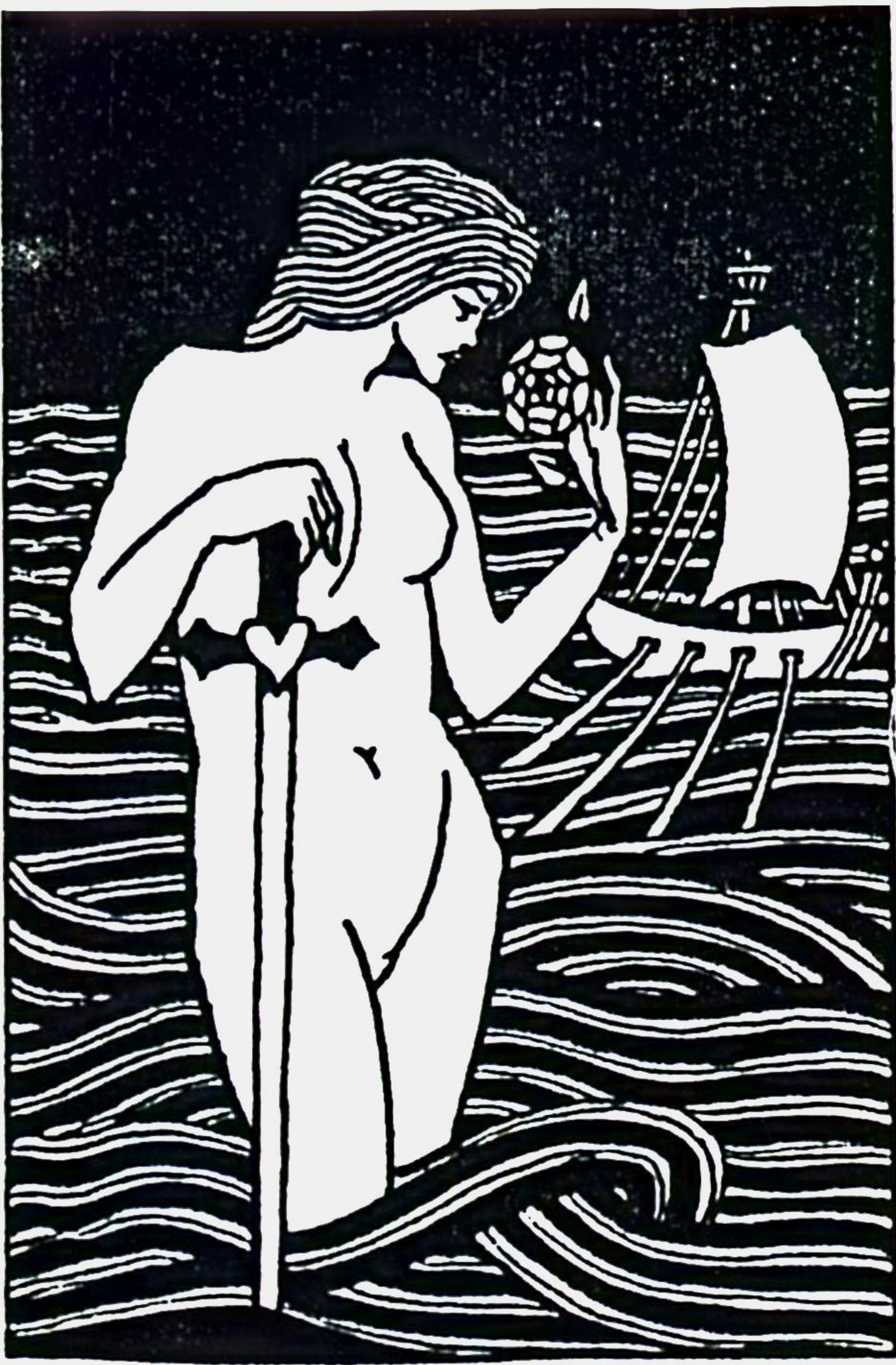


### Invocation of Pan

Herein there are two Altars in the North, placed upon green cloth and adorned in animal hides. Thereon stand the Horned God and the Warrior Goddess. The Incense is of Cedar, Pine and Musk. With the athame make the Circle deosil. Invoke Earth using a sigil of Fire in the four quarters, beginning in the North. Make the signs of N.O.X. in each Quarter, then circumnambulate deosil three times in the sign of Baphomet, ending in the North.

Invoke Pan charging forth with erect Wand. Reading from "Hymn to Pan" inflame thyself with prayer. (Optional: Read also Liber A'ash s.f. CCCLXX and/or the Prologue and verse 1 of Liber Lapidis Lazuli s.f. VII.)

Oils harmonious to the Incense may be used upon the Wand; chant Iacchus-Priapus-Omphallos-Pan. IO PAN, IO PAN PAN PAN, IO PAN ! The Elixir is not released until the opening of the Veil.



## *Pan to Artemis*

Uncharmable charmer  
Of Bacchus and Mars  
In the sounding rebounding  
Abyss of the stars!  
O virgin in armour,  
Thine arrows unsling  
In the brilliant resilient  
First rays of the spring!

By the force of the fashion  
Of love, when I broke  
Through the shroud, through the cloud,

Invocation of the Goddess and her Adoration

The Incense is of Frankincense (solar) or alternatively of the Moon. Again the Circle is made deosil, but now three times three, using a libation cup, the athame and incense thrice each. The form of the Goddess is unveiled, and she is invoked with the consecrated Wand by the reading of the first verse of "Pan to Artemis", and with a great pentagram of Earth with the sigil of Luna or of Venus (1) traced upon her. Move widdershins to the West (balancing the deosil invocation of the God) as in the Craft tradition, read the second verse and again make the Pentagram and Sigil. Repeat with successive verses in the South and East. Return to the North for the final verse, inflame thyself again with prayer, concentrating with full force upon the consecrated Wand, and then sacrifice the Elixir, containing and re-absorbing it. Upon reading the line "I invoke, I invoke", strike the Altar three times. Concentrate on the union of Pan with Artemis and the transformation of the God into the Huntress. Assume the form of the sign Puella. At this point consume the Libation invoking the trinity of Goddesses thou hast chosen, as Io Kore- Evoe Artemis- Io Hecate or Hail Isis- Hail Nephthys- Hail Ma'at, etc. Do this in batteries of three, and assume the form of the sign Mulier, saying thrice:

Hail Great One of triple form!

Thy lover and priest, Pan, calls thee forth!

Hail Mother, Sister, Lover!

Kore, Artemis, Hecate!

Hail Daughter, Sister, Lover!

Evoe Artemis Evoe!

Come Thou forth and join Thy lover

Who stands before Thee, singing praises!

My heart longs for thee!

It is filled with joy by thy holy presence here.

Great Mother, Holy Sister, Lover!

I call Thee forth to join me!

Purify me and strengthen me!

Allow me to see thy daughters on earth

As Thyself.

I aspire to see all thy daughters on earth as thy

secret self.

Goddess, Priestess, Lover,

I worship them as I worship Thee,

Seeing within them Thy glorious shining self.

Evoe Mother, Evoe Sister, Evoe Lover!

Evoe Artemis, Evoe Diana, Evoe Net! (2)

At the end of this recitation thou shalt be in the sign Mater Triumphans, or Isis Rejoicing.

Now meditate further upon the union of Pan and Artemis and their interchange, thus feminizing thy male self and imbibing power for thy female self.

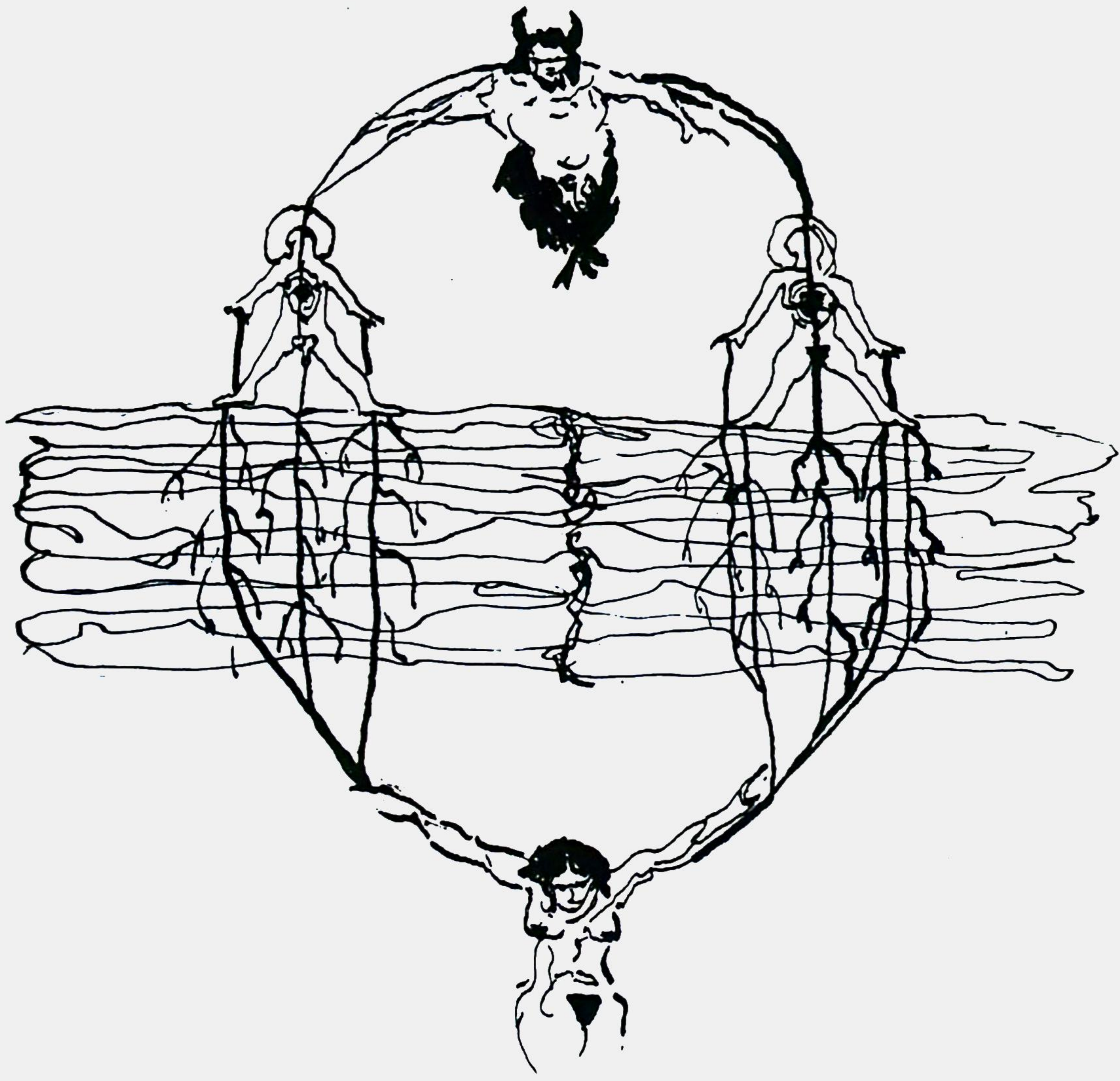
Close with the usual formulae.

Notes:(1) This ritual can be performed either on the New and Full Moon, or weekly on Monday or Friday. For Full Moons and Mondays the lunar sigil is recommended, while for New Moons and Fridays use that of Venus. Bear also in mind the correspondences of the particular Goddesses being invoked- see note (2).

(2) The deity names here are but examples; they should be made in batteries of three and reflect the Mage's initiated names for the Goddess. For most purposes a trinity of solar/venereal, lunar and saturnine/chthonian is recommended, as this parallels the IAO formula and is most balanced.

N.B. Although this ritual is designed for the use of a male, with a bit of creative alteration the sisters of the current could use its formulae to invoke the fiery, solar or martial qualities of such Goddesses as Anat, Sekhmet, Pallas, Babalon etc.

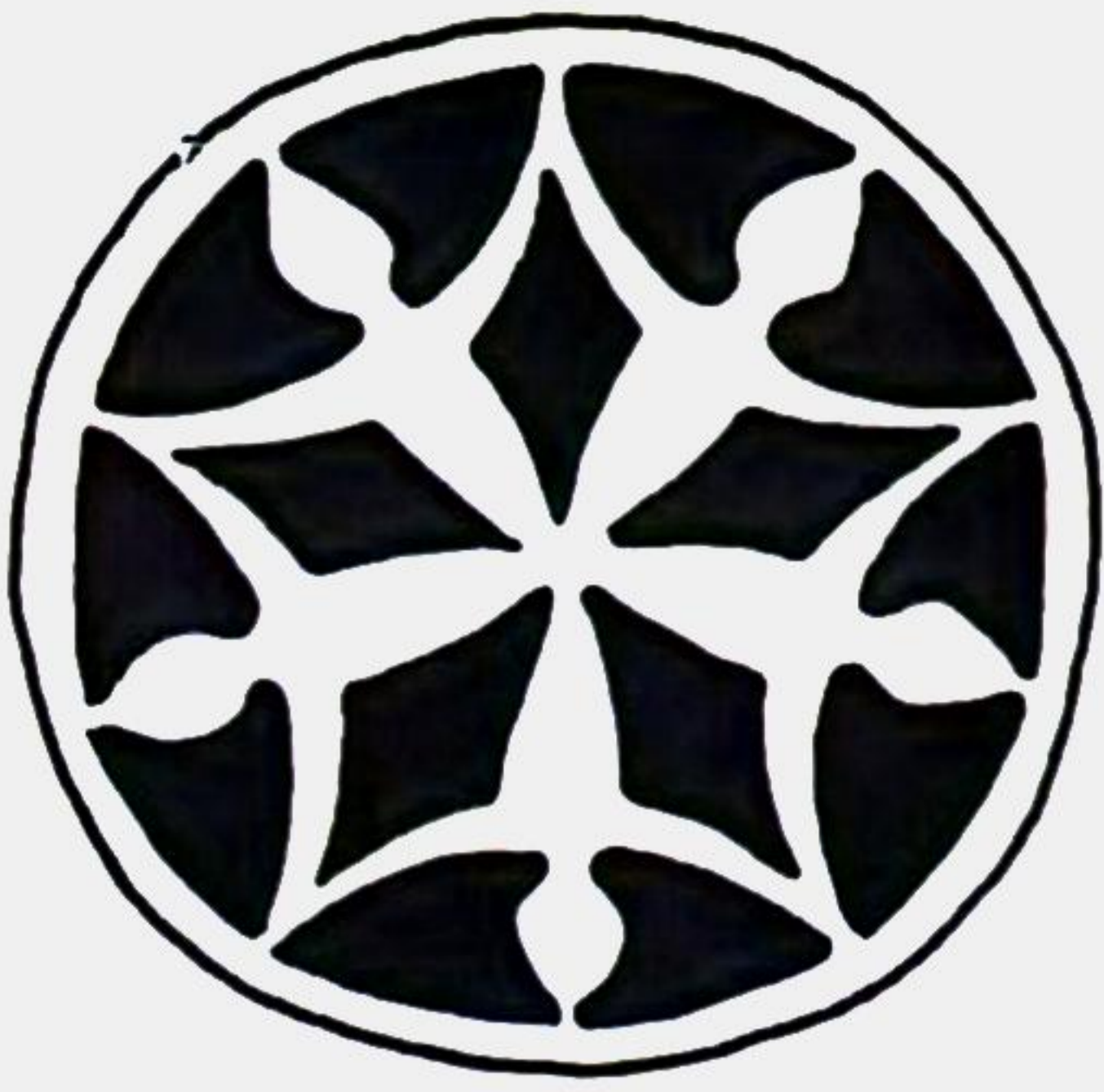
\* May I always grow in Inner Wisdom & Understanding. May I see every problem that I face as an opportunity to develop myself spiritually in solving it.

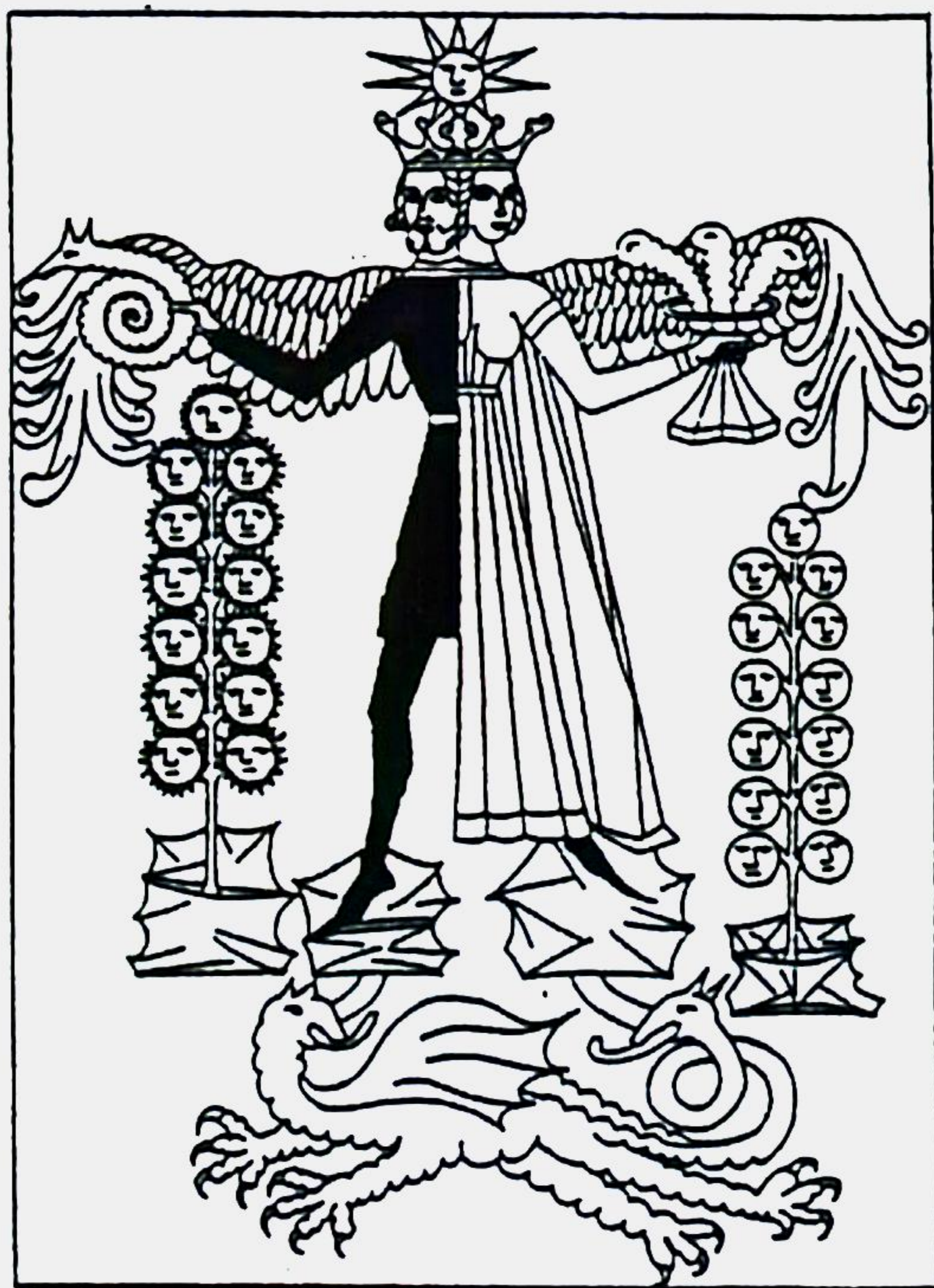

Report #1: Absinthe  
(*Artemisia absinthium*)

Names: Common Wormwood, Roman Wormwood, Sea Mugwort, Wormwood.

Ruling Planet: Mars, Luna                      Element: Fire

Drug Effects: Absinthinol, produced when the herb is soaked in alcohol, is a narcotic and hallucinogen.

Medicinal Uses: Stomach tonic, anti-spasmodic, anti-epileptic, treats worms in stomach and bowels.

Other uses: Insecticide when mixed with vinegar. Half and half heated vinegar and alcohol extracts may be used as a poultice for cuts and bruises.

Methods of ingestion: as tea, liquor, smoked or as incense.

Useful in baths for sore or stiff muscles.

Dangers: Overdose or extended use of absinthinol may lead to spinal nervous disorders, fits, damage to central nervous system.

Dementia Narcosis is possible after heavy use over long periods, i.e. daily use of one ounce (30 ml) liquor for several months.

Observations: After working with this herb for over three years, our studies show that small infrequent doses of absinthe can be a stimulating experience. It mixes well with other hallucinogens;



if taken in combination with mescaline, psilocybin or LSD it extends the period of effect by several hours. Avoid mixing with Datura sp. or other scopolamine-containing substances as it is antithetical to these and acts as an antitoxin.

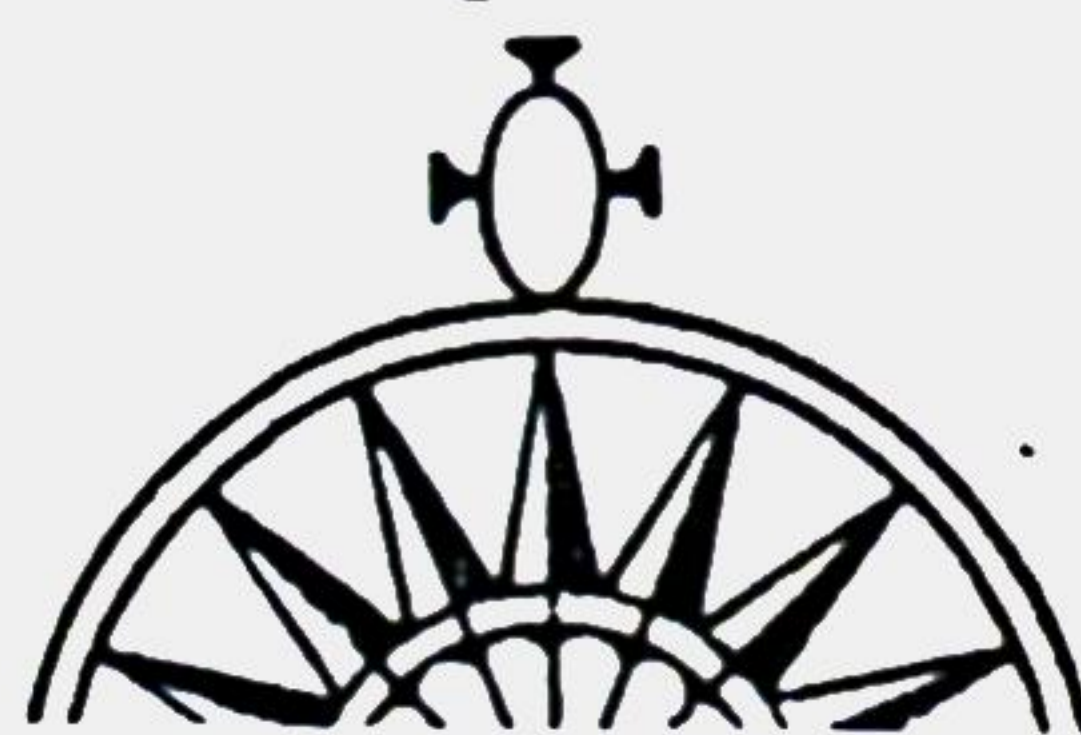
Absinthe is under the co-rulership of Mars and Luna. It gives a bodily narcotic effect, a sensation of relaxation or heaviness, while the mind is clear and subject to colour hallucinations. It should not be taken with wine or spirits, although it goes well with beer. It is good at parties if you wish either to dance all night, or to sit around and get 'colour rushes'. This is especially true when it is taken with hallucinogens. The narcotic effect reflects the lunar aspect, while the visual and mental stimuli are Martial.

Fifteen to thirty drops of Absinthe before retiring after heavy alcohol consumption will cause a stupor-like sleep leaving you feeling relaxed and refreshed the next morning.

Smoking wormwood, or another herb soaked in absinthe, will produce a half-hour 'body stone'. The tea is almost unpalatable unless cooled and drunk quickly. It will aid digestion and produce noticeable effects within twenty minutes.

Fifteen to thirty drops after a heavy meal will act as a stomach bitter, aiding digestion and reducing gas buildup.

Large doses are hallucinogenic. Try half an ounce (15 ml) at first; if there is no effect take similar doses at half-hour



intervals.

DO NOT take more than ONE OUNCE (30 ml) per HOUR.

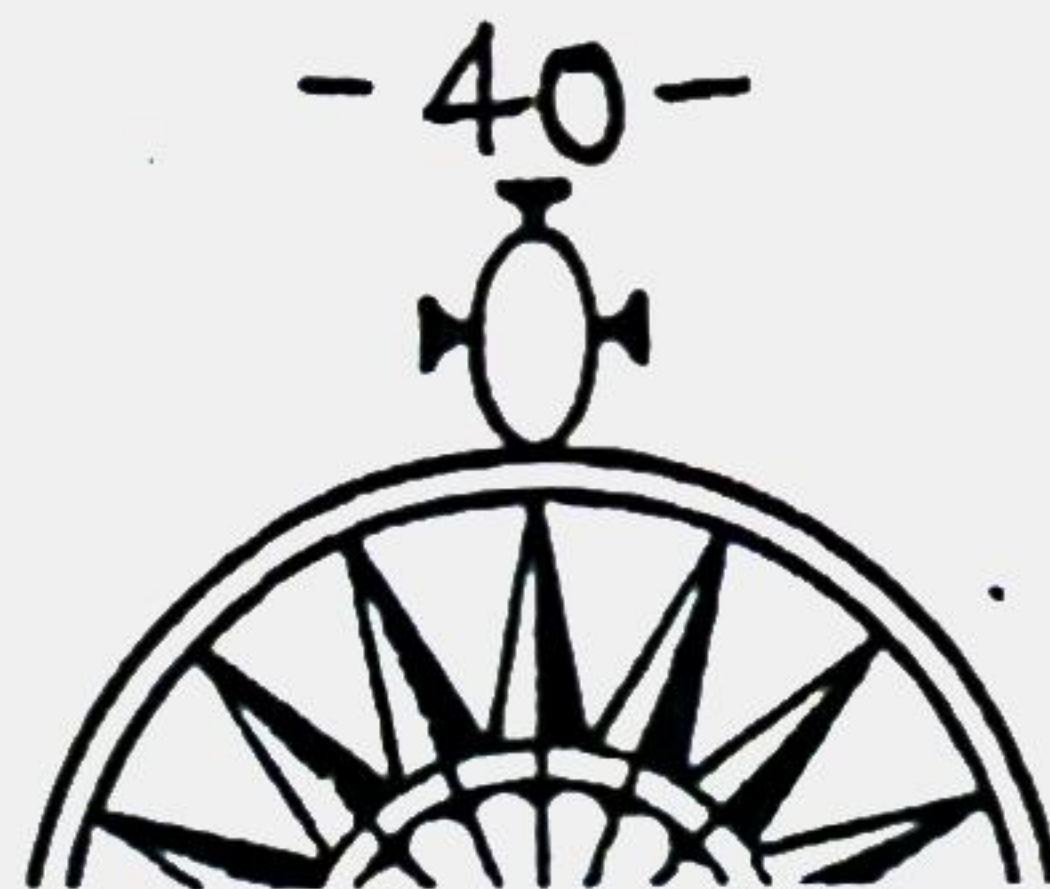
DO NOT take more than TWO OUNCES (60 ml) at one sitting.

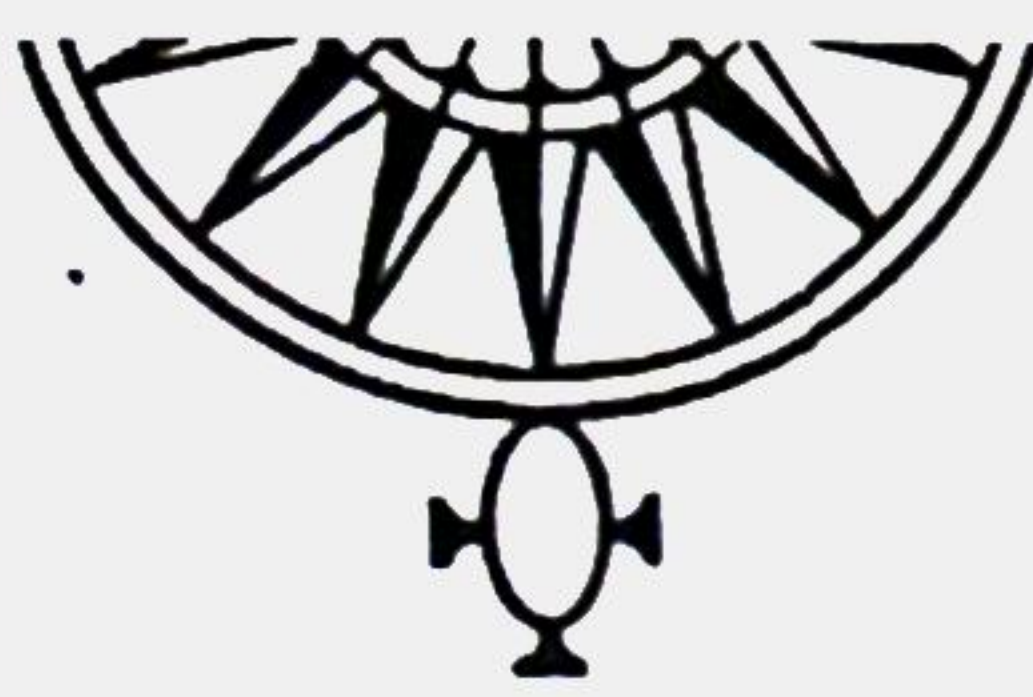
The above doses apply to individuals of average size and weight.

Preparation:           1 oz. (30 g) Wormwood  
                          26 oz. (700 ml) Pernod or Ricardo Liqueur  
                          26 oz. (700 ml) distilled water

Soak the herb in liqueur for a fortnight between Full and New Moons. Decant alcohol from herb, and put aside. Boil water and soak herb until the next Full Moon. Decant tea from herb, mix with alcohol extract and let stand. Dry the herb over the next fortnight until New Moon. Burn it to a fine grey ash (a propane or butane torch is useful here); this ash will contain the crystalline salts of the herb. On the New Moon add the ash to the liquid mixture, and shake at regular intervals over the next fortnight. The mixture will now taste very bitter. It should have a golden-brown colour with a greenish tinge, or flecks of electric green in it.

Allow the absinthe to stand for six months. This long period is to allow the bitterness to fade sufficiently to make the liquor drinkable, and to activate the absinthinol. After six months the drink will have transmuted into a smooth, bitter





liquor. But what a kick! instead of getting drunk you are stoned.

Prematurely decanted absinthe is still psychoactive, but it is very bitter and may cause stomach aches. Remember to start with small doses and increase them gradually.

Report #2: Damiana  
(*Turneria aphrodisiaca*)

Name: Mexican Damiana

Description: A small pale green shrub bearing yellow flowers. The dried herb smells minty and has a gold-green colour. The herb contains a greenish volatile oil which smells something like a mixture of mint and chamomile.

Range: Mexico, West Indies, California, Texas, and South America.

Ruling Planet: Venus

Element: Water

Drug Effects: Aphrodisiac.

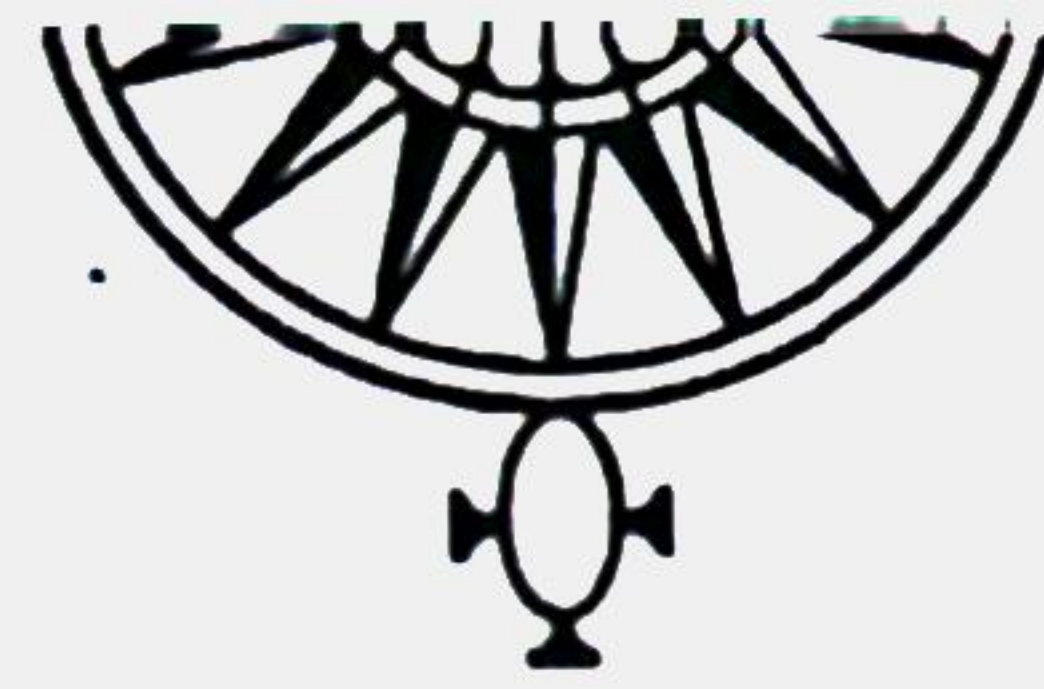
Medicinal Uses: Purgative, diuretic, tonic, stimulant.

Method of Ingestion: As tea, liqueur or in capsules.

Other Uses: In herbal smoking mixtures, or in baths as a stimulant.

Dangers: It has been said that extended use of the liquor can lead to liver disorders.

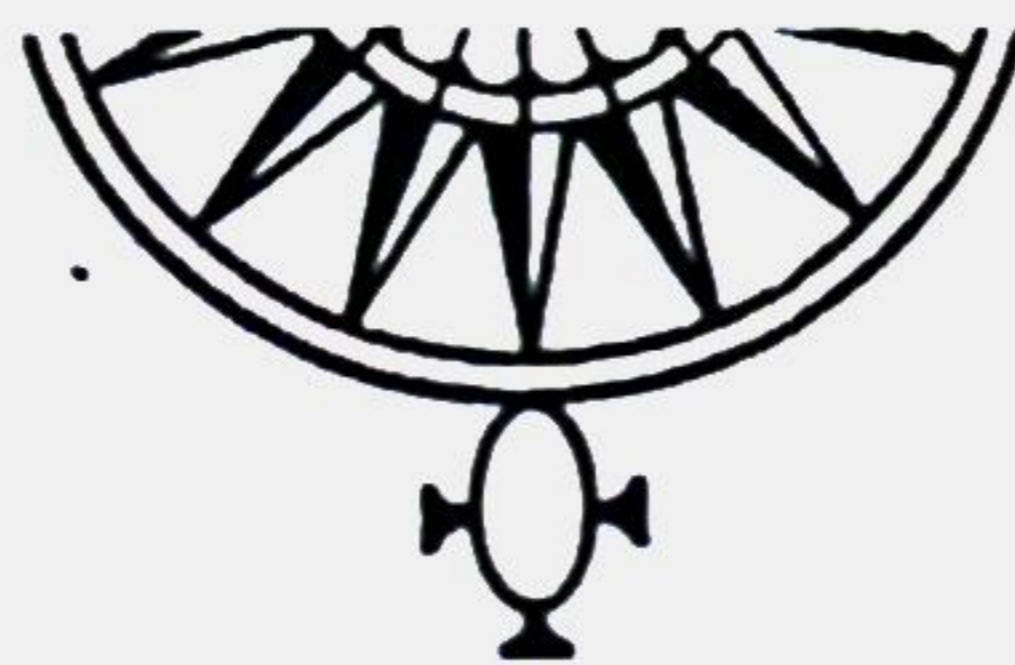
Observations: Damiana is most commonly known for its aphrodisiacal properties. It can be infused into a tea, or taken



in capsules mixed with other herbs to increase sexual vigour. We have been most successful in making a very good-tasting damiana liqueur. The drink seems to produce a relaxed state which helps one to feel more comfortable in any social situation. Impotence is a common male problem, usually caused by one's inability to relax and feel comfortable with another person; it is usually more a psychological than a physical problem. Some people report that they can become very sexually aroused by their fantasies, but cannot perform when faced with the 'real thing'.

With the help of a loving partner and the desire to get to know your sexual self, damiana can help correct this condition. Damiana is a medicine, and not something to make one 'over-sexed'. Our personal experience shows that with the right approach, damiana can help one attain and maintain a healthy sex life, and work out mental hangups which are the cause of the problem in the first place.

The effects of damiana can be best described as heart-warming. It seems to relax the nervous system, making it easier to 'open up'. Although the tea is pleasant to drink, the alcohol extract is stronger, and we have found this liqueur to be a most enjoyable social drink as well as an aphrodisiacal medicine. We have had no reports of unpleasant side- or after-effects from using the herb, and we find that it does not need to be used all the time to increase sexual potency. Many have



reported that they no longer require it at all, and that sexual expression comes as naturally as it should. This is good news, especially as some of these subjects had had serious sexual hangups and blocks. Obviously the inner experience differs from person to person, but experimentation with damiana may yield some pleasant surprises to those seeking its help.

Preparation:            2 oz (56 g) damiana  
                              26 oz (700 ml) vodka  
                              26 oz (700 ml) distilled water  
                              Honey and lemon & orange juice to taste

The procedure is the same as for the absinthe recipe above, except that after adding the ash do the following: Melt honey in a pot of boiling water and add to the liqueur along with lemon and orange juice to taste. Place the mixture in a cool, dark place and shake regularly until the next full moon. The extract is now ready to drink and gets better with age. Enjoy it!

We recommend a dosage of one or two glasses.

To make tea, steep one teaspoon of the herb in one pint (550 ml) boiling water. Simmer for twenty minutes and drink.

To take dry, combine equal parts of ground damiana, saw palmetto berries, ginseng and kola nuts. Put in #00 size gelatine capsules. Take 3 to 6 daily.

NOTE: We have found that damiana and damiana mixtures are best prepared starting in the hour and on the day of Venus, shortly before the (waxing) Full Moon.

**research:** Notes on the Enochian Tablets:2

Each square of the four Watchtowers and Tablet of Union is divided into five sections, to represent a truncated pyramid. The attributions of the five sections vary according to the position of the square in the Tablet.

The centre section of each square is coloured according to the element ruling the Tablet as a whole, except that the squares forming the Great Cross and Sephirotic Crosses are coloured white, representing the element of Spirit in each Tablet. The colours of the elements are as follows: Fire--red; Water--blue; Air--yellow; and Earth--black. The centre section of each square bears a letter, which in the case of a white square is black; elsewhere it is of the colour of the element ruling the quarter or 'Angle', except that in the Angle ruled by the same element as that ruling the Tablet, the letter is of the complementary colour. For example, on the Air Tablet the letters are coloured as follows:

- Upper Left....Air Angle.....mauve on yellow
- Upper Right...Water Angle...blue on yellow
- Lower Left....Earth Angle...black on yellow
- Lower Right...Fire Angle....red on yellow

Note that the element ruling a particular Angle is the same on all four Watchtowers, e.g. Air rules the upper left quarter of the Water, Earth and Fire Tablets.

In the Great Cross, the upper section of each square is always white, again for Spirit, while the lower section is coloured according to the element ruling the Tablet. The left-hand section is coloured according to the element ruling the sign of the Zodiac corresponding to the square. This is determined according to the following scheme: Each sign governs three squares, one for each of its decans. The squares in the centre of the Cross belong to the horizontal arms, so the two columns of the vertical arms are divided in the centre. Thus each line contains twelve squares, or four signs. The horizontal arms, or 'Linea Spiritui Sancti' are attributed to the four fixed signs, starting with the fixed sign of the element of the Tablet for the left-most three, and proceeding from left to right with the other fixed signs, in the opposite sequence to that of the Zodiac. Similarly, the left- and right- hand sides of the vertical column, or 'Linea Dei Patris Filique', are attributed respectively to the cardinal and mutable signs, starting at the top with the ones corresponding to the element of the Tablet and proceeding downwards in reverse order. For example, the Great Cross on the Water Tablet would be divided as follows:

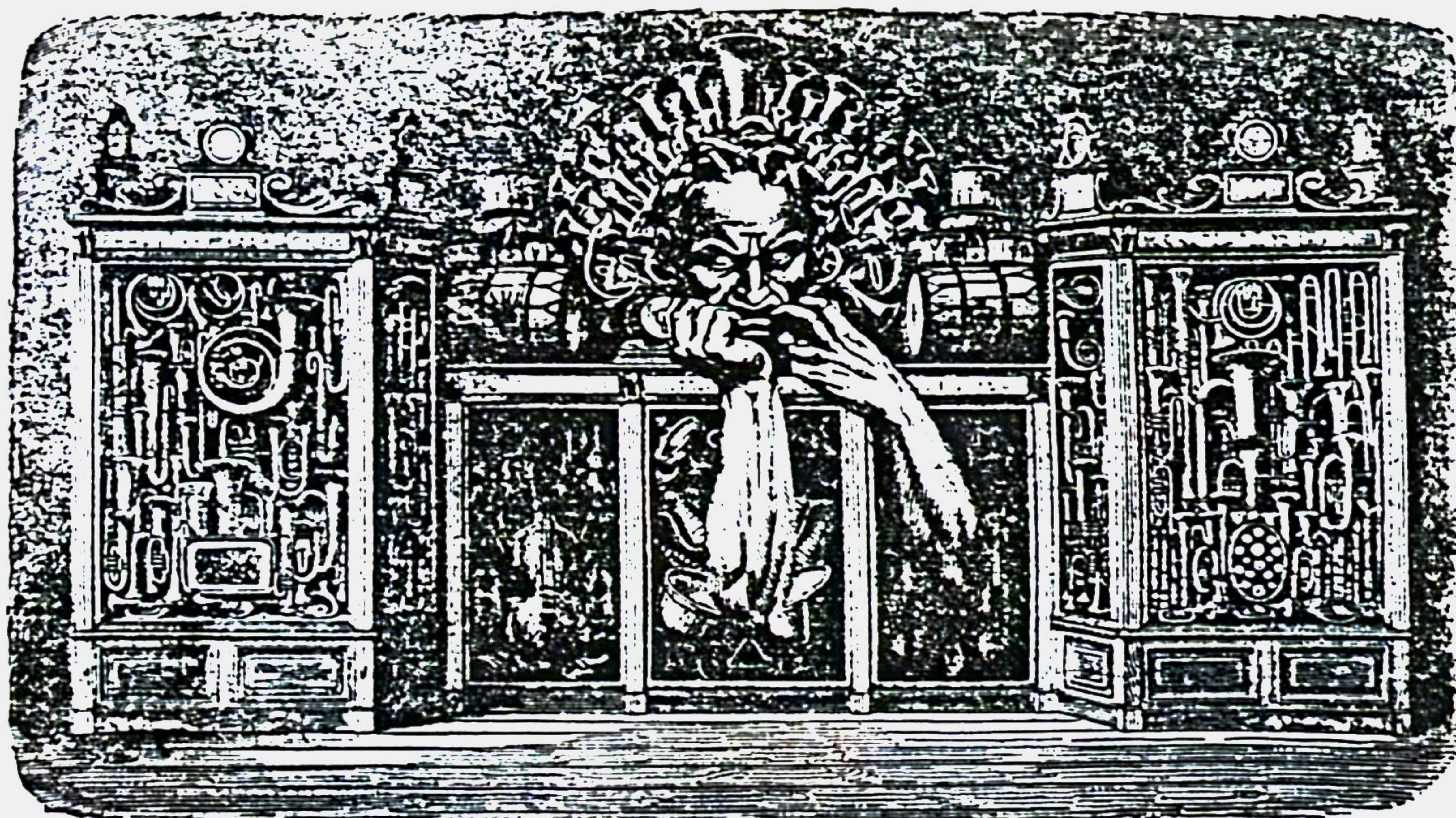
Studying this example should clear up any confusion on the procedure.

The right-hand section of each square on the Great Cross is coloured according to the planet ruling the decan corresponding: Sol, Jupiter--red; Mars--blue; Mercury, Saturn--yellow; and Luna, Venus--black. These planetary rulerships appear on the small cards of the Thoth tarot deck. If these are not available to check, the realms may be worked out as follows: Mars rules the first decan of Aries. The succeeding decans' rulers go around the Zodiac in descending order: Sol, Venus, Mercury, Luna, Saturn, Jupiter, Mars...ending with the third decan of Pisces ruled by Mars. Note that even though the order of the signs on the Great Cross is reversed, the decans still proceed left to right and top to bottom in each sign.

In the Sephirotic Crosses, both the top and bottom sections of each square are coloured white. The left-hand section takes the colour of the Tablet element, while the right-hand section is coloured according to the element ruling the Angle.

The third instalment of these notes will discuss the colouration of the remaining squares of the Watchtowers, and of the Tablet of Union.

# Book Review:

The Secret Temple  
Robert Wang: Samuel Weiser Inc, 1980.

This book is perhaps the best guide to the construction of magickal instruments and paraphernalia on the market today. Robert Wang's writing is clear, precise and concise. The book is easy to read and gets right to the point, dispensing with the mystical mumbo-jumbo which gives the reader of some authors' works the feeling of searching out pins in haystacks.

The book begins with nine beautiful colour plates, pictures of Robert Wang's own completed instruments and temple furnishings. This is, in itself, an invaluable aid for those who have difficulty visualizing objects from written descriptions. After a brief preface, in which the author discusses the nature of magickal instruments, his reasons for following the Golden Dawn tradition of construction and consecration, and the construction of basic, interim instruments, the book launches into part I, 'The Instruments'.

This section of the book provides detailed, step-by-step instructions for the construction and ornamentation of the Lotus Wand, alternative or supplemental Wands, the Rose Cross Lamen, the Sword, the Fire Wand, the Water Cup, the Air Dagger and the Earth Pentacle. Wang is very practical in his descriptions, informing us how these instruments may be constructed from inexpensive and readily available materials.

Although much of this material is included in Israel Regardie's GOLDEN DAWN, the detailed diagrams and graphic representations of appropriate God-names and sigils are information not to be found in this form elsewhere.

Part II, 'The Temple', provides detailed, step-by-step instruction in the construction of a temple cabinet, the Altar, the Lamp, the Censer, the Cross and Triangle, the Pillars, the temple diagram, the Banners of East and West, and the Enochian tablets.

Information regarding consecration and use of these instruments is not given, but Wang does give direction as to where it can be found. Although complete unto itself, this book can just as easily be a starting point for innovation and individualization by all. "These methods are both safe and sound when followed to the letter, and are ideal for personal development...Yet this is a method from which one may branch out freely once its principles have been understood."

Arica Institute is a non-profit educational organization incorporated in New York. Its purpose is to act as a publishing house, and to maintain records and archives for the Arica School. After an initial ten-month training program held in the city of Arica, Chile, Ichazo moved the School to New York City because he felt that that was the toughest place on earth to build a mystical school. If it could be done there, it could be done anywhere. The Arica School is an informal body of individuals who have achieved a certain level of training in the Arica method, and have chosen to consider themselves School members. This makes it difficult to describe the School --Sam Keen, in an interview with Ichazo published in PSYCHOLOGY TODAY, called Arica "perhaps the closest thing we have to a university for altered states of consciousness."



In a book, THE HUMAN PROCESS FOR ENLIGHTENMENT AND FREEDOM, Ichazo states: "Arica means freedom. There is no paper, no signature, no promise. We are playing the whole game of consciousness; there is nothing else." The purpose of the School is to catalyze a jump in the level of society to what is called a metasociety, that is, a society based on the common recognition of Unity between all human beings. In a pre-Inca language of South America the word Arica means 'Open Door'.

As with any school, the direct interaction of Arica with the public is through a series of training programs. These are of two kinds: programs designed for the general public, focussed on some particular aspect of consciousness; and programs in what is called 'the line of the School'. Examples of the former are 'PsychoCal', a sequence of physical exercises for loosening and toning up the body, 'Teamwork', a training for groups which need to interact as high-performance teams, and 'The Evolutionary Couple', a training in couple interaction. Trainings in the line of the School are all part of a graduated program designed to produce enlightenment. This program is based on a scientifically complete theory of the human psyche. Each of the nine levels of training in the Arica School is designed to produce a realization of a specific principle of consciousness. These nine principles are: No Time, No Position, No Contradiction, Interaction, Equality, Equilibrium, Freedom, No Effect, and All Consciousness. The only commitment asked from a participant in Arica trainings is acceptance of responsibility for



being in the training. Because the entire emphasis is on clarification of consciousness Arica trainings will benefit all seekers -- whatever spiritual path they have chosen to follow.

Arica respects all religions and traditions, recognizing that interaction is a divine principle, and that the sharing of knowledge is a source of enrichment. We say that Humanity is One Body and One Spirit. Within this unity, our variety and individual differences are our greatest treasure. We also declare the Unity of God:

God is Eternal  
Is in All of Us  
Is in Everything  
Is One Without Second.

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# ALTERED STATES...

The sensory-deprivation tank is not a new item. Its inventor, Dr. John Lilly, used the tank for mental research projects 25 years ago. However, with the release of the movie "Altered States", the sensory-deprivation tank is enjoying a resurgence in popularity. I took my first voyage in the tank coinciding with the release of the movie, a great example of synchronicity.

The tank provides an absolutely dark, soundproof environment. One floats in ten inches of water saturated with epsom salts, providing enormous buoyancy; This saline solution is at a temperature of 93.5 degrees F (34.2 deg. C). At this temperature, one is neither too cold nor too hot, and within minutes awareness of the physical body disappears.

The term 'sensory-deprivation tank' is a misnomer. I tend to think of it more as an awareness-enhancer. Once one has settled down and become accustomed to this new environment, the astral senses come fully into life. This aspect has led me to research the tank more fully along lines of magical experimentation. With the physical body temporarily eliminated, one is free to roam and

explore any universe desired. The tank can propel one into the darkest pit of horror, or accelerate one's progress towards the Divine Illumination brought about by the descent of the ineffable Light into one's immortal Soul.

The tank is only a tool for the magician to use. It is his or her intentions that provide the outline for the journey into deep inner space. Here, one is indeed Master of the Universe. The mental baggage and attitudes one brings into the tank provide the actual map of where this experience will lead.

My appointment was for Noon, and before entering the building, I performed Liber Resh (s.f. CC) on a brilliant, cloudless Southern California day. In order to keep the tank water clean, one is required to shower. As I did this, I mentally recited the Psalm 51.7: "Purge me with hyssop...". I then turned around and faced the tank. It is a coffin-like box, eight feet long and four feet wide and high, with a hatch at one end. As I climbed into the tank, I reaffirmed my intent to rise up the Middle Pillar of the Tree of Life.

I lay down in the tank and tried to make myself sink, but I found this impossible to do. With this fear gone, I began rhythmic breathing in a four-fold pattern. As I was doing this I concentrated on each psychic centre in the manner described by Frater Aleyin (see the Seventh Ray v.VI no.2, iss. 19, "The Hermetic Caduceus") and brought them forth into existence,



glowing..

By this time, I had no longer any input from my physical body registering in my consciousness. I had left the material plane of Assiah, and had entered the Astral of Yetzirah.

"Every man and every woman is a star." This is what I imagined myself to be, and went in search of others of my kind. By the power of Will, I forced my astral being to rise from this black realm. Up and up, and up, with every last quantum of energy I had, and further still, I rose. Faster and faster, at the speed of thought I pierced the dark veil in search of Light and other beings of Light.

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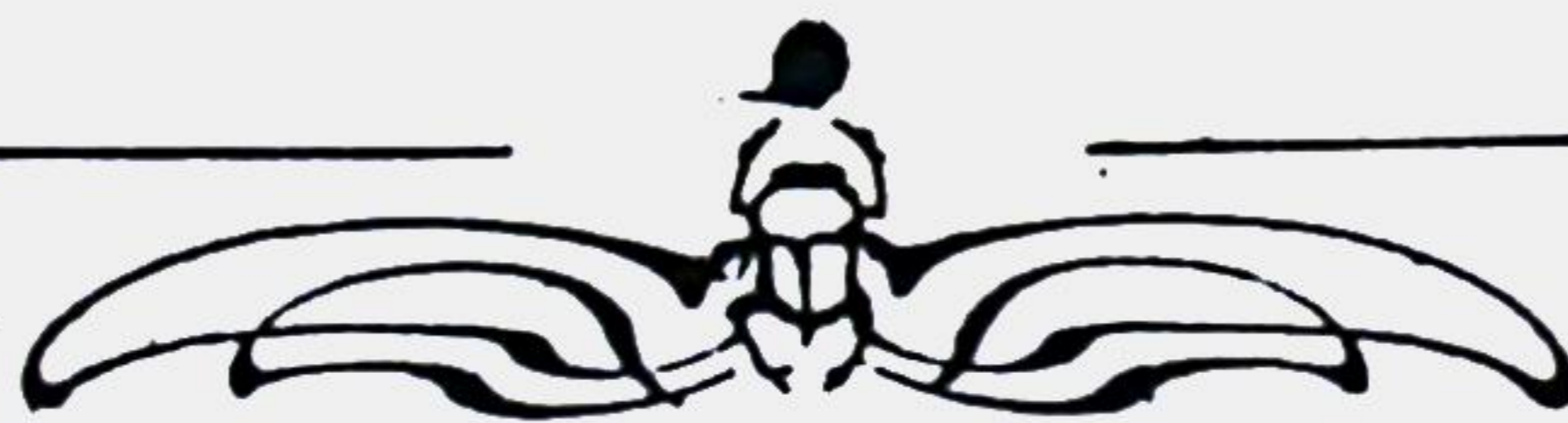
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## Resource Guide to Canadian Occult Groups

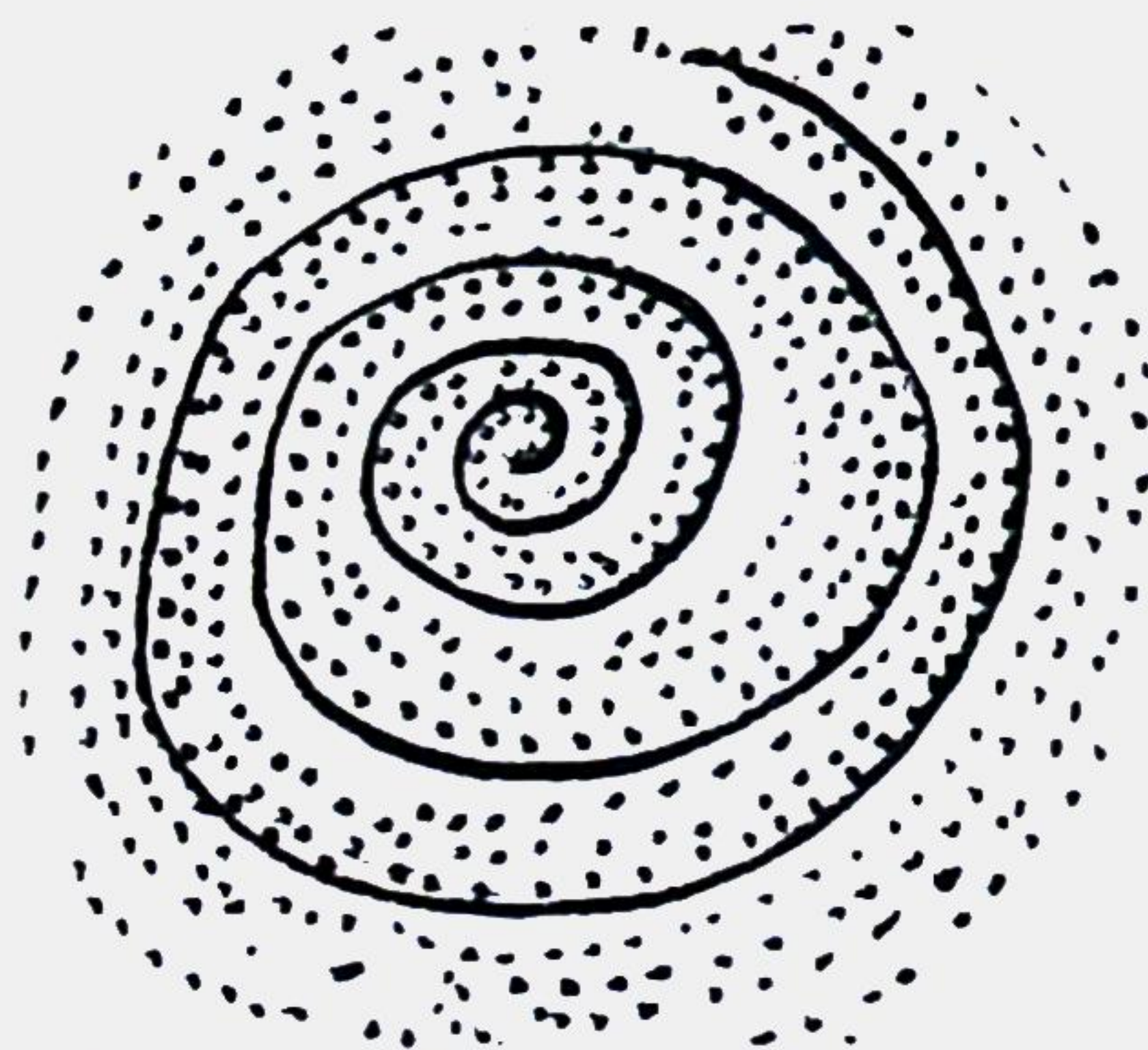

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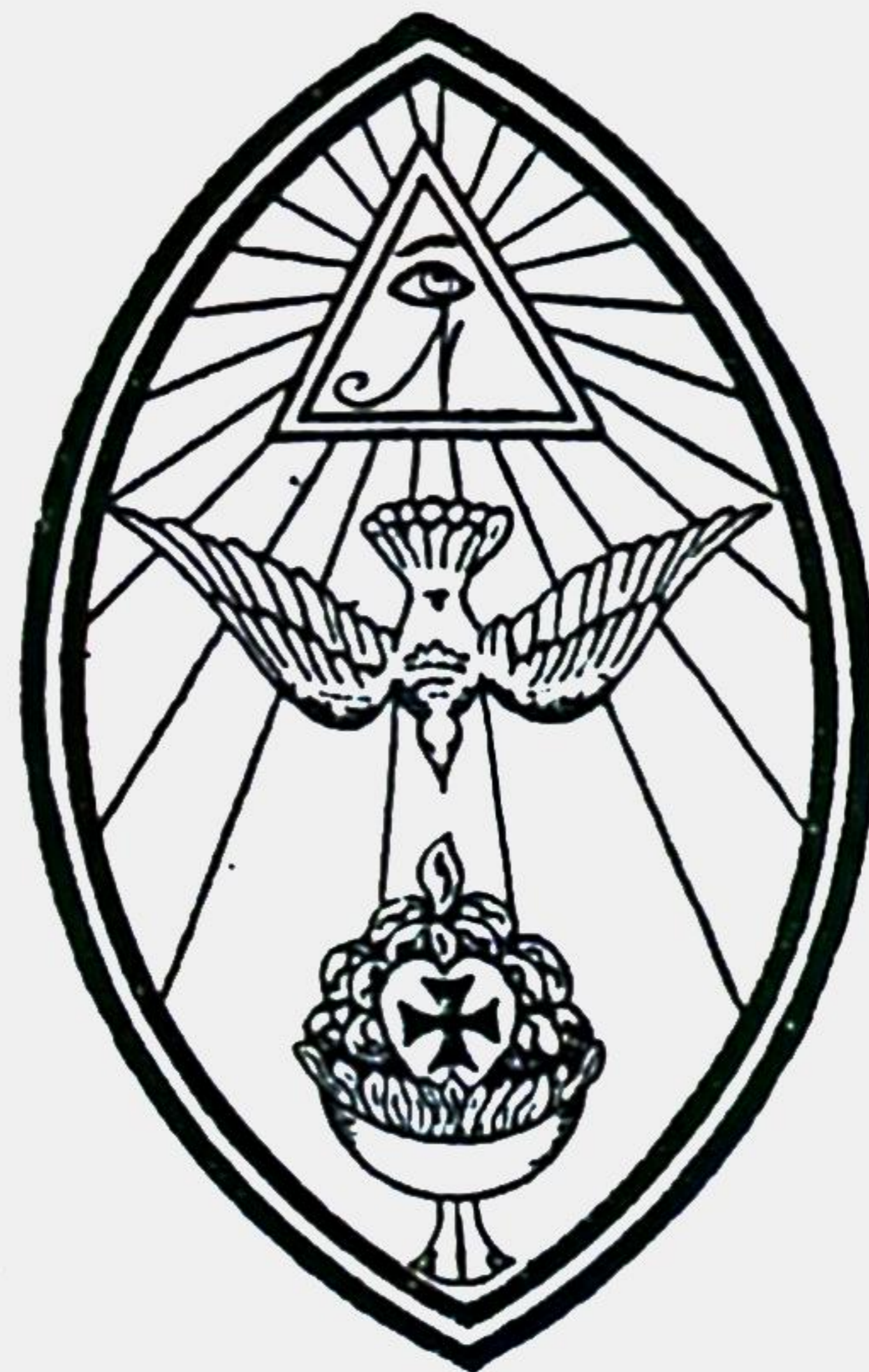
