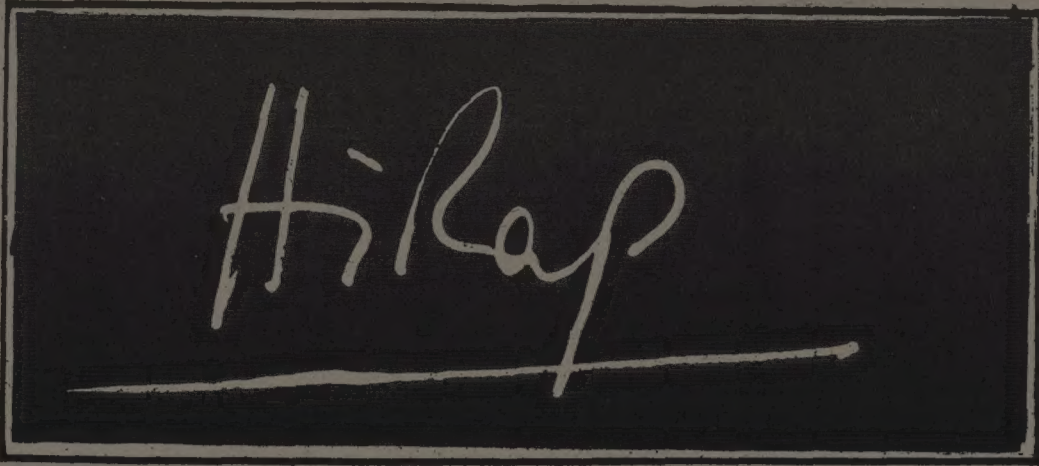

TIM LEARY IS ALIVE AND WELL IN A SWISS CELL

"Tim was arrested on July 1st, 1971. The U.S. source of the arrest is unclear. The conjecture is he was seen by both US nationals and Swiss citizens. This was reported to various authorities, particularly the United States Embassy. The reports consisted of the fact that he was a fugitive from U.S. jails. He was arrested on an informal although legally satisfactory warrant.

There are two parts to the legal story. One relates to the formality of extradition and what defenses can be interposed. The second relates to what is called QUOTIENT which is roughly but not exactly similar to bail in this country.

There is a bi-lateral treaty between Switzerland and the United States which in turn requires:

- a) Apprehension by the Swiss government of a person who is wanted for a crime in the U.S.
- b) That within sixty days the Swiss government receives a formal request for extradition which would cite the nature of the crime and the sanctions that were imposed in the United States for committing that crime and testimony as to his identification.

I have examined with considerable care in the company of Tim's three Swiss lawyers the treaty in french. It is a rather peculiar one. It recites a series of crimes which can be the basis for extradition. These are traditional crimes like murder, arson, burglary and so on. All the crimes cited in the treaty are cited similarly with the exception of two. That is when there is a statement of the government in it's request for extradition that a crime has been committed the Swiss government is not to examine the nature of the crime under it's own law but accept the evaluations and judgements of the courts in the United States. So, for example, if someone commits robbery in the U.S., the Swiss government does not look to see whether the robbery was a misdemeanor or a felony in the U.S. nor does it look to see how heavy the sanction that was imposed in the U.S. was for committing that crime, but accepts the judgement of the U.S. court and the U.S. government in transmitting the request.

There are two exceptions and they are very curious since they seem to allow a local option. These two crimes are larceny and "stupefacient" - which includes marijuana.

With regards to larceny, the Swiss courts who are presented with the extradition request look to see whether the amount that was stolen was more than one thousand francs. If it were less than one thousand francs, then the Swiss have the option of applying their own standards even if in U.S. terms a conviction was for the felony of larceny. If it were for one thousand francs or less, the Swiss courts have the power under this treaty to apply its own standard and refuse extradition. Now we come to the other exception-Stupefacient-which includes marijuana. The treaty has been construed in that regard. The question is crucial in Tim's case, and it is quite distinct from the issue of political asylum. The question is the amount of marijuana which was in his possession at the time he was charged, and which was the basis of his conviction. My recollection is that the amount he was apprehended with in California was less than three grams, if fact, that was fluff in his pocket, and a number of seeds. If you took that amount and added it to the Texas amount, which was 11.66 grams, you would have an amount which, in total, in Switzerland, would be the basis for a misdemeanor conviction, and a sanction of not more than a week. I am told that for Swiss Nationals who are apprehended with that amount or less that the time served is about three days. Therefore, the Swiss courts have the power, in construing this treaty, to apply its own law, and point out that this amount couldn't be the basis for two successive ten year terms.

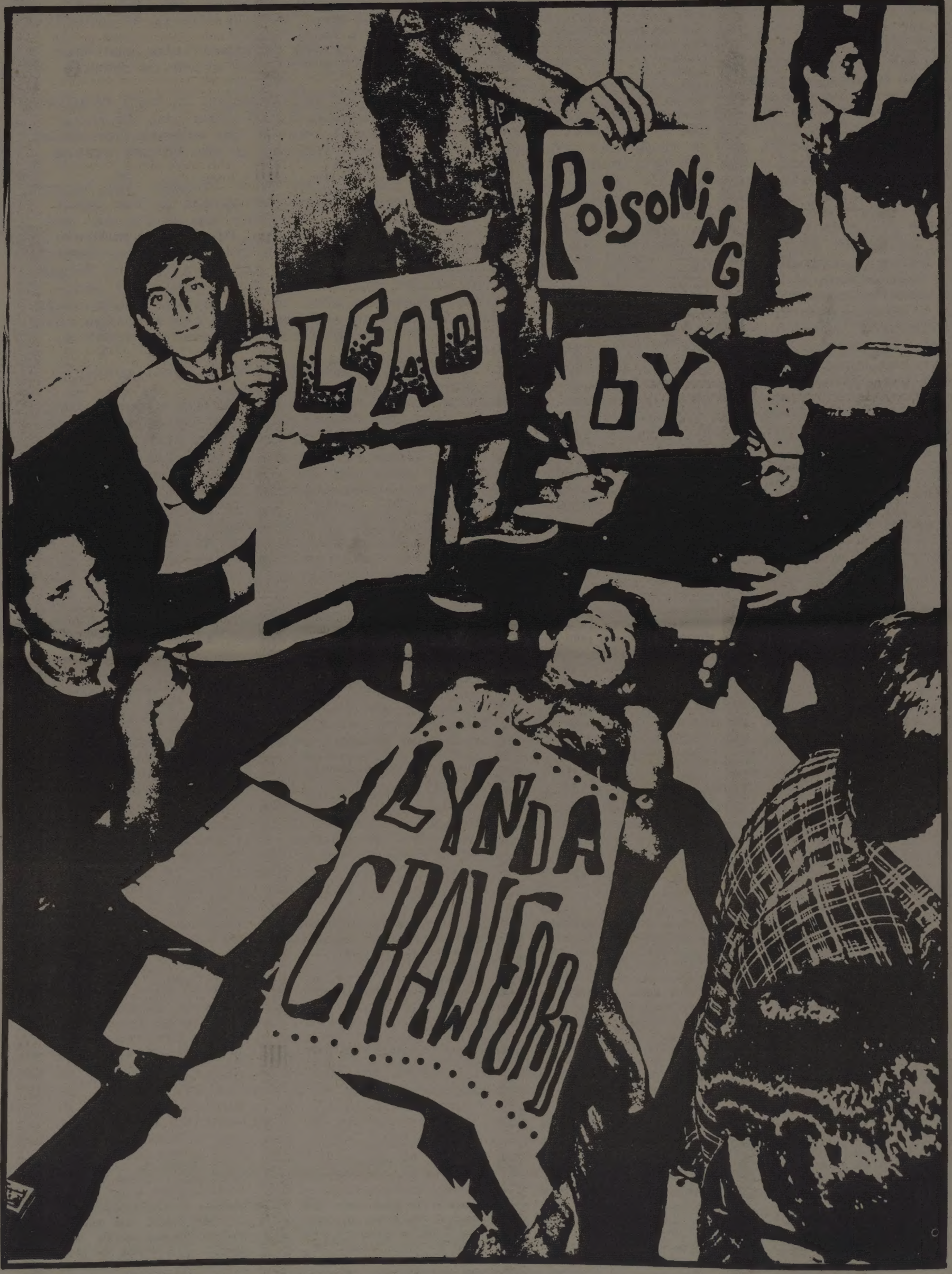
What will happen politically is another matter. I am talking as a lawyer when I say that I believe that there is a strong possibility, given the nature and substance of Tim's superb legal team, that there is a good fighting chance that he can avoid extradition. The second question, unrelated to the construction of the extradition treaty, relates to political asylum. Tim's lawyer has already filed a request for political asylum, and has been told formally, by the Swiss Minister of Justice, and informally by other people in Judicial positions that the request for political asylum will not even be entertained until there is receipt, if indeed it is to come, from the U.S., of a formal demand for extradition. The U.S. has 60 days from July 1 to file such a request. If it does, and whenever it does, THERE IS A PERIOD OF THIRTY DAYS THEREAFTER THAT TIM'S LAWYERS CAN PUT IN WHATEVER OPPOSITION THEY WANT TO. Presumably, that will consist of the issue of political asylum, and the question of construction of the treaty the way I described it.

Informally, we learned that the request for extradition is in preparation. It is therefore unlikely that the U.S. will not file for political reasons. It still may not, but I would be very surprised if it didn't.

The second question relates to quotient. In Switzerland, ordinarily, there is no provision for bail. The procedures there, unlike in the States, are very expeditiously handled. The longest time that it takes between apprehension and review of conviction, if there is to be one by the Supreme Court, takes approximately 16 months. During that time, ordinarily, the prisoner stays in jail. The quotient, which is roughly equivalent to bail, is a device which is used in unique cases, to release the prisoner within the Canton while the legal proceedings take place. No formal request for a quotient has been made. There is apparently a very good reason for that. It seems that once the request is made for posting the quotient, it must be met within a limited period of time. This has been the subject of misinformation which ought to be understood. However, it does appear that once a formal request has been made, it must be met within 2-3 weeks. The head of Tim's legal team, who is very prestigious, and a prominent lawyer, believes that in Tim's case, because he is the subject of such pressure from the U.S., the quotient, if it is set at all, will be approximately \$125,000. Parenthetically, one should know that while in the United States, jail-breaking should be considered a serious crime, in Switzerland, it is not even a misdemeanor, much less a felony! It is not a crime in legal contemplation at all. In fact, when I discussed this with Tim's lawyers, they laughed at it and said "You don't understand Mr. Standard, it is an obligation on the part of all prisoners to escape!"

It must be made clear that quotient is in no way a bribe nor is it ransom. If we think about it, \$125,000 would be a reasonable sum in this country-if Tim could get bail at all! We see, over and again, that bail is being used as a detention device, and while it is not ordinarily used this way by the Swiss, it is probably due to the interest that the State Department has shown in Tim's case. This means that money has to be gathered in large amounts-and immediately.

I am not sanguine-nor is Tim-about raising that money either from benefit or fund raising efforts on a broad scale subscription basis---Although he does not look upon such efforts with anything but love. He is most appreciative of any efforts made on his behalf.



The only conceivable explanation behind the blatant inefficiency on all levels in combating the Lead-poisoning problem in the city can be that those responsible, (first and foremost the Nixon Administration for the incomprehensible neglect of, despite periodic promises, requesting any federal appropriation of funds to help relieve this child-killing disease; the Health Services Administration for erroneous treatment of cases that are handled by their Health Department and the Bureau of Lead Poisoning; and the Housing and Development Administration for their delay in eliminating lead sources from the homes and their failure to do a good job even when they finally get there) are starting to exercise a efficient method, in the deadliest sense, of population control by, as Congressman Bill Ryan of New York put it, "a sentence to death by neglect."

This isn't an overly dramatic outlook. Even though relatively few people, (except those struck right in their own home with children suffering from lead-poisoning) are aware of the magnitude of the problem; because of the inadequate program involved in Lead-poisoning control, children are falling to this disease in larger proportions than they did from Polio before the Salt vaccine. Polio, known at one time as the largestcrippler and killer of children would today, even without the vaccine, take second place to the damage being done by Lead-poisoning - yet the public is generally ignorant to the existence of this acute health menace and the Administration that is aware couldn't give a damn.

Last year, the Kennedy-Ryan bill was passed bringing about the Lead-Based Paint Poisoning Prevention Act, enabling Congress to come up with an appropriation (which was \$30 million; the majority of which would go to the HEW for grants for screening of areas in the city to detect and repair those apartments having the dangerous lead-based paint). After Congress came up with the proposed appropriation, the next step is for the Administration to request the amount they deem necessary from the amount appropriated, at which point Congress then authorizes the funds. Well, with \$30 million appropriated by Congress, an amount that while not completely adequate, (Congressman Ryan suggests a figure closer to \$5 million to really attempt a wipe-out of Lead-poisoning) it would certainly place a big dent in the existing problem and what does the Nixon Administration do with this amount at their disposal? Nothing! They made no request for funds! The program can not get the money, even though Congress appropriated it, until the Administration requests either all or part of the \$30 million and our 'child-lovin' Nixon chose not to make a request. It has to be his latest scheme for population control. With the children that we are losing from lead-poisoning and the young men we are losing from

Viet Nam his scheme must be coming along quite successfully.

But the Administration doesn't stand alone in the area of neglect to Lead-poisoning. Within the whole process of detoxification, once a child has been struck by leadpoisoning, there are gross inefficiencies, from the hospital they go to for treatment to the emergency repair unit that goes to the home of the child to remove the lead sources. In speaking with Robert Fezzuoglio, pediatric social worker at Kings County Hospital, he cited the main flaws in the present program being enacted there and at other city hospitals. "The detoxification process lasts approximately 7 days and it is very painful. The lead must be extracted from the blood with needles - 12 needles a day. It is very successful in stopping the poisoning but there are complications: this process could cause kidney problems and blockages so during treatment you always have to watch out for this. The second time a child goes into detoxification the complications get worse. The lead level in the blood rises and it is harder and at more strain to the child to remove it. Each time a child comes back their lead level has raised til eventually it reaches the point of brain damage, mental retardation and ultimately death.

The problem is that they do keep coming back. The reason for this is that in many cases, the emergency repair unit maintained by the Housing Administration, has erroneously certified a home as "cleared" safe from lead in plaster and paint. A child who has been treated for lead poisoning then returns home to be re-exposed to the same disease. Or else it has been repaired inefficiently and in a few weeks the paint peels. The more paint that peels, the more children are going to die.

There is also another problem. The child comes in for lead-poisoning and is treated for lead-poisoning. In most cases, the child is healthy except for the lead but if they stay in the hospital for any length of time, as they do because of the delay and inefficiency again by the emergency repair unit to get to the child's home and eliminate the lead sources (even in the best cases the Housing and Development Administration has taken four to six weeks to clear a home although the actual treatment of the child requires a week), the children are exposed to other diseases at the hospital. In the last two years, children admitted to Kings County for lead poisoning have come down with pneumonia, measles, ear infections, chicken pox and other diseases. In one case, a child was transferred to Coney Island Hospital after he had been successfully treated for lead-poisoning because his house hadn't been repaired yet. While there he contracted a viral infection which caused a heart attack. The boy died.

The final and most ironic predicament is that of the healthy children who are being exposed to lead poisoning from highly toxic paint...right in the hospital's pediatric wards. The

paint in the hospital has been checked in certain areas and has been found to contain lead. Now, all of the hospital has the same type of paint, so you can draw your own conclusions as to whether the hospital itself is safe for the child."

Dr. Vincent Guinee, director of the department's Bureau of Lead Poisoning Control, confirmed what Robert Fezzuoglio had to say. He confirmed similar conditions exist at Lincoln and other city hospitals but that the department was moving as swiftly as possible toward a solution. "There are about 11 separate bureaucratic steps to clearing a house," Guinee said. "We are hoping to get it down to two or three weeks for clearance. That's the best we can hope for under the present system." Obviously the 'present system' is not only not helping the lead-poisoning problem but in many ways, such as the situation at the hospitals, contributing to the difficulties in treating the children.

Of course, after the hospitals, where the children supposedly get treated, you then have the homes, which are supposedly repaired by the Housing and Development Administration's emergency repair unit. The one thing that everyone seems to agree on is the ineffectiveness of the slow-moving emergency repair unit to de-lead an apartment. In an effort to find out what sort of defense the HDA were using to explain the continuous number of complaints about their work, I spoke with Edward Franklin from the West Side Emergency Repair Program Rescur Unit. Concerning the poor job done on removing lead sources from apartments and erroneous certification of a home being 'cleared' he had this to say: "as far as doing a poor job, I would say that this is the fault of the tenant. It takes time to de-lead an apartment. The tenants get irate that we are taking so long. They have to go here or there and they don't want to be held up so the repair unit rush and sometimes the job is not complete. As for false certification, most often it is the case of putting on another coat of paint, only to find afterwards it is the same thing - a paint with some content of lead in it.

Paint is bought by the tenant or landlord. Usually the landlord will send the tenant to a paint store they know and the tenants, ignorant of the contents of different paints, won't realize they are still buying lead-paint." Asked about the constant delays in reaching apartments that reportedly have lead sources as long as six weeks after they have been notified, Franklin said: "The biggest problem is manpower. There are five boroughs that have to be taken care of with only a certain amount of men available. All programs have been cut down, due to the recent government cutbacks in budget and staff...they just aren't hiring people anymore. Our whole Rat program went down the drain because of this. We are still able to function in the lead-poisoning program, but not full force"...

Franklin's first two statements as far as putting the fault of a poor job on the tenant

for ruffing them or false certification because the tenant buys lead-based paint, offer no defense at all and rather show quite clearly their inefficiency. They are supposed to be the repair unit, not the tenant; how can they 'clear' an apartment just on the basis of re-painting it without having some sort of check that the paint is lead-free? I mean, lead-based paint was the cause of their having to go there in the first place. As far as the shortage in manpower, this is a very real problem and one that stems back to the original offender of this whole mess - President Nixon.

The money, which was spoken of earlier, if requested by the Nixon Administration for the program would have enabled the House Administration to get a larger and more adequate staff. Of course, the unconcern with the problem of children dying could very well be based on the fact that they are sure it will never happen to their children (or grand-children) as a survey being done at the moment shows. There have been over 700 lead poisoning cases reported in the city so far this year, most of them among black and Puerto Rican youngsters who come from homes in the Bronx, Harlem, East Harlem, Lower East Side, and other ghetto areas. It seems quite unlikely that either Nixon or any of those in his Administration have their children living in these heavy lead-poisoned ghettos, where the landlords don't give a damn and in many instances haven't painted an apartment for years. According to Franklin of the HDA, "We find that in many of the apartments we go into, to de-lead, they haven't been painted for as long as 2 years." Nixon, as demonstrated many times in the past has always been more interested in projects that take lives rather than those that save lives, especially if its the lives of 'those poor niggers and spics'.

Fortunately, there still are some whose minds haven't become mere adding machines for war profits and have a drop of the humane in them. One is Congressman Ryan, busying himself with trying to get the money allocated to the Lead-poisoning program even without the Administrations request. Another is City Councilman Donald R. Manes from Queens who urges mothers, doctors, social workers and anyone else who can document problems involving lead-poisoning to write to him. His address is 125-10 Queens Blvd. in Kew Gardens, Queens, 11415. Then there are the different Block Associations who have joined together to get in touch with landlords, tenants, supers, and check each apartment, find out which apartments have lead-based paint, and contact the repair service to come in and de-lead...before there is a tragedy. There are more, people working silently but quickly, to over-ride the unconscionable DECISION ON THE PART OF THE Administration to do nothing to combat this horrid threat to our children. As for Nixon...EAT LEAD!

SHENANDOAH, Va (LNS) -- At the western edge of the blue Ridge Mountains of Virginia, in the Shenandoah Valley, is the tiny town of Shenandoah, which for the past ten years has been the site of a branch plant of the Alliance Manufacturing Company, an Ohio-based subsidiary of the North American Philips conglomerate. Alliance makes 85 per cent of the small electric motors that run nearly every make of typewriters, record players, and tape recorders. A decade ago the residents of Shenandoah collected \$57,000 in door-to-door donations, which was presented to the Alliance Co. as an encouragement to locate a plant in their town. At that time, the people of Shenandoah thought that bringing industry to their community would solve their problems of chronic unemployment and poverty, which are characteristic of the entire Appalachian region.

Well, Alliance came. Now one

of those same citizens, a man who had donated \$100 to help attract the plant, says that he only hopes someone will blow the Alliance Co. off the face of the earth.

Three hundred employees are now on strike against Alliance. All but two three of the strikers are women, since women do virtually all of the plant's production work.

The strike began on June 2 as a result of the company's refusal to make a contract agreement acceptable to the newly-recognized Local 174 of the International Union of Electrical Workers (IUE).

In Ohio the average wage for Alliance workers is \$3.10 an hour. In Shenandoah the starting wage is \$1.60, and the top wage, the wage that 85 per cent earn, is \$1.76.

Not only that, but half of the bonus pay for overtime work is taken by the company and, according to the company, given to the "consumer". (Alliance's consumers are the electrical commodity producers such as GE and Westinghouse) In other words, instead of getting time-and-a-

half for overtime, the Alliance workers get time-and-a-quarter.

The company has offered the workers 21 c. over a three-year period. The workers are demanding a 35 c. raise the first year.

The workers' main complaints aren't about wages, though, but about working conditions, seniority and grievance procedures.

"They were getting so they were putting real pressure on the girls. They weren't allowed to talk to one another. They thought they should sit at their work area and not go to the rest room except during their ten minute break. I told the foreman if they couldn't use the rest room they might as well put a padlock on it".

"When they laid off back in January or February they made the statement that there was some dogs in there that they had to get rid of. Girls that had been there eight and nine years they called dogs".

"They called them dead wood. Took them ten years to find out they were dead wood"

"On this grievance procedure, they wanted the final step left up to the plant manager, and then if you don't like his decision, strike. But who wants to strike every other week?"

"When they first came out here they called us 'hillbillies'. They went back to Ohio and said we came to work barefooted and carried our lunches in molasses buckets. So after ten years, you can see, I'm wearing a pair of shoes. They cost me a dollar. They've done a lot for me".

"They didn't think we needed it. They thought, the people in Ohio, let them have their wages and not let us have it. We didn't deserve it. We wasn't as good workers as the ones up there."

"This is why the company came here, because they knew they could get cheap labor

here. And then they turn around and call us dogs. Now we're showing them how we can bite"

The company lawyer, George Gardiner rode by the picket line one day.

"He said he was going to serve us lemonade on the picket line, but I don't know what happened to it. The first day he drives up with the window rolled down and a great big smile on his face. And he rolls that window up real fast, you know, and his car is plastered with eggs and rotten tomatoes, and he found that it wasn't the pleasant picket line that he thought he was going to drive up and meet."

"They told us when came out that it was not going to be a picnic. They had the town police there the first day, that morning. That evening there were at least 25 state troopers for about 80 girls."

"They were afraid. They know we're a bunch of women, but they better watch us."

The company easily obtained a court injunction forbidding more than three pickets within 100 feet of the plant. The state police declared that no one would be allowed to picket on the street leading to the plant. Any workers who set foot on the pavement were immediately arrested. Within a few days the picket line was reduced to a row of people standing alongside the road, far from the plant.

The company quickly began recruiting scabs, most of them high school women looking for summer jobs. Several of them are below the legal working age, but the police have refused to take any action against the company.

Recently the striking women have made gate collections at plants up and down the Shenandoah Valley. A carload of strikers traveled to Ohio and put informational pickets around the Alliance plant

there, shutting it down when the Ohio workers refused to cross the line.

On June 17 the police stepped up their attempts to break the strike by arresting a woman under a 1946 Virginia statute that makes it illegal to picket a plant unless you were employed at that plant at the beginning of the strike. The woman had been an employee of Alliance, but she was one of a group of the most active unionists who were laid off in January.

A staff member of the Virginia Weekly, a local underground paper, was arrested on the same charges as he attempted to interview strikers on the picket line. Two days later nine more men, some of them husbands of the strikers, were arrested under the same law.

The law was ruled unconstitutional and invalid by the Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals in 1950. Shenandoah Police Chief Charlie Hammer, said he was aware the law had been ruled unconstitutional twenty years before. "I'm going to five it a trywhetherit's illegal or not," he told the arrested men.

So far more than twenty-five strikers have been arrested, on charges ranging from assault and battery to destruction of property to "illegal picketing". The president of the Virginia AFL-CIO was also arrested for trying to join the picket line.

The strikers are not likely to be intimidated into a settlement.

"I don't know. It took us ten years to really find out that they were using us. And you know nobody likes to be used. And it's awful that we didn't start this long ago, really."

We have become without need.



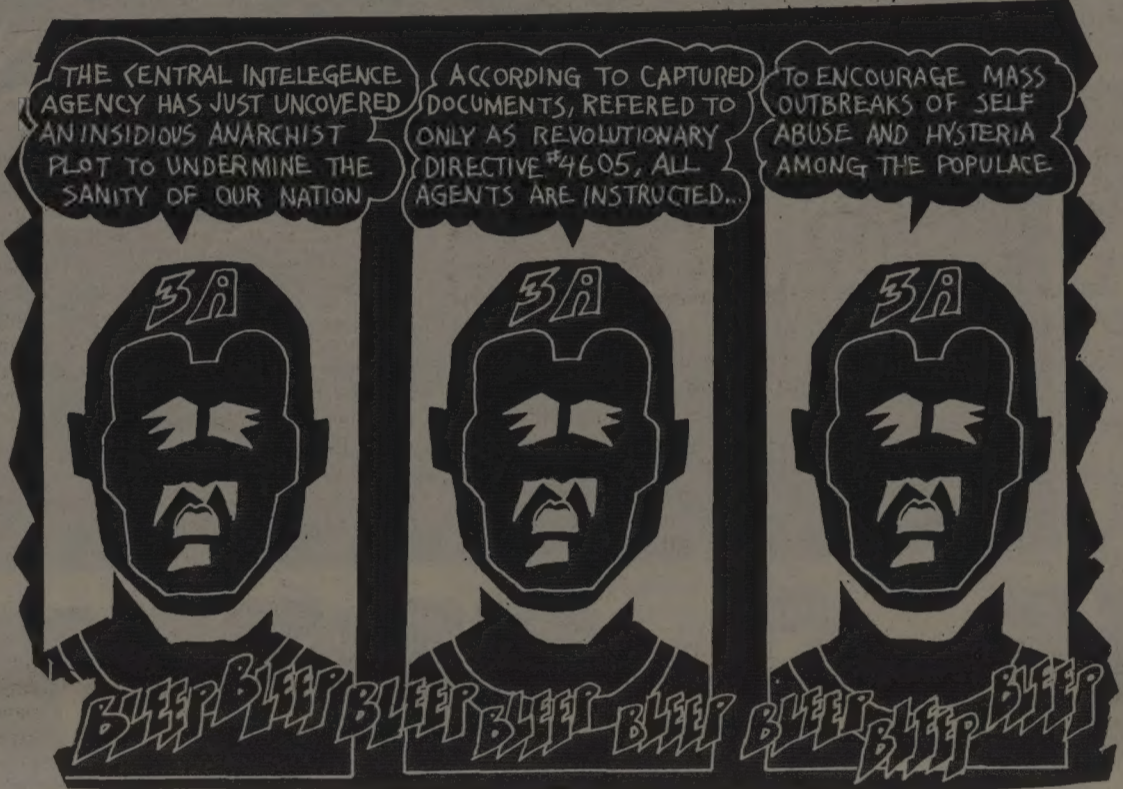


Much of the art of this corner of the century has depended on getting the most mileage from symbols so widely broadcast and known as to be, very often, mere catchwords. Or to create such symbols. Thus (to pass over an assumed catalogue of Warchol and other masters of McCluhamism, as well as rock'n'roll and modern jazz which apart from the superstar commercialism is a folk movement comparable to the uilding of the cathedral of Chartres and the utopian style of virtual communal anonymity so missed in modern art by Ingmar Bergman in his essay "Why I Make Movies") we come to the comic strip, so far the best medium created for the instant dissolution of the vast ocean of cultural flotsam and jetsam and (in its dialectical throes) their reintegration into new spatio-temporal dramatic constructs that, at best, give as much pleasure as the greatest films and fiction. The ultimate penetration of thge hip comic strip into cvinema (discounting the unreleased animated Fritz the Cat) is Nicholas Roeg's and Donald Cammell's Performance, where extreme montage became the total realization of a thought style that easily dissociates the world itself into a freely re-associable abecedary of multi-sensory signs whose political sexual and metaphysical contexts and connotations lie, as Warvol says of the meaning of his divers arts, on the surface. Roeg and cammell took a perfect measure of gangster genre potboiler and 60s-style psychedelic bildungsroman, and told an exciting story (one that defined our time as much as Death in Venice defined Mann's) of ego-loss, polymorphous perversity and the oppressive obsolescence of sex and social roles. All this with more pity and terror and humor and sensuality such cathartic intensity so selfom found in the drivel of establishment modernist. A glowing testimony to the growing subtlety of the masters' of comic-style hip-eclectic.

Walkabout, Nick Roeg's second film, is quite a comedown, a failure of vision and a bore withal, is Roeg's attempt to bolster a lame pastoral fantasy with his ultra-modern opaque obviousness. The opening is a characteristically omic-style freeze-frame pastiche of Antonioni:

blank office buildings and people unrelated save by the camera-discrbnd qualities of disestablished emptiness and sterility. Then we follow a man around in these surrounding until he decides he can't take it any more, so he takes his daughter (about 16) and son (about 17) out into the desert (Australia), where he shoots himself (after missing them). Intellectual Charles Whitman. OK so they walk around and freeze abd broil and sweat and suffer and finally they meet this aborigine (whom we'll call Sabu in honor of Lenny Bruce). Sabu is on a sort of bar mitzvah kamikaze mission called a walkabout where he walks about trying to see if he survives and is worthy of being in the tribe or something, hence the title, anyway. Since he knows of the lore of the jungle everything turns out alright and theyhave all kinds of kun doing jungle type things like hunting with boomerangs and swimming and doing whatever folks do when they're in the jungle all alone far from the worries and cares of everyday life and have only a radio along with you on which someone keeps saying "Civilization cannot survive," which is the lamest thing in the picture. Although you may be wondering how they got from the fefer to the jungle and the answer is they walked. I might add that they do everything but what you might think they would do and that is because she is busy having dream sequences of tree trunks turning into crotches. Ultimately she rejects his amour and he kills himself and she goes home and slaves over a hot stove and all those things you don't do, presumably in the jungle.

Anyway this much is spooned out in an interminable, shapeless montage of stunning nature photography that doesn't impress anyone but is undeniably good to look at. The real fault lies with this simpleminded allegory of a beautiful dumb girl as Civilization and its attendant Evils and the wholly racist image of Sabq the Nature Boy. Her inability to accept him qas hardly the combustive force of Mick Jagger and James Fox entering each others heads like Hiroshima, and belies moreover a naive faith and ignorance of the redemptive power of an ironclad tabu-ridden society that has been afraid of everything new since they discovered fire - a society



whose uninitiative sterility leaves them the wholly mechanical agents of nothingness.

That's the other side of the comic style. You can't be a nature poet with it, you can't be complacent or sentimental or simple. Performance ends in death, Walkabout in death-in-life-Roeg's ultimate pessimism about the living alternatives he seems to celebratwe. Evidently he is committed enough to be depressed by imminent doom. So he says Why Bother? And so do I. Skip Walkabout.

The Nun, based on an anticlerical novel of the 18th century, is about a young French bourgeoisie who is forced to take holy orders (no doRY). It's pretty long and obvious but director Jacques Rivette does nice imitations of Bunuel and Bresson. Best F ALL IS WHEN THE FILM NEARLY TOTTERS FROM Bressonian peaks to S. Clay Wilson deeps as she is transferred from a repressive abbey to a convent of dykes.

Xbuyt she runs off with her father confessor who gets caught and eventually she becomes a hooker in Paris and kills herself. A nice, not too special flick that strikes moderate blows for feminism and atheism. If you're into it.

The Devils N THE OTHER HAND IS A NIFTY Ken Ruxsel romp through the merry medieval mind. Adopted from a book by Aldous Huxley and a play by John Whiting, this

Grand Guignol has more direct literary equivalents in Dsade. Oliver Reed is the saintly priest and debaucher of virgins and Vanessa Redgrave is the sex crazed Mother Superior. Who could ask for more, but you get it: a devil-exbrciser who moves like Mick Jagger and a drag queen Louis XIV. You na,e it and it abounds. Highly recommended.

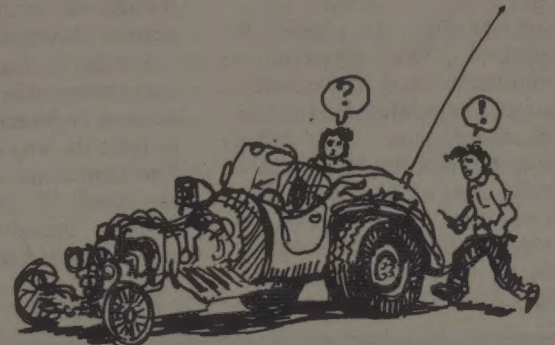

U.S. SPY TEAMS IN LAOS

Ban Houei Sai, Laos:

SCOPE is the US intelligence operation in northern Laos, created to assess enemy activities in the area. SCOPE is such a major operation, with such a large backing, and extended over such a long period of time, that it is difficult to maintain secrecy.

SCOPE uses the Air America fleet, and has its own small army of US "advisors" and crack Lao commandos. SCOPE's mission is to detect enemy strengths in the area, and to forecast future moves in enemy positions.

Northern Laos is traditionally a place of mystery. The terrain is mountainous and inaccessible, sparsely populated by fiercely independent non-Lao tribal minorities like the Meo and the Black Thai. The Royal Lao Government troops gave up contesting the region, securely held by the Pathet Lao, four years ago. The Chinese have

helped build a two-lane all-weather road 80 miles into these mountains. Another 50 miles has already been surveyed. The Chinese highway heads directly toward Thailand, and is solidly constructed with concrete culverts, and about 40 storage and maintenance depots along the way. The road is strongly defended by Pathet Lao and North Vietnamese troops. There are 51 anti-aircraft radar-synchronized gun emplacements covering the road. Because of the flak, aerial surveillance of the road has been hazardous mission. The answer has been the SCOPE teams which specialize in hands-and-knees infiltration through the scrub for ground to ground observation.

A SCOPE team consists of about seven men; small enough to move undetected, big enough to fight its way out of trouble. The teams are equipped with the best of American spy devices, including starscopes and portable radar.

It is impossible to deliver the

watchers close to the scene by air, since the noise would draw enemy patrols. SCOPE men must walk 20 miles from secured bases around Ban Houei Sai, to the road.

Even in this strange country, Laos, Houei Sai is odd. "Mr. Ernie", ostensibly the US Information Service representative there, wears a jungle camouflage suit and commando boots. In a saloon, silent Air America pilots drink with Filipino ground crews. In the village hotel, returned US commandos celebrate successful missions with whiskey and Thai women. Colonel Khampai, base commander, is really up on first-line opium buying. Out at the strip, there is an interesting stream of air traffic, transports from Udorn, Thailand, and porters and helicopters to the forward bases.

For a big operation, SCOPE is as low-key as it can be. Houei Sai has no big cars weaving through the village. There are no personal

helicopters for anyone. The Americans involved are careful not to attract attention to themselves. (Former US chief, "Mr. Tony", was allegedly recalled because of his drinking).

There are about 30 company-sized bases spread in a curve to the north and east of Houei Sai. The nervecenter for the whole operation, code named 118-A, exceeds Long Cheng in secrecy and importance.

The territory traversed by the SCOPE teams consists of rolling hills, 1000-5000 feet in altitude, with thick bamboo stands and scrub brush. The patrols are forced to follow animal and native trails, thus exposing themselves to ambush. About a kilometer from the highway, they camp, and two men bellysrape forward to establish visual contact. Once in position, the watchers are relatively safe from detection, and they tend to stay on till supplies and nerves are exhausted.

Intensive enemy activity

makes the withdrawal just as dangerous. On one occasion (February 12, 1971), a base was wiped-out as a patrol returned to it. "And there is nothing worse," commented one of the team from Fort Benning, Georgia, "than to go out past your front line and have them move it when you want to come back."

At present there are 7 SCOPE teams in operation. There is even one about 20 miles across the China border, in Yunan Province, monitoring traffic before it enters Laos.

SCOPE intelligence has established that there are probably no Chinese infantry regiments in Laos. There are, however, five Red Army engineer battalions deep in Laos, below Muong Sai, and probably more just inside the border. 16-20 trucks a day move down the route, supplying local construction teams doing roadwork near Hong Sa, the last village before Thailand.

SCOPE continues to watch the highway closely, for the history that is happening up there is worth watching.

CONFESSIONS OF A MIDWIFE!

You ask me to publicly confess in writing as to my crimes against nature, and to the charges that my mothers claim psychological and physical ecstasy during Natural Homebirth.

Well, I know the trend is to think of cesarian as the natural way (which makes me a pervert). I know that every mod girl is taught to expect screaming pain in childbirth unless anesthetised. And the Bible says: Thou shalt bring forth children in pain. Civilization says that all mothers shall deliver in hospitals for the sick and dying. Presumably, pregnancy is a terrifying disease and childbirth its depths of torture; on one's back strapped to an operating table, legs stirrured up in the air like a clown, draped in stifling modesty; a semi-conscious bundle of drugged meat or vegetable, to be sliced with episiotomy or cesarian; a poking - bag of many fingers, gloved and bare, single and double, fore and aft; now bereft of husband or any friend, and soon to dimly see one's newborn baby whisked away; while mama is committed to incarceration for

three more days, in convalescent quarantine from respectable healthy society, like a sinful leper.

Not that I'm against biblical painful childbirth, for masochists, or against the American way of life. It's my mothers, not I, who claim ecstasy.

I would admit that my mothers are Queen of their own castles, and I their servant; rather than they the victim, and the medic God. For that, however, I might be excused because of my lack of AMA membership. Similarly, my lack of academic indoctrination in medical ethics surely excuses my repeated erroneous massage of sensuous tissue due north of the urinary meatus, prior to every orgasm. Instead the physical ecstasy might be explained by the mother's own happy psychological atate of mind her husband's presence, his kisses, embraces and massages, which, of course, are to be deplored by any respectable operating room standards of antisepsis.

In addition, it may be that in the childbirth process the structure and tissue due north of the urinary meatus become

unavoidably erect and excited. Having conditioned my mothers against pain, then, it is difficult to prevent them from having multiple orgasms.

During delivery my mothers are admittedly pampered with pillows and cushions in a sitting position, as though Queen on her throne holding court, on her own comfortable bed, in sensual lingerie, with her favorite hairdo and perfume, obviously feeling sexy.

STRUGGLING OVER SMUGGLING

VIETNAMESE BLAME U.S. FOR DOPE SMUGGLING

Saigon:

In the midst of all the furor over GI drug addiction in Viet Nam, Vietnamese have noticed the all too common tendency of Americans to push the blame onto the Vietnamese. They do not deny the corruption of their Saigon government officials, since corruption affects their daily lives in many ways more immediate than drug smuggling, and they acknowledge it through their deep resentment toward the regime.

The Vietnamese also resent the American attempt to perpetuate the illusion of American moral superiority. This resentment comes through clearly in a June editorial of Dan Chu Moi (New Democracy). The paper, which is neither a strong supporter nor strong opponent of the

Saigon regime, wrote:

"In yesterday's issue, we presented some accusations from the American press about the extensive corruption in U.S. military and civilian circles in Viet Nam. This is no less important than the shady dealings among officials of the Republic of Viet Nam (RVN) which high American leaders have been denouncing so stridently in the last few months.

"The American leaders have elaborated their denunciations by saying that the corrupt mentality of the Vietnamese has led to chronic smuggling, which has not only damaged the economy of Viet Nam itself, but has also created the heroin addiction among American troops. They see it as threatening to bring about the collapse of the social and political foundations of America as well!

"But revelations in the

American press have shown that this grave illness is not only afflicting Vietnamese, but a number of Americans as well.

"We are reminded of the strong diplomatic note which Ambassador Bunker sent to President Thieu on drugs, even though about a year ago one of the Ambassador's own pilots was caught smuggling a half ton of opium in a US Air Force plane into Tan Son Nhut airport.

"We still do not know how many times this pilot smuggled how many tons of opium into this tiny country to erode the spirit of the Vietnamese people.

"And this is without mentioning the opium which may have been smuggled into South Viet Nam on American military and civilian aircraft, which RVN officials have not known about. Or more correctly, have had no right to know of, because the RVN customs service has no right to

inspect American aircraft, according to a secret treaty!

"The American press has simultaneously denounced many American military officials, as well as CIA agents, who have had their hands in smuggling opium into Viet Nam. American Air Force planes have deposited it at the exclusively American airports in Viet Nam, or brought it in by sea through military ports controlled and guarded completely by the Americans.

"Has this long silence, with no denunciation by RVN officials of the systematic American smuggling, come about because Vietnamese officials have had no way of knowing what cargo is brought into Viet Nam in American military planes? Or is it because our people have had too much awe for our allies?

"And now, the American leaders have had the audacity to prepare for the RVN

government a list of people, most of them high officials, said to be involved in the large-scale smuggling of this poison heroin.

"Aware of the extraordinary facts above, people should learn that the Americans themselves must close their own wide doors first, and then the problems of all kinds of smuggling, including that of heroin may stand a chance of being solved!

"If not, don't ask why there are so many rumors. For instance, Time has reported, that the Americans have sounded the siren with these loud denunciations to cover up more extensive smuggling — by the Americans themselves!

"Who is really playing the main roles in creating the corrupt situation causing the collapse of the social and political foundations of the U.S., and the suffering of South Viet Nam as well?"

I CALLS EM' LIKE I SEES EM'

A people's navy of two rowboats and a canoe was launched into Manhattan's East River near Pier 36 on Friday morning July 23rd, as part of a determined demonstration against the Nixon Administration's support of the military dictatorship of West Pakistan.

The demonstration began with a memorial service for the 600,000 Bengali people who have been killed or have starved to death since the regime of General Yahya Kahn began its aggression against East Pakistan on March 25. The demonstration's immediate aim was to protest the loading of equipment, including military supplies, aboard the Pakistani freighter Suttlej. Sister Elizabeth MacAllister and priests Neil McLaughlin and Joseph Wenderoth spoke during the memorial about the need "for people to overcome their sense of helplessness about the awesome horror in East Pakistan and try to do something about stopping it." Aijazz Ahmed, a West Pakistani radical and one of the main organizers of the Friends of East Bengal, a sponsor of the demonstration, called upon those present to "think of the action as an opening step in a sustained struggle" aimed at building mass public opposition to Nixon's support of the genocidal aggression against the people of Bengla Desh.

After the memorial service the group of about 100 marched to a site about a mile down the river, where the three boats were launched. The plan was for the nine activists in the People's Navy to place their boats in front of the Suttlej as a blockade. There were two Police boats circling about fifty yards offshore when the launching took place. Although it is legal for small private craft to be in the East River, it was anticipated that the activists would be ordered to move their boats when the Suttlej began to move out. Most of the "crew" members of the Connecticut chapter of the Committee for Non Violent Action and NY Mayday, had planned to refuse to obey the police order and subject themselves to arrest. However, the situation did not develop that way, as the people in the boats learned from some friendly dockworkers that the Suttlej would not set sail until Tuesday the 27th. The people's Navy returned to shore after a few hours on the high seas.

At a meeting on Monday it was decided to resume the blockade on Thursday August 12 when the Al Hamali, another Pakistani freighter, is due in.

A similar action occurred on July 14 in Baltimore where a small number of rowboats and canoes spent three days in the harbor in an effort to keep the Pakistani freighter Padma from docking. Seven activists were arrested, charged with misdemeanors, and released. That action helped precipitate a decision on the part of the International Longshoremen's Assoc. to refuse to load the Padma. Altho the Local 829 reversed its position two days later, and loaded the ship (the captain had been able to persuade the unionists that no arms were aboard), the initial receptivity of the Longshoremen can be considered a major victory. The good relationship which developed between the demonstrators and the trade unionists had, as one result, an invitation for a four person delegation, including two East Bengalis, to go to the Longshormen's yearly convention in Miami to discuss the issue of shipments to Pakistan. The delegation's work at that convention proved partially successful as the Longshoremen voted positively on a resolution recommending that locals not load any military supplies bound for West Pakistan.

However, demonstrations must continue. One fact which must be understood by people in the movement and communicated to the public at large is that "non-military" economic and material assistance also has a major role in maintaining the West Pakistani forces in East Bengal. According to Dr. Eqbal Ahmad, a Pakistani scholar and a defendant in the Harrisburg Conspiracy, without U.S. economic aid the dictatorship's troops would have to be withdrawn in a few months. It is impossible to overemphasize the urgency of the situation and the need to mount actions against U.S. complicity immediately. As the World Health Organization has pointed out, if the army is not withdrawn, this summer's crops won't be planted and a famine would follow,



with an estimated ten to fifteen million Bengali people dying from starvation by the winter.

It is also necessary to keep up actions aimed at the military shipments themselves, as there is no guarantee that various Longshoremen's locals will follow the recommendations of the International against loading such materials. In New York City, leafletting on the pier on the day previous to the action, and discussions with various longshoremen during the action did not lead to the same receptivity shown by the Baltimore local. One reason for this may be that work is much scarcer on the New York docks so that the longshoremen have to take what they get or get nothing.

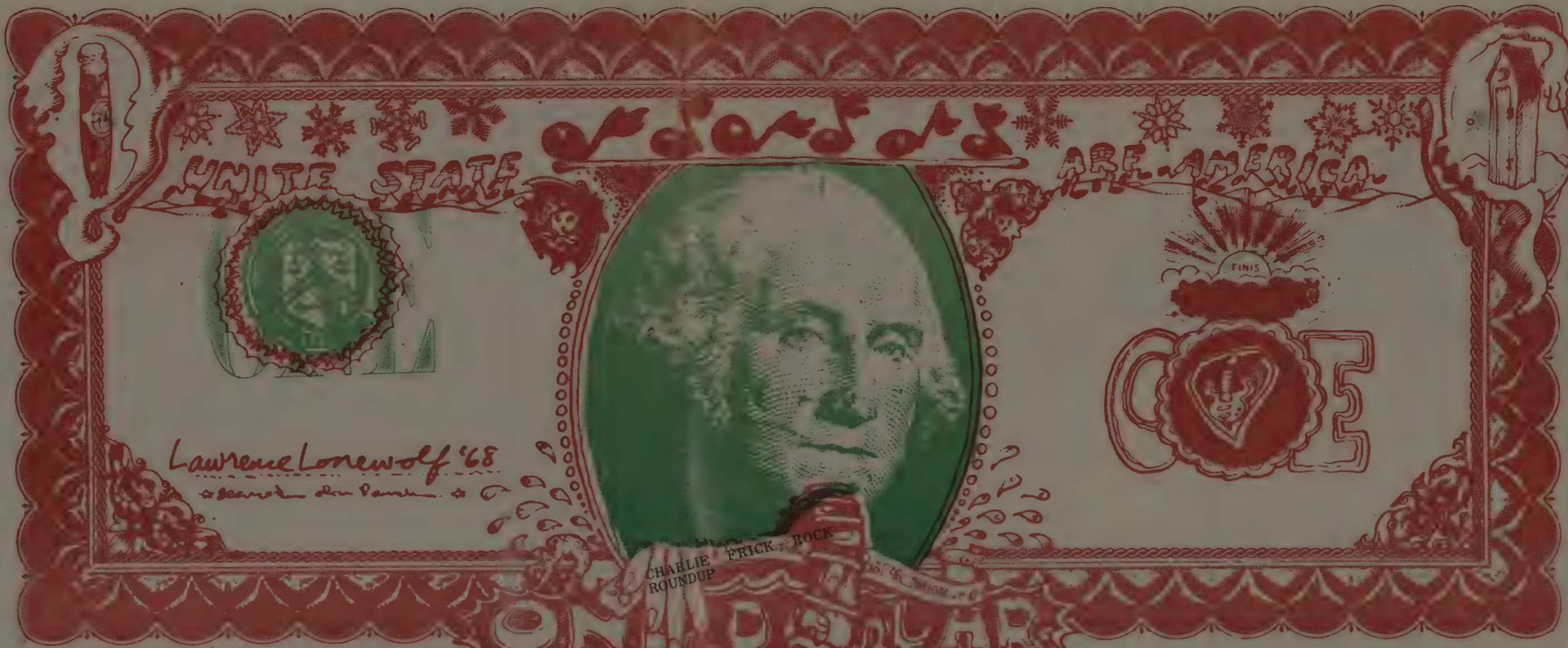

Barnum said there's a sucker born every minute. Nowadays every sucker born has a silver spoon in his mouth.

Payola is what's driving this musical rocketship jukebox land towards the great aquarian assimilation. It's all commin from the electric mecca so if you bomb here (musically that is) you're going to bomb all over the country. Hip culture news travels faster than the telephone and they'll have you off the record racks in Timbucktoo before you get back to your hotel. If you fuck over the New York audiences they're going to fuck over you. You saw what happened to Big Bill Graham. can and will happen again. It can happen again!!!

If a group comes to N.Y.C. and fucks up, it will ruin them for the next six months. This is a heavy thing to have over your head especially when all you got to do to make millions is go out there and sing a couple of songs. Fuck up and you'll have to wait till next time around on the tour before you can grab that brass ring at the top of the album charts.

Like I went to see Alice Cooper 3 times when they were here in the city they did the same act all three times except in the last show before a group of GTO driving tattooed 19 year old greaser hip kids they threw money at them real dollars from up on stage came floating all of this money. It drove the kids bananas. Alice was laughing all the time. The act had the same material as in their latest album *Love It To Death*, on Warner Brothers records, and after the third time seeing it I wanted to see it more. It's really a great stage act complete with their own light show. If they come back to the city next time and don't have a whole new set of songs and effects freakier than this one they'll bomb. You have to keep topping yourself as well as others in the business to remain in the public's favor. The record companies know this and usually try to release a new album around the same time that a group hits the electric mecca. Its an old advertising trick so the swains will

associate the pictures with the words and buy the product. Alice Cooper's next album may be called *A Halo Of Flys* but thats not definite. Hopefully there will be a new stage presentation to go with the music. The people want to get off on the experience as well as on the jukebox quality of the performers. Rock and roll may yet become a theatre attraction as big as Broadway, god knows it makes more money even now than the great white way has seen since Flo Ziegfeld passed on. I just hope Alice and the boys will have enough balls to try out their new act on the New York audience, that is if Frank Zappa will let them.

One thing that always sells is the insane desire of people to leave their own time warp and experience other places other traces of times gone by. This is why the oldies market is so big these days, every one wants to go back and get into the same heads that they had in the late fifties, maybe because things weren't so crazy then or something, anyway there's a new resurgence of oldtime rock and roll music commin around again with the original stars that made it happen when you were going with your steady to the soda shop.

If you have even the slightest recollection of the freaked out fifties *The Persuasions* will take you right back to from where you came. They have that kind of power cause their music is essentially the same as it was 15 years ago. You may have seen them at any one of the oldies revival shows that have been playing around for the past few months. Its all on the way back. If you're too young to remember, the *Persuasions* were the top acappella group of all time. The most loved the most imitated of all the vocla groups that ever sang a song. They've been working on their thing for a lot of years now and are as smooth and as sweet as they ever were.

Their comeback release is an album called *The Persuasions We Came To Play*, Capital records No. st791. Moade not too long ago it has some of the old time heart ache songs done in a style that's so slick so smooth that you know from the first note why they're the best. Old songs like Chain Gang, A Walk On The Wild Side, Gypsy Woman, and a really nice acappella version of Let It Be

bring those golden days right back to the center of your brain screen. Yeah some groups always sound good, *The Persuasions* are one of these cases where a band has stood the test of time and all the styles of rock music that have passed under the bridge in the last few years. They're still here and working around, go see them the next time they're in town to see where all of this stuff has evolved from. I hope this record is the first in a long series of steps aimed to recapture an audience that was stolen away by the hypnotizing effects of the flash and crash of electric rock and roll.

There are very few groups that can make a smooth connection with music of the past. It's important however, cause people want to go back there for some reason. It holds a fascination that record companies are only now beginning to discover.

The amazing success story of *Sha Na Na* is a tribute to those days gone down the tube into the past. I won't tell you who they are cause you probably know and I'm sick of writing for uninformed swains. *Sha Na Na* has a new album that's what I want to saw. In there with the best of them in the oldies category. They can bring back other people's oldies with amazing accuracy and they have a really great stage act to go along with it. Gold lamay suits for some of the singers while others in the band prance around in guinea tees and dark shades flexing their muscles and greasing down their hair. Its the 50s right there in front of you up on stage. They're all on the rag these days playing everywhere from kalamazoo to timbuck too.

Again their new release is simply called *SHANANA* on Kamma Sutra records No. ksbs 2034. The first side is a live recording of one of their oldies shows. Done this year at Columbia University, it has all the excitement. They run thru an assortment of flashes from days gone by. Yakety Yack, Jailhouse Rock, Duke of Earl, Tell Laura I Love Her, Blue Moon, Great Balls of Fire, and Rock and Roll Is Here To Stay. Its Incredible the representation is flawless the songs have been preserved.

The back side of the album has received nothing but bad reviews from all of the hip

people in the media. *Shanana* went into the studio and made some of their own music. Its not oldies, its *Shanana* music and people don't like, so what? I happen to dig it cause I've been waiting for them to come out with something of their own. They're a talented bunch of musicians who have been repeating the formulas of the fifties for so long that almost everybody thought that they really were a fifties group. They're not. They're just as much a part of the seventies as any one else on the charts today. Listen to the top 40 cut they made up and put on the back side of the album. Its called *TOP FORTY* and is all about:

"Are you on the top 40 of the lordy lordy will you be a hit in heaven as you are on earth Are you on the top 40 of the Lord?"

They ask questions like: Did you know what you were losing when you were winning all your rock and roll dreams? Its great stuff their own creations their own feelings and stuff happening now that they've gotten a name for themselves maybe they'll turn out more of the *Real Shanana Music*. And oh yes, will you be in that silver juke box in the sky?????

Move up the time slide a few years to the sixties there were some strange cultural things happening too. Its all down there in another anthology album called *Early Chicag Happy Tiger* records No. HT1017. Chicago turns out some of the finest music that's ever been, like a dream from a rock and roll scene these hit come flashing back from the depths of the memory. This album represents many styles of early sixties rock by some groups that are long forgotten. A dozen songs form anothe time another place.

A group called *The Shadows of Night*, a fine rock and roll band doing their rendition of Muddy Waters' *Got My Mojo Working*, and a group from that wonderful year of 1966, *The Cryan Shames* playing Lennon & McCartney's *You're Gonna Lose That Girl*. And early recording of *The Flock* playing *Magical Wings*, a group that later evolved from and into the legendary *Illinois Speed Press*. They used to be called *The Rovin Kind* and they play John



Sebastian's *Didn't Want To Have To Do It*. And last but not least, two of my favorite groups of all times, *The Trolls* (Wild Thing) playing Dick Clark's hit *I've Got To Have You*, and the group that went by the name of *H.P. Lovecraft*, that's right, they're back from the past on this record playing *Any Way You Want Me*. The rest of the dozen songs on the album are semi bubblegum hits that made it beg enough to make top 40. The cut by *Lovecraft* makes the album worth the price of admission to the past...

Again out of the ashes of the rock and roll sixties emerges a group that had it made but was stuck into the commercial music field by some fast thinking fast talking promoter and had all their popularity overshadowed by the AM hype-*The Association*. I liked them, hardly anyone else does or ever did. They're one of those strange twists of fate cases that appeals to swain brains in the am Category. They got permanently stuck into the brains of millions way back near the shelf marked *BUBBLE GUM*. That's too bad but that's the way the cookies crumble. Their music just happened to appeal to greasers that are in love. Guys and chicks that a ride around on the nation's highways in overpowered automobiles with the radio up all the way.

On their album, *The Association Stop Your Motor* Warner Brothers No. 1927 they even dedicate one of their songs to the millions of greasers out there all over this land. Its called *That's racin*.

"I was born with a silver wheel n my mouth and it was racin and I said Daytona, her I come. I been a pit man a gas man a flag man just be around the around the cars. Just don't call me crazy till you've tried it out. You know I think I'd even steal for that car."

I'm glad that someone has finally saluted those freaks with the hot cars the real silent majority in this country. The rest of the album is mellow they've had a lot of time to get it all together, West coast sound. Unmistakably west coast. Its nice music, all the words make sense and the melodies are pleasant to the ears. If you think they're bubble gum well maybe that's where you wanna be at. They're just another band with a sound of their own. Vaguely reminiscent of all the rest of the west coast mellow rock groups. They have taken some new sounds maybe from Jamaica music and incorporated it into their presentation. They're right you know, really tight, not a wasted phrase or note, not a word that doesn't fit into the scheme of things.

Maybe when everyone in the electric mecca starts crashin from all of the lsd that is in the rock line this summer they'll be able to get into this music. You can't be hyped up all the way to get this stuff in your brain. It just don't flow that way...

The association in my mind has always been a jukebox group, everyone knows that but they're also plugged into a very beautiful stream of music that no one talks about. Its close to that of the *BeeGees* or the *Strawbs* or another unknown group called *The Amazing Blondel*. Juke box music is fine. Just recently another long time jukebox group by the name of the *Beach Boys* crossed after years of main line AM hits about surfing and fast car songs into the dollars and cents market of FM. They made it out of the dungeon of ol goldie AM stuff into the lime light of the hippest of all contemporary audiences.

What about the Association? Have you heard their new material? Do you even know what I'm talking about? All of those thousands of one night stands that they've been playing for years in colleges and small towns has given them a chance to get it incredibly together. Like nothing I've heard they've got a lot of voices and use them like

they know what they're doing. I mean 5 part harmony are no easy thing to pull off. You can't hide talent behind hype. It comes shining thru and the music makes you understand. They are one of the finest musical bands in America today and pretty soon with the *Beach Boys* paving the way they'll be back on the top of the charts in no time at all. Maybe by the middle of this fall people will have the Association on their lips again.

There were other groups from way back when and I have to mention one of them not because they have a new album out or even because someone released an anthology of their hits, just because I like them as much as any of the other groups from the sixties. Everyone seems to have forgotten about the group that recorded *Red Rubber Ball, The Cyrkle*. I haven't forgotten.

From across the sea comes another blast from the past. Maybe this one will never reach your record stores maybe it'll never even reach these shores. It's a pirate tape from 1966 that some one had the fortune of getting a hold of and in the true rock and roll spirit, (and the capitalistic drive) released a bootleg single. The record came out a few weeks ago on some London record racks under the name of _____. It's from the time of *The Rubber Soul* album and has as yet been unreleased by EMI. Its genuine Lennon McCartney stuff and the recordings are of good quality. One track is an up number along the lines of *Get Back* and the other is a lyrical thing tentatively called *BABY JANE*. Another bootleg that's selling like hotcakes strangely enough over in limeland is a collection of tapes from the all time master of rock and roll *Elvis The Pelvis*. In a typical white cover bearing the simple name "I Wanna Be a Rock And Roll Star" this album, bootlegged by the British bootleg master Jeffery Collins contains material spanning the years from 1956 to 1961 stuff like the original recording of *My Baby Left Me*, a live version of *Jailhouse Rock* and *Fame Or Fortune* and a song not too well known called *A*

Cane and *A High Starched Collar*.

In a interview the master bootlegger said that they have material now ready to turn out perhaps a dozen or so more bootlegs by the end of the year. Among this material are tapes of teh Beatles BBC broadcasts and their Saturday club. There's enough for a double album, we might call it *Rock and Roll, hahaha*.

Other bootlegs are a Dylan called *The Mountain Comes to Mohammed*, A Stones bootleg called *Under My Thumb*, a Jimmi Hendrix bootleg called *Burn Your Brothers House Down* and a series of tapes collected on the *Pink Floyd* in their many concert appearances on the continent. There should be more bootleggers many more, especially in America where the rock and roll industry is king of all the music maybe the technicians should go underground.

There's another thing happening with tapes only this time there tapes with pictures. Yeah bootleg Video tapes of rock and roll bands. There's some guys out there in the swamps with a set of camera and maikes and tape machines. They papped into a club in New Jersey, the club is called *Earth Life*, and is frequented by artists and groupies alike, all sorts of rock and roll happens there, no liquor is served so there are no greasers cluttering up the works. Anyways this bunch of guys showed up last week with some equipment. They got out their monitors and said hey guys wanna see some rock and roll, People came over to the screen as one of them slipped a tape cassette into the thing. There on the screen as plain as day was the *Grateful Dead* playing away. They do this sort of thing every now and then. We just like to have tapes of rock and roll one of the camera men said as he was getting ready to take some pictures. We have tapes of the *Dead* and *Creedance* and the *Stones* and the movie *Let It Be* and a whole lot of other stuff...They collect them and show them to each other in their cellar somewhere out there among the swamps. This night a quiet wednesday in the middle of the week they were there to make a teevee

film of a group called *Godspeed*. No one knows about them. They used to go under the name of the *Brats* and played down at the Jersey shore. If you keep your eye on them maybe you'll hear more, they're destined for someplace, maybe its outer space. When I spoke their guitar player he said that they were planning to add another keyboard, "Yeah we wanna be the first in the area to use a moog as an integral part of their act". Something to keep your eye on, Rock and roll that's gone the way of the American greaser seventies out there in the New Jersey swamps. Remember, I told you so....

The sixties represented to a lot of people the time of electrical radicalization. Rock and roll was the cause of most of it. When music became no longer just some notes and lyrics and turned into the stuff that drives same people wild its called *High Energy Music*. There are all kinds but the most familiar to most of you is *High Energy Rock*. Stuff like the *Dead* used to do and *Quick Silver* and the *Allman Brothers* and the once lamented electronic side show from Detroit *THE M.C. 5*. Yeah they were my favorite cause, they had something that none of the other groups could get or even understand, for want of a better word I'll call it *RAUNCH*.

They were responsible for turning around more heads than any other band I know of. You either dug them or couldn't stand to be in the same room where their music was playing.

They fell out of favor with the hip community a while ago (and consequently off the charts). A lot of bell bottoms silva thin smoking hipsters in the music business said that they had sold out. The one time house band for the white panther party had sold out gone the way of all rock and roll bands who had too many nights of the blues. It was said that their music was coopted turned into bubble gum and put in the jukeboxes all over the land. Just because they made an album of what they thought was honest music that didn't happen to turn on some of the more influential media people they were slandered and relenquished to the black list of rock and roll. There is not one radio station in NYC today that will play their music. Just think back a while remember their first single *Kick Out The Jams*? That one turned on a lot of people everywhere but now no one seems to care...

This time around they (MC5) couldn't have possibly sold out to the pigs in the record business, they have nothing left to sell. But their music speaks for itself. If they make it this time around it'll be on the strength of their music and not on their political affiliations. Maybe this time America will be ready for them. When they first hit town a couple of halloweens ago there was so much energy released that everyone got sucked into their trip whether they wanted to or not. The band still has the same energy quotient the same people playing with them, the same magic combination that turns lots of sophisticated rock and roll equipment into a full blown musical experience. Their new album *High Time* is made to be played real loud. Yeah the MC5 are back again and I for one hope that all the idle gossip surrounding this band will have been forgotten by the time you hear them again. They were responsible for some of the best rock and roll shows that this city has ever seen, maybe this time when they come around again more people will be dreaming the dream that's dreaming them.

THE 51st STATE MYTH

After two months of steady diatribe by almost every liberal politician in town about turning New York City into the 51st state to spite Nelson Rockefeller who is a pig, only Bella Abzug has put her money where her mouth is. Lacking facilities, funds, manpower, and the support of even those who said they would support her, Bella and her staff have been making a valiant effort to collect 45,000 petition signatures by the end of August to get the issue on a ballot by November. Day after day, her aides and a few volunteers, mostly women, pound the pavement in the sweltering heat, circulating petitions and setting up stands, but as of this writing they have only 10,000 signatures. The other major proponents, who talked grandly of saving the city from the farmers and fishermen even if we have to secede from the Union to do it, have quietly begged off, leaving Bella holding the bag for an idea who's time has not come. There is no honor in Gotham.

She launched her drive with the confidence that in spite of the inavoidable constitutional and political road-blocks the issue was bound to face, the urgency of such a proposal at a time when the city was all but collapsing, would improve the probability of the idea getting through. Soon enough, people like Lindsay were soon in there

designing new-flags and currency, even though they laughed openly at the idea when proposed by Mailer-Breslin two years ago. But this year was different. Since Albany's slash in the city's health services, slash in the city's welfare payments, slash in the city's sales tax, de-control of the city's rent-controlled apartments and all around stabbing in the back of the city's poor, endorsers for the 51st State have come from all corners and include Congresswoman Shirley Chisolm, no. 1 absentee Charles Rangel, no. 1 presentee William Ryan, City Councilman Carter Dapper Dan Burden, feeble-mouthed rent commissioner Ben Altman, Percy 'ghost writer' Suttan, labor, media, just about everyone eager to get New York City out of the terrible State it is in. And just what is this sure-fire method of getting New York out of its troubles?

According to a memorandum on the feasibility of the idea, put out by Bella's office, statehood would have two major fiscal on the city:

1) the city would no longer provide tax revenues to the state and would no longer benefit from State services; the financial aspects of this are that the city currently generates approximately 50% of total State revenues, or about \$3,550 million. The benefits derived from the state come from three sources: the Local Assistance Fund, which supplies direct financial aid to localities, and

the State Purposes Fund which covers such services as the State University system and mental hospitals, and the Debt Service and Capitol Construction Fund. Together, the portion of these benefits derived by the city are worth only \$2,907 million or \$643 million less than the City's contribution to the State. In this regard, Bella's office notes that the take-over of State Services by the City would be less disruptive for New York than for any other city in the country. First, because New York City's budget is second in size only to the Federal budget, and second, because the City presently provide more extensive services than any other city - including higher education which in most areas is provided only by the state.

2) Federal assistance, which would go directly to the city rather than through the state - the city would acquire substantial fiscal flexibility. First, the 15% limitation in several Federal programs for any single state would increase the city's funding eligibility. The extent of this increase is impossible to ascertain because allocations are primarily political. Second, the city would no longer be subject to Albany's discretion in allocating federal funds. While the city gets a large share of aid, the major Federal categories of welfare, medicaid and education all have automatic pass-through per capita formulas. New York City's

share of the non-automatic pass-through aid is 20%. Third, the minimum of 2% to 3% of Federal funds kept by the State for "administrative" purposes would increase. The Bureau of budget indicates that the bias is partly Federal because many of the discretionary programs are rural-oriented. Bella also notes that without the 70% of the State Aid to welfare in New York City, the City's share of State aid is less than the new State's revenues by a minimum of 20-30 million dollars. Thus, Bella places her argument for statehood completely in the alleged fiscal benefits.

Manhattan Borough President Percy Suttan, however, is more melodramatic in his concept of what the 51st State would mean: "The past year's regressive repressive session of N.Y.S. legislature has re-affirmed the need for independence from the whims of upstate farmers and suburban businessmen. In the past session we saw the virtual abolition of Rent Control for thousands of New York City apartment dwellers; we saw state budget cutbacks that will leave thousands of New Yorkers jobless and hungry; and we saw the enactment of a blatantly racist welfare residency requirement. Admittedly the drive for independence from New York State - for the future of New York City and its people is at stake." The support of statehood has also come quite heavily from those upstate, which as Jane Trieter, Campaign director for the Bella headquarters put it, "they'd be glad to see us succeed. They consider New York City to be the cause of all their problems and wouldn't have any second thoughts about bidding us farewell." Assemblyman Simon, who has also sponsored a high school contest to design the flag of the new state, is optimistic about the results: "they want to get rid of us on an amicable basis," he said. Both these sentiments were conformed recently when a salty resolution in support of statehood for New York City was passed by the Common Council of Buffalo wherein a Mr. Franczyk stated "the reasoning behind the move for Statehood for a certain Congresswoman from N.Y.C. was based on her and many of her prominent supporters belief that New York State is "dominated by farmers and fishermen," or other citizen's view that the City of New York dominates the destiny of the entire state; and both views, though for different reasons, lend support to the idea of New York seceding from the State, therefore let it be

resolved that the Common Council expresses its support of proposals which would result in the City of New York seceding from the State of New York."

Presumably to also gain the outright endorsement of Lindsay rather than his not-out-of-the-ordinary wishy washy stand on most matters, Bella's office, when asked if they didn't feel that a stronger mayor would be able to better negotiate more home rule, were reluctant to place the blame there: "Home rule for cities has been a losing battle in New York from the Nineteenth Century to the present. Some legal protections have been inserted in the constitution barring intervention in local matters though special legislation aimed at one city, but courts have held in the state's favor when disputes arose. The weakness of home rule codes was flaunted in the recent Albany vendetta, which hamstrung the rent authorities of any city with a population over 500,000 (i.e. New York City) while extending rent control in upstate cities." Bella and her supporters have faith that the plight of the city could be resolved right down the line the day we name our new state bird.

The view of the situation, however, depends on whose figures you are reading. The report of the Citizens Budget Commission, a non-partisan group, argues that the city would not benefit at all by separation from the state, particularly in light of the higher cost that would result from a city takeover of state services. Other experts claim that New York City's share of the state budget is only 45%, and that it gets much more than that back in aid.

At the beginning of June, the only outright opponents of the idea were people like John Marchi and Vito Batista, conservatives who had every incentive to support Rockefeller and oppose the liberals. But as time went on, it became apparent that even many liberals opposed the statehood plan, including Edward Koch and Herman Badillo.

"It would solve nothing," says Hal Mayerson, of Badillo's staff. "It's an easy, nonsensical solution when hard work is required instead."

One of the main arguments against the idea is that it is politically impossible, that despite resolutions from Buffalo, it would never go through the

state legislature, much less the Congress of the United States. To do it would require immense political force - years of delicate lobbying and rough pressure which the city is in no position to institute. Another argument is the time element: the city has problems which must be worked on NOW with whatever funds are available, and some that aren't. Grandiose political schemes will not feed the masses.

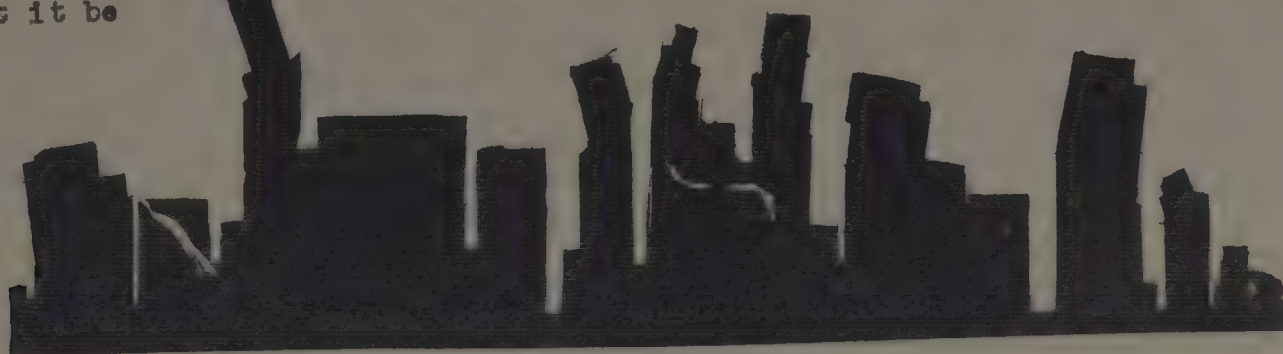
Moreover, there is a legitimate doubt as to whether the city CAN govern itself. The machine of old is gone, and nothing has ever sufficiently replaced it. Previous mayors like Wagner retained their hold of the reins by private understandings with the labor unions and by accommodations with the right political factions. Lindsay, already lacking a real political base of his own, has recklessly frittered away many of the options enjoyed by the likes of Wagner before him.

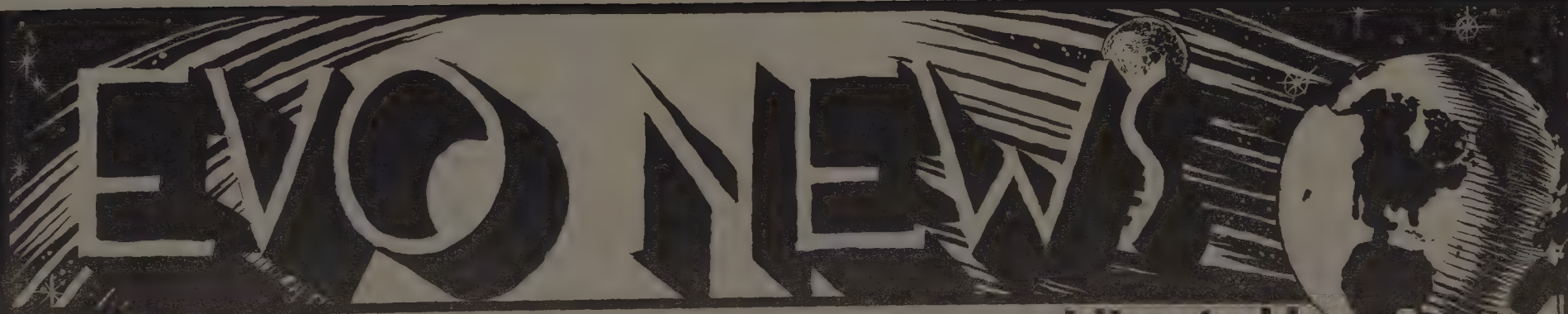
With or without Lindsay, it is dubious whether the city can marshal the funds and resources to construct hospitals, prisons, new subways, highways, welfare facilities and other essential services! Right now, it can barely operate the ones it has. Lindsay argues that the subways got fucked up when the notorious state-appointed M.T.A. took them over, but this is only partially true. The subways had been deteriorating for years UNDER CITY MANAGEMENT! City-run hospitals and prisons are often in chaos, almost completely unfunctional at times. As it is, the state holds 11,000 city prisoners behind its bars. What would the city do with them - put them in the Old Women's House of D.?

If the city were to take it all over, the payroll would jump up by approximately 100,000 names. How many of these would take their paychecks over the border home to Upper New York State, or Buffalo, as Breslin suggests we call it? And who would pay for them - big business?

Big business has been leaving the city at an unprecedented pace despite Lindsay's efforts to keep it here. The Mayor has been so eager in this regard that his appear not unlike those of Nixon trying to bail out Lockheed. Recently, the city persuaded the state and various businesses to lend \$2 million to a manufacturer of office furniture to convince move back to the city from which he moved in 1964 to Nassau County. The workers in the company, Vanguard Diversified,

THE GRAVEYARD OF DEMOCRACY

this is the essence of our struggle - a struggle we share in common with all citizens and organizations who take their stand against the technocratic totalitarianism which crushes the freedom and dignity of peoples in Southeast Asia, Latin America, Eastern Europe and in Greece.

Liberty Hangs among the Spies

SIERRA VISTA, Ariz. (LNS)- Fort Huachuca, located near the Mexican border, has a new function now-it has landed the U. S. Army Intelligence School and Headquarters from Fort Holibird, Md. And as a result, it's growing sideburns.

Officials here have opened up a new playroom for apprentice spies called "Country Joe's" with the purpose of "encouraging the enlisted man to be more honest about his hangups". The room has tiedyed curtains, no furniture, black lights, graffiti, and cushions lying around the floor.

"Everything in Country Joe's is made, bought or scrounged by the guys", said an information officer at the base. "That way it's more meaningful-it's ours."

Regulations for the spy's rec room are no ties, no shoes, and no rules. Says a base official: "If your neck and toes are free, maybe the rest of you will loosed up, too". The groovy room has become so popular that it's already been put off-limits to everyone except Intelligence School students.

Kids Still Niggers in Eye of Law

(LNS)-The Supreme Court has ruled 6 to 3 that juveniles do not have a constitutional right to a trial by jury. The ruling upheld laws in 29 states and the District of Columbia barring jury trials in youth courts.

In five other states there are no jury trials by virtue of court rulings; in the remaining states trials for youths are allowed under certain circumstances.

The judgement came down after lawyers from Pennsylvania and North Carolina argued that if their juvenile clients had been tried by juries of their peers, they would have been found not guilty. Instead, their clients are on probation until they are 21 in youth centers:

-In 1968 Joseph McKeiver of Philadelphia, then 15 years old, was charged with robbery, larceny and receiving stolen goods after he and about 20 other teenagers took 25 cts. (!) from another young man. McKeiver will be on probation until he is 21.

-In 1969, Edward Terry, then 15, also of Philadelphia, was accused of assaulting a cop with his fists. He was committed to a youth center for an indefinite period of time when the court found out that he had once assaulted a teacher.

-In the North Carolina case, Barbara Burnrus and 45 other black minors, ranging from 11 to 15 in age, were charged with impeding traffic after a demonstration against school consolidation in Hyde County. All of the young people in that case were placed on probation until they are 21.

-Justice Harry A. Blackmun presented the majority opinion which argued that giving jury trials to juveniles would "put an effective end to what has been the idealistic prospect of and intimate, informal protective proceeding".

-Justice William O. Douglas, who doesn't think that the current juvenile proceedings are as great as Blackmun does, gave the minority opinion summation.

-"Where a state uses its juvenile court proceedings to prosecute a juvenile for a criminal act and to order confinement until the child reaches 21 years of age.... then he is entitled to the same procedural protection as an adult"

Gay O.K. By God

new york (lms)-- Protestant churches are beginning to support gay liberation. Reporting on the First National Conference on Religion and the Homosexual held in March, the Interchurch Center in New York City explained the reasons for that meeting.

"During the past few years homosexuals in the church have increasingly gained the courage 'to come out' for their sexual identity. Some have gone the lonely route of seeking acceptance and understanding within their denominations, others have found it necessary to form separate congregations."

Evidence of changes in the Protestant church's attitude towards homosexuality was first made public when the Council for Christian Social Action of the United Church of Christ denounced police persecution of homosexual homosexuals in 1969. In 1970 two other denominations, the Lutherans and Unitarian Universalists, took public stands in support of homosexuals.

One

One of the speakers at the March conference was Ernest Reaugh, who is an active layman at Trinity United Methodist Church in Albany, N. Y. Here is how he described one confrontation with his own congregation.

The homosexual can be a fully accredited member in good standing of both the church and society so long as he hides his true identity. But what if he doesn't want to live a double life.... Could you accept him as a human who hears a different drum beat, or must he appear to fit the model you and society have developed? This question is particularly poignant to me, because you see, I am a homosexual.

Oh wow! All of a sudden these aren't abstract issues anymore. It's you and me. It's very personal isn't it? I'm the same guy who served on the Official Board, sang in your choir, still serves on your Commission on Worship and your Commission on Membership and Evangelism, has worked on your stewardship drives. And now you know, I'm a queer!

Can you accept it? Can you judge me on the basis of how I served, or only on the basis that I sleep with other men? Can you cope with this? I think not. Nothing you have ever done gives me any indication that you can accept a human without a value judgement.

So I've given you an escape-an easy way out. I've written a letter to the Council of Ministries of Trinity United Methodist Church.

"Gentlemen: it became a matter of personal integrity during the consideration of the draft of the new Social Creed for me to declare openly my homosexual preferences. Since I realize that you and the members of this congregation are not prepared to accept an

avowed homosexual into the fellowship of the church, regardless of whether he feels he is trying to live a Christian life, I hereby tender my resignation from the institutional church.

"You are, of course, free to either accept or decline this resignation. I do ask, however, that your decision be tendered to me in writing.

Let me say this to you. Should my resignation by some chance be declined, it means that this church stands ready to help remove all the oppressions that insult the homosexual, for I will not submit to either tokenism or to tolerance. Rather it will mean that this church takes a public stand against the sodomy laws of the Criminal Code of the State of New York and supports the rights of private sexual acts of consenting adults. It means public support of a fair employment practices act guaranteeing job security for the homosexual in both public and private sectors. It means publicly supporting changes in the income tax laws giving homosexual couples the same treatment as heterosexual couples. It means allowing this sanctuary to be used for the blessing of homosexual relationships where the ministers find love is present.

But it also means setting a precedent that people can be different and still be accepted into the Christian family. It further means that you will take up the yoke of the oppressed and march side by side, brother and sister, homosexual and heterosexual, man and woman, hippy and straight, black and white, young and old-take up the yoke to do battle against all the conditions that oppress man"

Reaugh's resignation was unanimously declined by the Board of Ministries and the church is now going through the process of relating to the Albany gay community. It has problems with allowing special church services for homosexuals to be held in its building.

Another speaker at the conference was the Reverend Robert Clement, founder and pastor of the gay Church of the Beloved Disciple in New York City.

"We are a new and unique church, a free church..." he said. "Our being homosexual has freed us to be able to look at ourselves as unique individuals, as human beings with dignity and respect"

During the past few years many gay churches have been founded across the country. One of the best known is the Metropolitan Community Church (MCC) of Los Angeles which was started by a Pentecostal pastor in 1968. The L. A. MCCC has spawned several other MCC churches and missions in California as well as in Chicago, Florida, Arizona, Colorado, Texas and Hawaii.

Among the conclusions of the conference were resolutions to give support to growing institutions in the gay community. Those projects include the National Sex and Drug Forum and The Council on Religion and the Homosexual, counselling centers for gays run by gay church people in San Francisco, the Gay House, a Gay community center in Minneapolis and the Homophile Community Health Service in Boston.

Just About What You'd Expect...

WASHINGTON (LNS)-The First National City Bank of New York, the nation's second largest bank, has accelerated the deterioration of New York slums by taking money out of those neighborhoods-in the form of individual's bank deposits-then making it available to their prosperous clients.

That is the conclusion of a 547 page report entitled "Citibank" put together by a group of young researchers sponsored by Ralph Nader.

The bank did not reply specifically to this central accusation of the report. A high bank official did say that he thought the report was "based on serious misconceptions about the banking system and a frightening cynicism about other people's ethics".

As an example of its social concern, the bank cited the total of \$100 million it plans to lend for the financing of low-income housing in the city this year. It did not mention, however, that oh just one commercial office building in the financial sections of the city the bank's financing amounted to \$115 million.

ARMY DISCIPLINE CRUMBLING LIKE BAD CHEESE, sez brass



WASHINGTON (LNS)—What are the armed forces coming to? is a questions that high-ranking generals are asking all over. Col Robert Heintz, Jr. writing in the June 7 issue of the Armed Forces Journal, has come up with an almost apocalyptic answer. The title of his article is "The Collapse of the Armed Forces"; the Journal itself calls the material "strong and not altogether pleasant reading".

"The morale, discipline and battle-worthiness of the U. S. armed forces are lower and worse than in any time in this century and possibly in the history of the U. S.

By every conceivable indicator, our army that now remains in Vietnam is in a state approaching collapse, with individual units avoiding or having refused combat, murdering their officers and non-commissioned officers, drug-ridden, and dispirited where not near-mutinous.

"They have set up separate companies", writes an American soldier from Cu Chi, quoted in the New York Times, "for men who refuse to go out into the field. It is no big thing to refuse to go. If a man is ordered to go to such and such a place he no longer goes through the hassle of refusing; he just packs his shirt and goes to visit some buddies at another base camp.

Operations have become incredibly ragtag. Many guys don't even put on their uniforms any more.... The American garrisons on the larger bases are virtually disarmed. The lifers have taken or weapons from us and put them under lock and key.... There have also been quite a few frag incidents in their battalion."

Can all this really be typical or even truthful? Unfortunately the answer is yes.

"Frag incidents"

or just "fragging" is current soldier slang in Vietnam for the murder of strict, unpopular, or just aggressive officers and NCO's. With extreme reluctance (after a young West Pointer from Senator Mike Mansfield's Montana was fraged in his sleep) the Pentagon has now disclosed that fraggings in 1970 (209) have more than doubled those of the previous year (96).

Word of the deaths of officers will bring cheers at troop movies or in bivouacs of certain units.

In one such division—the morale-plagued Americal—fraggings during 1971 have been authoritatively estimated to be running about one a week.

Bounties, raised by common subscription in amounts running anywhere from \$50 to \$1000, have been widely reported put on the heads of leaders whom the privates and Sp4s want to rub out.

Shortly after the costly assault on Hamburger Hill in mid-1969, the GI underground newspaper in Vietnam, "GI S Says", publicly offered a \$10,000 bounty on LCol Weldon Honeycutt, the officer who ordered (and led) the attack. Despite several attempts, however, Honeycutt managed to live out his tour and return Stateside.

"Another Hamburger Hill" (i.e., toughly contested assault), conceded a veteran major "is definitely

out".

The issue of "combat refusal", an official euphemism for disobedience of orders to fight—the soldier's gravest crime—has only recently been again precipitated on the frontier of Laos by Troop B, 1st Cavalry's mass refusal to recapture their captain's command vehicle containing communication gear, codes and other secret operation orders.

As early as mid-1969, however, an entire company of the 196th Light Infantry Brigade publicly sat down on the battlefield. Later that year, another rifle company, from the famed 1st Air Cavalry Division, flatly refused on CBS-TV—to advance down a dangerous trail.

"Search and evade" (meaning tacit avoidance of combat by units in the field) is now virtually a principle of war, vividly expressed by the GI phrase, "CYA (cover your ass) and get home".

Symbolic anti-war acts (such as the one at Pleiku where an entire medical unit, led by its officers, refused Thanksgiving turkey), peace symbols, "V"-signs not for victory but for peace, booing and cursing of officers and even hapless entertainers such as Bob Hope, are unhappily commonplace.

As for drugs and race, Vietnam's problems today not only reflect but reinforce those of the Armed Forces as a whole. In April, for example, members of a Congressional investigating subcommittee reported that 10 to 15 per cent of our troops in Vietnam are now using high-grade heroin, and that drug addiction there is "of epidemic proportions".

Only last year an Air Force major and command pilot for Ambassador Bunker was apprehended at Tan Son Nhut air base outside Saigon with \$8 million worth of heroin in his aircraft.

Sedition-coupled with disaffection within the ranks, and externally fomented with an audacity and intensity previously inconceivable—infests the Armed Services:

At best count, there appear to be some 144 underground newspapers published on or aimed at U. S. military bases in this country and overseas. Since 1970 the number of such sheets has increased 40 per cent (up from 1033 in 1969). These journals are not mere gripe-sheets that poke soldier fun in the "Beetle Bailey" tradition, at the brass and sergeants. "In Vietnam", writes the Ft. Lewis McChord Free Press, "the lifers" the Brass, are the true Enemy, not the enemy". Another West Coast sheet advises readers: "Don't desert. Go to Vietnam and kill your commanding officer".

Heintz goes on to talk about other threats to the military like Movement for a Democratic Military, the American Serviceman's Union, Jane Fonda, and her theater group, etc.

And what is Heintz's solution? More discipline. He quotes Robert E. Lee, who said: "Men must be habituated to obey or they cannot be controlled in battle".

BASEBALL LIBERATION! INDENTURED ATHELETE CURT FLOOD FIGHTS BACK

ST. LOUIS (LNS) — Curt Flood, at the age of 33, has already been a star baseball player for the St. Louis Cardinals, and accomplished portrait painter, founder of a corporation which buys shoes and clothes for poor kids, and a successful writer.

None of these things came easily to Curt. They said he was too small to play in the big leagues, yet he was a .300 hitter nine times and was second only to Willie Mays as a defensive center fielder. He never felt at ease at school, yet his paintings and his book have been admired by a large number of people.

But Curt is only popular with some kinds of people. An official of the Missouri Human Rights Commission called Flood a "black racist". No less an authority on race relations than August A. Busch, whose Busch Brewery's hiring policies discriminate against blacks and who is the owner of the Cardinals, blasted Flood as being the kind of person causing all this trouble today..

What did Curt do to deserve all this?

When Curt Flood was traded from the Cardinals to the Philadelphia Phillies, he did what no other player had the guts to do. He sued major league baseball over whether they had the right to trade him. How can a team decide everything about a player's career without giving him a chance to see if he can play somewhere else? Why should anybody work where he doesn't want to?

When Curt asked these questions most of the players supported him, but the businessmen who own baseball teams protested that Flood was trying to ruin the game for the fans. They knew that if Flood won in court the players and fans would get a better deal but the owners might have to make a smaller profit from their teams.

In speaking of August A. Busch's reaction to his refusing to be traded, Curt wrote in his book, "The Way It Is":

".... with considerable emotion, he advised reporters that he could not fathom what was happening in our country. He declared that my recalcitrance was somehow related to the unrest on American campuses. He was absolutely right.

"It seemed to me that I saw the world with young eyes. I was offended by the disparity between American reality and American pretension. I wanted reality upgraded and pretension abolished".

Another of the things that Curt talks about in his book is racism. He talks about how he felt as a black man knowing that all teams have quotas and will only play a fixed number of black players no matter what their ability is. He talked about how there are no black managers or club executives although there are many blacks who could qualify for those jobs.

Curt talks about the days when Solly Hemus was managing the Cardinals, and Flood and Bob Gibson couldn't get a chance to play regularly, although both went on to be all-stars. He talks about how Hemus once proudly told about calling a player on another team a "black son of a bitch". It seemed that all blacks and Latin Americans looked alike to Hemus. One af-

In his book, he says:

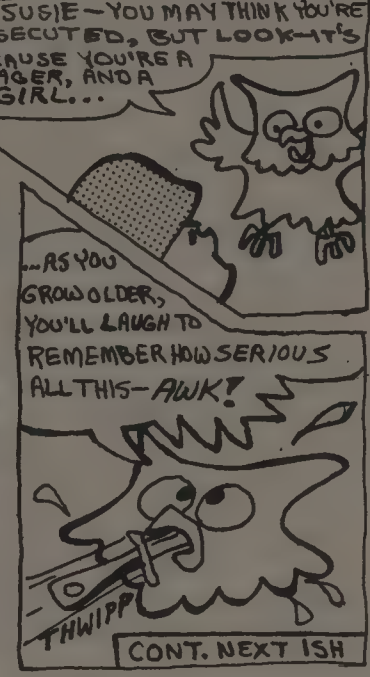
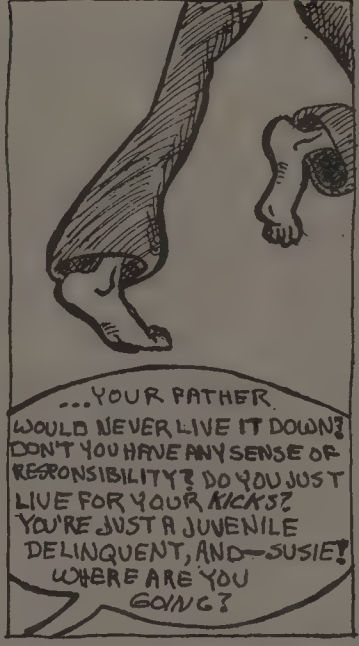
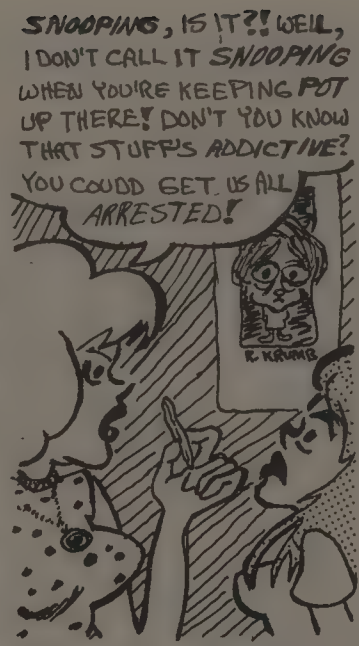
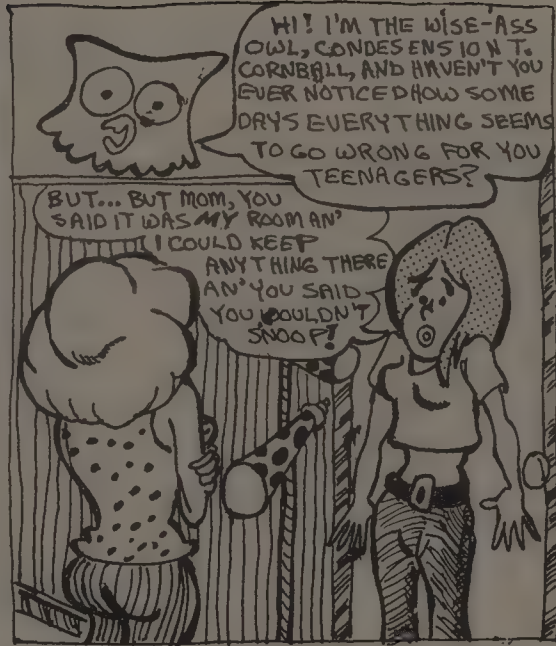

Contrary to popular myth, Abbie Hoffman just ain't rich. I happen to know because I am manager of the mail order end of Hoffman's unique venture in publishing, Pirate Editions. Abbie formed Pirate Editions when none of the establishment publishers would publish his newest book, STEAL THIS BOOK. And despite the fact that STEAL is doing well (even in the face of real repression - the book is banned again in Canada), Hoffman's maney situation is nowhere near as affluent as many jealous myth-makers and cynical rumor-mongers would have it.

Some financial date: in order to publish his own book, Hoffman's total investment amounted to something in the vicinity of forty thousand dollars. Grove Press picked up the nineteen thousand printing cost in return ofr rights to sole distribution of the book. Abbie raised the other twenty-one grand himself, some out of his own pocket, but mostly in loans form friends. So far, eleven grand has come back from the book sales, but he's still in the hole for nine thousand.

So that's pretty much how it stands, gang. Had a hard time commuting from Brooklyn each day, and there is a shortage of "low-cost unskilled labor" in Nassau. Lindsay will visit the plant himself next week.

In the boroughs, the council men are vowing that they would prefer to secede from the city just as the city is seeking to secede from the state. Assemblyman Anthony J. Mercerella of the Bronx suggested that his borough "go back to Mather Westchester. After all, the Bronx is the only part of New York City that's really in the United States." In a recent article in the Wall Street Journal, Richard Stone veers toward a similar attitude when he suggests that Manhattan "...was, for instance, a hub of pre-British activity during the American revolution," and "chances are it never would have fought in Union Ranks in the Civil War." These prejudices are dumb, but they will keep Manhattan from ever leading the

other boroughs to independence. Lindsay proposes a National City - but look at Washington, D.C. Its residents, mostly black, are persona non grata

to the rednecks of the Congress, which allocates funds. Would we want Ellender to have a say in the governing of New York City?

Most of these points are moot, however, as the 51st State itself is nothing much more than a political public relations stunt, at least by Lindsay. From the beginning, it has been clouded by Partisan politics. Lindsay grabbed at it to bail himself out of the beating he was getting from Rocky in Albany, and from the strike which was directed as much at him as at Rockefeller, even if he doesn't think so. Bella's effort has been deserted now by most of the politicians - and Lindsay has been right out there. Now that he is moving into the democratic party, he appears to have lost interest. Why worry about Queens when you can be president of all the people?

At home, the Lindsay effort has been particularly questionable. The Mayor has seized upon rent decontrol as a major blow against the people of the city, yet his own Rent Institute Report on Rental Housing found serious inequalities in the rent control rules (discriminating in favor of middle class dwellers). Rent decontrol had come close to passage in the city before the state ever got into it, but Lindsay saw the issue and suddenly the city became the Great White Father of tenants. Rent Commissioner Ben Altman formed a Tenant's Advisory Council (the landlords had one long ago), but he grants them no power, and he doesn't even support rent strikes. Half the council has already resigned because of Altman's pussyfooting on the issues, yet Altman and Lindsay are repping about how badly the state is treating tenants. The poor tenants, indeed!

Bella plunges on alone, but Lindsay has lied to the people of the city. Even Bella must be questioned for the shoddiness of some of her work on the subject. (Her report gives Maine and West Virginia - both in the last century as precedents for New York City statehood.) She plunges on alone, while Lindsay has lied to the people of this city about quite different matters. To gain leverage in a political battle, he has cruelly used the tenants and everyone else, even as Assemblymen Andrew Stein recently exploited the poor people of Suffolk County to gain points against Duryea. This in no way exonerates Rockefeller and company - Rocky is a fascist dog who deserves to be dragged from the statehouse and shot in the head. But the last thing the people of this city need is a three-day cure

or fly-by-night revolution launched by rotten liberals.

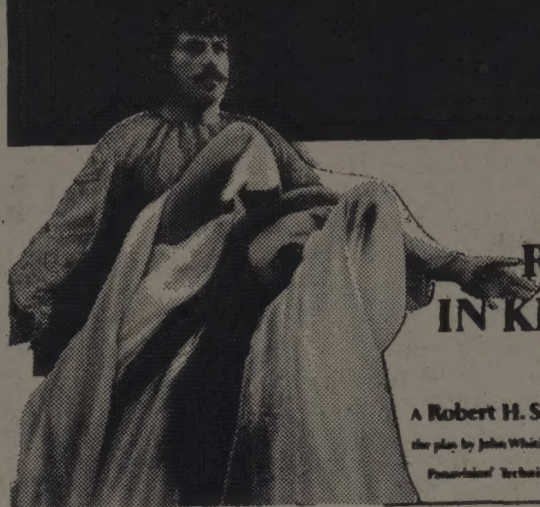
