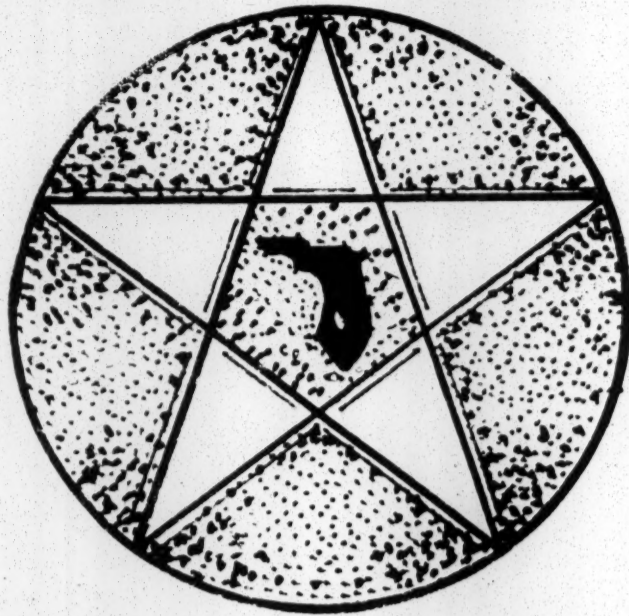

## Mohawk Nation at Akwasasne

Many of our readers will ask what place do American Indians have in an Aquarian (New Age) publication. After all, they have been around for ten thousand years and have seen many an age. What do illiterate, painted heathens have to share with Aquarians?

If you see eye to eye with the above said, take another look and take that look in "Akwasasne Notes", the publication of the Mohawk Nation at Akwasasne, in New York state.

Akwasasne Notes is a newspaper type publication, and within its pages are many articles, inspira-

tional pieces, and poetry composed by and about the American Indian people. Within its pages is the portrait of a people, far from their stereotype of an illiterate and backward people.

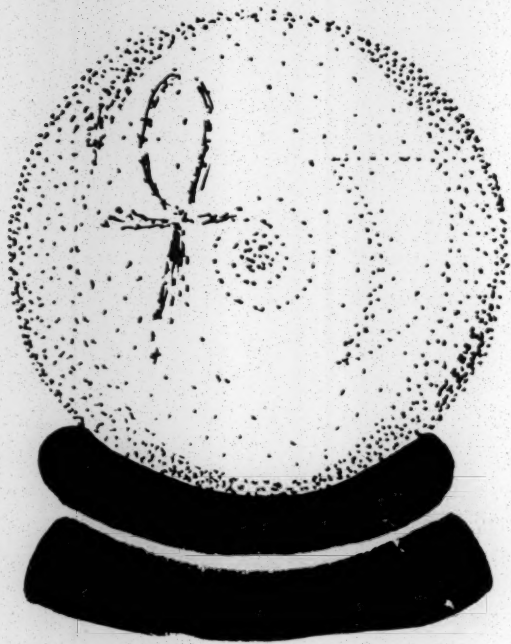
The newspaper is excellently written and contains much information, good and bad, concerning the modern Indians' plight to rescue from the hands of an alien & hostile people what little he has left of his rightful land and heritage. It reports from the American Indian point of view such tragedies as the incident at Wounded Knee. This paper is the thought of a wounded people, crying to a country that would rather cover up the embarrassment and disgrace of the situation than acknowledge a grave error and correct it.

The contents of Akwasasne Notes are hostile at parts, and even if the trend is away from hostility and anger, I feel that in this situation it is justified.

The people at Akwasasne are attempting to voice their little heard opinions. They need help, & much of it. Below is a copy of an impressive stamp which "Notes" is putting out as a fundraiser. Support them by buying and using the stamps, through subscribing to the paper, and most importantly, by digesting and listening to what they have to say. I feel the last is of a greatest importance.



# PAPS



The Professional Association of Psychics and Sensitives (PAPS) is one of the leading Aquarian groups here in our area. It is an organization of original and inspired thought, amongst other things, dedicated to uplifting the standards of all psychics.

The Association began operating about a year ago, when some area psychics began receiving messages from the other side. In full, they now have become the aims and objectives of PAPS.

They are most impressive, and some of them read:

..TO UNITE UNDER ONE NAME ALL PRACTICING PSYCHICS AS A PROFESSIONAL BODY OF PEOPLE.

..TO INSPIRE THE HIGHEST ETHICS AMONG OUR MEMBERS TOWARDS THE PUBLIC.

..TO REPORT TO THE ASSOCIATION ANY MAL-PRACTICE WE THINK ARE LIKELY TO INJURE OUR STATUS AS A PROFESSIONAL BODY.

..TO CLOSELY INVESTIGATE THROUGH THE BOARD OF THE ASSOCIATION ANY TESTING OF PSYCHIC PEOPLE BY ANY MEANS WHATSOEVER AND TO MAKE SURE THAT ONLY THOSE OF OUR MEMBERS WHO DESIRE TO BE TESTED SHALL DO SO KNOWING PRECISELY THE AIMS OF SUCH TESTING THROUGH THE ASSOCIATIONS' INVESTIGATIONS.

There are seventeen aims in all, all as impressive as those listed above. Although originally working through the charter of a group in California, PAPS applied and received legal status from Tallahassee.

PAPS should be accredited for being a trail-blazing group in the area of testing psychics for authenticity, and the instigators of such projects as the forming of a wholistic healing center, planned for later on this year.

One of the most impressive and vital functions of the Professional Association of Psychics and Sensitives is their monthly meeting, one of the few around which is both free to the public and of a most high caliber. I must confess that I have attended but one of their meetings, but it so impressed me that I felt a great need to report on the proceedings. The particular meeting I attended dealt with various methods of healing, and many excellent and well-known area healers were there. Lectures were accompanied by demonstrations, entertainment, via songs and reading material, and personal discussion with some of South Florida's most level-headed and interesting Aquarians. The meeting itself was compact and orderly.

PAPS holds their meetings on the first Sundays of every month in the foyer of the building at 1408 S. Bayshore Drive, beginning at 8 PM. They are most excellent and highly recommended.

Recently it has enlisted in its ranks some of the more influential area lawyers and psychics. 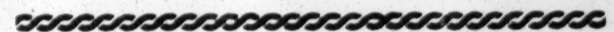
