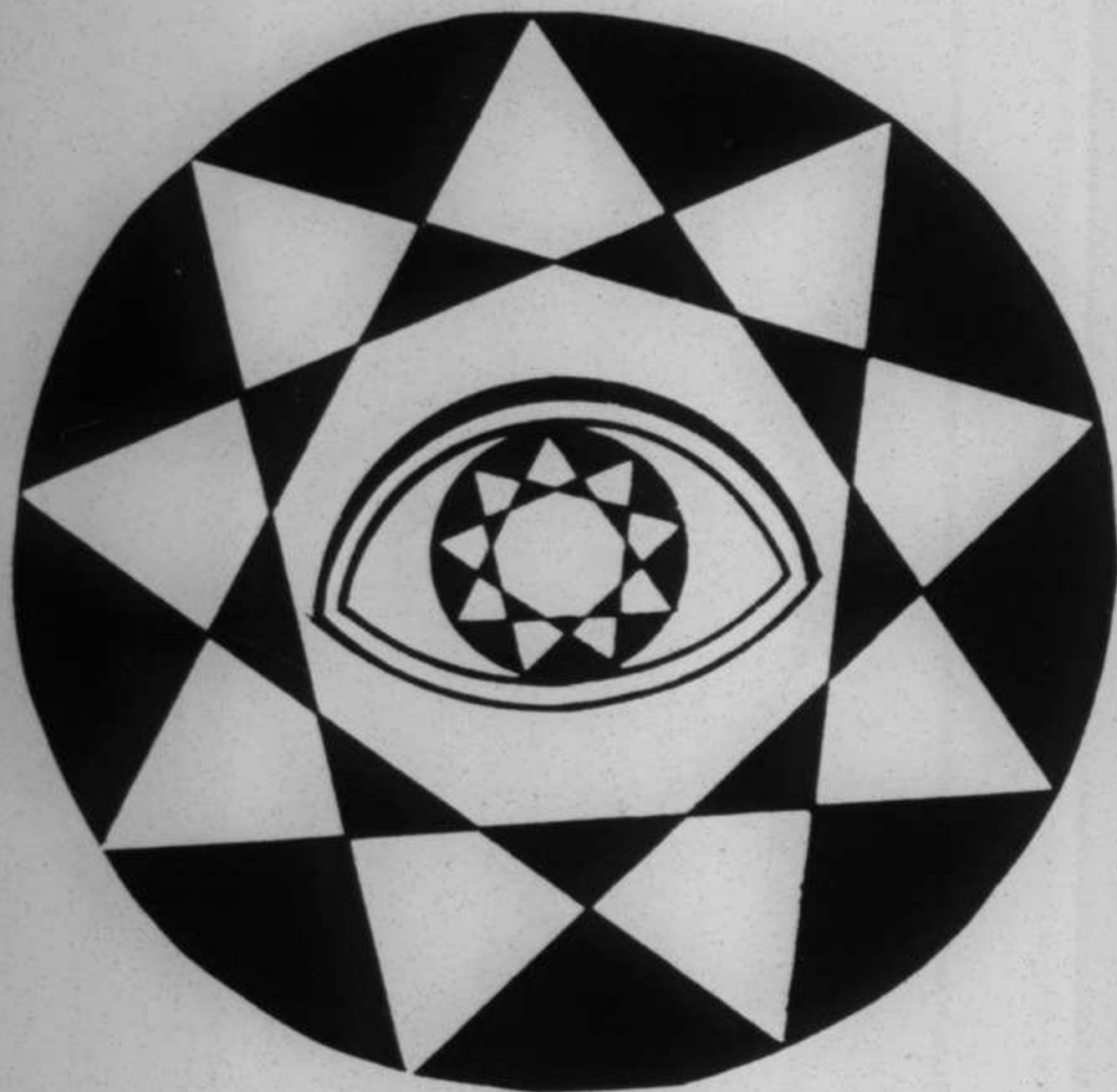

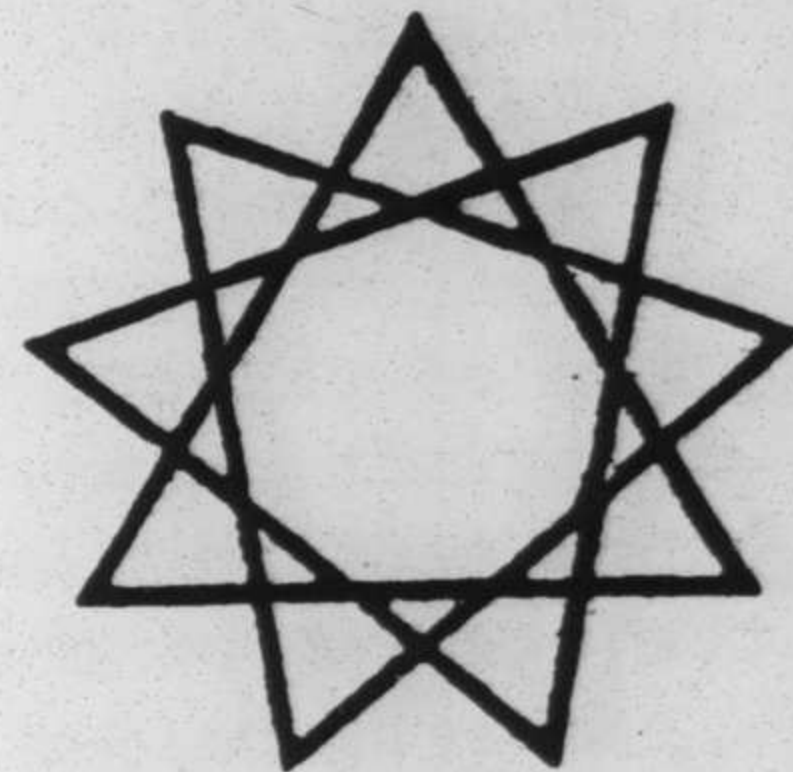

THE YOUNG WITCH

Between 1570 and 1700 at least one million people found guilty of Witchcraft were burned at the stake or otherwise put to death. Among the victims were thousands like the misguided young woman seen here, who is rubbing her body with "Elwou Clotment".

Recently I had the delightful experience of visiting the much publicized Witchcraft Museum in San Francisco. Rita Kan, O. A. staff member, commented that Ripley's 'Believe It or Not' museum down the street seemed to have some left over exhibits. Indeed, there is a carnival effect with life sized motorized wax dummies representing such occult scenes as table tipping seances and voodoo dancers. If some of the sets seem a bit gimmicky, the historical artifacts are well worth the \$2.00 admission fee. The Gardner collection, formerly housed

in the famous Witchcraft Museum on the Isle of Man, included fascinating samples of correspondence of well known occultists and a bizarre group of objects used in ritual witchcraft, mummy's eyes, pickled hands and other such items. For the student of the occult, the Witchcraft Museum located at 235 Jefferson, Fisherman's Wharf in San Francisco is worth the visit.

ASTROLOGY IN AMERICA

Evangeline Adams



A burst of astrological enthusiasm grew out of the late 19th Century Theosophical movement. Max Heindel broke away from the main group and founded the Rosicrucian Fellowship which has a strong interest in Astrology. His book, Message of The Stars, is his most famous book. Also located near Los Angeles is the Llewellyn College which was founded in 1908 professing to teach a scientific type of Astrology. The flamboyant career of Evangeline Adams was probably the most important impetus to popular Astrology in America. She began her career in 1899 by checking into the Windsor Hotel in New York. As soon

as she had unpacked her charts she predicted a terrifying future for the hotel's proprietor. The next day the hotel was totally destroyed by fire and some of the guests, but not Evangeline, were killed. The proprietor told the story to the newspapers thus creating an overnight fame for Evangeline and her astrological abilities.

A radio program, articles and books and a studio at Carnegie Hall helped keep her in the spotlight and created a legend of fame for Miss Adams for many years.

Astrology For Everyone, one of Miss Adams' best selling books, is a very simplified account of popular astrology. The illustrations of The Zodiac used here are from her 1931 edition.

The hows and whats of astrology are explained to the laymen. The author includes anecdotes about famous people she has done horoscopes for, always delightedly proving the accuracy of her astrological insight.

Her famous theory of vibrations is summed up by her by pointing out that since everything in nature influences everything else, why shouldn't the stars influence man?

A famous trial where she was prosecuted for fraud, provided her with another spotlight. She cast the chart of the Judge's son for the court and so impressed them with the accuracy of her predictions that astrology was given legal accolade.

One of her proteges, Carroll

Righter, has been one of Hollywood's most important Astrological Consultants.

Popular astrology in America tends towards personality profiles. In the next issue we will examine some of the lesser known philosophic interpretations of Astrology in America.

Evangeline gives a brief sketch of the astrological chart of the United States. Keep in mind the fact that this excerpt comes from the 1931 edition of her book.

Certainly, nations have horoscopes—just as people do! France was born on such and such a date; Italy on another; Germany on still another; and our own country, as every American knows, on the fourth of July, 1776. All an astrologer needs to know to draw a horoscope of anybody or anything is this information about the birthday. It is better, of course, if she also knows the place and the hour; and in these matters, too, it is possible to achieve scientific accuracy so far as the United States is concerned.

and she continues by assuming ...

—that the life of the American nation dates from that moment in Philadelphia at 3:03 in the morning, when the signers of the Declaration of Independence reached a positive decision to declare to the world their independence of England.

The Sun was in Cancer when the United States was born, but Gemini, the third sign of the Zodiac, was "rising," as we astrologers say, at the moment of birth, and is, therefore, most influential in determining our destiny. Gemini is itself a very nervous, restless, versatile, and highly mental sign. The fact that the United States was born so strongly under its influence would be enough, according to astrology, to account for much which is significant in American character and history. But that is not all. The ruling planet of the sign Gemini is Mercury, "The Messenger of the Gods," which governs the mind, the imagination, and the nerves. This combination of celestial influences explains why we are the world's greatest travelers, greatest advertisers, greatest salesmen—and why, incidentally, we are so subject to the American disease of "nerves."

I said, "Sure, fine, I didn't realize that I was worthy." First Al showed up with some gin, then

Kathy, a gal I had invited, then Les and then Rudy the transvestite. This seemed to be The group -- the hard core -- the purists.

We drank for a while and talked about the phoney put-on's in Anton's group until Kathy's boy friend showed up wanting her to leave.

Les became surly and called his secretary -- threatening her with her job if she didn't come over right away. He said she was one of Anton's most popular sacrificial virgins. She told him he could toss his job because she couldn't get a baby sitter this late. Kathy's boy friend insisted that they leave. THE MOVEMENT

The Movement is the newspaper dedicated to the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness, a light and love religious group based in Rosemead, Ca. The articles tend to be very intense in their tone, spiritual and subjective. Much of the business of the MSIA ministers and council members is also discussed. The reader almost feels like a trespasser reading some private accounts of religious activity.

The advertising is very mundane after the spiritual quality of the articles, but MSIA seminars and study courses are also advertised along with Real Estate brokers, Country Fried

Chicken. If you are truly spiritual, and feel a need to communicate with others who are filled with inner light, this is the newspaper for you.

BEYOND REALITY

This magazine is one of the slick commercial publications available on the newstands. It has had a successful year of existence that is envied by all of us in the field of occult sciences.

It is a serious magazine with an excellent format. The articles are well researched and well written, with attractive professional illustrations. All occult interests are covered at random and from a serious or studious viewpoint. The only 'fakery and sham' to be found in this mag might be in the various advertise-

ments. Many of these are definitely 'unreal', but since they are paying customers they are given space. Obviously the advertisers do not reflect the editorial opinion expressed in the main text. They are kept distinctly separate and do not interfere with the interesting reading material. Although some articles are trite or too scholarly to be readable, this mag is one of the best available.

This is one of the most complete and serious magazines of a metaphysical nature to come from the west coast. It is in simple and beautifully organized format.

The editor, obviously a dedicated professional, has done a fine job of clear, concise writing and editing. Though only one year old, this magazine has shown steady improvement and can compete journalistically with the best.

The articles are both readable and informative. None of the 'sensational' appears in these pages. Astrology, (including the most accurate sidereal form) eastern religions, macrobiotics, herbal lore and book reviews are some of the serious topics discussed in each issue. Even the advertising stays away from the lurid, unreal occult ads found in most of the other mags. One gets the feeling that The Center endorses each of its advertisers. The Centerfold is a program of coming events and classes to be held at the Metaphysical Center. It is so marvelous, it makes the reader want to move to San Francisco to be able to take advantage of the offerings. Don't miss this one for \$3.50 per year!

The Occult

A History By Colin Wilson

The author denies being an occultist. What he says though, throughout his magnificent history of occultism, is that the power of higher consciousness is not hidden or secret. This Faculty X is simply the directly experienced awareness of a purpose to life.

He dazzles the reader with flashes of insight into a broad spectrum of events and ideas from evolution, the Tarot, Gurdjieff, time experiences... just to mention a few. His evolution is man's expanding capacity to enjoy subtle vibrations. He points out that the higher the form of life, the deeper its capacity for registering meaning and the more powerful its hold on life.

The Tarot is described as a 'lunar knowledge' system whose symbols stimulate the subconscious to link with the conscious. The lunar system refers to occult knowledge rather than scientific knowledge. The moon goddess was the inspiration of poets and mages while the masculine sun god captured the rational mental drives of western civilization.

Science clings to the idea that truth can be seen more clearly in the sunlight than in the moonlight. The author points out that certain things become invisible in a strong light and highly rational modes of thought are like a wide net through which all the smaller fish escape.

Mr. Wilson offers, as I see it, a valid criticism of Gurdjieff's system. While underlining the brilliancy of his psychological insights, Mr. Wilson points out that Gurdjieff fails to make enough of man's intentionality as a mechanism of consciousness.

In the final chapter, 'glimpses', the author describes what he calls 'Time-Three'. From his own experiences and observations he shares his belief and hope of humanity's upward psychic evolution.

The Editor

COLIN WILSON's brilliant first book, *The Outsider*, gained him an international reputation. He has since written almost thirty books: science fiction, detective and spy stories; penetrating psychological studies; scholarly works and encyclopedias; and a number of novels. Mr. Wilson brings a background of many years of personal interest and exhaustive research to *The Occult*. He lives in England with his wife and two children.

Mystic Cauldron

(soup pot)

Favorable reader response to a foods article by Darius inspired us to seek the expertise of a well known local herbalist and chef.

In America, frontier gardens and kitchens furnished both food and remedies for the settlers. As years passed, much of this early plant knowledge became lost or forgotten. Today, with the reawakening of interest in our planet earth, lost lore is again a fascinating hobby and the mystic powers of certain herbs and foods are being explored.

Let us explore for instance, an old friend and common herb, *allium sativum*, or garlic. Miraculous and curative powers have long been claimed for garlic.

The following recipe for garlic soup is still known as a popular cold remedy.

5 garlic cloves, peeled and pressed, 1 tblsp. cooking oil, 2 qts. chicken bouillon, salt and pepper to taste, pinch of thyme and rosemary, 1/2 cup light cream, 3 egg yolks beaten and 1/4 cup grated cheese.

Saute' garlic in oil until brown. Heat bouillon and add

garlic and seasoning to it. Simmer for one hour. Add cream to eggsm, then add a little hot liquid. Add eggs to soup. Remove soup from heat after 5 min. Serve with croutons and grated cheese. Makes about 2 quarts.

To merely season food with garlic, pierce each clove of garlic and drop it into the food. Remove the clove before the food is served. The flavor of garlic is supposed to give strength and toughness to the diner.

An early American remedy for acne or boils was thought to be a special garlic salve made in the colonial kitchen.

This salve was also applied to the chest to alleviate congestion.

Remember, to rid hands of strong garlic smell, use lemon juice.

in battle in a bileous breeze.

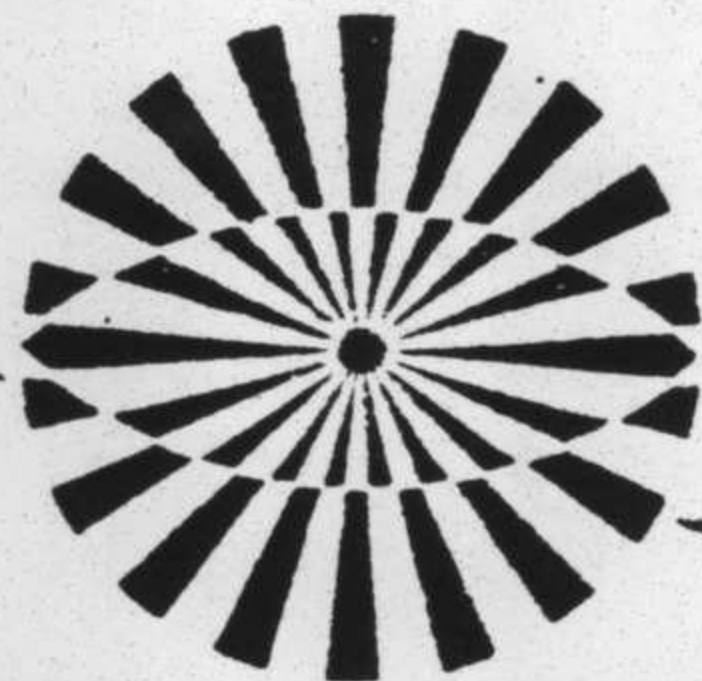

The author of Graphotherapeutics, Paul de Saint Colombe, proposes that the use of graphology in the form of writing exercises will actually reverse personality traits. Historically the accepted view has been that handwriting communicates in two ways, what one says and how one says it, it is reflective of a current mood or emotional stance. The author includes in his book, case histories with writing samples and biographical accounts of individual personality changes.

Letter examples with a verbal description along with their personality significance are also provided,

I include here samples of some of his letter M's.

Some of my questions concern other possible factors that could have caused personality changes in his case histories. For instance, the effect of contact with an authority figure, the concern and interest by another person, the setting up of a schedule and specific goals, the acceptance of the client for the responsibility to follow through with the writing exercises prescribed by the author, and the success of attaining a mutually important goal.

I am impressed with a tool such as graphology which the author has evidently used so effectively, but I think that it is simplistic to believe,

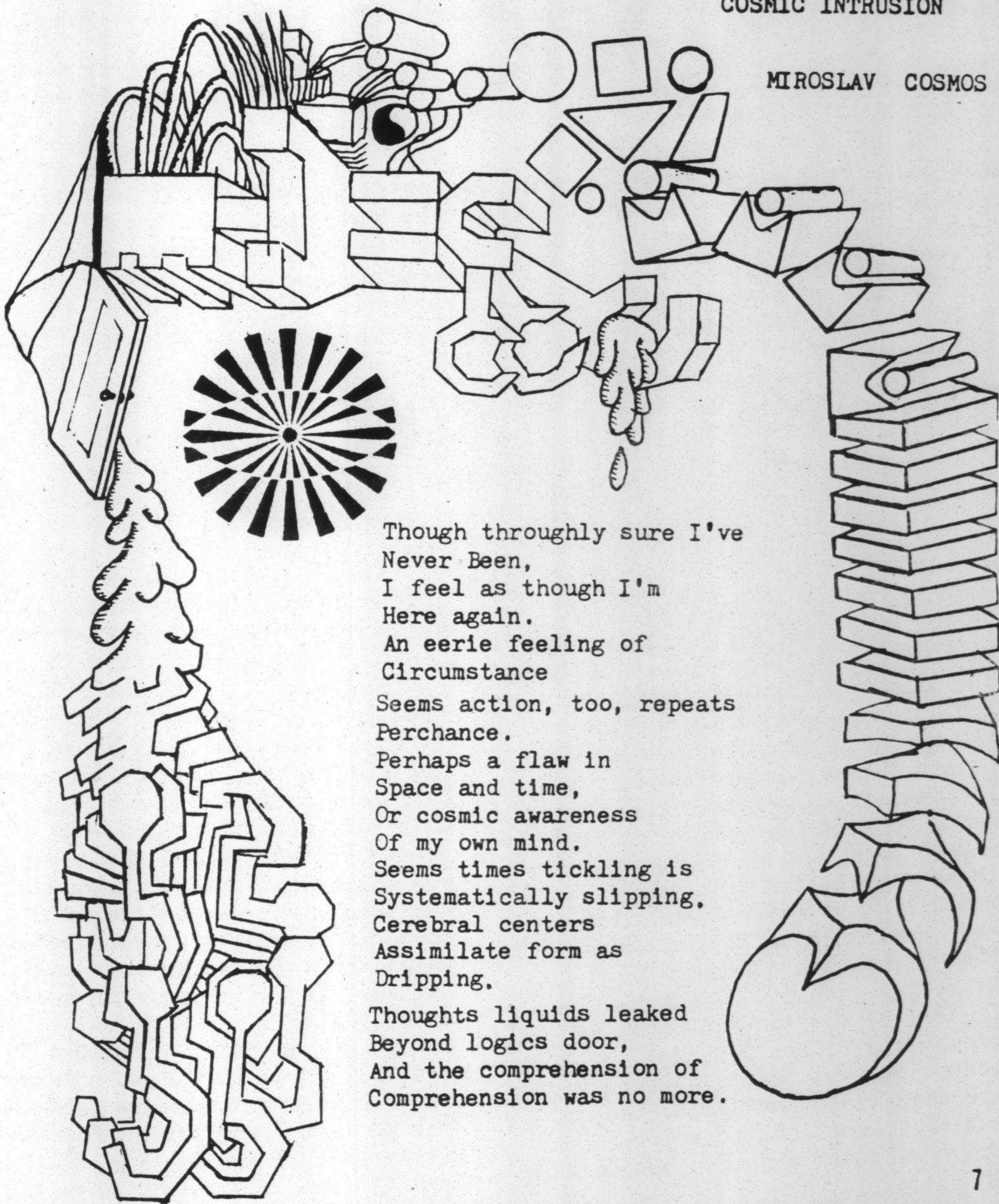

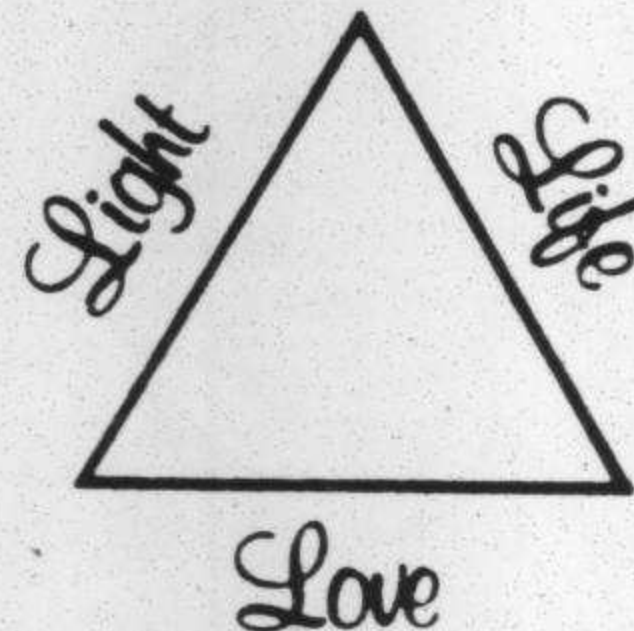

Editor Richard Cavendish is already an established authority on magic and witchcraft. Most of his contributors are outstanding in related occult fields with literary publications of various kinds to their credit. All in all it is a very impressive anthology of serious occult information.

The issues are small, on poor paper considering the investment. These issues are available commercially at supermarkets, drugstores and newsstands for .95 per issue, or \$106.40 for 112 unbound issues. If compiled into the bindings, also offered by this company, the cost will then become an even \$120.00. Quite a hustle Mr. Cavendish has going for him.



Were all of the material published and bound like a proper encyclopedia at this price, it would be a bargain for serious students of the occult. As it stands, these students would do better by borrowing the original books from the public library.

As for being, 'The Most Unusual Magazine Ever Published', Mr. Cavendish and company obviously have not seen some of the publications which cross our desk!

Mystic Cauldron (sex pot)

The role of Sassafras (*Sassafras Albidum*) in American folklore and early exploration is unique. In the century following the journey of Columbus, explorers visiting northern Florida and South Carolina were given samples of this aromatic root by the Indians, who called it 'pauame'. The native Americans claimed it to be a remedy for malaria, high fever, comfort for the liver and stomach and a powerful aphrodisiac. This plant with a strong pleasant smell was supposed to ward off evil, and evil, rather than bacteria, was believed to be the real cause of sickness.

Impatient to secure adequate supplies of sassafras, the English charged their early explorers to search for it. Sassafras became one of the first exports sent by Capt. John Smith from the Jamestown colony. However, since it was not curing all the ailments it claimed to cure, a disappointed public lost faith in it.

Much later, and many miles



away, the dried and powdered leaves of this tree were introduced as an essential ingredient in Creole Cookery, particularly in Gumbo. Known as File' powder, it is believed to have been a legacy of the Choctaw Indians.

Today sassafras is popular as a delightful non-addictive beverage. Oil of sassafras is distilled from the bark and roots of the trees and used in soft drinks and candies. Old timers like my Grandfather Elliot, age 96, regard the brew as a general tonic necessary to rejuvenate sluggish body processes as winter fades into spring.

The tree, which grows wild in the eastern United States from Maine to Northern Florida and as far west as Louisiana, is sought by the new generation of natural food enthusiasts.

Like them, I use a mattock to grub out the sassafras roots, which, contrary to popular belief, may be harvested at any time of year. I have found that the trees growing in the poorest soil produce the best tea.

A strong, pleasant odor will tell you if you have found the right root. Note the illustration, the leaves have three distinct

shapes. Scrub the root with a brush and chip off the bark with a knife. The bark chips can be used at once, or dried and stored indefinitely .

For those who are not interested in harvesting their own, many independent grocers in the country carry a supply of the prized red root. They are tied in neat miniature bundles. The large split roots are to be avoided as they are lacking in flavor.

To make sassafras tea, put a few chips in a little water, cover and bring to a boil. Let simmer for about five minutes, then pour through a strainer into a cup, stirring in honey to taste.

Your tea should have a bright orange color, a pleasant odor, and a delightful taste.

Here is a File' food favorite for cocktail party use...

FILE' SPREAD

Cream a stick of margarine , blend in 1 tblsp. File' powder, 1 tsp. paprika, and a few drops of of lemon juice. Spread on crackers. Garnish each with a tiny shrimp rolled in finely minced parsley.

File' powder, as mentioned above, is made from sassafras leaves. Since it is a thickening agent, it can become stringy if boiled. It should be added to boiling liquid gradually, and after the dish has been removed from the heat.

CHICKEN OYSTER GUMBO

1 small chicken
1 lb beef stew
1 cup diced okra
1 tblsp. butter
1 onion
3 pts. water
2 dozen shucked oysters
1 1/2 tsp. File' powder
salt and pepper

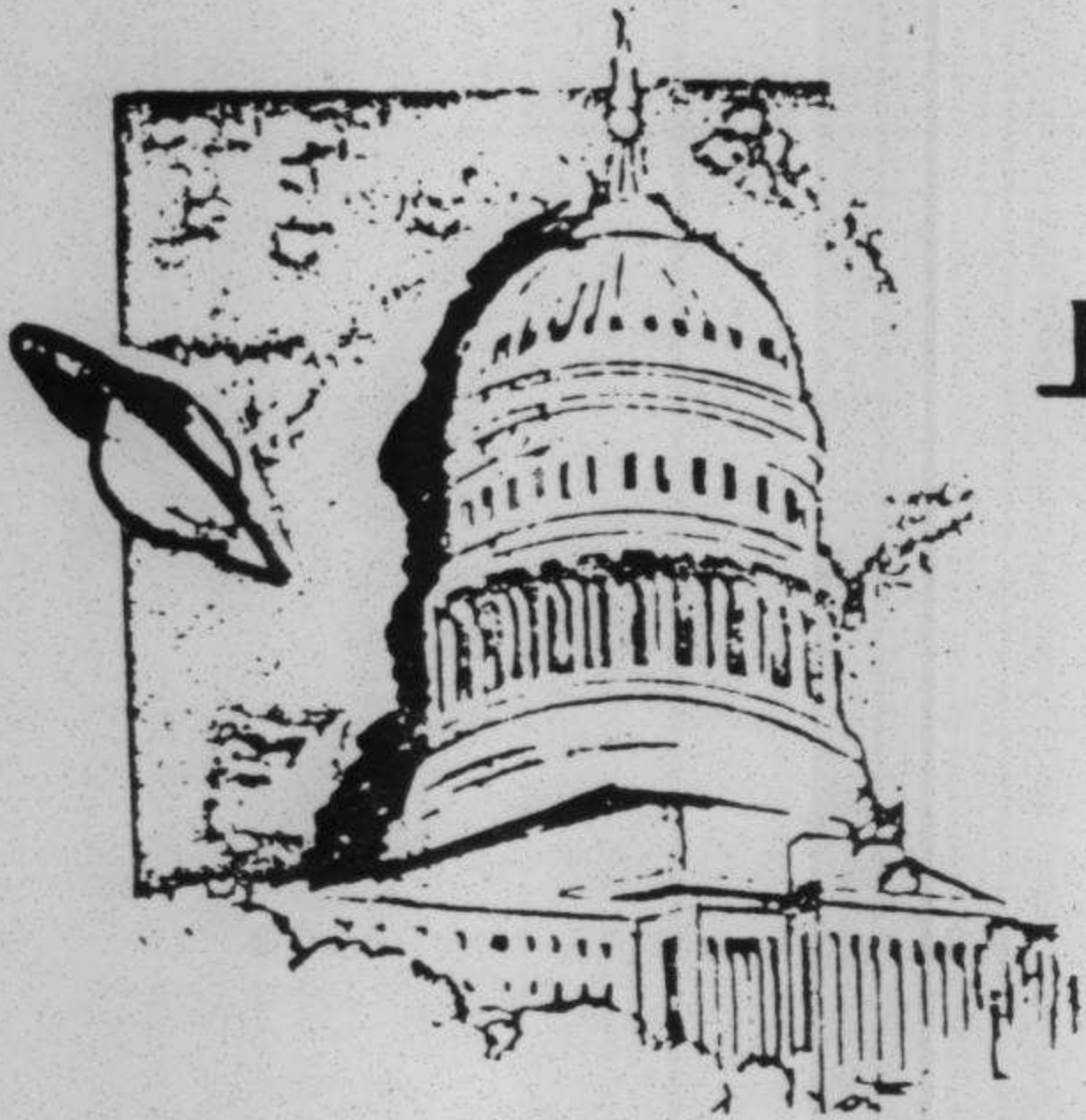
Cut up chicken and stew it with beef and okra in water. When a strong broth is made and meat is tender, remove chicken bones and cut meat in small pieces. Add oysters with liquor and season to taste with other ingredients except File'. Remove from heat and gradually add File' after oyster edges curl. Serve at once.

Although the occult properties of sassafras seem to have been reduced over the years, Verta Mae, the famed Vibration Cookbook author says, "It cleans you out."

AMERICAN OCCULTISM

Occult history in America draws from such diverse backgrounds as the ancient witchcraft of native Indians, Voodoo rites brought from Africa and South America and the belief in sorcery carried to the new continent by the early English and Dutch settlers to the distinctly American heretical varieties of traditional Christianity.

The religious trend in America was experimentation, the discovering of new paths to personal salvation. The Europeans who came to America had left behind them a religious way of life directed for them by politicians and ecclesiastics. The religious groups in America were destined to be controlled and inspired by credulous but practical 'ordinary citizens'.

Historians have not always agreed on the definitions of 'Occult' and 'Religious'. The common characteristics most often accepted are, the element of secrecy and an emphasis on the 'unknown'. If a society includes some secret rituals permissible only to the initiated, and its sacred literature includes

answers to the 'unknown', it would be considered Occult rather than Religious.

According to this definition, such a purely American sect as the Mormons would be classified as having a semi-occult origin.

However, other than the infamous witchcraft trials in Salem, Massachusetts, colonial America offers little to the history of occultism in comparison to the intensity of later activity in America.

Experimental occult communities such as the Mountain Cove Community of Harris and the famous society of Hopedale flourished briefly. American history also contributes to the list of occult personalities. Thomas Harris, Brigham Young, the Fox sisters, Andrew Jackson Davis and Adin Ballou would just begin a long and fascinating list.

Theosophy owes much to America since it was in New York City in 1875 that Madam Blavatsky founded her spiritualistic society, inspired by astral communication with two Tibetan mahatmas.

Pseudo-occultism finds fertile soil in America and those who exploit this fact find fanatic enthusiasm for such cults as Isis-worshippers, Devil Devotees, and sex-oriented rituals, and yet the same soil produces scientific and academic studies of psychic phenomenon, mysticism and dream analysis.

The most successful, in terms of membership and political power, religious groups to come from pure American soil, is Mormonism.

It is a fascinating story of the credulity and plain but beautiful American kind of talent and a perfect example of enterprising esoteric enthusiasm.

Included here is a picture of the handsome young Joseph Smith, founder of the sect.



JOSEPH SMITH : the Prophet

Modern occultists refer to the strip along the New York Thru-way from Buffalo to Albany as the 'Psychic Highway'. Historians refer to this district as the 'Burned-over District'.

For the first few decades of the 19th century the fires of revivalism swept over Western New York preparing souls for an intense spiritual awakening. The highway was soon crowded with religious 'free-lancers' who preached moral and spiritual reform to eager listeners. These preachers had little formal education and only the vaguest affiliation with the orthodox ministry.

One of the many major American faiths born of this strange mixture of time and place was Mormonism. A fourteen-year-old boy named Joseph Smith was converted by a 'hell-fire' methodist revivalist near Manchester, New York. The preacher advised the young boy Joseph to seek God in solitude so that He could guide his path. Joseph prayed for this guidance in a grove of trees on a hill not far from his father's farm. The Lord told him not to become affiliated with an established church because he, Joseph Smith, was to become the instrument for the establishment of the True Church of Jesus Christ.

Three years later, in 1823, the angel Moroni came to Joseph and told him of a sacred book that was buried in the same near-by hill. The angel led Joseph to the sacred spot and it was there that the golden plates were found. Soon after the plates were translated into the Book of Mormon the angel removed them from the earth. This book is considered the fulfillment of the Christian Bible for the religious group known as the 'Latter Day Saints'.

The Book was originally written in a form of Egyptian hieroglyphics and it chronicle the history of the American continent.

The history of the original Americans begins in the seventh century B.C. with a man named Lehi, his wife and four sons. Lehi was told by the Lord to flee his country of Judea. He and his family went to the Arabian desert where the revelations of God continued to pour in on Lehi. He was told to build a large ship. He and his family set sail and after many months landed in South America. Here they prospered and multiplied. Two of Lehi's sons were named Laman and Nephi.

Nephi was god-fearing but Laman was wicked. The brothers quarreled. The descendants of Nephi were fair-skinned and beautiful. The descendants of Laman had dark skin and were unpleasant. The tribes continued their quarreling through the years. At the time of the ascension of Jesus, who came and counseled the descendants of Lehi, it was the Nephites who received the blessing.

Their troubles continued until 429 A.D. when a final battle was fought and the Nephites were destroyed by the Lamanites. The battle occurred on the hill which is known as Cumorah and is located near Manchester New York.

The Nephites left a record in the form of gold plates and it was this book that Joseph translated into the Book of Mormon.

With Korra Deaver

On a recent visit to Little Rock, Arkansas, I was fortunate to find

the founder of the "Institute of Psychic Science, Inc." and editor of the bi-monthly publication BREAKTHROUGH! available for an interview. She was most gracious and answered Miroslav's and my questions with a very appealing sincerity.

The institute was established in 1971 with the purpose of promoting education and research in the psychic field. Ms. Deaver studied a variety of psychic disciplines, including Unity church, Silva Mind Control and Hypnosis. she is emphatic about using the term 'esoteric' rather than metaphysical to describe her teachings. She explains this term as a synthesis of systems including knowledge of the invisible world, masters and planes and theosophy. She is able to teach this to her beginning students in very basic terms. There is a variety of course offerings but the basic group

consists of three nine week sessions. The first is called E.S.P., Extended Sense Perception, the second involves techniques for self-hypnosis, mind-expansion exercises which include training in the use of the supra-conscious which is the ability to think outside the brain and the third session uses the text Wisdom of the Masters.

After completing these courses the students, in Korra's words; "Have a high spiritual understanding of themselves and one important thing that happens is that they are centered in their inner selves because they have learned to contact their high-selves, or their own god-presence rather than personalities, carnate or discarnate."

These graduates then form an inner circle and meet regularly for continued personal inner development.

Favorable reader response to a foods article by Darius inspired us to seek the expertise of a well known local herbalist and chef.

Mint came to America with the earliest settlers. As a naturalized herb with over thirty species, it has been unkindly dubbed as unwelcome weeds in many places.

Nevertheless, the uses of mint leaves for cooking are indeed as many as the 'sparks from Lucifer's kitchen'. With the scarcity of doctors at the time the colonists were struggling for survival, mint was far from being an unwanted nuisance. Garden mint was widely used as a poultice for such ailments as stings from mosquitoes and bees, headaches in small children and when brewed in a broth it was known to relieve the discomforts of menstruation.

When mint was used in baths along with 'baulme' and other common herbs it comforted and strengthened the nerves and muscles.

To bring things a bit more up to date, extracts of mint are widely used in commercial medicines, candies, gum, toothpaste, skin lotions and shaving creams. Mint has many medicinal uses. Its high content of vitamins A and C

explain why it was effective in curing scurvy, night blindness and illnesses connected with deficiencies of these vitamins

Here are a few of my recipes for mint

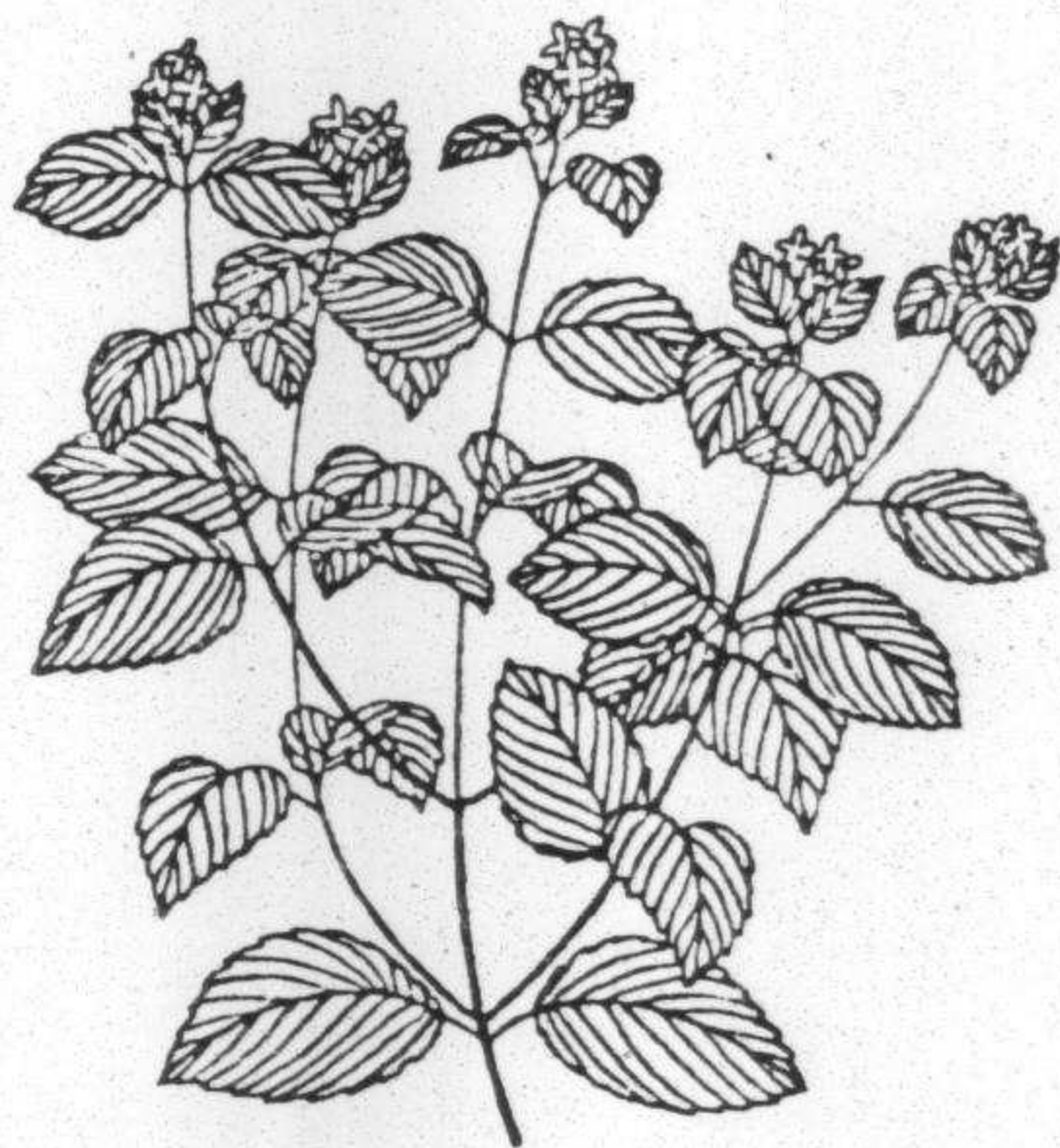
MINT VINEGAR

1 good handful of fresh mint leaves
(or 3 tablespoons of dried mint)
1 quart of pure apple cider vinegar
(or 1 qt. distilled white vinegar)
Wash the fresh mint, shake it well and bruise it with a pestle or wooden potatoe masher.
Pack in a glass quart jar, pour in vinegar, (when using dried mint, bring vinegar to a boil before adding mint.) Cover tightly and let stand for two weeks. Strain and bottle. You might want to add a few drops of food coloring which produces a verdant 'artists green'.

This is an excellent mint vinegar with lamb. Mint vinegar is delicious in iced drinks. You might want to freeze a tray with

a mint sprig in each cube....it makes an interesting conversation piece.

American pioneers learned many survival trade secrets from the Indians. They had been relying on the forces of nature, herbs as their main source of medicines, long before the white man arrived. A pep tonic using mint leaves is an adaptation of an Indian brew. They would steep a heaping teaspoon of mint leaves in hot water, strain and then drink when warm. Usually this tonic would be taken an hour or so before mealtime.

MINTED APPLES

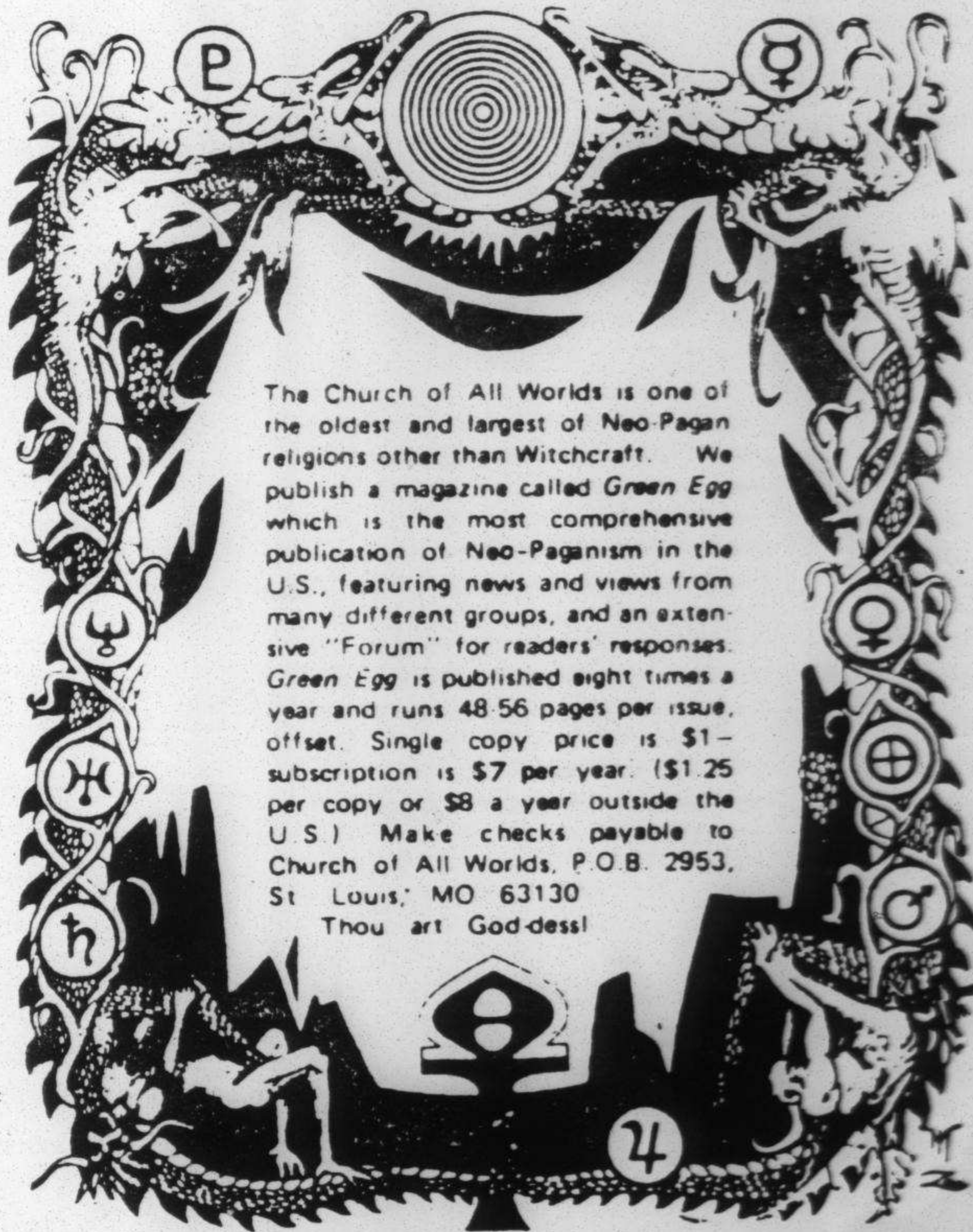
- 1 cup water
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/4 cup chopped mint
- 2 large apples

Boil the water, sugar and mint for 3 minutes. Add a bit of green food coloring. Peel and quarter the apples and cook in syrup until tender.

Strain syrup and pour over the apples.

President Andrew Jackson Joined 1821 Hunt for a Witch

Andrew Jackson is the only U.S. president ever known to have taken active part in an investigation of witchcraft.

And "Old Hickory," hero of the Battle of New Orleans, found the supernatural tougher to overcome than the British troops he routed in 1815.

Jackson launched himself on the witch-hunt partly as a lark and partly as a favor to an old friend, John Bell, a wealthy plantation owner who lived several miles north of Nashville, Tenn.

Bell's family had been plagued by the pranks of a mysterious being known as the "Bell Witch" or "Kate," who apparently objected to the engagement of Bell's youngest daughter, Betsy, to a store owner.

Kate would appear to the Bells as a strange-looking beast, a giant bird, a rabbit or a "pretty little girl."

Jackson, then semiretired in Nashville and eight years from his first term in the White House, decided in 1821 to go witch-hunting.

According to historian Col. Thomas Yancey: "Gen. Jackson and his men were riding

on horseback discussing how they were going to do up the witch . . . when just within a short distance of the (Bell) house, traveling over a smooth, level piece of road the (party's supply) wagon halted and stuck fast . . . as if welded to the earth."

Then, according to a member of the Bell family, "a sharp, metallic voice came from the bushes, saying, 'All right, General, I'll let the wagon move on.'"

"Gen. Jackson exclaimed, 'By the Eternal, boys, it's the witch. This is worse than fighting the British!'"

The wagon freed, Jackson continued on to the Bell farm house, where he spent two unsuccessful days trying to find an explanation for the mysterious goings-on.

Then Jackson returned to Nashville.

Today, a historical marker stands alongside U.S. Highway 41 near the spot where Jackson's wagon stalled.

An inscription says in part: "The witch scared off Betsy Bell's suitor . . . No satisfactory explanation of the witch has ever been advanced."

Salem witchcraft trial testimony released

SALEM, Mass. — Witchcraft hysteria swept this seaport town nearly three centuries ago. Now the witch trial to their deaths is being published.

An old English record of courtroom testimony reveals the fear that gripped the village in 1692 when teen-age girls said they'd been put under spells. Within a year, 19 persons had been hanged and one crushed to death.

The Eusex County commissioners are in the process of signing a contract for publication of the Salem Witchcraft Papers, testimony from the witchcraft trials.

Included in the trial records is Benjamin Hutchinson's statement that his wife was tortured by a witch:

"My wife was much afflicted after the last execution with violent pains in her heart and teeth and all parts of her body . . . she being in such

excessive misery that she said she believed that she had had a spell cast upon her.

"Whereupon I went to Mary Walcott, one of our neighbors, to come and look to see if she could see anybody upon her; and as soon as she came into the house she said that our two neighbors — Sarah Buckley and Mary Witheridge — were upon my wife; and immediately my wife had ease and Mary Walcott was tormented."

Dream Telepathy

Dream Telepathy is an historical survey of dream studies, detailed accounts of experiments conducted at the Maimonides Medical Center in New York, and fascinating theories about the humanistic implications of such studies. Their method of study involves an experimenter who 'beams' thoughts to the dreamer and later these thoughts and dreams are compared. The gist of the book is that there is scientific proof that there is a significant relation between what is sent and what is received.

In the forward, Gardner Murphy says, 'It is difficult to imagine today, a study more important, more nearly central to our fundamental problems in parapsychology..'

The authors do get into these problems and include comments by other experts, pro and con, about the authors theories.

Basic to the question of what happens in the dream state is the question, what is the dream state? I was very much drawn to Ullman's theory which he calls the PSI vigilance theory. The dreaming

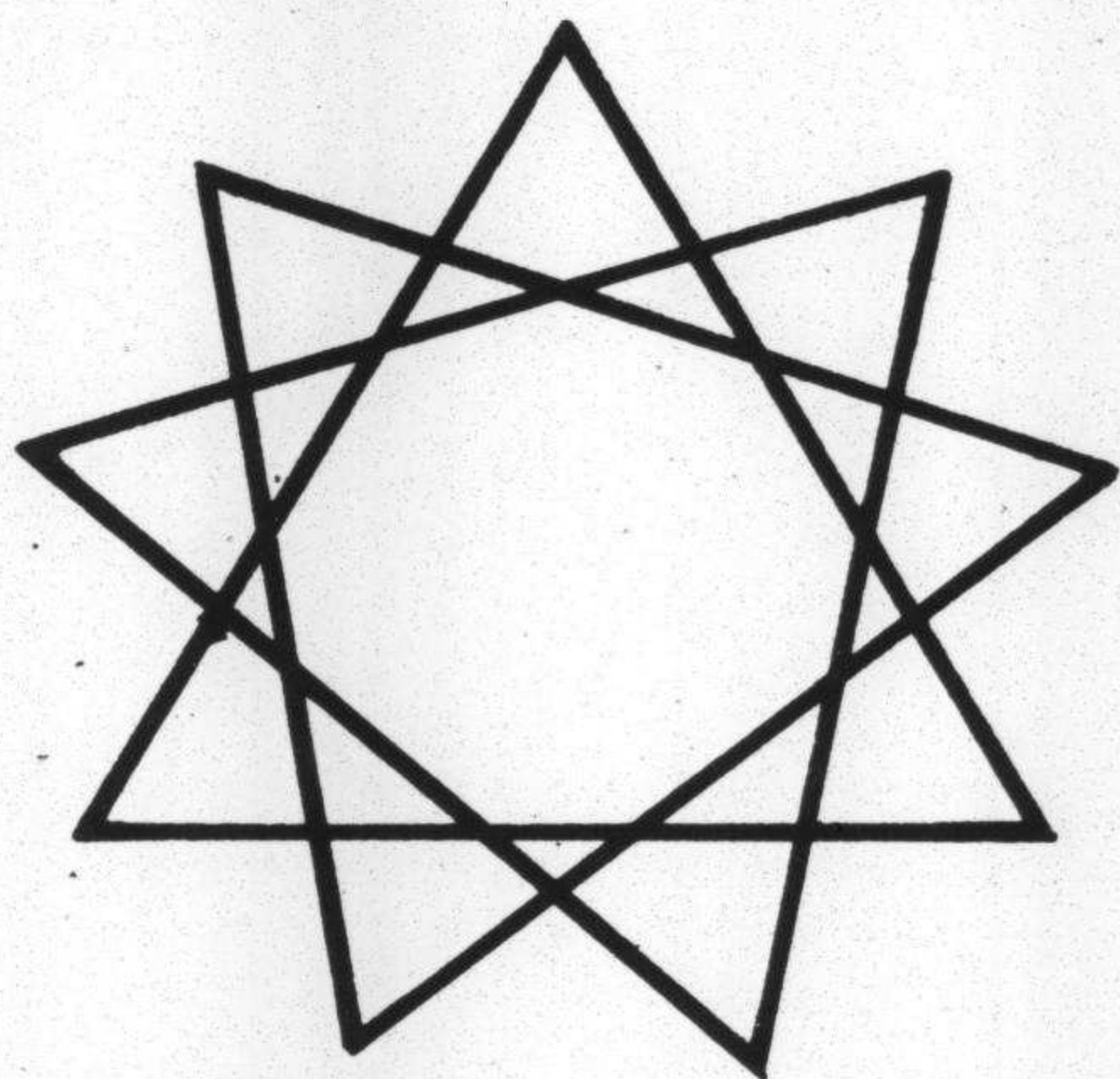
state is a possible linkage to a primitive danger sensing mechanism. It is a system of survival vigilance, one that responds to symbolic threats rather than physical threats to his social existence. What the dreamer is doing is scanning his psi field to see if anything, internally or externally, must be dealt with. This is why the dream state offers such a favorable state of consciousness for E.S.P.

But this is by no means the most accepted theory and others just as fascinating are presented. I agree with the authors that this kind of investigation has importance to the future of mankind. "Man's psychic potential suggests that in the basic fabric of life everything and everyone is more closely linked than our discrete physical boundaries would seem to suggest. Perhaps all forms of life are vitally interrelated in ways we do not yet clearly understand".

DR. MONTAGUE ULLMAN, a psychiatrist and psychoanalyst, and DR. STANLEY KRIPPNER, a psychologist, head the dream research team at Maimonides Medical Center's Dream Laboratory in New York City.

MYSTIC OR MADMAN?

Historical references to the life and writings of Swedenborg always do something with the question of his alleged madness. Not all mystics demand such attention by their historians. Why Swedenborg?



The brief biography given alone suggests perhaps that his mystic visions were more extreme than most and that before his conversion he had a scientifically practical mind, superior to many other mystics. It is this severe and sudden contrast that intrigues his historians. Those who defend Swedenborg emphasize the effect of this contrast by pointing out that because of his scientific training he was more able to observe and record the smallest detail even while on the very pinnacles of ecstasy. Even though some of his detailed descriptions of the flora and fauna on the moon, for instance, do not now square with scientific knowledge, his defenders say that what he saw was true for him only and in no way takes away from his insight with the scheme of divine humanity.

the writings of Swedenborg?

"The universe is an image of God, and was made for use. Providence is the government of the Lord in heaven and on earth. It extends itself over all things, because there is only one fountain of life, namely, the Lord, whose power supports all that exists.

"The influence of the Lord is according to a plan, and is invisible, as is Providence, by which men are not constrained to believe, and thus to lose their freedom. The influence of the Lord passes over from the spiritual to the natural, and from the inward to the outward. The Lord confers his influence on the good and the bad, but the latter converts the good into evil, and the true into the false; for so is the creature of its will fashioned.

"In order to comprehend the origin and progress of this influence, we must first know that that which proceeds from the Lord is the divine sphere which surrounds us, and fills the spiritual and natural world. All that proceeds from an object, and surrounds and clothes it, is called its sphere.

"As all that is spiritual knows neither time nor space, it therefore follows that the general sphere or the divine one has extended itself from the first moment of creation to the last. This divine emanation, which passed over from the spiritual to the natural, penetrates actively and rapidly through the whole created world, to the last grade of it, where it is yet to be found, and produces and maintains all that is animal, vegetable, and mineral. Man is continually surrounded by a sphere of his favourite propensities; these unite themselves to the natural sphere of his body, so that together they form one. The natural sphere surrounds every body of nature, and all the objects of the three kingdoms. Thus it allies itself to the spiritual world. This is the foundation of sympathy and antipathy, of union and separation, according to which there are amongst spirits presence and absence.

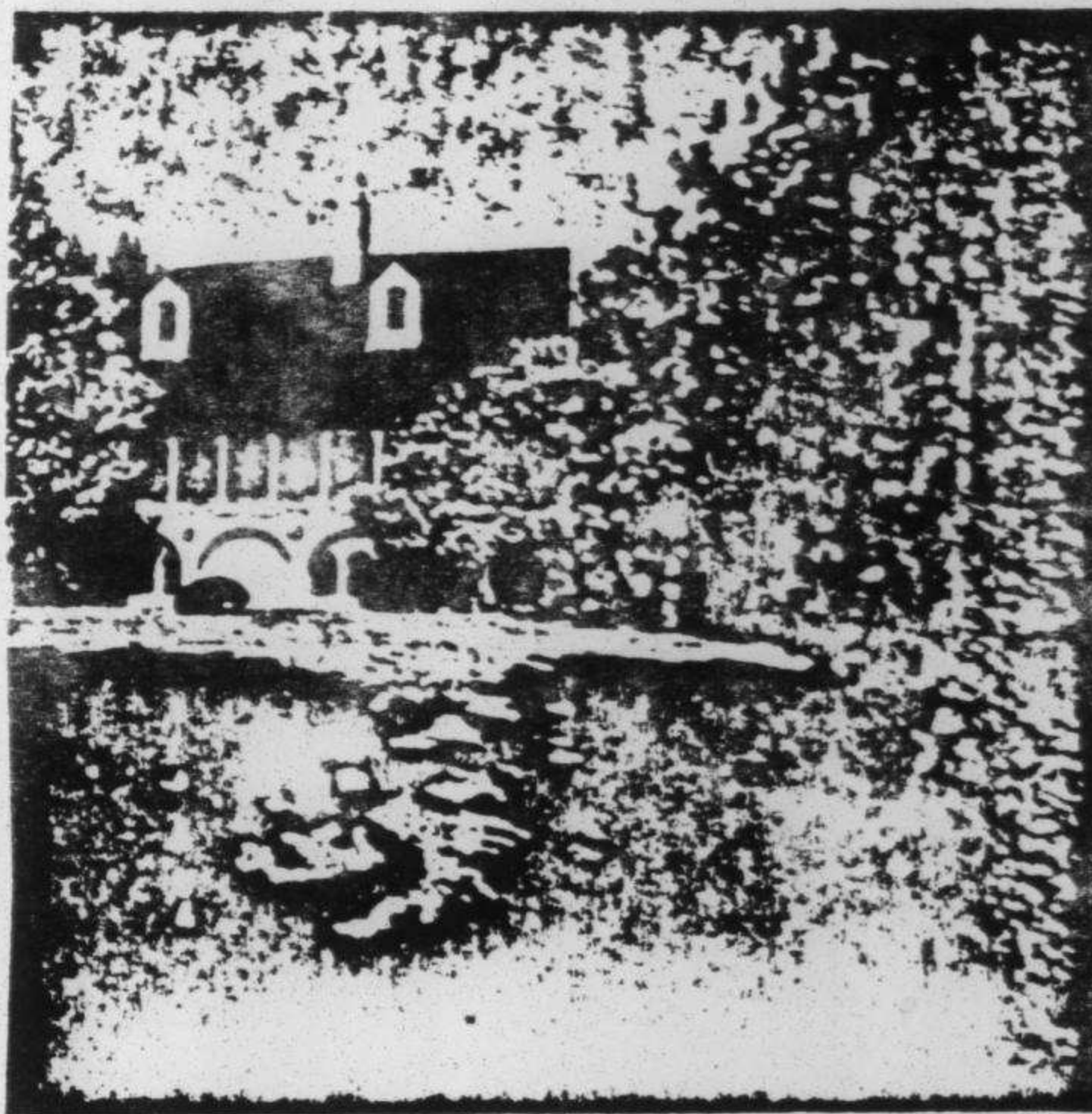
"The angel said to me that the sphere surrounded men more lightly on the back than on the breast, where it was thicker and stronger. This sphere of influence, peculiar to man, operates also in general and in particular around him by means of the will, the understanding, and the practice.

"The sphere proceeding from God, which surrounds man and constitutes his strength, while it thereby operates on his neighbour and on the whole creation, is a sphere of peace and innocence; for the Lord is peace and innocence. Then only is man consequently able to make his influence effectual on his fellow man, when peace and innocence rule in his heart, and he himself is in union with heaven. This spiritual union is connected with the natural by a benevolent man through the touch and the laying on of hands, by which the influence of the inner man is quickened, prepared, and imparted. The body communicates with others which are about it through the body, and the spiritual influence diffuses itself chiefly through the hands, because these are the most outward or *ultimum* of man; and through him, as in the whole of nature, the first is contained in the last, as the cause in the effect. The whole soul and the whole body are contained in the hands as a medium of influence. Thus our Lord healed the sick by laying on of hands, on which account so many were healed by the touch; and thence

from the remotest times the consecration of priests and of all holy things was effected by laying on of hand. According to the etymology of the word, hands denote power. Man believes that his thoughts and his will proceed from within him, whereas all this flows into him. If he considered things in their true form, he would ascribe evil to hell, and good to the Lord; he would by the Lord's grace recognise good and evil within himself, and be happy. Pride alone has denied the influence of God, and destroyed the human race."

THE CHURCH OF NEW JERUSALEM TODAY

The first society was organized in the U.S. in 1792 at Baltimore. Today there are 63 Swedenborgian churches in America. The general Church of the New Jerusalem is an educational movement looking toward a full acceptance of Swedenborg's doctrines. Their periodical New Church Life is published at their headquarters in Bryn Athyn, Pennsylvania.

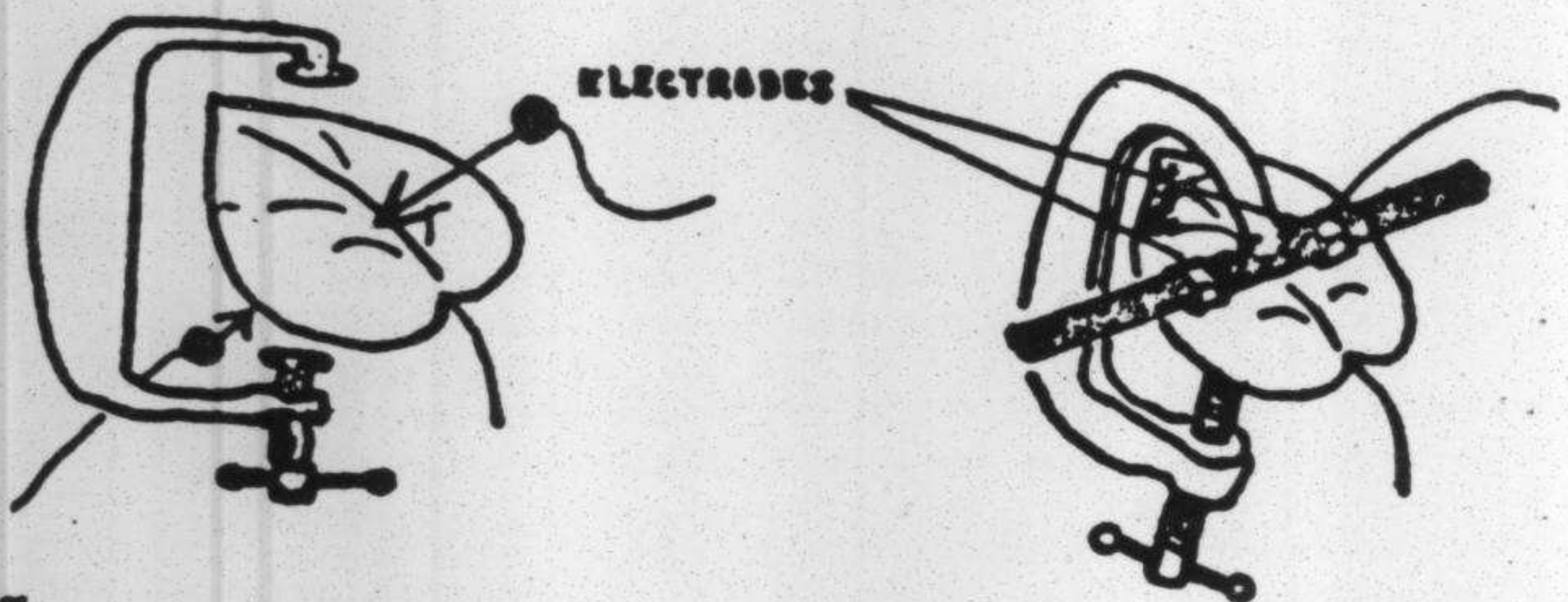

THE AMERICAN GREY WITCH

Do The Dead Really Talk?

"What is a Grey Witch?" will be the question that will come to most of you. I will try to explain why I am a "Grey" witch.

Black Magic vs. White Magic - is there really a difference between the two? A person who practices black magic must be in league with the devil and the white magician is one who performs works which only can help people - unselfish acts of good. But is this the way it really is? When I was growing up in a small town in the mid-west, local 'fortune tellers' and spiritualists kept an open Bible on their 'working' tables to counteract any workings of the dark world or its lord.

Throughout the ages the designation of 'black' has become synonymous with evil and 'white' with all things good. The villain in a horse opera wore a black hat, and the hero a white one. The difference between Black and White magic has been said to be the 'purity of motivation'. but this does not fit every situation. A better distinction is the 'degree of control'. Anything you say or do exerts a form of control on others. Example, when you say, 'Hello, how are you?', you expect a response. The only difference between the black and the white is a force of will, the degree of control exerted. Both want to gain something, be it riches, job advancement, love, etc.,

but it's how you go about gaining and if you are harming others in doing so. I like what Dr. Leo L. Martello had to say on this subject. Magic per se is neither white nor black, 'just as a knife is neither good nor evil' I believe that there is good in both areas and thus I have tried to take the 'best' of both, becoming a Grey Witch, a blending of black and white.

Witches can be born or made, in my case I was born of a woman who possessed psychic powers. Due to the fact that she, like most people of her day, feared such powers and felt that it was all the work of the Devil, seldom used them nor would she educate me in their usage. But I possessed them by birth and as I reached adulthood I realized that I too possessed these psychic powers and that I could read 'trees', minds, and see future events in the cards. But it was during my study of physics that I discovered and formulated my personal theory of Spiritualism.

Since everything is built of and consists of electrical energy, protons and neutrons (plus and negative atoms) then what we call our soul is nothing more than a form of electrical energy. This electrical energy, as with our own speech, floats through space, never disintegrating for eternity. There are certain individuals who act as

receptors who can pick up these electrical waves. The process can be compared to the electrical waves sent out by a radio station to be picked up by radio receivers. The medium is the 'radio' receiver and the 'spirit world' the radio station. I have often illustrated this electrical energy by the use of a simple button-bell system, which is enclosed inside a plain ungimicked box, through the use of spirit energy, this bell can be rung without human touch. It has been predicted by this country's scientists that some day we will be able to build a receiver that will be able to pick up and unscramble these voice waves floating in space and we will be able to hear the voices of such famous personalities as Gen. Washington and Edwin Booth.

While practising as a medium some years back I made the acquaintance of a middle aged woman who had lost her husband several years before. She had taken on a much younger lover, who worked as a merchant seaman. She often came to me to ask questions of her dead husband and he would give her advise about her various problems.

On this one occasion the young man had taken a job on a private yacht which left out of Miami, Florida. It was to be only a short trip, but

she became worried since she had not heard from him for some time. I had tried to contact her husband several times, but without any result. One day while speaking to her on the phone, her dead husband spoke to her. This is not surprising since the telephone is an instrument based on electrical energy. Her husband told her that he was unable to speak to her since he was very busy with her lover. We could not understand this message at the time, but it became quite clear later.

A month later I had a visitor at the theatre where I was working, it was the woman's lover. He told me a story of how he had been shipwrecked and that he and one other fellow were the only ones to escape. They spent two weeks in a life boat, the other fellow died after a week. The sailor had never believed in the occult or in my powers, but he now had doubts about that belief. He told me that the only reason he was able to survive without food or water was because there was someone or something in that boat with them that kept telling him to hang on. If it was not for the protection and presence of that third 'person' he would have given up as his friend had and he would have died of starvation and exposure. The question he asked me was of course, what was the power that had saved his life?

Who or what was that 'third person'? Was it her dead husband, or what some would call a 'thought form' or an extension of my own psychic energy? Who really can say, possibly it was a combination of all three, but it did happen.

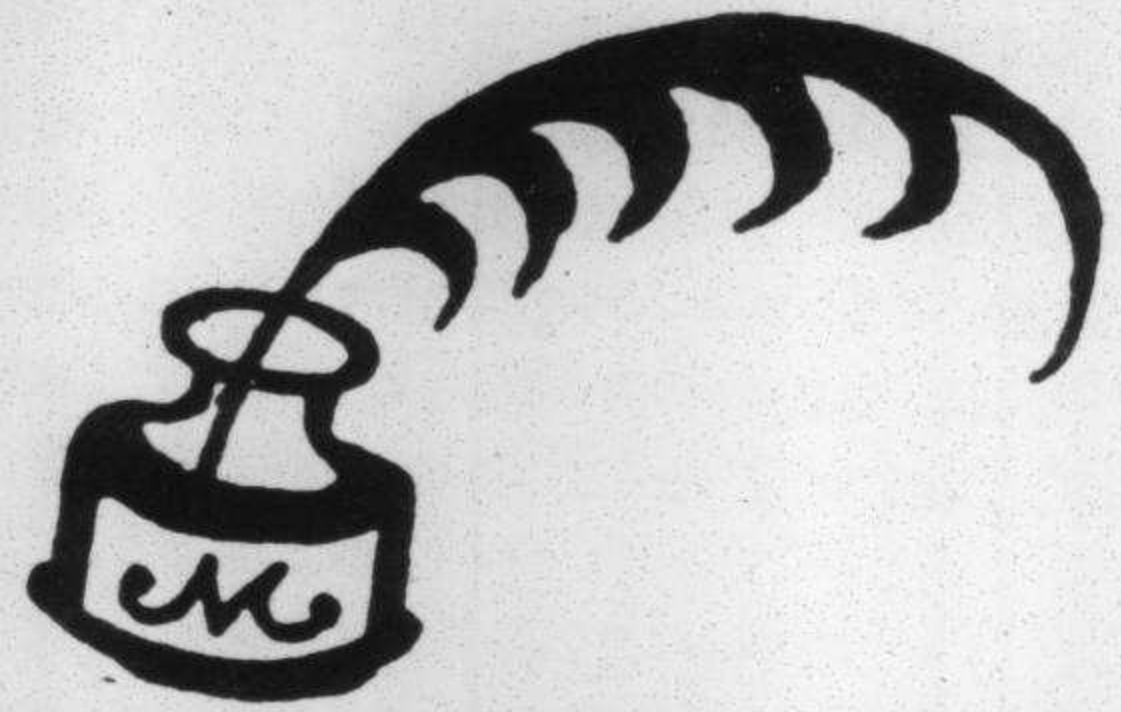

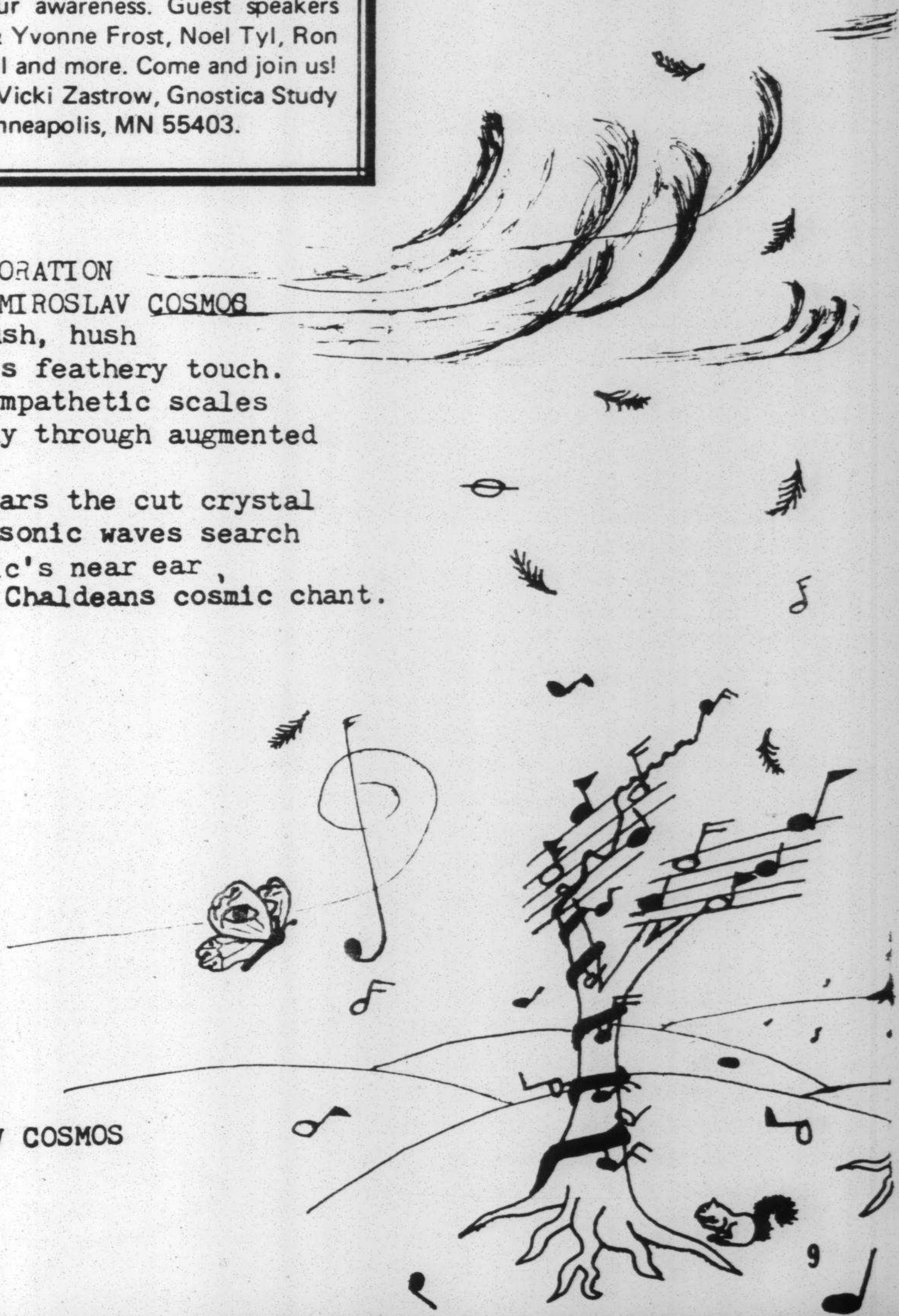
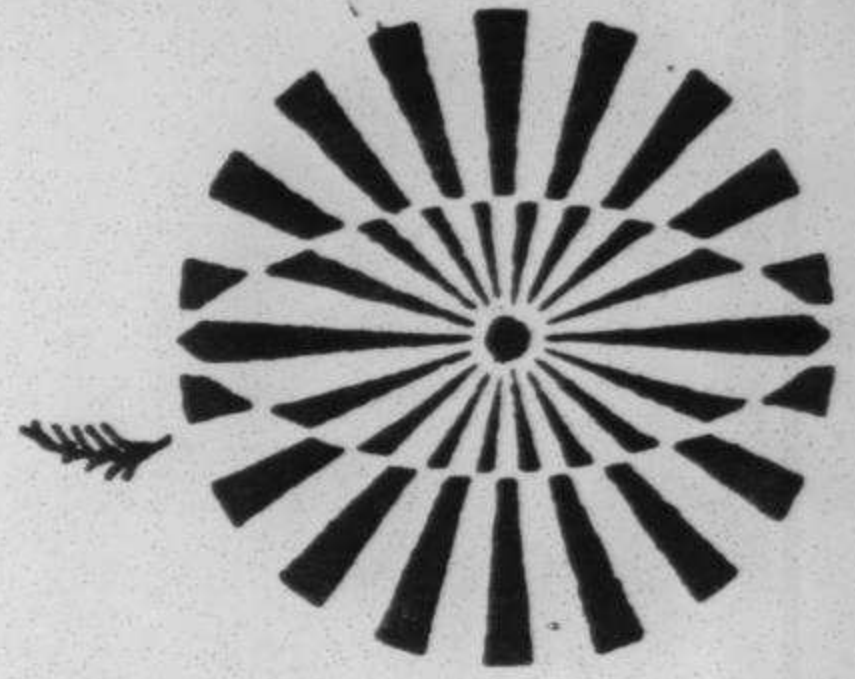

INTRODUCING MIROSLAV COSMOS



Our guest Herbalist this issue is a subscriber who tells us about a curious little-known American cult. Members of the O.A. staff have tried some of these recipes and found them delightful to the taste and sight.

I have been intrigued with the 'return to nature' movement begun by the young people in our society. I remembered a manuscript of my grandmothers which has been long collecting dust in my attic. The readers of Occult Americana might be as fascinated as I was with some of the more basic aspects of this strange cult which was popular in my grandmother's time. About 150 years ago in the mid-west these 'People of Sekonarah' lived their own 'back to nature' style. They left behind them only their handprinted manuscripts including their sacred texts and detailed directions on "how to BE nature incorporated within the Spirit" :

When I was a child my grandmother told me stories of this commune that remind me now of the flower children of a few years ago. One of the basic prerequisites of the Sekonarah people was that they live in and with nature and constantly detail the Beautiful. Flowers were a staple ingredient of their diet. They were cultivated for food and the petals were dried to be used during the long winter so that each day could begin and close with the physical incorporation of the Beautiful.



SISTER ABIGAIL'S BLUE FLOWER OMELET

4 eggs
4 tbsp. milk
dash salt and pepper
1 tbsp. minced parsley
1 tsp. minced chives
2 tbsp. butter
12 chive blooms (or violet
blooms)

Gently beat eggs, add milk, herbs and seasoning. Melt butter in heavy pan, pour in mixture. When the edges of the omelet begin to set, reduce heat. When set, sprinkle washed blooms over omelet and fold. Serve immediately on a hot platter.

VIOLET SALAD

Mix together 1 cup each: (washed and cubed) marinated artichoke hearts, cucumbers, endive and cantelope. Toss gently with thin sweetened mayonnaise. Add Violet blooms and toss very lightly. Serve cold.



FLOWER BUD GARNISH

Flower buds steeped for an hour in boiled vinegar with 1 tbsp. sugar. Dandelion, Marigold, Rose and Calendula buds are suggested. Used to garnish salads.

TEAS

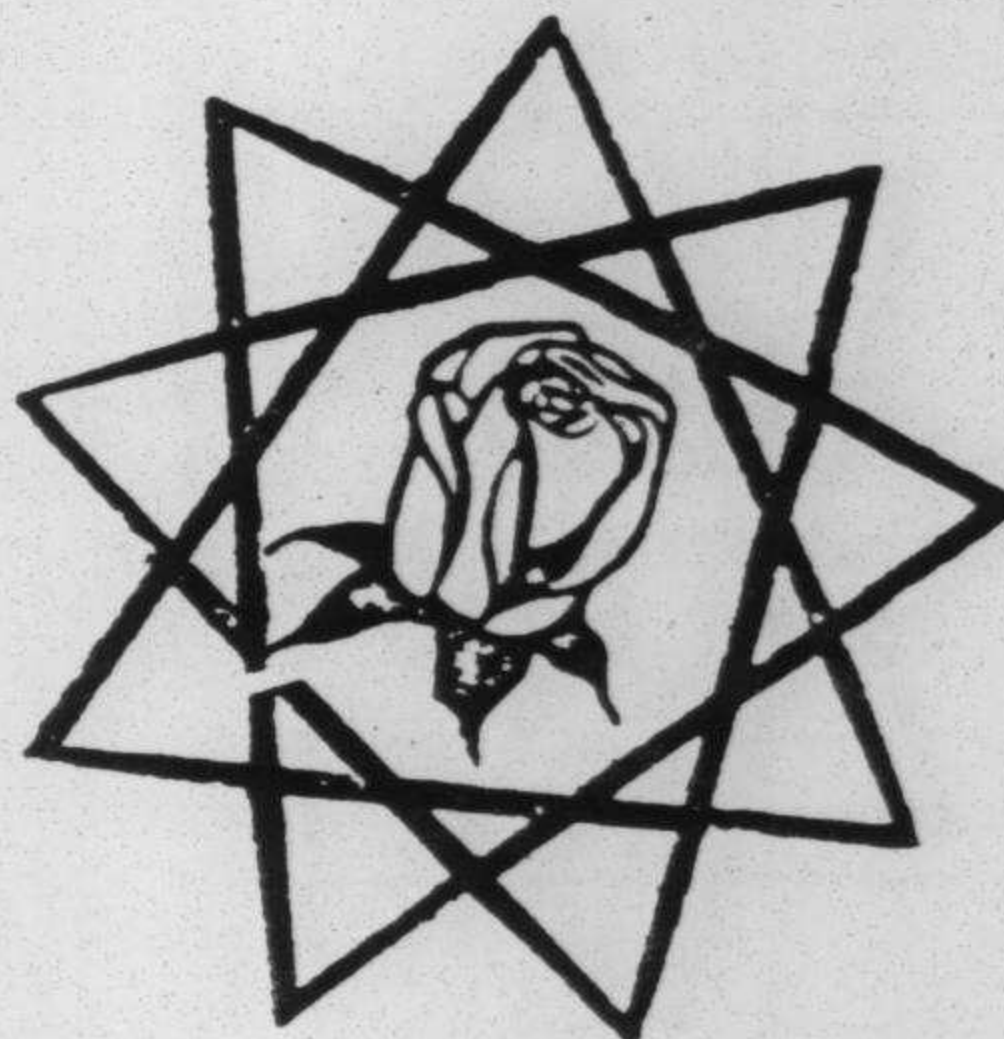
The dried petals of any of the flowers listed above may be used for making flower teas. A crockery tea-pot should be used, or any earthenware vessel with a lid. The petals are put into the pot and covered with boiling water. The lid is replaced and the petals left to infuse for about 5 minutes before the liquid is poured off.

GERANIUM VINEGAR

Fill a jar with clean-freshly picked Geranium leaves that are free from moisture. Cover with white vinegar and leave standing for at least 3 weeks. Strain off vinegar into bottles, add a fresh Geranium leaf to float and then cap.

FLOWER PICKLES

2 cups fresh blooms, one kind or in combination - Violets, Primroses, Marigolds, Nasturtiums. Place in pot and cover with water. Cook until tender. Drain and spread on paper towel. Salt gently after they have cooled. Place in jar with lid. Cover with a mix of water, vinegar, salt and sugar to taste. Serve cold.

GARDEN-FLOWER WINE

To 3 gallons of water, put 6 lbs. powdered sugar, boil the sugar and water together for $\frac{1}{2}$ hour, keep skimming it as the scum arises. Let it stand to cool, beat up 3 ounces betony with a large spoonful of ale yeast, put in a peck of flower head, let them infuse and work together 3 days, covered with a cloth. Strain it and put it into a cask. Let it settle for 3 or 4 weeks then bottle it.

WATER OF PINKS

Macerate 1 lb. of the petals of red pinks and $\frac{1}{2}$ drachm pounded cloves in 10 pints alcohol for 8 days. Distil in the water-bath, add a syrup made with 5 lbs. sugar and 3 pints water and color a deep red.

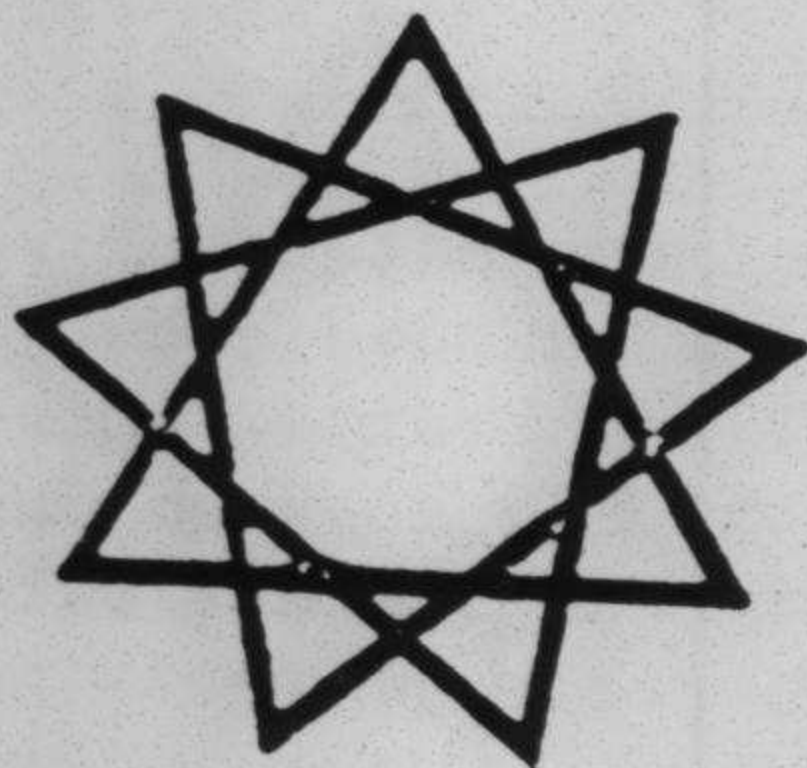

WHOLE-EARTH
INNER SPACE is a magnificent outpouring of information which outlines the author's vision of a world united by brotherly love and cooperation by psychonics. (which, dear reader, is a scientific theory of occultism... a combination of physics and psychics). Since the mystical experience, man's inner space, is as scientifically real, provable and repeatable, the recognition and use of these laws will unite mankind.

From the chapt. RELIGIONS

All existing world religions have errors both of doctrine and of practice. Yet, avatars have arisen in all religions and there are truths of spiritual science buried and distorted in all religions.

The Middle Eastern religions all erred in making divinity external, and in attributing personality to it. Christianity, as it is today, is a particularly noxious superstition, completely corrupting the teachings of its avatar (indeed, not even possessing any record of that teaching). Christianity is noxious because of the fanaticism of its Jesus Freaks and revivalists, with their Puritan asceticism, sectarian intolerance, and their anti-empirical emphasis on faith (euphemism for superstition and dogma). The asceticism is a misunderstanding of the methods and ideas of the early Christian mystics, who practiced physical austerities in order to have religious experience. These hermits never claimed that everyone should follow that path. Christian asceticism is also a reaction to the spiritually impoverishing form of Roman debauchery. Puritanism, which is asceticism for no purpose, ultimately leads back to the same spiritual impoverishment suffered by the Romans.

Emphasis by reformers on faith in the Christian bible over experience is what led to the protestant revolt and to puritanism. This is idolatry. The bible is what the scholars call a corrupt text. It was so mangled and corrupted by Jewish and Hellenic ideas that Christ's true ideas of reincarnation, the law of karma, and the law of grace, and the divinity within are almost totally obscured.

Of course, there remain certain uncorrupted passages in the new testament, with their explanations omitted. For instance, 'as ye sow, so shall ye reap' is only

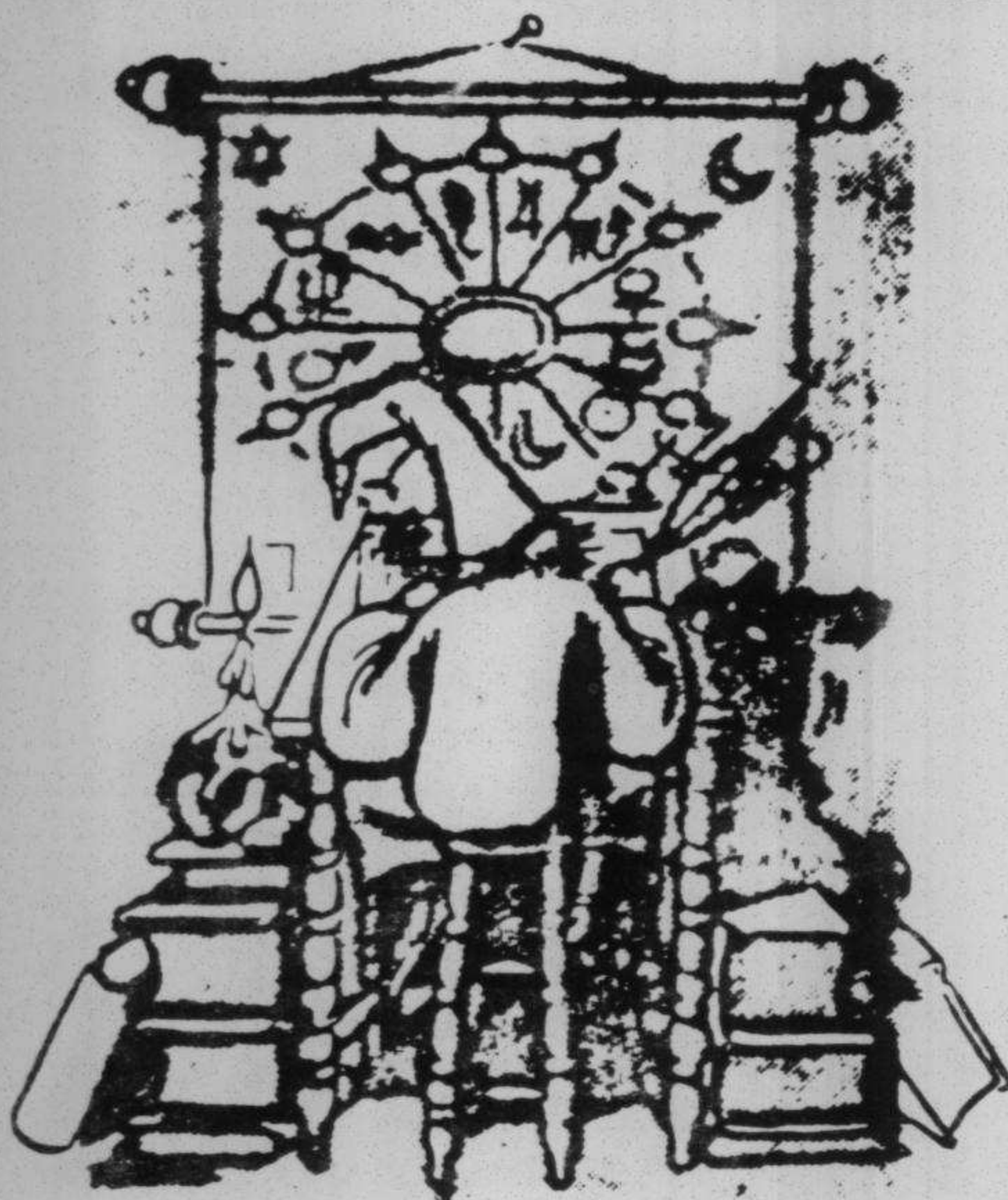
'those who live by the sword, shall die by the sword.' The entire turn-the-other-cheek philosophy makes no sense except as a way of avoiding getting entangled in other people's karma, in which case it is the same as Krishna's basic advice. Forgive your enemies, become indifferent to their action against you, or you will waste future lives being part of their punishment. In saying that he was the son of god, the carpenter did not imply any special divinity; rather we know from modern avatars that he taught the divinity within, i.e. we are all sons of god, which must have seemed either blasphemous or totally unintelligible to the Hellenized Jews and Romans of his day. So his idea became translated as a special divinity, not unlike that claimed by the Roman emperors.

The chief problem with Hinduism and Buddhism is their rejection of worldly concerns, their rejection of evolution and emphasis on other-worldly and timeless

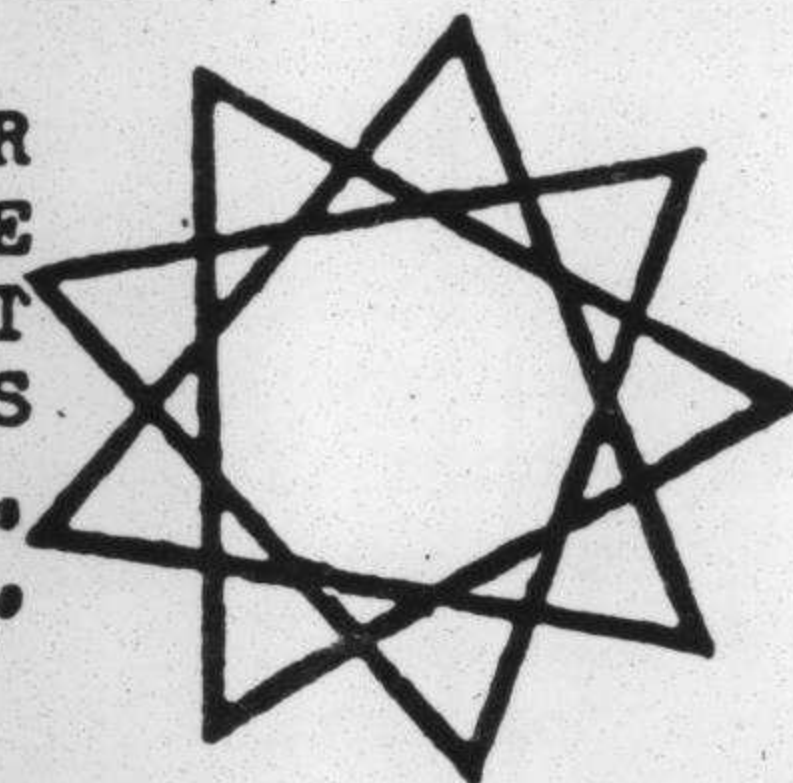

meditation. They wish to get off the wheel of reincarnation, not knowing of the evolutionary path we must follow. The Hindus and Buddhists also destroyed the purity of their avatar's ideas by externalizing internal archetypes as a pantheon of gods and demons. Hindus also have certain overly rigid views about reincarnation and karma which tend to deny the role of free will. Belief in a mechanical and external karma and in a rigidly cyclical history have been India's excuse for sacred cows, caste, over-population and every other failure to meet the requirements of life. Speaking of sacred cows, Cayce makes it plain that animal consciousness is quite different from human, and human entities do not reincarnate as animals.

These criticisms really apply to the unintelligent followers and fanatics in every religion; the intelligent and creative thinkers in every religion have always been in accord.

Religion begins with certain questions: 'what is man and what is his relationship to the universe?' 'What about survival of death and what about immortality?' 'What is the law of retribution or reaction in the universe?' 'What is the meaning of it all?'

Man is an immortal droplet (Atman) of Brahman encased in a mind, encased in a psychonic body, encased in a physical body. Our souls were once part of oversouls and have participated in the drama of the physical evolution of the universe over billions of years. We are now going through a stage of evolution as psychonic bodies incarnating in Homo Sapiens. In this form we shall regain the status of cosmic citizens of the universe. This stage will last billions of years. Ultimately, the physical universe will collapse and explode again, having different basic particles and geometries. Long before that we will have reintegrated into the Great Spirit.

The law of retribution is 'as ye sow, so shall ye reap.' This is a subjective and psychological and internal law. It appears that the superconscious center of self decides fate as a lesson, and a spur to evolution. This is true of higher centers as well as individual centers. 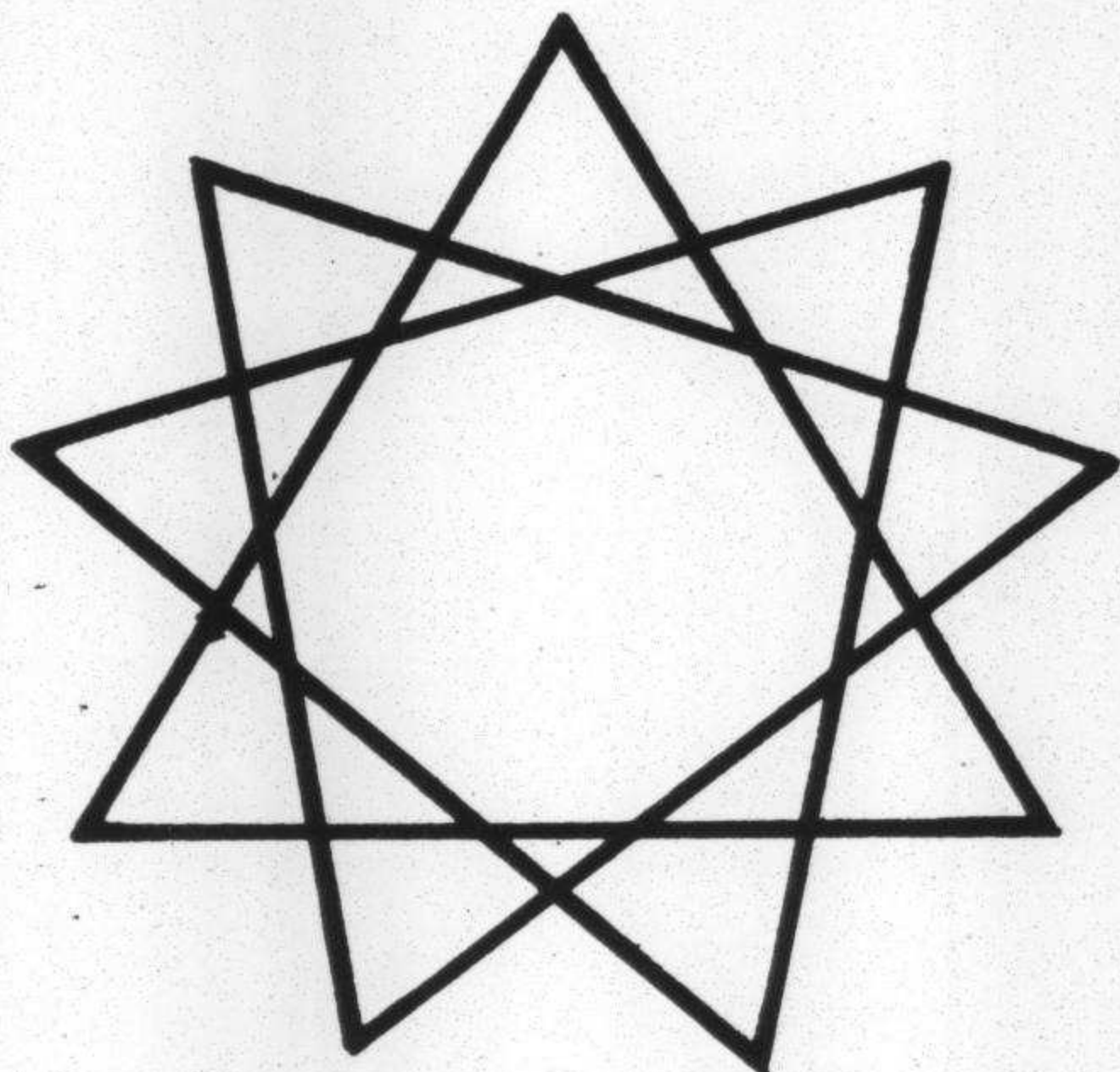
Dr. Humphrey does give us theory and some very practical suggestions.
