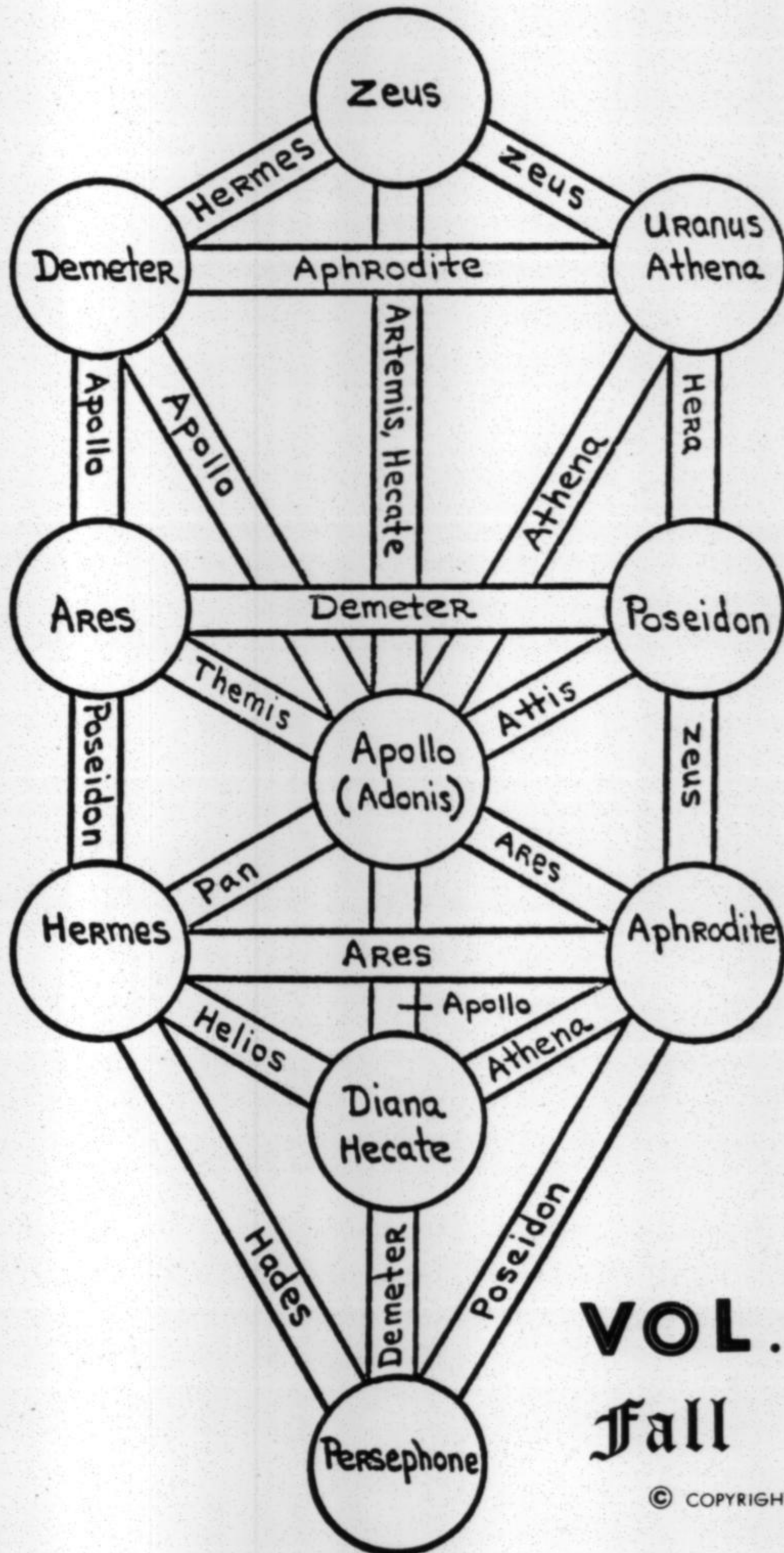

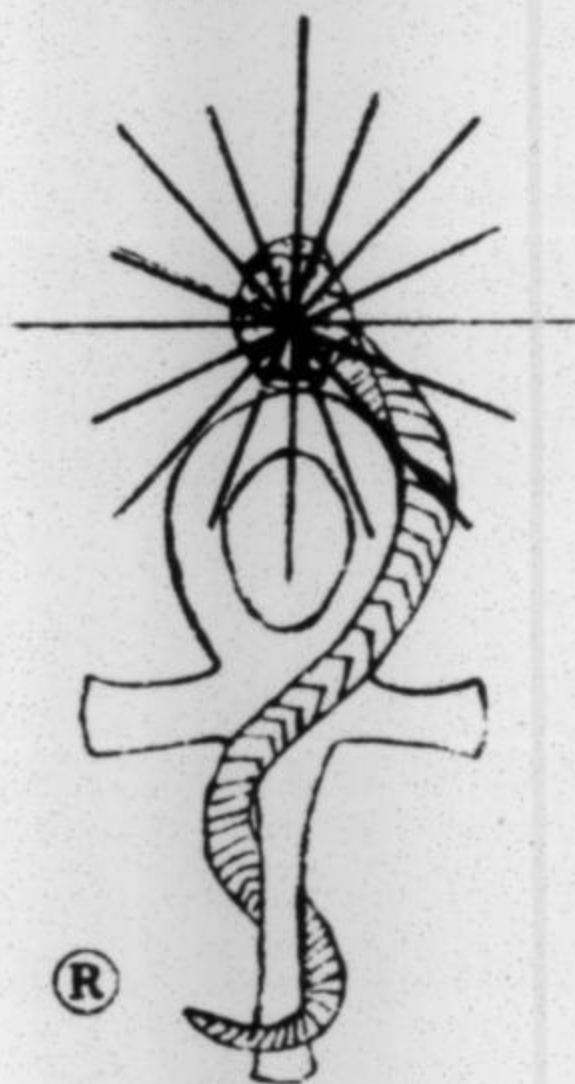

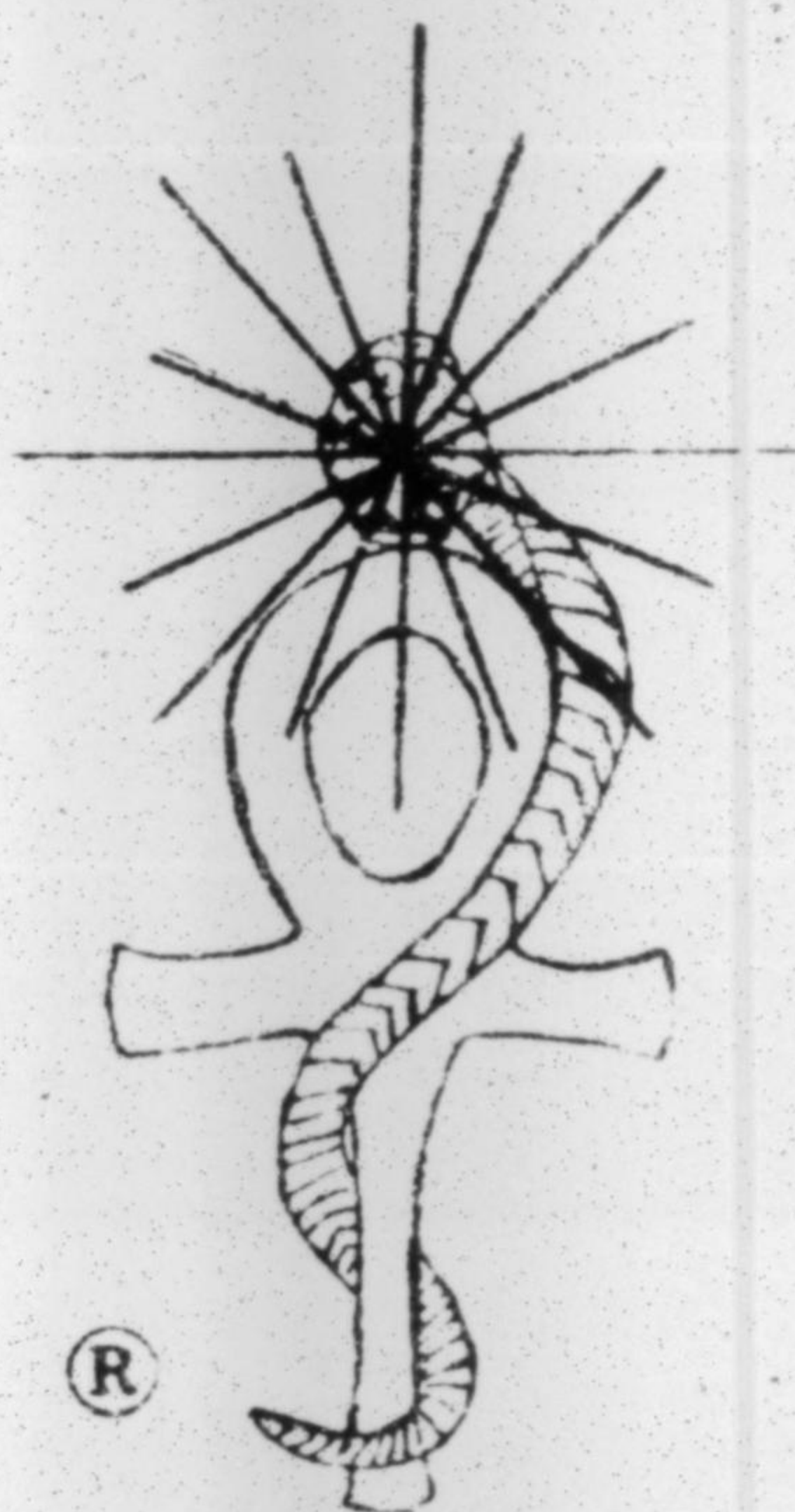

EDITORIAL

AN OPEN LETTER TO CALIFORNIA OCCULTISTS

The conventional news media have been carrying items of late which are in them selves actionable or recount instances of Religious Discrimination and Persecution. Although most of these have been reported in one form or another in the Aquarian press, and in spite of the generally sympathetic reactions expressed, there has been no concerted, co-ordinated action.

One such incident concerns our good friend Fred Adams and the harassment he has been receiving from his neighbors and his superiors at work, (see Green Egg Vol VIII, No. 73, Page 36).

Our research into several of these cases reveals that action could be taken under the Unruh Civil Rights Act, (Calif. Civil Code, section 51, and subsequent). This Act is somewhat broader than the equivalent Federal statute, and provides for both actual damages, plus a minimum of \$250.00/day for each day that such discriminatory activity continues. There are several Public Interest Law Firms in the Los Angeles area which could be contacted with a view toward initiating an action under this statute. To our knowledge this has not been done or even threatened.

I would like to encourage the suggestion that local A.A.D.L. councils or circles be formed at once to combat the continuing threat to California Occultists (see AADL NEWS, Page 8, this issue). We would be willing to support any such local council, and whomever they elect to direct it.

There are a considerable number of Occultists in California, and if they care enough about their future security and Religious Freedom to organize, they can overcome the present growing anti-occult trend. So long as special and individual interests prevail over the welfare of the Occult Community as a whole, nothing effective is going to get done.

The solution is in your hands, so get busy. You might be next.

An introduction from The Gnostic Society

Before the beginning there was nothing, only a profound abyss. Then there came a realization. This is the primal polarity; the awareness, and the depth from which it came. The dynamism of this polarity began generating other polarities; intelligence and its thoughts, words and their meanings, reason and its reflections, power and wisdom, activity and stillness, all subjects and all objects. The totality of these generated qualities make up the fullness of existence. Thus was the universe formed, not by creation but by emanation. The source of all is scattered in all. The most special thing in the universe, the most holy, the most sacred, is hidden in every stick, beneath every stone, in every heart, veiled by ignorance. Ignorance is a trap the fullness fell into. It threw itself, out of itself, into itself, terribly far from itself. The farthest, most ignorant fragment of all forgot, even, that it came from the fullness, and said: "I am God, the only God, and all this is My creation." This is blasphemy.

Divinity lies within all of us, like a grape waiting for the fermentation of Knowledge, waiting for the consecration of the Knowers life, waiting for the transformation of that life from darkness into light. We are not damned, we are only ignorant. We do not need to be saved, we need to be initiated. We do not need anyone to do the work for us, we need to be given the tools to do it ourselves. These were the teachings, 2,000 years ago, of the Gnostics.

"Whoever shall receive the mystery is in the world, but is more excellent than all the angels; in the world but better than the archangels, higher than them all: The lords, the gods, the powers and the pure ones, above all the emanations, all the confusion; in the world but a sovereign in the light, in the world, but not in the world." Remember, said the Gnostics, the Light from whence you have come. And they pictured the driving force of divinity as the rooster headed **ABRAXAS**, who neither damns nor saves, but heralds the dawn, crying: "Listen! Listen! Boundless Light! **I AWIOY WIA WAWIWIA!**"

What does all this mean? Is it a deeply felt religious faith, or is it a consciously contrived allegory, an attempt by some ancient speculators to synthesize classic philosophy with the pagan mysteries? For its best interpretation, Gnosticism had to wait until the 20th century, when the psychologist C. G. Jung pointed out that it was a sort of proto-psychology. For do we not all come from a void beyond remembrance into a primal fullness? Do we not all slowly differentiate, until an ego finally pulls itself away from the whole, only to take credit for our life? And is not further growth and creativity dependent upon our overcoming this demi-god and reestablishing contact with the profound depths of our own being? This interpretation is an excellent working hypothesis, but does not explain everything; for Jung's very theories of the relation between the conscious and the unconscious were themselves influenced by Gnosticism. Thus we are left with Gnosticism, and the fragments of its wondrous literature. Perhaps the Knowledge it implies is beyond the kind we can reason out with logic. We present day Gnostics assume that it is, and for this reason, we place emphasis less on theology than on psychology, mythology, and ritual.

What happened to Gnosticism? By the end of the 3rd century, it had been crushed by Christian orthodoxy. Much of its spirit, and many of its doctrines survived and were re-cast in the middle ages as the various systems of inner regeneration: Alchemy, Magic, Tarot, Kabbalah. Even today, Gnosticism is not extinct, the Gnostic Society is devoted to keeping it alive.

OR

A CASE AGAINST SMOKING

Tobacco is one of the classical Mars Sphere substances or incenses. The case against the personal use of tobacco goes beyond the Magician receiving an unwanted Geburah influence. The habitual use of ANY substance should be avoided if a person desires to be a well rounded and balanced Magician. Not only is the habit itself an indication of a breach in the Magicians' Magickal Will, but when that habit involves a substance as destructive, accident prone and debilitating as tobacco (or for that matter marijuana, hashish, or any other physically or psychologically addictive substance) it indicates a serious defect in self-control.

Insurance companies have for years given preferential rates to persons who do not smoke, in fire, accident and life insurance, including automobile insurance. Insurance underwriters have found that persons who smoke are more combative, thoughtless and careless, both of their own safety as well as that of others. These certainly are symptoms of uncontrolled Geburah influences, although I doubt if these underwriters are aware of this correlation. The simple fact that non-smokers live longer, suffer fewer accidents and have fewer fires does not seem to make a significant impression upon the smoker.

The well balanced Magician is (or should be) aware of the desires, comfort and safety of others. Persons who smoke, particularly in public and in confined spaces, are uninterested in anything but their alleged pleasure. The fact that they may be seriously injuring someone else does not enter into their heads. If this is pointed out to them, they become quite indignant, even if the area is a posted "No Smoking" area. This reveals the smokers' shallow regard for others (or even the law) and his extreme selfishness.


To those Magickal students or practitioners who smoke, I would like to suggest a Magickally beneficial exercise: practice not-smoking for at least one hour a week (or 2 hours a month) whenever the Lodge or group meets. Not only will this assist in the training of the Magickal Will, but it will make the meeting more pleasant (and endurable) for the non-smokers in the group. This simple exercise is even more important if and when any constructive Magick is to be done by the group. Not only is the reek of tobacco smoke exuded by the person and clothing of the smoker very noticable to the non-smoker, it may actually interfere with what ever is being attempted by the group.

Dispute on Race Differences in IQ Scores Revived

CHICAGO—Why don't blacks traditionally do as well on IQ tests as whites?

The answer from psychologists and educators is that IQ tests have been designed for white, native-born, middle-class children.

Controversial psychologist Arthur Jensen, professor of education psychology at UC Berkeley's Institute of Human Learning, admits this is so but denies its importance where blacks are concerned.

Instead, in a paper delivered Tuesday to the annual meeting of the American Psychological Assn., he postulated that an inherited "G factor" helps explain why there is an average 15-point gap in IQ scores between the two races.

Jensen said the "G factor" helps persons perform tasks and problems that require mental manipulation and transformation of ideas, and whites on the average inherit more of this factor than blacks.

The "G factor" is not a new concept. It was hypothesized in psychology at least 25 years ago to explain whatever it is that IQ tests measure.

Jensen's notoriety is attributable in part to his resurrection of this concept to explain racial differences in IQ test achievement.

For the last 15 years, Jensen has been widely criticized by minority groups, most of his colleagues and others for his belief that intelligence is made up of factors that are roughly 80% heredity and 20% environ-

The protesters insisted on remaining on the stage behind Jensen, bearing placards with messages like "The New Genocide—This Happened in Germany 50 Years Ago" and "Say No to Racism."

Jensen, reviewing his findings on heredity and intelligence, maintained:

—The "G factor" is found in all standard IQ tests, regardless of the diversity and content of the tests.

—The less the test problem is based on habit and the more complex it is, the more important the role of the "G factor."

Jensen said that black-white differences on the tests could be perfectly simulated by comparing groups of younger and older white children.

He concluded that differences in "mental maturity" and not cultural differences lead to varied test scores between younger and older whites as well as between whites and blacks of the same age group.

Finally, Jensen hypothesized that if his "G factor" does reflect mental maturity and a capacity for mental manipulation, one would expect a large racial difference in tests requiring the most complex manipulation and transformation.

'The IQ Myth': Second Showing Still Leaves Skeptics

A few weeks ago, CBS News reran its special report, "The IQ Myth." The show's purpose was two-fold. First, it sought to paint IQ tests for children as both meaningless and socially dangerous. Second, it sought to buck up that school of thought which insists—contrary to the evidence—that heredity has nothing whatever to do with intelligence. The enterprise was no more successful the second time around.

Not for lack of effort. During the course of a single hour, Dan Rather, our host, rattled off the following ex cathedra judgments about intelligence and IQ tests, with all the certitude of a sports announcer giving us the box scores.

1) IQ scores do not measure intelligence. 2) They do not measure the ability you're born with. 3) "It isn't some natural lack of intelligence, but a cultural handicap that holds poor children back." 4) "... it is not a fact that a lower IQ means less intelligence, and there is even less evidence to show that intelligence is 80% inherited." 5) An IQ "isn't basically something you're born with. Mostly, it's what you've learned and it isn't necessarily permanent. By recent evidence, it can be improved with education." 6) It is a "myth" to suggest that "race is a determining factor in a person's capacity for intelligence." 7) "IQ is not a natural talent, a godly gift, but something their family and their community have given or denied them."

About these seven conclusions, two points. First, every single one of them corresponds with the preconceived notions about human nature of the political liberal. Second, not a single one of them is proven or justified by the flimsy evidence and biased testimony Mr. Rather has advanced.

Indeed, it is just as the "environmental" school is reeling under the blows of argument and experience that Mr. Rather pushes his way into the ring, to announce its triumph. His verdicts notwithstanding, the influence of heredity upon intelligence remains very much an open question.

If Mr. Rather wishes evidence of that assertion, all he needs do is call for Federal funding to study the truth or falsehood of his claim that neither race nor heredity have anything to do with intelligence. He will find himself the target of the same academic Know-Nothings and Yahoos who have broken up the classes and threatened the safety of those academicians who have advanced the opposite view.

Professors Jensen, Herrnstein and Shockley (all of whom assert a connection between heredity and intelligence) are not the target of uncivil and violent protest because they profess some easily disproven and kooky theory. They are under attack in the academic community because some of their colleagues are terrified that they may →

have stumbled upon the truth.

And if this minority is proven right, not only are many of the assumptions behind some lucrative Federal programs proven false, but also assumptions upon which so many intellectuals have built their worlds will come crumbling down. It is a fear of the truth—not confidence in their own conclusions—that makes the enemies of Jensen and the others so dogmatic and hostile.

Yet, the show did make some valid points.

Most important among these is that, while an IQ test may accurately indicate how an individual will do in an academic environment, it is no guarantee of how well an individual will do in life. IQ tests do not measure curiosity, creativity, courage, drive, personality or luck for that matter—all of them factors that can be far more significant in terms of personal success than an IQ of 145. Who among us does not know of a class genius now shuffling papers in the bowels of some bureaucracy or a "class clown" now drawing down a six-figure salary in his own occupation?

The second point validly made is that IQ tests have been misread, misused and abused in the past. But then so have aptitude tests, college board exams and bar exams—the last of which tell us little or nothing about a lawyer's integrity or his ability in the courtroom. But merely because claims for IQ tests have been exaggerated is no reason to throw out the baby with the bath water. They are, and can be, a useful tool in determining performance in an academic environment.

Indeed, if Mr. Rather had a strong case, he would not have had to rely upon witnesses or comments whose appeal was transparently to the emotions rather than the intellect. Here is a sampling from the anti-IQ crowd, culled from the report:

IQ tests are "the most effective device ever invented by the middle class to oppress the poor and keep them in their place." "The tests are slanted against the social and cultural background" of

blacks, Chicanos and poor whites. "What you've outlined here is a fairly long history in this country of IQ tests being used as a foundation of racism." "Labeling is dreadful as far as I'm concerned, in any shape, matter or form."

This isn't reasoned argument. It is straight out of the copybook of the liberal intellectual pandering to the biases of the black and poor—at the expense of the American middle class.

Consider the comment about "labeling." The abuses of those IQ tests have not done a thousandth of the damage to public education as the "reforms" of those egalitarians who have romped through the American school system for 20 years.

How many able, intelligent black children have been denied the education of which they are capable by being forced to sit in the same classroom with some grinning switch-blade artist with an IQ two points above a vegetable? How many slow learners in the public schools have been permanently damaged, psychologically, by being kept in classrooms where they could not possibly keep up with the level of academic work?

And there are still questions that puzzle people, even if CBS has declared the case closed. If IQ is not inherited, why do identical twins—raised in separate and dissimilar environments—come up with IQ test scores much closer than the average difference within the population?

And if IQ can be raised through education, has there been a dramatic rise in the IQ level of minority students, in the last 10 years, over the generation, say, 20 years ago, almost all of whom were denied an equal educational opportunity?

These are sensitive social questions. But CBS would have done a more conscientious and creditable job if it had touched upon them instead of having wasted an hour stroking the conventional academic wisdom which appears increasingly unconvincing, despite CBS's heroic efforts. (END)

Dis-Case & Disease

Area Man Penalized; Must Close Church

A San Gabriel man has been ordered to pay a \$5,000 civil penalty for his part in a church operation that illegally performed marriages, divorces and funeral services, according to the Los Angeles city attorney's office.

A spokesman for the attorney's office said a final judgment had been obtained against Phillip Carreon. A court order was obtained, the spokesman added, forcing Carreon to close his business, the Church of Christian Veritas, California Divorce Council and Interfaith Council for Social Services, at 2211 S. Atlantic Blvd., Monterey Park, and notify his clients.

The judgment against Carreon, the spokesman said, also enjoins him from advertising a church without having a fixed place of worship; performing marriages; providing family, child or marriage counseling; performing bankruptcy counseling or any other legal counseling or acting as a funeral broker unless duly licensed by the State of California.

The city attorney's office has also joined Ventura County district attorney in filing a complaint against another Church of the Christian Veritas in Ventura County, the spokesman said.

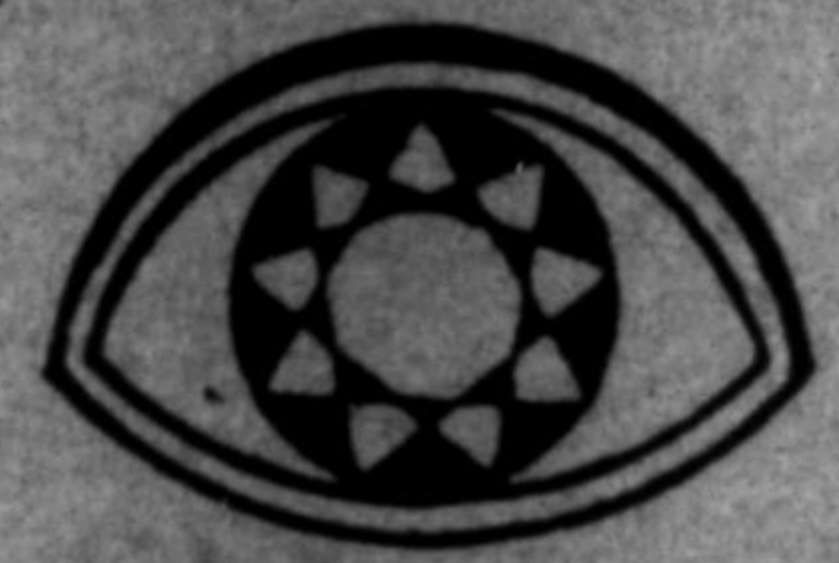

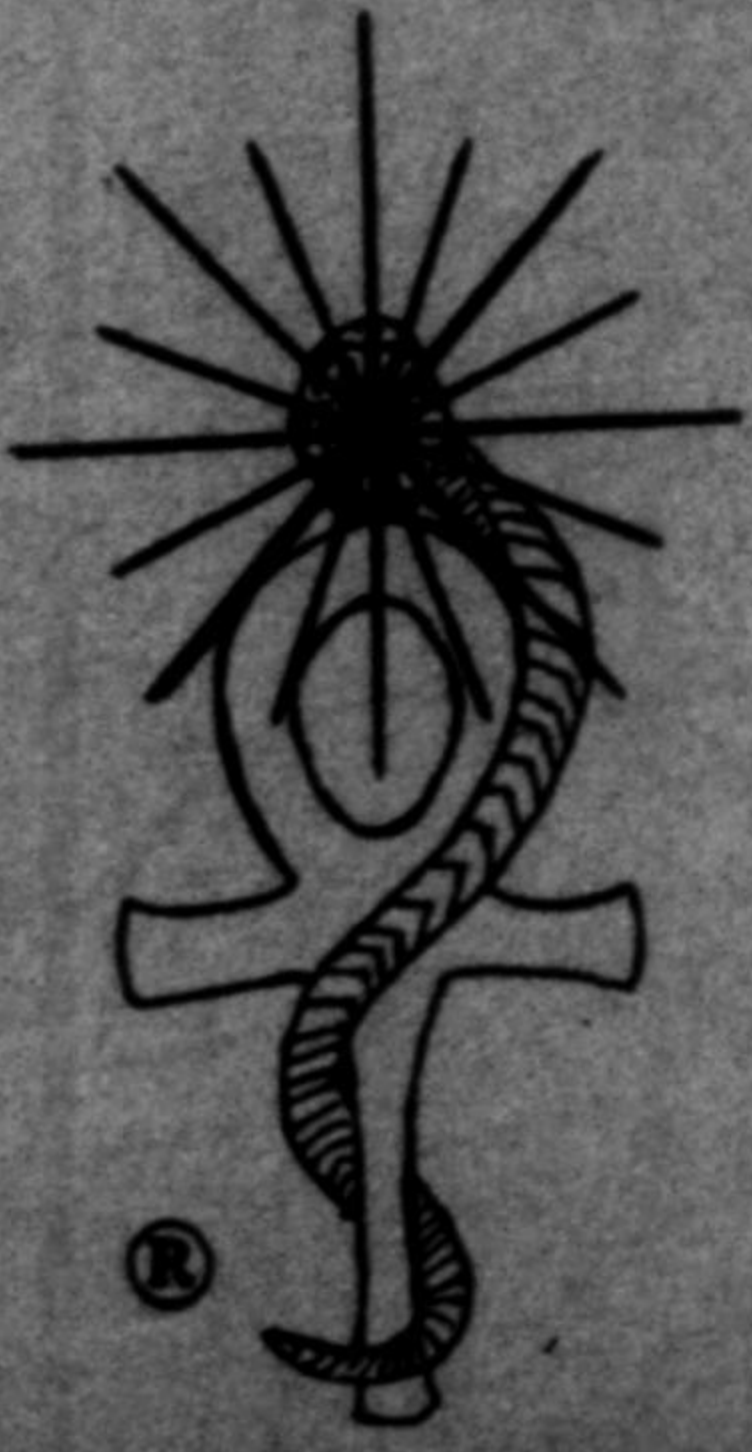

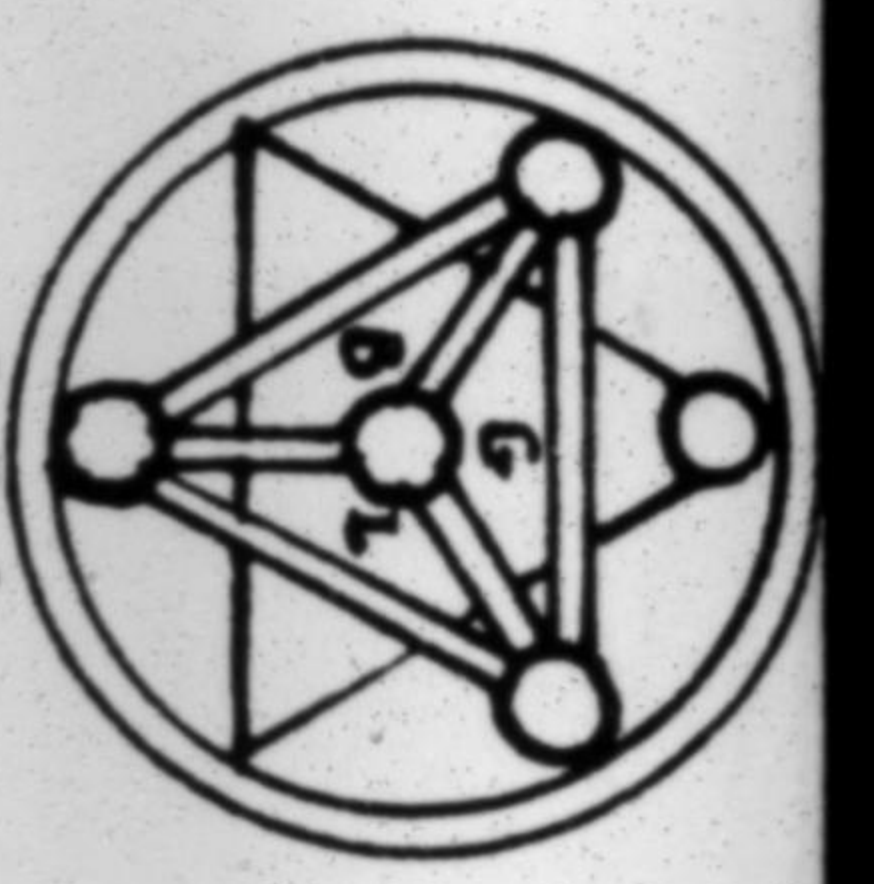
