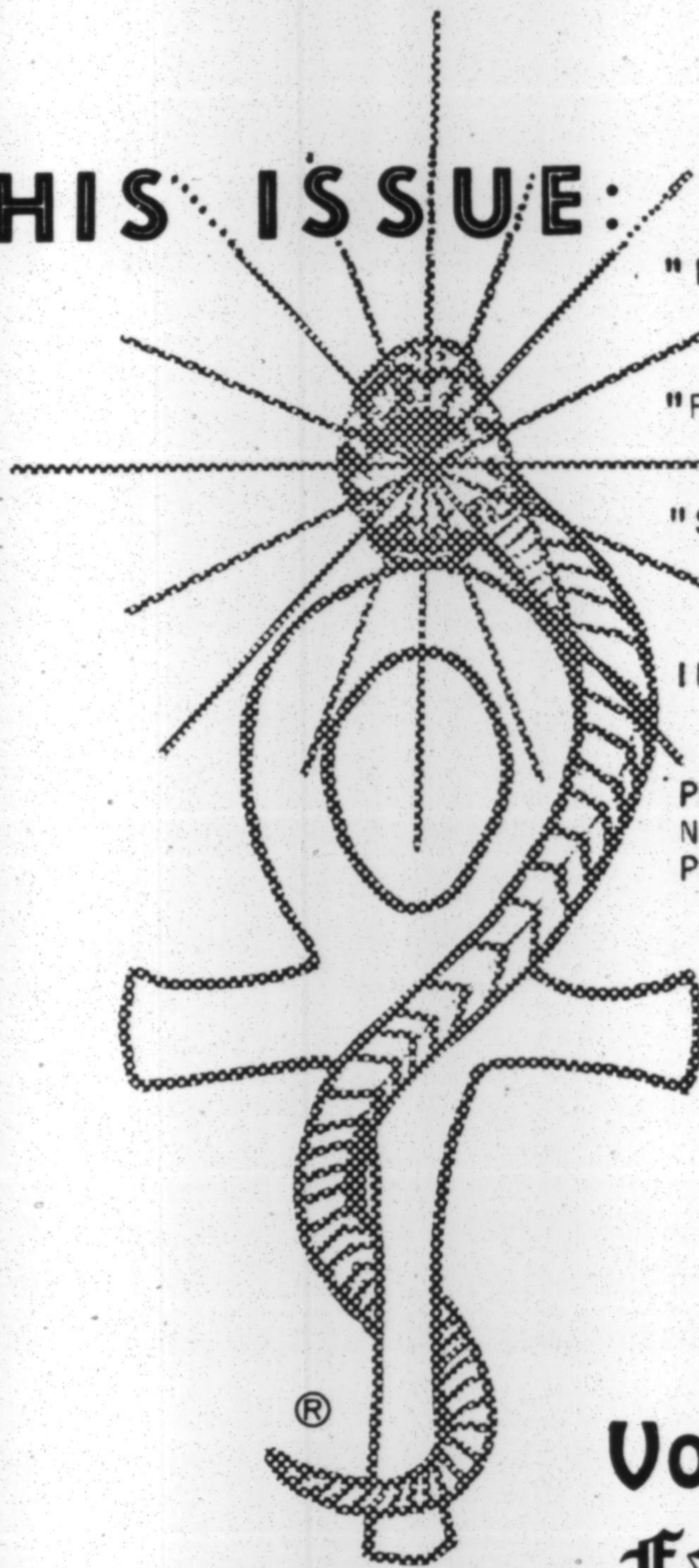

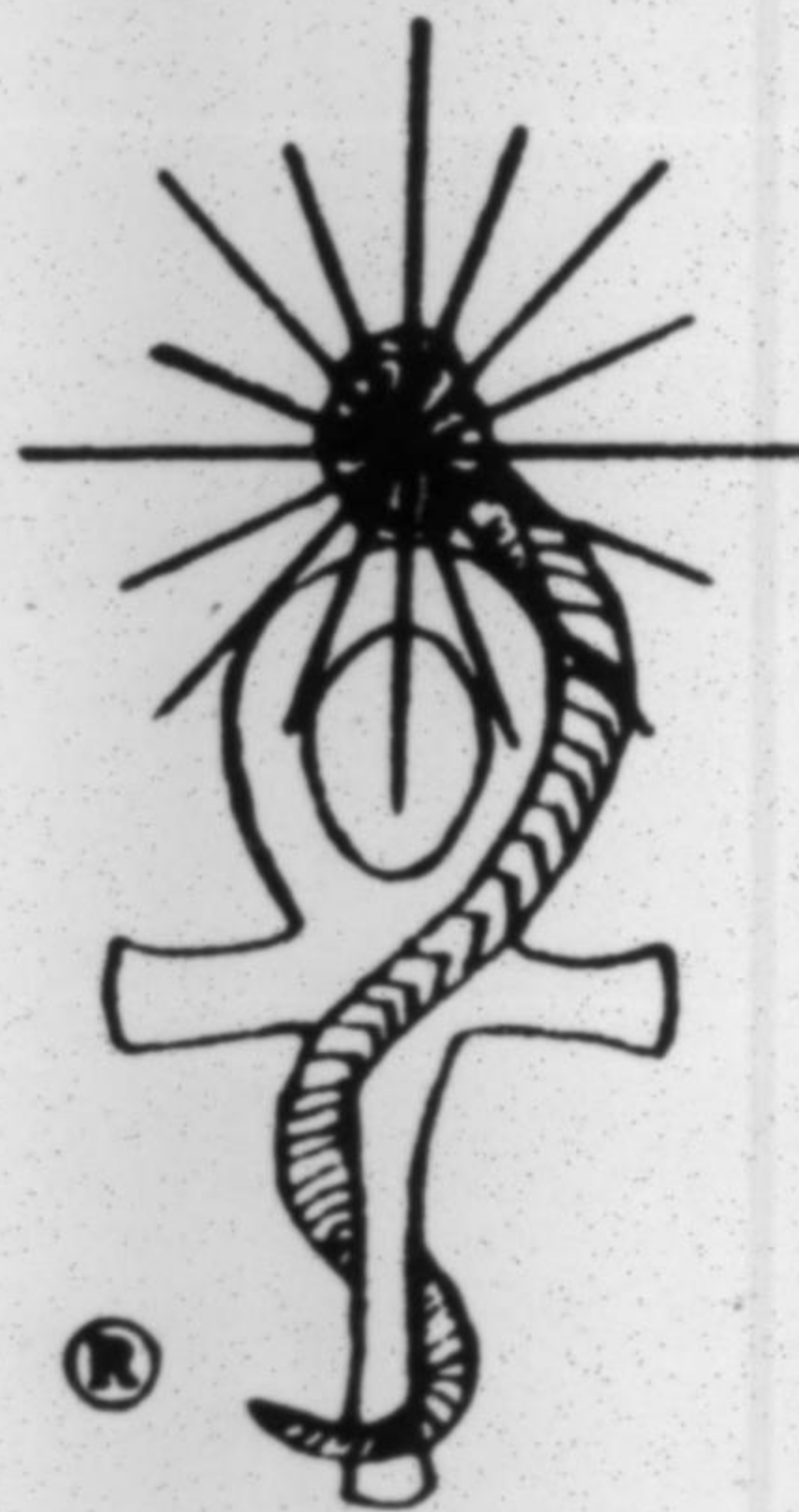

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# EDITORIAL

## INSTANT MAGICK

In the words of the apophirical Western Philosopher: "They ain't no sech animal!" Unfortunately, it's true, there is no such thing as Instant Magick.

The best possible student, with the best possible instructor, with all the time and facilities in the world to devote to his studies, would still take ONE YEAR to progress to the point of being a moderately competent Magician. People who say or think otherwise, are either fooling themselves or fooling others.

Sure, there are dozens of books purporting to give you instant "Powers" or "Mind Control" or some other garbage, in a matter of hours or days. HOGWASH! Either what they are peddling isn't Magick, or the book is so oversimplified and diluted as to be actually useless from a Magickal point of view.

No one has yet published a really complete course in Ceremonial Magick, and I don't think that anyone ever will. The best and most complete attempt to date is Louis T. Culling's "The Complete Magical Curriculum of the Secret Order G.'.B.'.G.'" which (perhaps fortunately) is not as complete as it sounds. Another magnificent try is Israel Regardie's "The Tree of Life", possibly the best book the good Doctor has ever written.

This is actually beneficial to the Magickal Student, as it forces him to search about and consult several sources, and thus (to some extent at least) prevents him from becoming too lopsided in his outlook, and too rigid in his thinking. Because many authors and authorities do not agree completely, the student is again forced to adopt something of the Scientific Method, and try out the various systems, and pick the one that suits him best at whatever stage in his development he happens to be. Of course, he is also free to change his methods as the need arises.

ANY school, system or discipline that attempts to limit a student's scope of inquiry, or to rigidly define what the student may or may not read or try, is (with a very few exceptions) doing the student a serious dis-service. Likewise, any school or discipline that does not allow the student to progress at his own rate, and either hinders his advancement, or pressures him beyond a few gentile reminders that his studies are lagging, is also doing the student a dis-service.

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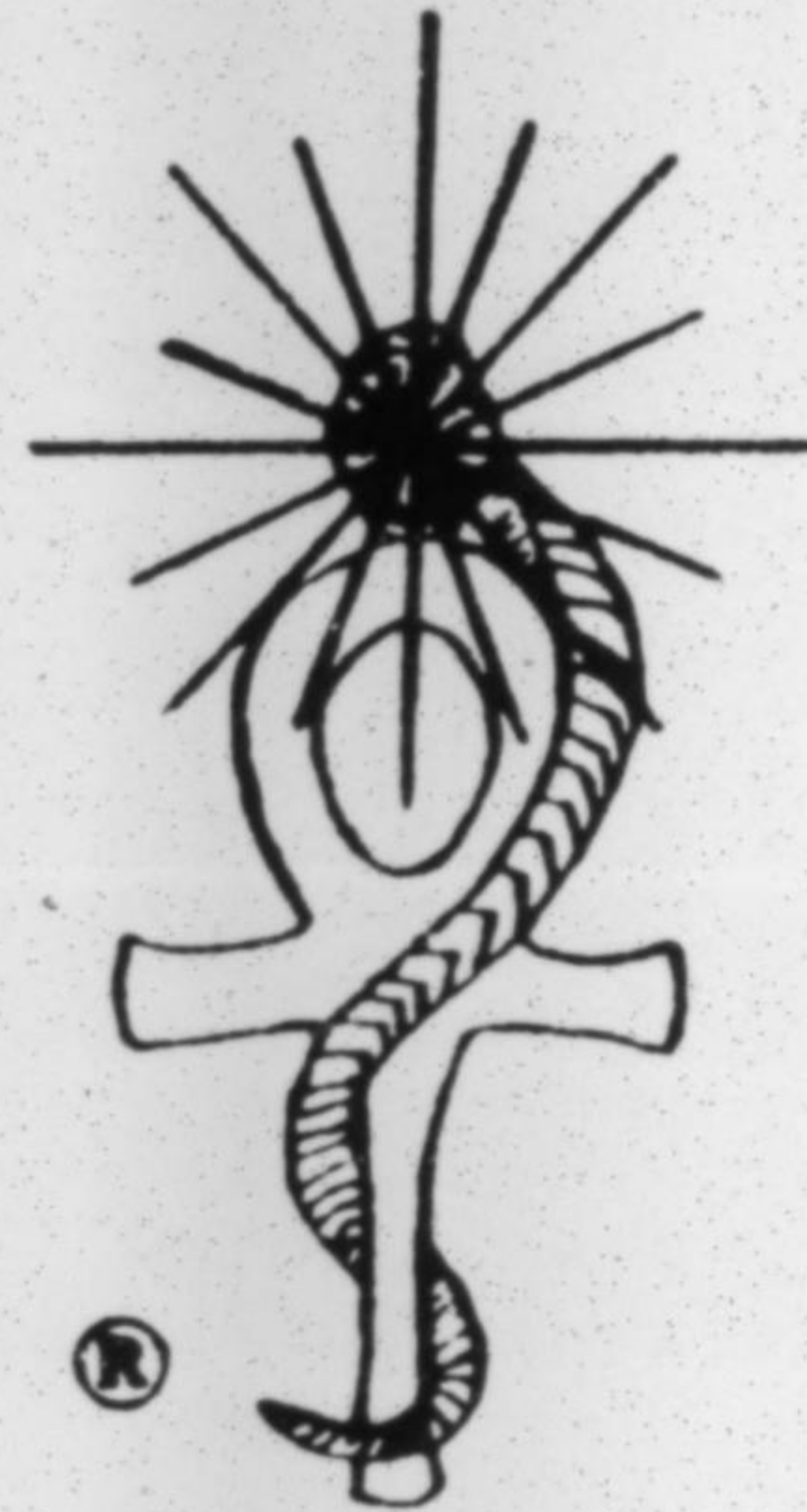
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These are the primary reasons why we do not have a fixed curriculum here at The Temple of Truth, and likewise why we offer no instruction by mail. Mail order courses are per se rigid, paced and narrow, all to the detriment of the serious student.

Many people are disappointed when they discover that we do not offer correspondance courses, or a single book or tape that will solve all their problems for them at one stroke and for no cost or effort. **TOO BAD!**

The laws of Thermodynamics, translated into human terms comes out something like: "You can't get something for nothing", or as Robert H. Heinlein put it "TANSTAAFL: There is no such thing as a free lunch" (or a free ride, except down hill).

Talents and abilities, insight and wisdom are gained at great cost and suffering, although squandering money, time and energy is no guarantee of success or even progress.

A Lodge, Order or instructor can help you reduce the wasted time and energy, help you reduce some of the cost, but you will still have to put forth considerable effort and time yourself if you are to progress. No one else can do it for you, you have to do it for yourself. ANY alleged "School", "Master", "Guru" or book that says otherwise is pulling a fast one, and is not to be trusted or relied upon in the slightest, and very likely is a phoney besides.


There is no "quickie" shortcut to Adepthood. You may compress the work into a shorter period of time (if you are able) but the work must still be done, regardless.



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# Real Witchcraft

The genuine practice of The Old Religion and an equally genuine pursuit of Magick have many things in common. Both suffer from similar public mis-conceptions. Both are afflicted with extremely large numbers of phonies and superficial look-alikes.

We of the T.:O.:T.: are very gratified to see a resurgence of genuine Witchcraft, amid the droves of commerical frauds and publicity seekings fools. This has, in the past, caused a problem to Magicians, when approached upon the subject of Wicca. Without some genuine Old Religion Groups to point to, the Magician was forced into one of two postures; The first was to ignore Wicca entirely. The second and equally bad, was to say something on the order of "Well... I suppose that there are some good ones, somewhere, but I don't know of any..."

Situations of this type have given rise to other mis-conceptions, among them the idea that the T.:O.:T.: is 'anti-Wicca'. This is not the case. Niether are we 'anti-Christian'. We are anti-phoney, whether it be Pseudo-Wicca, or anything else.

This problem is particularly acute here in Southern California, where there are hundreds of self-styled 'Occult' organizations of almost any desired stripe. A good many of these organizations cater to the credulous individual, who is asked to (and usually willing to) believe in something-or-other because it is 'The Word' of some "Master". Fully half of these organizations, we feel, are incorrect for an American to go into, because they are anti-egregorie, occasionally drug-oriented, or perhaps just plain destructive (in addition to being insincere).

The remaining half, are a very strange bag indeed. Largely credulous, frequently insincere, and even more frequently a money making gambit; I have visited some of these and observed that they spend more on special effects and electronic security devices than on anything else. (Spraying Christmas Tree 'glitter' on a shack dosen't make it a 'Temple'.)

Most of the remaining organizations probably do believe in what they are doing, however sincerity is not enough. Many refuse to dig into the actual origin of what they are doing. Occasionally they have 'must not read lists', or will admit when pressed that their origin or the history of their own organization makes them 'uncomfortable',

What is left, after removing all of the above, is a group of 'Witchcraft' organizations, some genuine, some not, and a few Magickal Lodges. Sometimes it is almost impossible to distinguish between the phony Wiccans and the real thing, if for no other reason than the phonies outnumber the genuine ones about 10 to 1. This confusion is augmented by the fact that here in the Los Angeles area there are two organizations, whose founders follow the Old Religion as a religion, but practice Magick from a qabbalistic viewpoint. There is no quick and simple way of classifying these people, as neither of these organizations have published any positional papers or descriptive literature.

A similar situation exists with regard to Magick. There are organizations and individuals who claim to be Magicians and the like. From the outside, it is quite hard to tell who is and who isn't. As in the case with some self-styled Wiccans, some of these alleged Magicians are in it for personal gain, real or imaginary.

The biggest single point of division in Magick, is whether or not a given individual or group is 'thelemic'. Thelemic Magick is based upon Crowley's "Book of the Law". (Thelemic refers to the 'Law of Thelema')

There is much of value in the O.T.O. and A.'.A.'. tradition, however we of the T.'.O.'.T.'. do not accept Liber al vel Legis as holy writ, or dogma. We view those who do, in a similar light to those other persons who refuse to examine the origins of what they profess to believe in. We have found that most religions, Christian and Pagan alike, as well as all 'Religious Cults' contain one or more 'articles of faith' which must be accepted without examination or question. This same mechanism exists in Thelemic Magick, and is the principal reason why we are not Thelemic. In fact this unthinking acceptance might be used as a test for differentiating between a 'cult' and a 'lodge' or 'order'.

Consequently, we of the T.'.O.'.T.'. are quite happy to see a trend toward genuine Pagan organizations, which are ready, willing, and able to differentiate between themselves and the general mass of popular phonies. We view this trend as a healthy sign, and hope that this growth will continue, if for no other reason than that the Public needs a standard of comparison, where none existed before. It is to our direct advantage to be able to point to an organization and say "These people know what they are doing."

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## AADL NEWS

### PASADENA DOES IT AGAIN!

Pasadena California, whose 1930 "Anti-Fortune-Telling" law was declared unconstitutional because it was too vague and too general, has been considering the adoption of a law exactly like Los Angeles' infamous LAMC 43.30, which reads (get this):

" No person shall advertise by sign, circular or handbill, or in any newspaper, periodical, magazine or other publication, or by any other means, to tell fortunes to find or restore lost or stolen property, to locate oil wells, gold, silver or other ore, metal or natural product, to restore lost love, friendship or affection, to unite or procure lovers, husbands, wives, lost relatives or friends, for or without pay, by means of occult or psychic powers, faculties or forces, clairvoyance, psychology, psychometry, spirits, mediumship, seership, prophecy, astrology, palmistry, necromancy or other craft, science, cards, talismans, charms, potions, magnetism or magnetized articles or substances, oriental mysteries or magic of any kind or nature, or numerology, or to engage in or cary on any business the advertisement of which is prohibited by this section." (emphasis added)

Aside from the many, many flaws in this ordinance, Pasadena attempted to "improve" it by adding a "religious exclusion" clause which is even worse, and even more unconstitutional:

" The provisions of section \_\_\_\_\_ shall not be construed to include, prohibit or interfere with the exercise of any religious or spiritual function of any priest, minister, rector or accredited representative of any bona fide church or religion when such priest, minister, rector or accredited representative holds a certificate of credit, commission or ordination under the ecclesiastical laws of a religious corporation incorporated under the laws of any state or territory of the United States of America or any voluntary religious association, and who fully conforms to the rites and practices prescribed by the supreme conference, convocation, convention, assembly, association or synod of the system or faith with which they are affiliated; provided, however, that any church or religious organization which is organized for the primary purpose of conferring certificates of commission, credit or ordinations for a price, and not primarily for the purpose of teaching and practicing a religious doctrine or belief, shall not be deemed to be a bona fide church or religious organization."

(emphasis added)

It is obvious that Pasadena, like a lot of other cities, in an effort to "control" something that they don't like, has (almost) thrown the baby out with the bath.

As the Southern California Rep. for the AADL, I attended three City Board meetings and discovered that it is the Police Department and the City Attorney's office that were pushing this "new" ordinance. A Police undercover Agent, John A. Rose, testified as to the need for such an ordinance sighting 4 cases in 3 years (all of which were acquitted due to unconstitutionality

of Pasadena's old law.) Four arrests in three years dosen't sound like a burgeoning crime problem to me, considering the extreme increase in other crimes in the city. Agent Rose also told some highly humorous (and patently fictitious) stories about fortune-telling problems in other cities, but couldn't be pinned down as to actual names and dates. He also related an alleged \$20,000 bribe attempt on the part of someone (un-named) to get the Beverly Hills City Attorney's office to "throw" an appeal case (which they lost anyway). Frankly, with that kind of money, they could have hired a good attorney and beat the case on its' merrits, which aparently they did.

This same story was related a second time, a week later by a representative of the City Attorney's office who also regailed the board (and the very small audience -- we were almost the only people there) with horrer stories of Fortune Telling "Wars" put on by Fortune-Telling "Families". When pressed, he related the previously mentioned 4 cases in Pasadena which all resulted in aquittals.

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# The Notebook

"SOMA" A MODERN  
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The Soma of the Ancients is of course lost in the mists of time. A modern re-creation was invented by the author several years ago, and is quite legal to have and use, provided one is an adult.

## Materials and Equipment

1 Pint, 151 proof white rum (minimum, may be more)  
1 Pound honey  
24 "No-Doze" tablets (Caffine Citrate)  
1 leakproof container of suitable size  
1 small saucepan  
1 heatproof funnel  
1 filterpaper for funnel  
1 moarter and pestile

## Procedure

Crush the "No-Doze" tablets to a fine powder. Place in filter paper cone inside of funnel. Place funnel spout in to container and pour a very small amount of boiling water over the powdered tablets. Recycle fluid at least three times, adding slight amounts of fresh boiling water each time. Discard filter paper and exausted powder residue. Add rum and honey. Shake quite vigorously, until mixture is evenly distributed. Cap and allow to cool.

## Use and Doseage

To be used sparingly, 1 Oz. or less, 30 minutes prior to a dificult contact or possession operation. Given orally to the receiver only. May also be used upon a receiver's first contact to assist in overcoming any fright or fear that may be present. Most effective if used with a meditation period or short isolation of receiver just prior to operation. Not to be ingested as a regular beverage. Not to be given to minors or persons in poor health, or persons suffering from gastric disturbances. Persons receiving "Soma" should not attempt to drive vehicles for at least 2 hours per ounce of Soma ingested.

## Effect

A combination CNS depressant and stimulant, and increases the blood-sugar level, producing a pronounced feeling of well-being without the drowsiness usually produced by alcohol alone.

## Safety

A ten times overdose was given to a volunteer with no lasting side effects. Such dosage is not recommended however.
