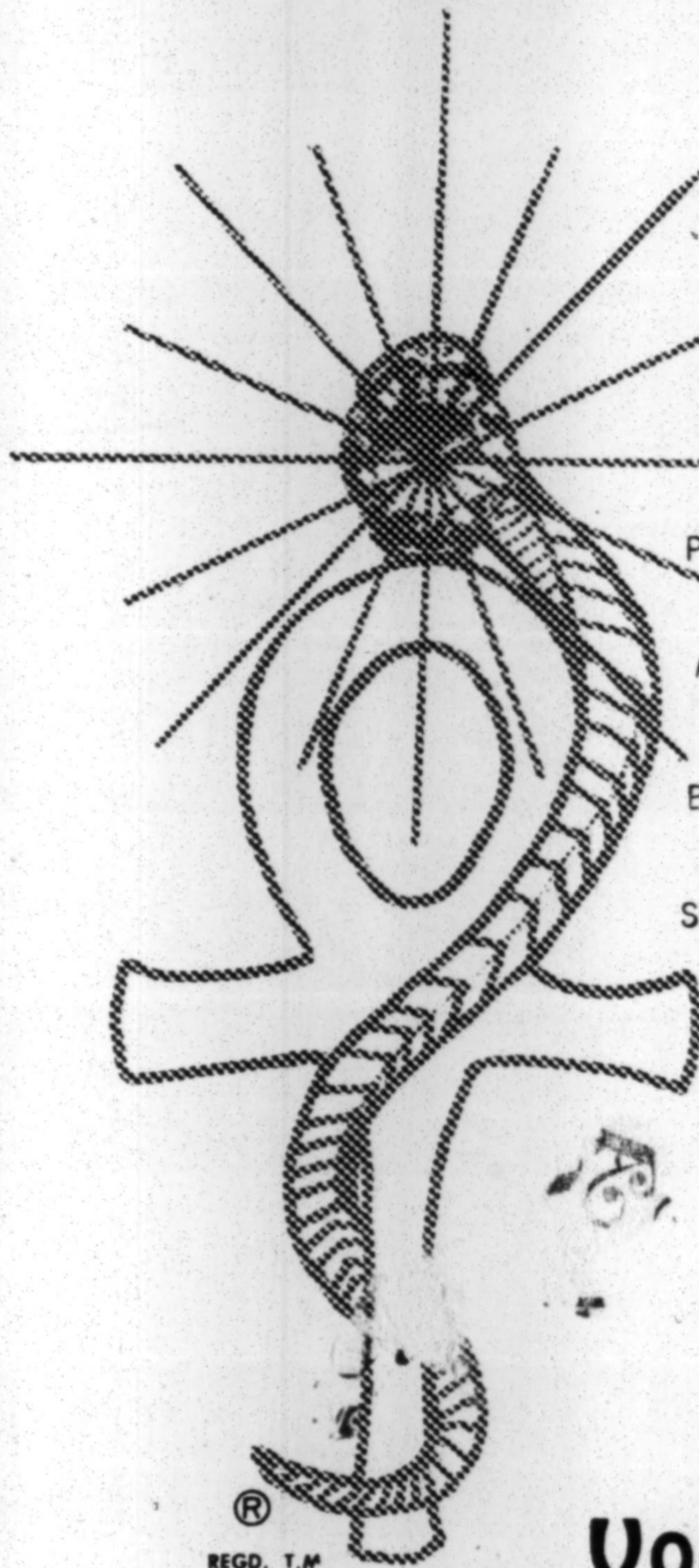

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

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EDITORIAL

MASSACRE AND SUICIDE

The gristly expose' of "The People's Temple" which I am sure you have all heard about by this time, which has dominated all of the media lately, has once again caused most if not all of the self-same media to group all "Cults" together. What the media has overlooked is that (1) this "Cult" was supposedly "Christian" and (2) Christian massacres are not new.

The sensationalist statements that "This is the greatest massacre and suicide in history..." are just plain wrong.

Mass killings and suicides are unfortunately quite prevalent in the history of the world, Christian and non-Christian alike.

The real tragedy of the "Jonestown" incident is that the personality type that produces a Hitler, a Rev. Jones, a "father Devine" and so on are quite well represented in the present-day Occult Community. Worse yet, there are still hoards of the personality types that permit and allow leaders of these types to exist and come to power. The "True Believer", the loyal unthinking follower of such a Hitler, a Rev. Jones, etc, are far more dangerous than just the leader alone would ever be.

Such people will condone or ignore any crime or unethical act on the part of their "leader" simply because he or she is "The Leader". Such people do not and will not apply what little stunted remnant of ethical sense or rational thought that may remain viable after some period of time in such an organization to the actions, statements or pronouncements of their "leader". They actively resist any attempts on anyone's part to apply such rational thought or criticism toward their "leader". What is really amazing about the "Cult Personality" is that they will (usually) continue to 'be faithful' even after being victimized by their "leader" or after having been expelled from the Cult.

The exact same mechanism that produced the Jonestown massacre can be seen at work today, right here in Pasadena, although at present (thankfully) on a smaller scale.

It is exactly this "Guru-Chela" or "Leader-Follower" relationship that we eschew, here at the T.O.T. We do not accept followers, period. About the closest that we will permit ourselves to become "leaders" is to act as an advisor or counselor.

We sincerely hope that this editorial reaches the "followers" of the organization referred to above, and that it will cause them to take a good hard look at both themselves and their leader, and we hope that it will shock them into some semblance of rational thought concerning where their "leader" is taking them.

Arithmancy

Arithmancy is today an almost lost art. Very little has been written on this form of divination. Arithmancy is intended for an individual to utilize, and like the I Ching but unlike the Tarot, it requires little training.

Arithmancy is not related to conventional numerology, neither is it related to Abramelin's Magic, although the Arithmantic "Magic Squares" look like they might have derived from an Abramelin talisman, and the use of these squares is totally different.

Central to the Arithmancy system is the "Magic Square" of which there are seven daily squares composed of 49 boxes in 7 X 7 array and one "special" square of 25 boxes or positions in a 5 X 5 array.

The numbers appearing in any given position are different for each square or matrix. One of the daily squares corresponds to one day of the week, and likewise to one of the 7 planets (note, the 7 planet system used in Arithmancy excludes "Earth" and therefore is probably not Kabalistic in origin, even though existing books on the subject claim Pythagorean derivation.)

Even more central to the system of Arithmancy is the Table of Questions and the tables of Answers reproduced below. It is possible to work Arithmancy with only these tables and forgoing the numerical tables, by using some alternate method of finding the number, such as picking numbered slips of paper out of a hat, using dice or a pendulum, or some other device.

The instructions and tables which follow were taken in part, from an extremely rare book published in 1927, "The Magic Square" by Walter Gibson, which is presently in the archives of the Magickal Order T.:O.:T.: (Temple of Truth).

According to the principles of Arithmancy, the value and reliability of the answers will be in direct proportion to the importance of the question, and the mental attitude and ability for concentration possessed by the consultant.

HOW TO CONSULT THE TABLES OF QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS.

FIRST: Select the question that you wish to ask from the table of 60 questions, which follows these instructions.

SECOND: Select the proper "Magic Square" or table of numbers corresponding to the day of the week upon which you are asking the question (or if the Magickal sphere or Planetary influence relating to the question is known, pick the Square relating to that sphere or influence.)

THIRD: Keeping the question (and its number) in mind, close your eyes and place a finger upon the square. Observe which number you have struck. This will be the number of the Answer Table (1 to 49) from which you will pick the answer. The answer itself will have the same number as the number of the question from the table of questions, which you selected in the First Step, above.

(Alternate method) You may also use a small coin dropped upon the square, use your pendulum to select a number, or -- with eyes closed -- place a pencil upon the square, the point of the pencil indicating the chosen number.)

FOURTH: Refer to the tables of Answers, using the number that you have just found to select the right table, and the number of the question selected earlier indicating which answer to use from the table.

EXAMPLE

On Wednesday, a person desires an answer to Question 19. He or she turns to the Magic Square for Wednesday -- the Square ruled by Mercury. Picking a number at random, the person strikes number 38.

The person turns to the Tables of Answers, picking Table number 38. From this table the person selects Answer number 19 -- the same number as his Question number was.

Bureaucratic Blunders

Parents in Austin, Tex., are encouraging their children to purposely flunk kindergarten screening tests. The reason? Only economically deprived or educationally handicapped children may attend full-day kindergarten classes free of charge. Others must pay \$30 per month.

The Pennsylvania Advisory Committee of that liberal bastion, the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights, has issued a report entitled, "The Last Suffrage Frontier: Enfranchising Mental Hospital Patients." These liberals always know where their votes are.

A Colorado "feminist collective," Virago, has received \$41,006 in CETA funds. (Virago has produced the "Leaping Lesbian Follies," performed in the nude and, in violation of the law, for women only.) Another CETA grant provided five staff members for the National Gay Task Force office in New York City. And HEW awarded a \$50,000 grant to the Center for Homosexual Education and Research at San Francisco State University to study "Civil Liberties and Sexual Orientation."

A lesbian "husband" was ordered to pay \$100 per month support to her "wife" by a San Diego, Calif., Superior Court judge this June.

OSHA has ordered a David, Calif., ranch manager to label one of the bathrooms in the ranchhouse he lives in "Men" and the other "Women," although the man lives alone. The same lonesome rancher was ordered by the California State Compensation Insurance Fund Agriculture Safety Commission to hold "safety meetings" of from five to 15 minutes "attended by all employees" on a regular basis to discuss safety rules and procedures.

A group of senior citizens at Chicago's Queen of Angels Catholic Church was told in June that they could not say grace before eating a meal funded under a federal grant.

The mother of world heavyweight champ Leon Spinks, who won \$320,000 in his fight against Mohammed Ali, is receiving several hundred dollars from state and federal welfare programs.

The feds, acting under a 1975 law requiring bilingual ballots if a sizeable portion of a population speaks a language other than English, are insisting that Robeson County, N.C., print ballots in both English and Lumbee. Lumbee, in case you didn't know, is the language of the Lumbee Indians, although Robeson County election director James McDowell says the local Indians no longer understand Lumbee and that, in fact, the language no longer exists.

Under a Dade County, Fla., regulation a Miami blind woman is being paid \$17,000 per year for her taxi fare to drive to and from work. The 88-mile round trip from her home to the snack bar she runs costs \$72 per day.

Three Coast Guardsmen have been kicked off President Carter's honor guard because their hair is too short.

A near-illiterate was hired at \$100 per day by HEW as a "consultant" to evaluate a federal reading program. Among programs receiving federal aid she was asked to evaluate was a remedial reading and math course. Here are some examples of her writing:

"There is no realistically promises that addresses the needs identified in the proposed program."

"The objectivities did not specify to the quantifiable of the success of the proposed program."

"No specified services that can verify the emphasizes to an individual."

California's new \$14.7 billion budget, which Gov. Jerry Brown calls "lean and austere," contains \$100,000 for floating toilets, \$165,000 for aquaculture studies, \$40,000 to help bring moviemakers to California, \$362,500 to photograph pine trees, and \$150,000 to pay elevator operators for the Sacramento, Calif., capitol's automatic elevators.

Boston mayor Kevin White recently decided to paint his city's traffic signal poles black, less than a month after spending \$24,600 to paint the same 2,000 poles yellow. Asked about the needless repainting, Traffic and Parking Commissioner Elimy Lloyd said, "It's a question of aesthetics."

The National Science Foundation has awarded \$100,000 to Cornell Univ. professor Harvey Pough to study Puerto Rican frogs—with the explanation, "Populations of three species will be examined in different habitats at different altitudes with different combinations of sympatry or allopatry. Physical characteristics of the frogs' major habitats and microhabitats will be measured and compared. The hypothesis that availability of suitable diurnal retreat sites is important in determining frog body size and population density in lowland habitats will be tested."

Former Federal Trade Commission lawyer Ben Stein (son of former Nixon economics adviser Herb Stein) in a recent column gave a remarkable insight into how the federal government works. Stein had been put in charge of an FTC lawsuit that alleged Coca-Cola engaged in false and deceptive advertising of its "Hi-C" drink. Stein writes, "After working on the theory and facts of the case for three or four months, with two lawyers under me, several secretaries and inexhaustible funds for travel and selection of witnesses, I decided that we had no case at all." Stein reported this to his supervisor, who agreed, saying, "I guess you're right. We haven't much of a case."

But when Stein suggested that the suit be dropped, the supervisor changed his tune: "We can't go around saying all this was a mistake. We've been working on the case for five years." The supervisor directed Stein to continue work on the suit, telling him it would be "good practice" for him. So the case continued for nearly two more years, costing the government hundreds of thousands of dollars and Coca-Cola millions in legal defense costs.

Last fall Congress voted to add 25 employees of the House of Representatives' beauty shop to the federal payroll. That figures. After all, our congressmen must be well-groomed for their taxpayer-financed photographers and TV film spots.

The U.S. Economic Development Administration approved a \$12,000 grant for the city of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, to give its fire house a new roof, storm windows and insulation. Close behind news of the grant, however, came a 400-page compliance instruction book, together with a note saying more instructions would follow. The city council decided to turn down the grant.

REFERENCE AND HISTORICAL ITEMS OF VALUE TO THE PRACTITIONER

THE LESSER RITUAL OF THE PENTAGRAM

Items Needed:

Magickal Knife or dagger (Magickal Sword may also be used)

Talisman: The Pentagram of Solomon

Optional Items (helpful, but not needed)

Magickal Robes

Magick Circle, etc. (general Temple set-up)

Place: Indoors or out, preferably away from un-interested spectators.

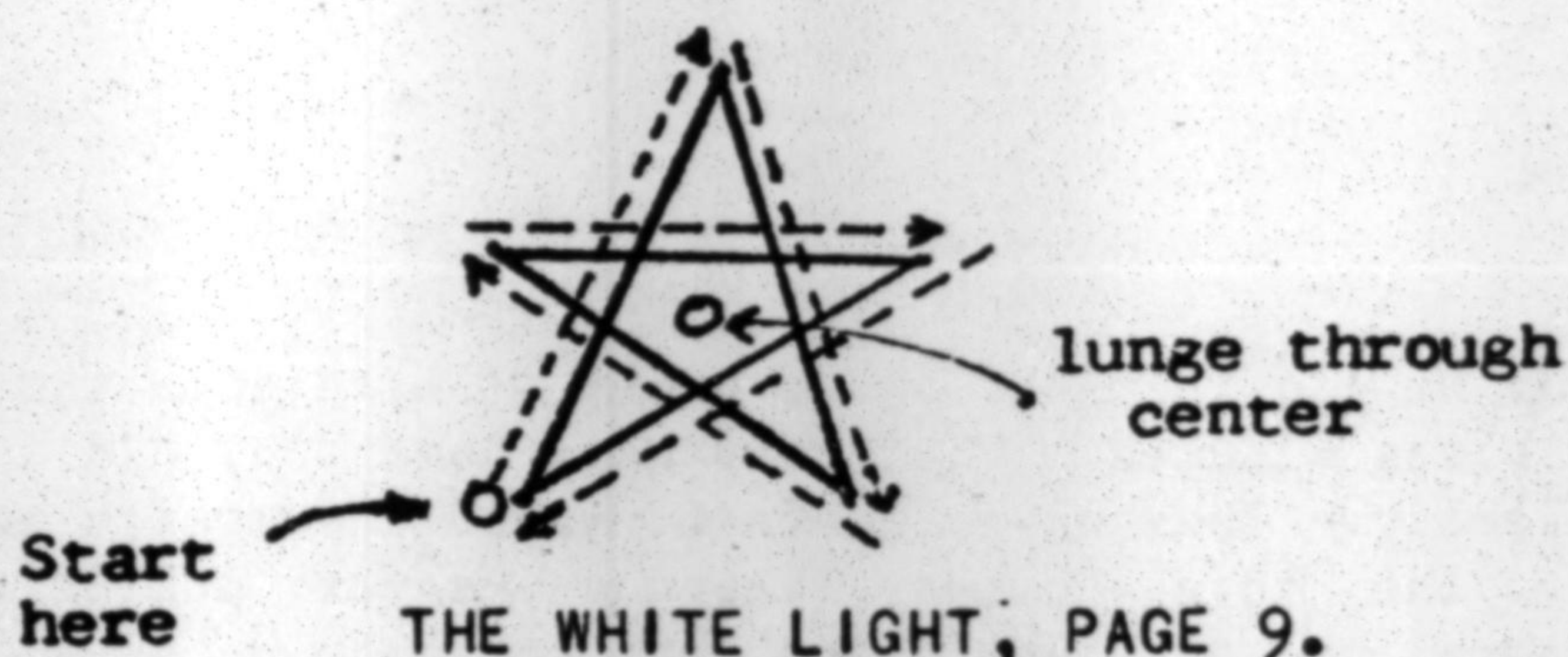
Take the knife in your right hand, face EAST. Touch your forehead with the knife and say "Ateh", touch your chest with the knife and say "Malkuth", touch your right sholder with the knife and say "Ve-Geburah", touch your left sholder with the knife and say "Ve-Gedulah", clasp both hands about the knife, with the point out before you and say "Le-Olam", turn the knife point up and say "Amen".

Trace in the air, with the knife (using your right hand) a pentagram (five pointed star, as shown in the drawing below), then lunge through the center of the pentagram that you have just traced with the knife saying "Yatveh". With your arm still straight out with the point of the knife out before you, turn to the SOUTH. Repeat the Pentagram and lunge, saying "Adonai". Again, keeping the point of the knife out in front of you, turn to the WEST. Again do the Pentagram and lunge, saying, "Eheiah". As before, turn to the NORTH, make the Pentagram and lunge saying, "Agla". Continue with the knife point still stretched out in front of you, around to EAST again. (you have now completed a full circle with the knife point with four pentagrams, in the air around yourself.)

Now stand with your feet together and with your arms out stretched on either side of your body, forming a cross (your knife is still in your right hand) and say, "Before me Raphael, Behind me Gabriel, At my right hand Michael, At my left hand Auriel, Around me flame the Pentagrams, Above me shines the Six-Rayed Star."

Still facing EAST, again make the Kaballistic cross, starting with 'Ateh' and ending with 'Amen'.

Book Review

"IN SEARCH OF...." By Alan Landsburg, 1978, Doubleday.

This 1978 book, which is nothing but a re-hash of some 1977 paperbacks is seriously out of date concerning Occult subjects, which make up Part Three, and is the only part here reviewed.

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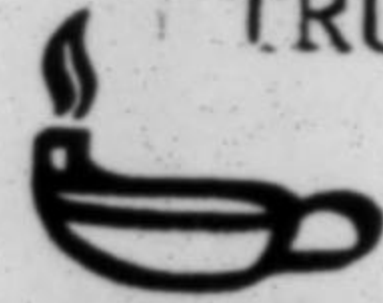
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
