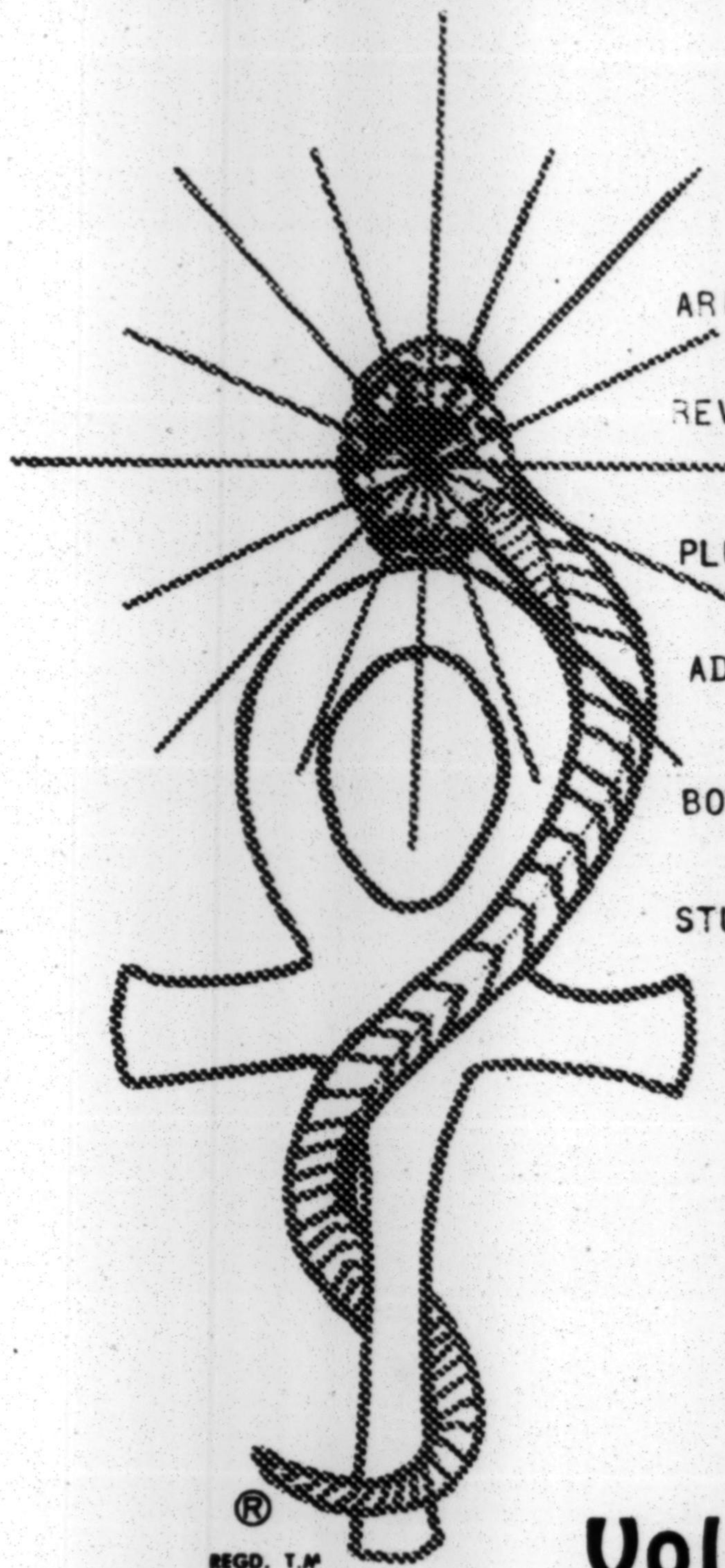




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# EDITORIAL

"The evil men do lives after them"... goes the saying, and it is certainly true today. In the wake of the "People's Temple" affair, a type of hysteria has overcome some officials of the State of California. In an effort to forestall any further repetitions of the People's Temple business, the State has embarked upon a Witch-Hunt of massive proportions. Some of you have heard of the fight between the State and the Ambassador College/World Wide Church of God (Ted Armstrong & Company). What the news media has not seen fit to report is that the court ordered receivers (friends of the Judge) and other assorted blood suckers, are paid lavishly (\$100/hour and up) from the funds they are supposed to be protecting. It is no wonder that Mr. Radier and others are hopping mad. Their organization is being looted by the very authorities that claim to be preventing the looting. This same sort of looting is very common in Probate, but there the person is (usually) dead and can't protest. Since all this requires that Attornies be hired and paid, the legal profession is (as usual) doing nothing about these abuses.

What is even more frightening, is that the State is instituting "Audits" of "Unconventional" Religious groups, where there is not and has not been any accusations of wrong doing or fiscal irregularities. In other words, the only criteria for being audited is that the organization be "unconventional". The unstated accusation here is that the organization is suspected of being a "cult". It seems the State is unable to distinguish between "A Cult" and "Occult".

This is but one of the many areas of the State's activities that border or actually infringe upon the 1st. Amendment's guarantee of Religious Freedom. The Internal Revenue Service (of all people) has recognised (at last) that Churches are automatically exempt, and has so stated in their publication number 557. The State of Calif. has yet to recognise that the process of granting exemptions on a case by case basis is in fact an infringement of the first amendment because some State employee must sit down and decide who is a Church and who is not. It is that decision making process, used by the State, under the premise of Tax exemptions, that is repungent to the First Amendment.

For these and other reasons, we recommend most strongly that persons and organizations of all religious views join and support HALT (see ad on back cover) now that the ADL has gone under.

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San Antonio, Texas. A U.S. district judge has found the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission's claims against Datapoint Corp.—arising out of the firing of a trouble-making employee, Helen Sierra, in 1972—"groundless and unreasonable." "The charges were pursued," said the judge, "for the sole reason of increasing defendant's expenses and to increase the nuisance value of the suit." The case "was brought and prosecuted in bad faith," and the majority of the EEOC's claims "were frivolous and were known by the EEOC to be frivolous at the time it filed its initial complaint." The judge awarded Datapoint \$87,890 in legal expenses.

In the Soviet Union the people only have what the government gives them; in the United States the people have only what the government doesn't take away from them.

To raise one person above the federal poverty line of \$4,430 costs \$36,000, according to a study by *Wall Street Journal* editor Robert Bartley. Bartley points out that in 1967 the official estimate of the poverty population was 27,769,000, while transfer payments ran to \$47.1 billion. By 1975 transfer payments had grown to \$115.6 billion—an increase of \$68.5 billion—but the poverty population had only dropped 1,892,000, an annual cost of \$36,000 per person removed from poverty. (All dollar amounts are 1972 dollars.)

Today legislation is originated by bureaucrats who, unlike politicians, are life peers and cannot be voted out of office. There is no coincidence whatsoever between the interest of bureaucrats, who have incentives to enlarge the scope of government, and the public interest.

The federal government's 15,792 lawyers are lobbying for a "Career Service Plan" which would take government lawyers out of the general white collar pay system and put them in a plan, endorsed by the American Bar Association, that would be administered by the lawyers themselves. Last year the average government lawyer earned \$27,606 plus generous fringe benefits while the average nongovernment lawyer earned about \$26,000.

## Book Review

The Magical Philosophy, Book IV:  
"THE TRIUMPH OF LIGHT"

In this fourth of the series, Denning & Phillips have at least pulled up their socks to some extent and avoided the gross and laughable errors contained in the three previous volumes. (See Reviews Section, TWL Vol.4, No. 3 -- Spring '78). They have not, however, improved the information to garbage ratio noticeably and still sound like a satire of Crowley, not that we're against Satire, but it should be so labeled, and not disguised as a serious work on Magick.

As we have already pointed out, the OSV system could be worked, much as Bardou, if treated as a synthetic system. The fifth volume is going to have to be a real blockbuster if the series is to live up to it's advertising, which so far it hasn't even come close. I place considerable blame on Llewellyn Publications for buying and promoting this series, when books of genuine worth go begging.

It is precisely this situation, that caused us to write and (hopefully soon) release our own book "Secret Magick Revealed", which is announced in this issue (See Page 11.)

The Authors are quite wide of the mark in many areas and even seek to justify a "Napoleon Complex" although they don't call it that. How they can presume to speak on the Psyche and the Microcosm while at the same time turning their backs on Jung is beyond me. Virtually all of my remarks about the first three books would also apply to this volume, so I won't bother to re-state them. By the time one has spent the \$50 or so, and worse yet, spent the time required to plow through this series, the student might be dissuaded from any further pursuit of the Art of Magick. To this extent, these books do a great dis-service to The Art which they claim to be promoting. So much so, that I have a small suspicion that these books might be black propaganda by hyper-fundamental Christians, attempting to sabotage one's study of The Art. The test will come with the fifth in the series. If it is like the others, it will mean that the entire series is a complete wash-out. We shall see.



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
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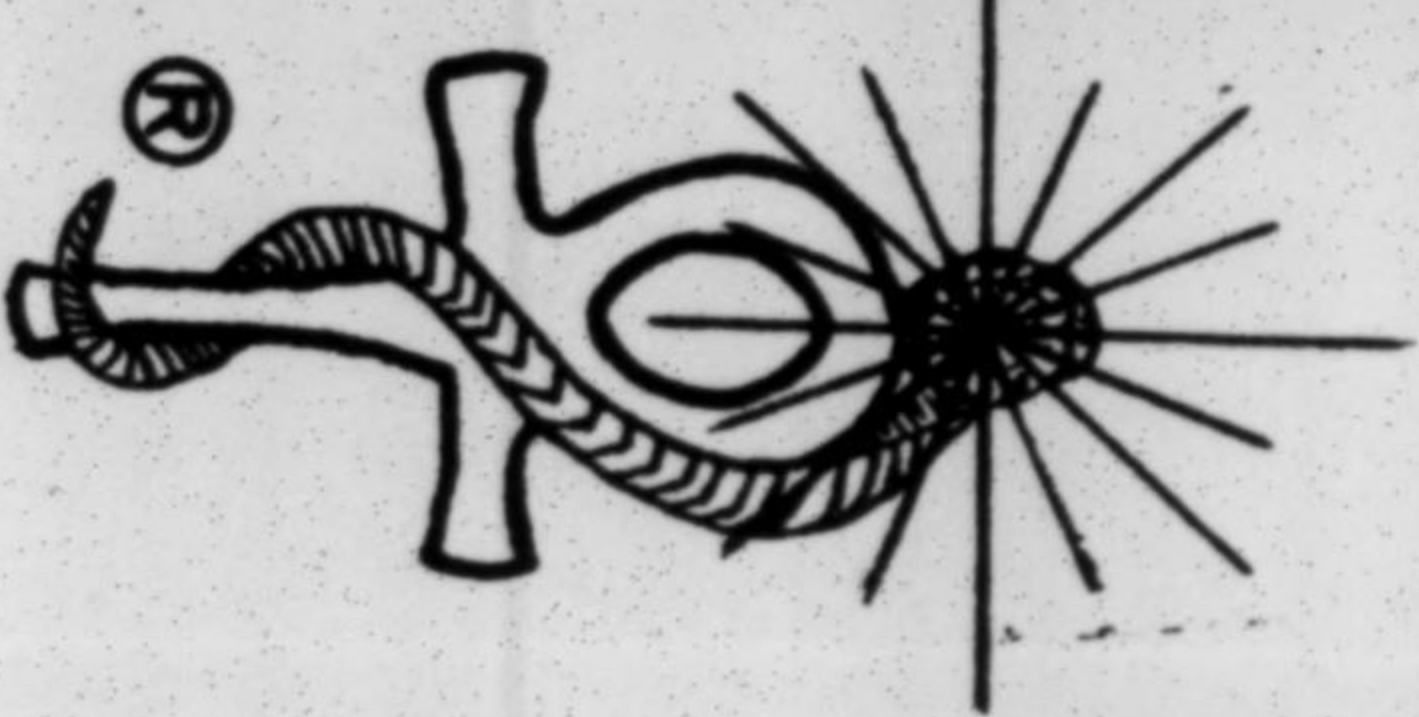
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
