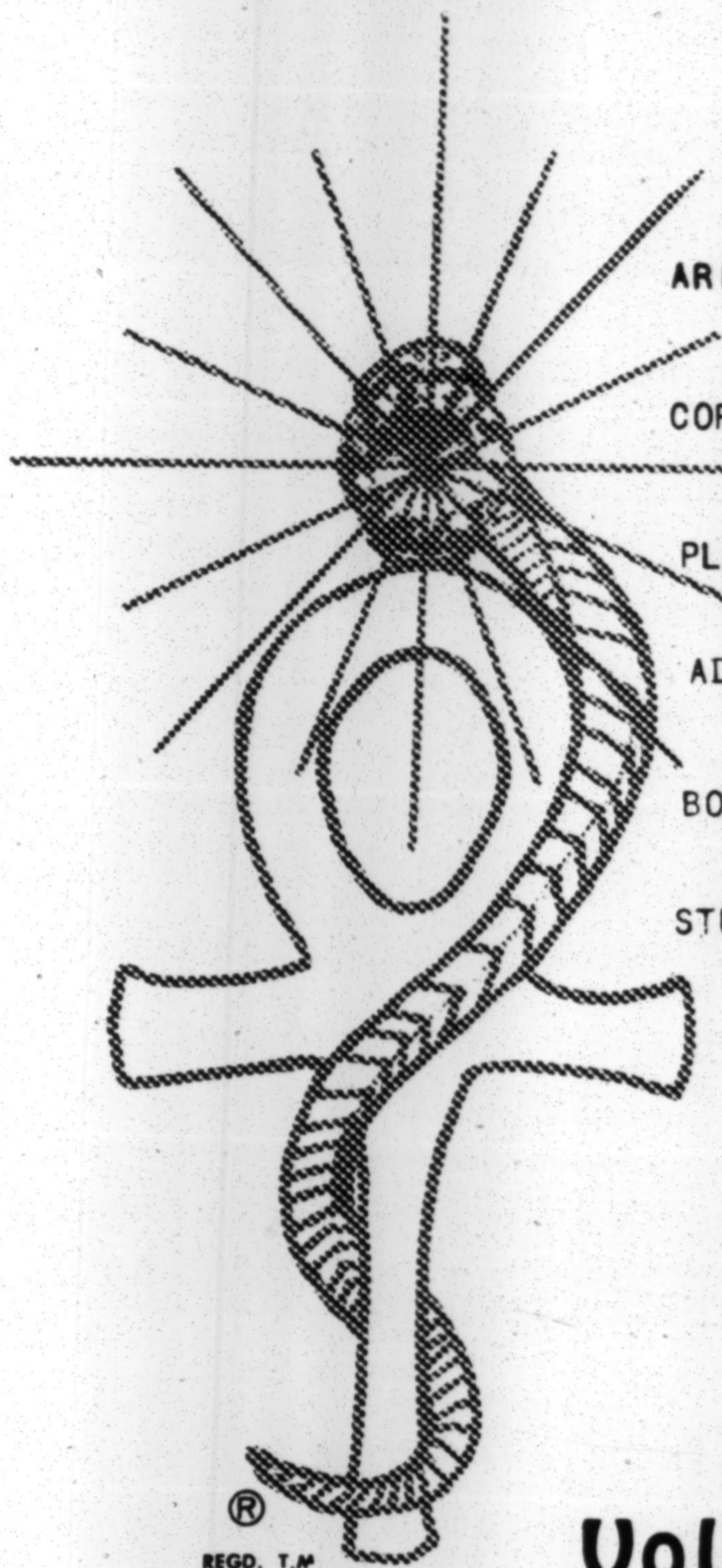





STATE'S WITCH-HUNT CONTINUES

The Witch-Hunt conducted by the State of California with assistance of the I.R.S. is continuing. Our contacts in Sacramento have informed us that the State's Franchise Tax Board (the State Income Tax People) has come up with a 14 point criteria for defining a "Church". Of course the existence of this criteria is highly classified and even those organizations being investigated or "Audited" are not told of the criteria's existence. Most especially, such organizations are not told what that criteria consists of. You are simply told that you "don't meet the criteria" and that's that. Our investigation has turned up one of the criteria's points: "Traceable Religious History".


Aside from the obvious un-Constitutional aspects of the criteria its self, the un-equal application of the criteria, and the investigating or "Auditing" of ONLY "Unconventional" Churches, reveals a basically un-constitutional attitude and procedure by the State, not counting the State's thoroughly anti-Occult bias.

What "Traceable Religious History" means, is that you can't simply start up a Church. You have to have graduated from or been associated with some other organization in the same vein or persuasion as the organization that you are trying to start. This former training or connection must be documented or traceable (says the State). HOGWASH!!

The fact that a criteria, any criteria, exists and therefore at some point in time was generated by some agency of Government, rather or not that criteria is ever applied, is of and by itself un-Constitutional on its face. This is a Prima-Facie violation of the doctrine of the separation of Church and State. Regardless of the merits of the criteria, regardless of how it is or might be applied, and regardless of the abuses that might have occurred that caused the State to generate such a criteria---the fact that such a criteria exists is the salient point. That point is totally undefendable.

Our investigation of the Franchise Tax Board has turned up several other interesting items, which we plan to discuss in a forth-coming book: "MAGICK & THE LAW; Keeping what you have."

Our contacts in Sacramento have informed us that the State's Franchise Tax Board (the State Income Tax People) has come up with a 14 point criteria for defining a "Church". Of course the existence of this criteria is highly classified and even those organizations being investigated or "Audited" are not told of the criteria's existence. Most especially, such organizations are not told what that criteria consists of. You are simply told that you "don't meet the criteria" and that's that. Our investigation has turned up one of the criteria's points: "Traceable Religious History".

Aside from the obvious un-Constitutional aspects of the criteria its self, the un-equal application of the criteria, and the investigating or "Auditing" of ONLY "Unconventional" Churches, reveals a basically un-constitutional attitude and procedure by the State, not counting the State's thoroughly anti-Occult bias.

What "Traceable Religious History" means, is that you can't simply start up a Church. You have to have graduated from or been associated with some other organization in the same vein or persuasion as the organization that you are trying to start. This former training or connection must be documented or traceable (says the State). HOGWASH!!

The fact that a criteria, any criteria, exists and therefore at some point in time was generated by some agency of Government, rather or not that criteria is ever applied, is of and by itself un-Constitutional on its face. This is a Prima-Facie violation of the doctrine of the separation of Church and State. Regardless of the merits of the criteria, regardless of how it is or might be applied, and regardless of the abuses that might have occurred that caused the State to generate such a criteria---the fact that such a criteria exists is the salient point. That point is totally undefendable.

Book Review

THE KEY OF SOLOMON THE KING
(Tr. By: S.L. MacGregor Mathers)

This version of the Greater Key, the Weiser Edition, has one great advantage over the DeLaurence Edition, in that it has none of the credulous garbage that DeLaurence inserted into the book. The Weiser edition also has a few bits and peices, not in the DeLaurence edition and a new foreword by Richard Cavendish.

The only serious drawback of the Weiser edition is its price, which is considerably more than the older DeLaurence edition, most likely due to the fact that the book is printed in Great Britain and the transportation costs added in.

For those students that have not yet acquired a copy of The Greater Key, the Weiser Edition is preferred.

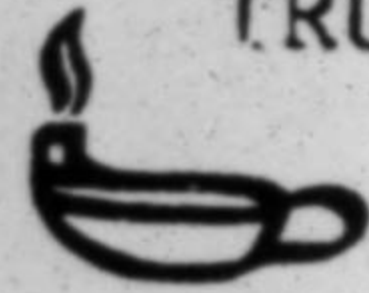

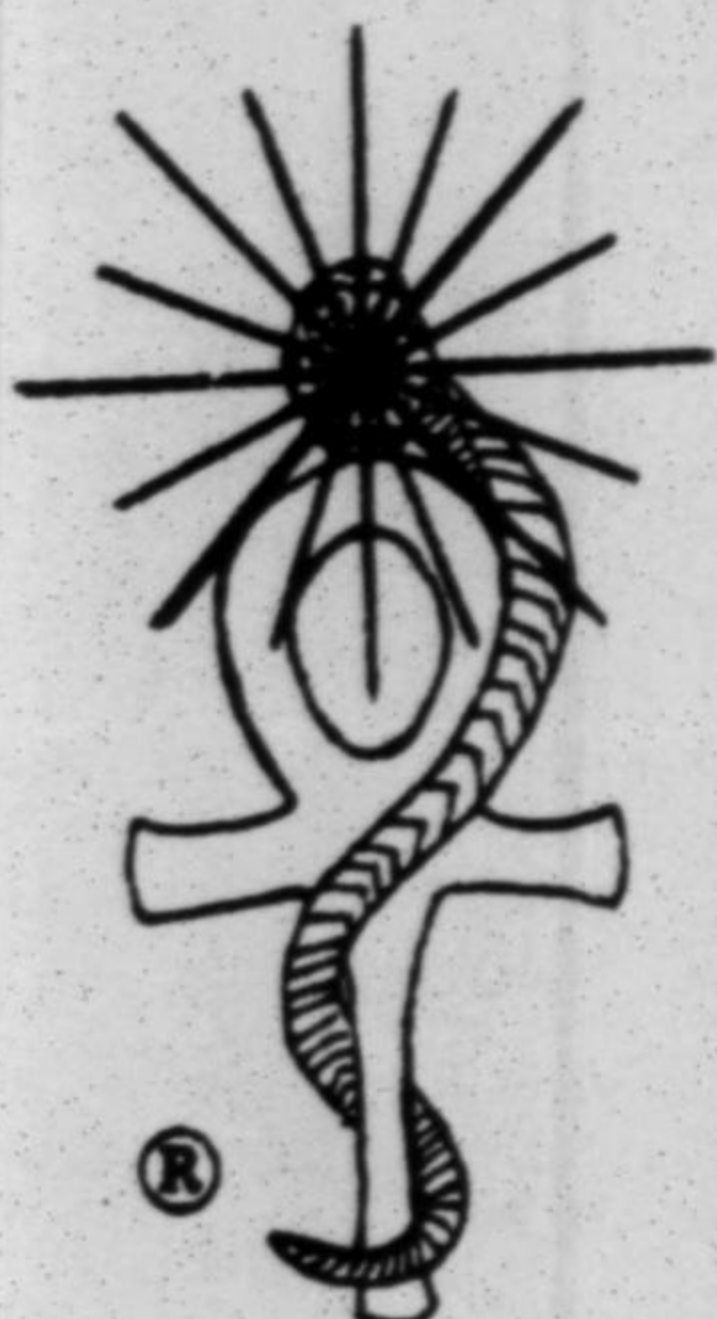

The Temple of Truth

THE TEMPLE OF TRUTH, unlike most other Orders and Magickal Lodges, is essentially *unstructured*. It has no "grades," issues no pretentious certificates, and has no fixed curriculum. The Temple of Truth exists primarily for its students and members, and hence does not get involved in the internal workings of other organizations. The Temple of Truth takes no part in political quarrels which sweep through the contemporary American Occult scene. Likewise, we abjure most of the "traditional" secrecy which all too frequently hides ineptitude and selfishness on the part of those purporting to know it all. What little is kept secret is simply for the safety of the individual student, and no information is "forever denied" to a promising student. Each individual is free to select his own course of study, as well as the rate at which he chooses to pursue it. This "independent study" concept allows the staff as well as the students considerable flexibility. The student defines what it is he wishes to do and then later submits a report on the results he has achieved. Selections from these reports may be published at a later date.

Individual students are encouraged to adopt the scholastic method but not required to do so. In any event, the lack of rigor will not bar the student from opportunities to test his theories. Empirical results are the cornerstones of the student's progress.

Flexibility is also stressed in the admission standards of the organization, the main emphasis being on a better than average moral and ethical behaviour on the part of the individual applicant. The applicant's motivation should be a desire for spiritual development rather than an egotistic craving to

be called a "High Priest" or a "High Priestess," or the lust for "Powers"—usually over others—in lieu of Self-control.

The student is encouraged to practice his magick in his own home as a part of his everyday life. This emphasis on individual practice (after an initial period of instruction) is one of the largest differences between The Temple of Truth, and other Magickal organizations operating in the present Occult spectrum. Membership in The Temple of Truth is non-exclusive, or in other words, members of other organizations can join ours. Dues are low because we are not supporting a large staff or headquarters complex.

The Temple of Truth is sponsored by The Light of Truth Church, a duly licensed and incorporated Religious Institution. The Church is neither evangelistic nor fundamentalist in the usual sense. We do proselytize the basic dignity of Man, and we recognize the subjectivity of what most people call "truth." The Church's teachings, being cabalistic, are compatible with Christian, Moslem, and Hebrew religious tenets.

Dues, donations, and so forth to either the Temple or the Church are entirely tax-exempt, under both State and Federal law.

The Church also operates a Gift and Occult Supply shop, The Magick Circle, at 1274 N. Lake Ave., Pasadena, California.

The Temple of Truth

THE TEMPLE OF TRUTH, unlike most other Orders and Magickal Lodges, is essentially *unstructured*. It has no "grades," issues no pretentious certificates, and has no fixed curriculum. The Temple of Truth exists primarily for its students and members, and hence does not get involved in the internal workings of other organizations. The Temple of Truth takes no part in political quarrels which sweep through the contemporary American Occult scene. Likewise, we abjure most of the "traditional" secrecy which all too frequently hides ineptitude and selfishness on the part of those purporting to know it all. What little is kept secret is simply for the safety of the individual student, and no information is "forever denied" to a promising student. Each individual is free to select his own course of study, as well as the rate at which he chooses to pursue it. This "independent study" concept allows the staff as well as the students considerable flexibility. The student defines what it is he wishes to do and then later submits a report on the results he has achieved. Selections from these reports may be published at a later date.

Individual students are encouraged to adopt the scholastic method but not required to do so. In any event, the lack of rigor will not bar the student from opportunities to test his theories. Empirical results are the cornerstones of the student's progress.

Flexibility is also stressed in the admission standards of the organization, the main emphasis being on a better than average moral and ethical behaviour on the part of the individual applicant. The applicant's motivation should be a desire for spiritual development rather than an egotistic craving to

be called a "High Priest" or a "High Priestess," or the lust for "Powers"—usually over others—in lieu of Self-control.

The student is encouraged to practice his magick in his own home as a part of his everyday life. This emphasis on individual practice (after an initial period of instruction) is one of the largest differences between The Temple of Truth, and other Magickal organizations operating in the present Occult spectrum. Membership in The Temple of Truth is non-exclusive, or in other words, members of other organizations can join ours. Dues are low because we are not supporting a large staff or headquarters complex.

The Temple of Truth is sponsored by The Light of Truth Church, a duly licensed and incorporated Religious Institution. The Church is neither evangelistic nor fundamentalist in the usual sense. We do proselytize the basic dignity of Man, and we recognize the subjectivity of what most people call "truth." The Church's teachings, being cabalistic, are compatible with Christian, Moslem, and Hebrew religious tenets.

Dues, donations, and so forth to either the Temple or the Church are entirely tax-exempt, under both State and Federal law.

The Church also operates a Gift and Occult Supply shop, The Magick Circle, at 1274 N. Lake Ave., Pasadena, California.

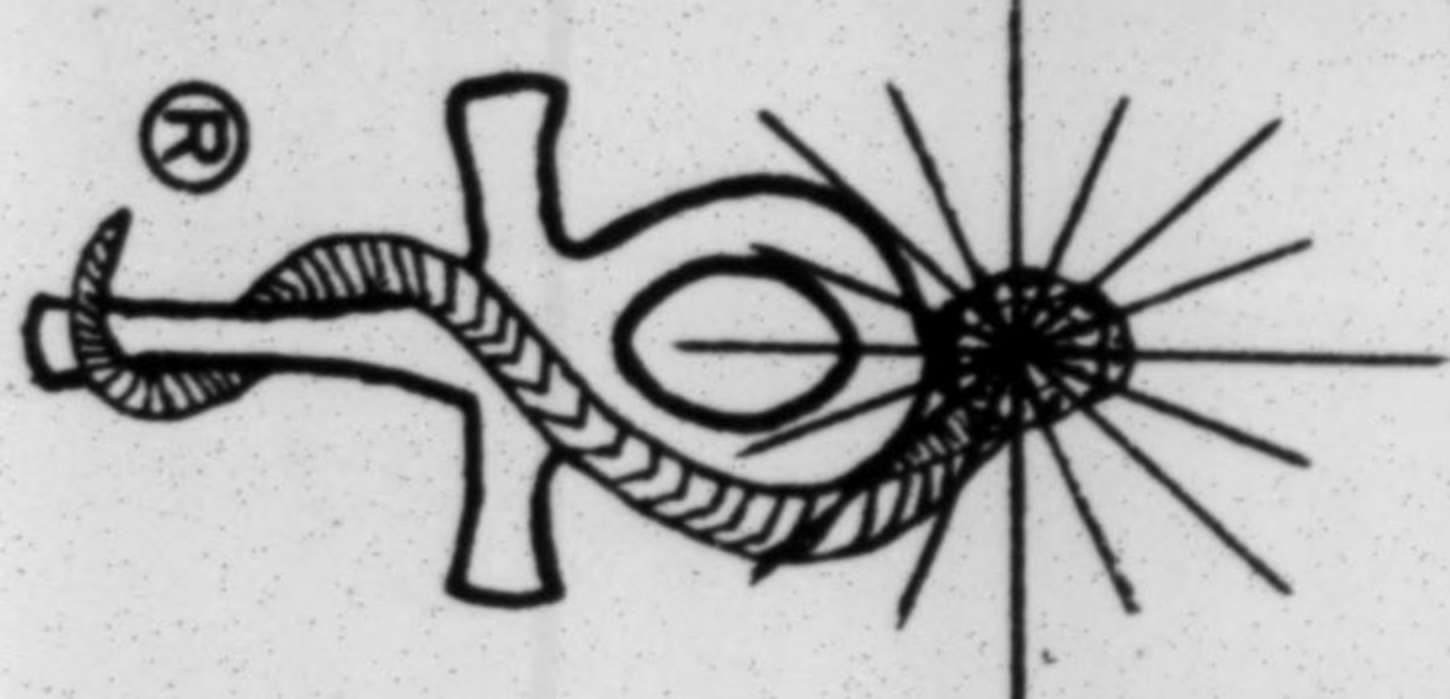
