CLEARING THE MIRROR

The original "Magik Mirror" (minus the future 'c') was actually a store location in Salem, Massachusetts which did business as a BiCentennial "happening" during the year 1975-76. Broadsheets by E. Macer-Story describing certain ancient uses of the magic mirror for divination and sorcery were available to "witch city" tourists, as well as similar broadsheets for other events both poetical and occult in the Boston area . These were placed on a table and bulletin board at one side of the store. On the opposite wall hung an original painting of an Indian Chief by artist Meredith Rice. Various clay talismans made in the ancient tradition by E. Macer-Story were also available, as hanging displayed in the store or made to order.

The stock of books offered by the original Magik Mirror was sent from an occult distributor in Minneapolis who was using a standard "small press" format, and from a more "down home" gypsy lore distributor located in Toluca Lake, California which provided "how to do" chapbooks of formulas, spells and remedies.

The "Magik Mirror" event broke even thanks to the co-operation of these distributors, along with live artists, poets and local mental magicians.

During this year long event, there was also an affiliation with the International UFO Network and UFOLOGY magazine, which published an article by E. Macer-Story entitled CONTACTEE : THE

MONROE EXAMPLE. This was about a man from the Salem, Massachusetts area who had come into the store with a story about seeing ufos while enlisted in the military and being told in a very forceful briefing by his superiors not to discuss this experience.

But it is important for the reader of this present Magick Mirror Magazine to remember that ufos and related issues have never been the only focus of "Magick Mirror" activities, as these activities continued in various locations after the BiCentennial. MAGICK MIRROR has also been the logo for plays, poetical happenings, and art exhibits created and scripted by E. Macer-Story, usually in conjunction with a producer who provided funds and/or premises for production.

NEW PUBLIC NYC LOCATION
From the continuing alchemical journals of E. Macer-Story:

"An unusual "energy streak" appeared on a photo of a discarded birthday cake taken on November 28, 1995. When I went out of the building at 9:15 a.m. to duplicate fliers to send to the Concord Group for their Taipei Expo in January, which included my new book LEGACY OF DAEDALUS, I found a half-eaten chocolate birthday cake on the floor of the lobby. It had been neatly sliced at the edges and was in a cardboard bakery box. I photographed it.

"In the Santeria religion, food is often placed on the floor as an offering to spirits. Since I intended to make arrangements for a small public office on West 13th Street later in the day, I hoped this was a

positive omen for the birth of a New York City **MAGICK MIRROR** commercial location, rather than a "hex" connected to the hot water problem in my apartment building the previous day.

"When I picked up the developed roll of film on January 9, 1996 (for reasons of economy, I often let candid psychical documentation shots accumulate on a black and white roll before developing them) I was actually more interested in photos which had been taken during a "Sufi Exorcism" on New Years Day but also discovered unusual energy streaking on two photos of the cake, as if this item also had been charged with talismanic "power" or had a spirit attending upon it."--E.Macer-Story

ANATOMY OF A PHENOMENON

It has come to the attention of the **MAGICK MIRROR** that offhand commentary to the effect that investigations conducted with telepathic and/or psychokinetic possibilities in mind "are not really ufo research" has been circulating behind the glad hand, under the table and quickly at fast food restaurants frequented by the ufo research crowd in locations outside the NYC urban area. Make no mistake. This IS the **Magick Mirror Magazine** and we do have ways of knowing about such provincial reflections

Under such circumstances, it is appropriate to comment that standing with a pair of horse race binoculars scanning the overcast sky for unusual aircraft (or any aircraft at

all) is a peculiar way to do scientific research into a type of unexplained phenomenon which is not always aerial at the initial encounter and which usually is observed unexpectedly.

One of the key aspects of investigating any event which has been reported to occur beyond the direct, present comprehension of the investigator --whether this unexplained event is the mating behavior of a deep sea jellyfish or the sudden appearance of aerial objects and/or lights which do not observe ordinary constraints of mundane aerodynamics-- actually is journalistic humility before the situation of incomplete knowledge. This should result in the taking of notes on the unexplained event which has actually occurred rather than some quickly-rendered, secondary interpretation of the puzzling event.

No one who has seriously studied the ufo phenomenon will deny that an important area of incomplete understanding is the observed mental alteration (often telepathic though not limited to awakening of telepathic capacities) of contactees and investigators of those contactees. Therefore, it is not actually "scientific" to omit the existence of unusual mental and emotional situations from a documentation of the ufo phenomenon. Rather, the omission of these odd mental outages and attributes--like the omission of deviations from the ideal in observed planetary orbits by enthusiasts of the Ptolemaic cosmological model-- leaves any detailed observations

about the ufo enigma artificially and therefore inaccurately represented in all quasi-scientific renditions.

Granted, some of these telepathic (or quasi-telepathic) high strangeness events are fundamentally embarrassing on the direct, interpersonal level. But personal reactivity should not stand in the way of accurate documentation. By analogy, certain vital procedures of neurology, urology, gynecology and dermatology --though emotionally embarrassing at times to the patient- - are necessary in order to completely understand medically the physical condition of the patient.

Five centuries ago, Leonardo DaVinci and other such entrepreneurs had to learn human muscular anatomy by dissection of cadavers in secret . Are we now at such a culturally immature stage in behavioral analysis that any real documentary analysis of "high strangeness" mental states and/or behavior related to "ufo contact" must be discussed in the closet, or under the table in clandestine meetings at a delicatessen?--E.M-S.

WHITE PANTHER PASSES

News recently emerged from Florida that Harry Lebelson, a white man who once worked for the Black Panther newspaper and who had been part of the "UFO scene" in New York most prominently during the years 1978-83, when he was a stringer for OMNI, died of congestive heart failure on November 9, 1995.

It is ironic that this reporter mentioned Lebelson in a talk for the Providence, R.I. CONSPIRACY

LEAGUE just one day after his death last November without knowing he had passed away just before this event. This talk, entitled THE DARK FRONTIER, will be published in a NEWSPEAK (Providence,R.I.) publication to be issued in April 1996. It is unfortunate that Lebelson will not be able to read this essay on the ancient and continuing battles between the interdimensional forces of light and darkness, as he was genuinely interested in the link between "UFO" and "supernatural" occurrences.

There was an "apport" which occurred during the time speakers were sitting in the NEWSPEAK bookstore, waiting to meet browsers who might be interested in their work. As this reporter gazed idly down an aisle of the store at mid-afternoon on Saturday November 11, a spiral-bound book fell off a shelf by itself. No one was standing anywhere near it. Taking this to be a PK event, this reporter went and fetched it and discovered that it was an issue of a journal on assassinations put out by Robert Culter, who was also a speaker for the CONSPIRACY LEAGUE event, though not present in the bookstore at the time of the apport.

This reporter had an associate, Rush Harp, who was also interested in spiritualism as well as politics and passed away of a heart attack in 1983 shortly after this reporter began commuting to the city from Woodstock, where he had been living. After his death, the Intelligence of Rush Harp spoke to me suddenly at a party in New York City by means of a spirit medium

who had not known the incarnate Mr. Harp personally. The information from the discarnate Intelligence of Rush Harp, which I wrote down hastily on a paper napkin amid a chattering group of party goers, proved to be accurate. It was a referral to a book on clandestine CIA research into mind control which had been in the deceased Mr. Harp's library, but after his death was for sale at the THREE GEESE IN FLIGHT Irish bookstore, which at that time was located on the village green in Woodstock.

In November of 1995, I assumed that the Cutler journal apport was again a manifestation of Rush Harp's spirit, since he had been closely in touch with Mr. Cutler when he was alive and riding about throughout New York and New England on his motorcycle. I marveled at the time about the fact that Rush Harp might have been "earthbound" for twelve years. Usually, spirits remain close to the living after death because they have unfinished business. I assumed that the unfinished business in this case might be unsolved political assassinations which threaten the stability of the USA.

However, now that this reporter is aware that Harry Lebelson had died one day previous to the apport of Cutler's assassinology journal, the possibilities become more complex. There were also unusual and unexplained interferences to the sound system during this reporter's lecture THE DARK FRONTIER at the Kiwanis Hall in Providence, R.I. the following Sunday afternoon. In a

telephone conversation between New York and Providence after the lecture, the MC of the conference, Joan D'Arc of the NEWSPEAK bookstore, informed this reporter that spectators had perceived that the interference with the sound system was very unusual. There were also several phone calls to the Kiwanis Hall during this particular lecture which rung softly and then had no one on the open line. It is a fact that Harry Lebelson, whose encounter with a possibly very-sophisticated black magick cult was mentioned by this reporter in her lecture, was very often on the telephone to this reporter about ufo and supernatural issues before he moved to Florida after heart surgery in 1983. He had a genuine interest in the progress of E. Macer-Story's psychic and magickal practice and sometimes referred persons from Florida who had experienced very unusual interdimensional phenomena.

But there is a more specific correlation to the assassinology journal apport! Lebelson had given this reporter in 1979 a rare copy of the issue of the L.A. FREE PRESS which was put out right after the JFK assassination, and which still resides in the MAGICK MIRROR files. I was puzzled at the time to receive this sudden gift but I assumed that the reason it is now in my files had something to do with conversations about how both Lebelson and myself had been involved in writing for small radical broadsheets during the Vietnam War era. The editor of the L.A. FREE PRESS, Larry Flynt, was

shot and seriously wounded after printing this particular issue, which contains unique reproductions of fliers distributed by far right groups just before the JFK assassination.

Because of my detection of neo-Nazi black magickal interests attempting to "use" the UFO scene as a cover for their activities, Lebelson brought this publication to one of our coffee and bagel meetings at the CitiCorp Center and then insisted that I keep it for posterity. So it is possible that the apport of the Cutler assassinology journal on Saturday, November 11 at the NEWSPEAK bookstore was generated by the recently deceased Intelligence of Harry Lebelson rather than the earthbound Intelligence of Rush Harp.

Although: How many discarnate radical activists does it take to throw a magazine off a book shelf and screw up a sound amplification and telephone system by the use of mind over matter? Maybe the unexplained phenomena during the "Conspiracy Conference" were a group effort from beyond the "other side" of death.

CANCELLATIONS

Ellen Crystal's newsletter CONTACTEE, which detailed her ufo explorations at Pine Bush, N.Y. and various other locations in New York state and Pennsylvania arrived in the MAGICK MIRROR mailbox for the first time last week. But it was

the last issue of this publication, which has been discontinued.

ERIC ST. CLAIR, the French publisher of EDITIONS RAMUEL (See Vanishing Publisher:Magick Mirror Magazine Spring 1995) who caused controversy by suddenly vacating his Paris flat without explanation, only to re-appear later in the country convalescing from a stress reaction, did actually pass away on March 17, 1996. He was not Irish.

GARY LEVINE, for a number of years the chief MUFON investigator for Eastern New York State and recent author of a non-fiction book on gangster Legs Diamond, was killed in a tragic car accident on February 12. Professor Levine will be sincerely missed by those who continue to investigate the mystery of the truly "supernatural" low flying ufo lights of the Catskill Mountains, which were one of his particular interests.

A UFO CONFERENCE scheduled for mid-March at Clark University in Worcester, Massachusetts failed to materialize. But before finally becoming non-existent, it transformed itself several times under the bizarre organizational guidance of "Rick Yindra", an individual appearing to be in his late thirties, who claimed to potential speakers for this event that he was a graduate student at Clark University, but ended up communicating about the conference from San Jose, California by telephone. In this context, Sr.

"Yindra" attempted to "use" his conference liaison with various speakers he had solicited to inveigle Clark University to pay his travel expenses (from California!) . At least one speaker was also asked to accept calls from Sr."Yindra" collect from San Jose to the East Coast.

Obviously, questions arise in the minds of those not completely disoriented by the irrational behavior of other "ufo entrepreneurs" as to why a graduate student in his late thirties would be trying to arrange a ufo conference at a small college in New England from the box office location of San Jose, California. The editor of the **MAGICK MIRROR MAGAZINE** was reminded of the "Aquarian Conspiracy" fad of the 1970's, during which "illuminated" individuals regularly made late night transcontinental trips on the "Red Eye Special" economy flight between the cities of the East Coast and California--for some reason feeling that this Bi-Coastal commuting was going to "change the world" by alchemical effort into a better place by legitimizing the use of telepathy and psychokinesis.

Later, those playing the role of Illuminated Pawns in this situation discovered that many of the projects and events at both ends of the "Red Eye Special" commute were either CIA sponsored or CIA infiltrated by a variety of "undercover agents", some posing as "shamans" and some with more mundane cover identities.

UFO PHENOMENA AND THE SELF-CENSORSHIP OF SCIENCE

George Andrews was one of the speakers for the ufo confrence

which did not happen as scheduled at Clark University this last March. The cancellation of this particular event was perhaps lucky for Mr. Andrews as his topic had been suddenly altered in process from the original subject matter, as captioned above, to "Evidence for UFO Phenomena Since Antiquity , and the Self-Censorship of Investigative Science" written in small print on a flier sent from San Jose, California.

A short summary of the original talk was prepared for the All Fools Day issue of the **Magick Mirror Magazine**, as follows:

"Those who insist on imposing four-dimensional frameworks on multidimensional phenomena in attempting to scientifically explain anomalous events may be missing the point, in a way comparable to someone trying to explain quantum physics in Newtonian terms. Groups such as CSICOP, the Committee for the Scientific Investigation of Claims of the Paranormal, which perceive themselves as watch-dog guardians of science, may in fact be sabotaging science by limiting in advance the scope of inquiry in order to come up with conventionally acceptable explanations that merely reflect their preconceptions.

"Arbitrary denial of the reality of UFO phenomena by the scientific community, in spite of substantial evidence to the contrary which has been surfacing persistently at irregular intervals for the last fifty years, demonstrates a self-

ensorship that is an abdication of responsibility on the part of contemporary scientists, and is incompatible with the principles their work is supposed to be based on.

"It is the academic research community which sets the tone for serious media coverage, as well as statements made by government representatives. Because it has systematically deprecated, minimized or denied evidence out of fear of ridicule, for a full half century adopting the attitude of zealot skeptics, the academic community now bears a large part of the responsibility for the catastrophic present situation, in which the population as a whole must adjust to the shock of acknowledging the reality of the alien presence on this planet, although deeply conditioned for fifty years to dismiss it as a laughing matter, as easily controlled as a television set. Of course, the decision made in 1953 by the CIA's Robertson Panel to pursue a policy of systematic ridicule towards civilian UFO reports is also a major factor in this equation, which illustrates the extent to which contemporary science is under the thumb of those in charge of the military industrial complex, since that disasterous policy is still being implemented to the present day.

"I suspect that the bottom line the government is so desperately trying to conceal consists of high strangeness so weird their best experts are unable to make sense of it. Just as in quantum physics our familiar normal reality dissolves into bewildering assortments of paradoxical particles, so it may be in

ufology, that in the final analysis what it all comes down to is extreme high strangeness, involving interactions not only with short gray and tall blond aliens, as well as giant praying mantises and high-tech reptilians, but also all the rest of the flora and fauna of outer space and of hyperspace. At present our most advanced scientific technology only enables us to perceive about ten percent of the universe that surrounds us, and we are only capable of using about ten percent of the potential intelligence latent in our brains. It does not seem unreasonable to speculate that there may be some as yet unsuspected connection between the types of subatomic particles whose behavior we find so puzzling, the types of entities involved in UFO close encounters, and that 90% of our potential brain power that we have not yet learned to use."

1952 UFO FLAP PREDICTED

The roving reportorial mind of the **MAGICK MIRROR** was reminded by reading the recent **CLASSIFIED COMMUNICATIONS** newsletter containing "A Half Century Of Paranoia" as compiled by Erich Aggen, Jr. of an anecdote concerning the Washington, D.C. "UFO Flap" of May 23, 1952 as told at a dinner party in upstate New York in the Winter of 1989-90 by the late environmentalist and professional computer systems analyst Larry Bogart.

According to Mr. Bogart, he had been living in the Washington, D.C. area in 1952, and had been

approached at that time by a middle-aged woman who did not seem in other respects unusual, but who told him that she was "psychic" and knew that Washington would soon experience an overflight of ufos.

Since this ufo overflight did indeed occur, Larry Bogart then became interested in the topic of ufos and in 1989 had developed a casual connection with various ufo groups and individual researchers. During this same dinner party, he informed a circle of interested guests that a certain reporter named Howard Blum was going to be writing a book on ufos and had contacted several researchers in the upstate New York area for tips and assistance. Blum's information foraging later became the ill-fated book **OUT THERE** in which a committee named "The UFO Working Group" is described as having revealed themselves to Mr. Blum ((Since he was a reporter from the N.Y. TIMES????)) to the extent of having provided him with rides to various research facilities in a special jet.

The most poignant question under these circumstances is simply: "What exactly was the practical connection which had been formed between the reportorial research of Howard Blum in interviewing individuals who had independently researched the ufo enigma AND the nominal "UFO Working Group" who identified themselves as his governmental hosts?"

It is basicly unremarkable but--if the reader will think about it--unusual that several established

amateur ufo data collection groups indignantly objected to Mr. Blum's book only because he had not repeated verbatim news of events and issues intimately familiar to these groups , and had thus not honored their organizational luminaries.

Larry Bogart, who staunchly maintained that there was an important connection between the "ufo craft" sightings and telepathic/hypnotic perceptions, was side-swiped by a car and killed in 1992. There is no reason to assume that this accident was part of a conventional, terrestrial political conspiracy.

As reported in Spring of 1990 in a Wall Street Journal article entitled Belgian Scientists Seriously Pursue Triangular UFOs Despite Jokes :

"Belgian brass take the position that they have seen their duty and are doing it. 'Our approach is that it's our job to see what's going on,' says Air Force Col. Wilfred de Brouwer, who is co-ordinating the investigation. As for the risk of ridicule, he says: 'I have no problem with that. I'm doing my duty.' "
