The twelve parts of column 3 show each of the twelve signs of the zodiac and the degree at which Saturn is found in their horoscopes. The killers' Saturn placements very infrequently coincide with the Saturn placements as found in the horoscopes of seventy-four humanitarians and spiritual leaders (annex 3), or as found in the horoscopes of seventy-seven astrologers (annex 4). I've utilized a circle to indicate where the Saturn placements of the three groups do coincide. In annex 6, I've combined the Saturns as found in the horoscopes of the three groups, and also ^{have} given the meanings of the zodiac degrees occupied.

Column 2 reflects the Sun-sign found in their horoscopes. The twelve parts of column 3 show each of the twelve signs of the zodiac and the degree at which Saturn is found in their horoscopes. The humanitarians' Saturn placements very infrequently coincide with the Saturn placements as found in the horoscopes of the seventy-six serial killers (annex 2), but somewhat more frequently as found in the horoscopes of seventy-seven astrologers (annex 4). I've utilized a circle to indicate where the Saturn placements of the three groups do coincide. In annex 6, I've combined the Saturns as found in the horoscopes of the three groups, and also ^{have} given the meanings of the zodiac degrees occupied.

COMPARATIVE CHART OF DEGREES OF THE ZODIAC OCCUPIED
BY PLANETS AND SENSITIVE POINTS IN THE HOROSCOPES
OF 76 SERIAL KILLERS
AND 74 HUMANITARIANS AND SPIRITUAL LEADERS

Note: In the following charts, each dot represents a planet or sensitive point as found in the combined horoscopes of 76 serial killers and 74 humanitarians and spiritual leaders. The 0 to 29 zodiac degrees of each astrological sign are shown in column 2; the killers' planets in column 3; the humanitarians' planets in column 4. Column 1 shows the placements of Saturn in the horoscopes: K = serial killers' Saturns; h = humanitarians' Saturns; a = the Saturns found in horoscopes of 77 astrologers. Column 1 is further elaborated in annex 6. The placement of all the planets in the astrologers' horoscopes are not included in this study.

Please note that the dark horizontal lines indicate the placement of one or more serial killer's Saturn. The vertical ellipses (()) show "clumps" of occupied degrees that appear to function as zodiac arcs, and are what are shown in the circular charts 20 and 21 found at the end of chapter 10.

Please also note the numerous times that certain zodiac degrees are not occupied, or seldom occupied, in the serial killers' horoscopes, but which are frequently occupied in those of the humanitarians -- and vice versa.

COMPARATIVE CHART OF THE DEGREES OF THE ZODIAC OCCUPIED
BY THE PLANET SATURN
IN THE HOROSCOPES OF 76 SERIAL KILLERS,
74 HUMANITARIANS, AND 77 ASTROLOGERS

Note: In the following graph, I've indicated the serial killers' Saturns by SK, the humanitarians' by SH, and the astrologers' by SA. If Saturn appears more than once in one of these three categories, I've indicated such by 2, 3, etc. To save space, I've included only the zodiac degrees that are found occupied in one of the horoscopes studied. The meanings attributed to these occupied degrees are drawn largely from Esther V. Leinbach book Degrees of the Zodiac, supported by estimates found in Adriano Carelli's The 360 Degrees of the Zodiac. I've coded 2-sided meanings as +/-; negative meanings with -, or -- if very negative; positive meanings with +, or ++ if very positive. I've reduced certain established meanings to key words or phrases. The introduction of demonic or angelic meanings (D and A respectively) is my tentative contribution based upon the data

falling out of this astrological experiment. I've placed a question mark (?) against those degrees whose established meanings are not clear, or if astrologers disagree regarding them.
