

Trotsky, as we know, still preaching his form of world revolution, being assassinated by Stalinist functionaries in Mexico in 1940.

Upon the death of Stalin in 1953, Khrushchev succeeded as Chairman. The extreme differences between the rules of Lenin and Stalin and that of Khrushchev can be seen from the latter's basic occult symbolisms. Born on April 17, 1894, his occult idea-forces line up as follows:

17th	- 8	(Individual or Personal)
April	- 4	(General Matters)
1894	- 22 - 4	(Current of Destiny)

If the individual (internal) number 8 sets Khrushchev in the Saturn-8 idea-forces of Russia, the Uranus-4 does not, and the Khrushchev regime therefore would be one that, according to occult lore, ^{was} ~~is~~ ^{totally} not receptive either to Russia or the Russian Communist Party. In addition, his name adds up to the Venus-6 which, although receptive, is only minimally so. Numerologically then, Khrushchev was a man of erratic ^{nature} ~~peace~~ which his career amply demonstrates.

The Venus-6 aspect, however, could not prevail in a climate dominated by Mars-9, as strong as it is in Communist Russia. Accordingly, Khrushchev was forced

into retirement a disappeared from the forefront of Communist Russia, which promptly returned to its militant Mar-9 attributes.

Khrushchev was the last of the "one-man rules" of Communist Russia. His successors -- Brezhnev, Andropov, Chernenko -- all belong to the so-called "collective rule" advocated by the Party. Thus, it has become increasingly difficult to identify the real powers in Communist Russia. It is only of passing interest, therefore, to note the name (power) numbers and destiny numbers of these three Soviet leaders.

Brezhnev:	Name	- 1

Of these three, Chernenko would, by occult standards, probably be the weakest, since neither his name or destiny number interlocks him ^{very firmly} with the powerful Mars-9 or Saturn-8 axes, irrespective of his age or ~~ill state~~ state of ill health.

Andropov is probably the most interesting, for he "built" the KGB, ~~an agency that epitomizes the~~ ~~exotic combination of the Neptune-7 idea-forces~~

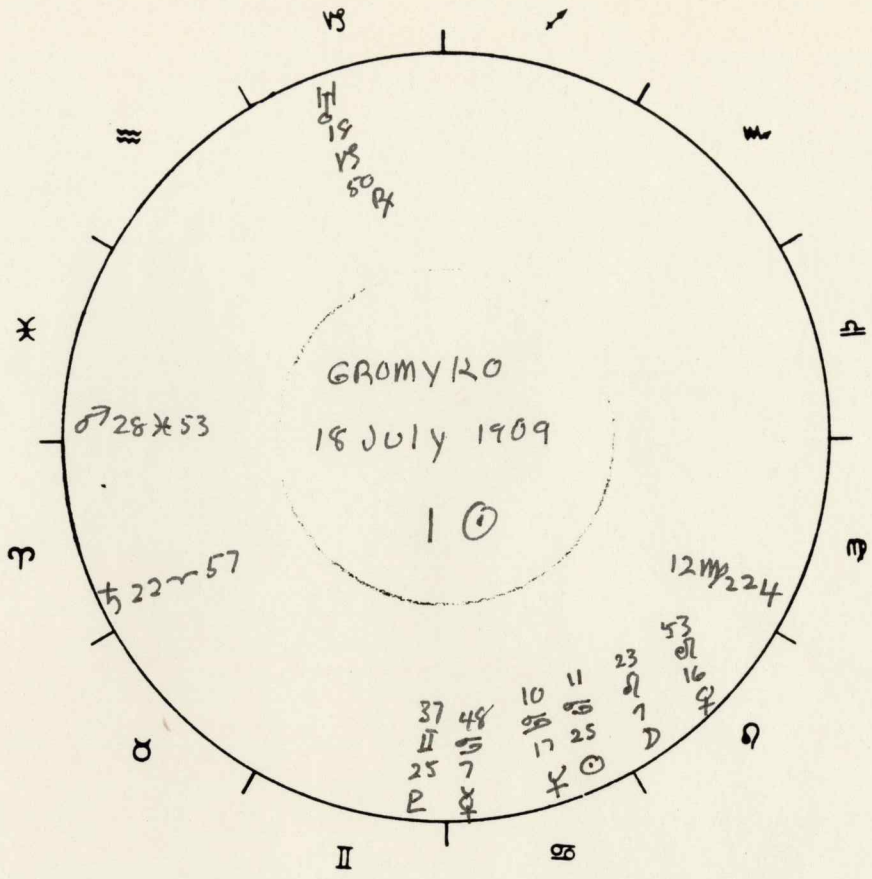
covert Neptune-7 idea-forces as no other human agency ever has. The occult idea-forces of this agency compared to the occult idea-forces of the American CIA are quite different, as we shall see in the next chapter.

HOROSCOPE AND NUMEROLOGY

The Committee for State Security of the USSR is best intelligence network the world has ever known. This is a fact and not a myth. It is too well-known to describe it here in any length. It is the organization of the Soviet secret police, and its responsibilities include the domestic control of over two-hundred and seventy million people, domestic and international espionage and the security of the Soviet leaders. It also administers the prisons, concentration and labor camps, numbering well over two-thousand five hundred.

The Committee for State Security of the USSR is known world-wide only as the KGB; and thus it is this acronym, according to occult lore, that is most important in ascertaining its name power. Considering all the other occult idea-forces that we have reviewed as being operative in Communist Russia, it is hardly suprising (to the numerologist) to discover that the acronym KGB numerically gives the Neptune-7.

KGB functions as a mantra, as all prominent names do, invoking and reinforcing the idea-force attributes occultly associated to its numerical symbology. The Neptune-7/Moon-2 axis has been described earlier in this book. The attributes of covertness, destructiveness, biological control and pain characteristic of the lower-order (committee-collective) dramatizations of this dual axis simply demonstrate the accuracy that the occult arts (if properly utilized) can bring to any analysis.

We have already seen that Andropov, long the chief minister of the KGB, had the occult destiny number of Neptune-7 also, indicating ~~that~~ his destiny ^{could be at home} ~~totally tied~~

~~into~~^{with} the secret machinations of Communist Russia.

Incidentally, it is interesting to note that Andropov's birth date brings out a strange contrast in his personal and practical areas. He was born on June 15, 1915. The number 15 reduces to 6 and June is the sixth month. Thus, in both these areas he was tied into the Venus-6 axis, indicating that he was, in his personal life, a sophisticated and cultured man. Indeed, he possessed one of the largest collections of modern art in Russia, otherwise forbidden to average Russians.

THE KGB was brought into formal existence on March 14, 1954, and it is this date that many astrologers erroneously use for constructing a horoscope for it. The KGB, in fact, was not a new organization, but an enlargement and renaming of one already existing.

This is quite different from the CIA which was founded as a new organization, on July 27, 1947. America's first secret service, the OSS, was abolished on September 20, 1945, and closed down completely fourteen days later. Hardly a year has passed, however, when it was discovered that the United States could not do without an agency that was chartered to keep track of foreign espionage and propaganda, and the new CIA was quickly formed.

A look at the numerology of the KGB's date shows that this date does not characterize the KGB at all.

- 14 - 5 Mercury (Internal matters)
- March - 3 Jupiter (Practical matters)
- 1954 - 19 - 1 Sun (Current of Destiny)

These numbers would indicate an intellectual organization, expansive, and one that may have an ego, but operates in the "full light of the Sun." The Neptune-7 (covert, destructive) of the KGB acronym is the only feature that fits the KGB's type-cast.

The occultist is, therefore, obliged to discover the real ruling horoscope of the KGB that will, in the first instance, reveal its actual numerology. And this is most probably the date upon which the first Bolshevik secret service was founded, of which the KGB is but the most recent evolutionary step.

The first Bolshevik secret police was formed on December 20, 1917, under the title of the All-Russian Extraordinary Commission for Combatting Counter-Revolution, Speculators and Delinquency in Office, otherwise known by its acronym of CHEKA. There can be little doubt that its roots go back to the Okhrana of the monarchy, which in turn was the outgrowth of the "Third Section" of Nicholas I. The Cheka subsequently went through several developments, known as GPU, OGPU, NKVD, SMERSH, etc.,

and finally the KGB. The KGB people still affectionately refer to each other as Chekists, and the carrying forward of this name only further indicates the real origins of the KGB as the CHEKA. The CHEKA can be considered a new organization, since the monarchical Okhrana was disbanded as a result of the Revolution.

The CHEKA was formed by Felix Dzerzhinsky who, next to Lenin, has been sort of sanctified and put up front as a hero of the Revolution.

Numerologically, CHEKA adds up to the Neptune-7 (as does KGB), bringing it into phase with the many other Neptune-7 characteristics of the Bolshevik Revolution. The date of December 20, 1917, reduces numerologically as follows:

- 20 - 2 Moon (Internal matters)
- December - 3 Jupiter (Practical matters)
- 1917 1818 - 9 Mars (Current of Destiny)

The numerology of this date is more in exact keeping with both the numerology of the Soviet regime and the familiar activities of the current KGB. The Moon-2 reveals its covert creation through dissolution attributes; the Jupiter-3 its expansive nature in practical matters; and the Mars-9 reveals its war-like aggressiveness, this latter also being the destiny number of the Soviet regime.

The astrologer can, to some good advantage, superimpose the two horoscopes of the CHEKA and the KGB over each other; but the CHEKA horoscope should be given priority in any combined assessment, since the fundamentals (and name) of the earlier organization are still being carried through into the KGB.

It is interesting to compare the numerology and astrology of the CHEKA-KGB with that of the world's other large intelligence network, the CIA.

HOROSCOPE AND NUMEROLOGY

The Central Intelligence Agency came into being when the Senate leaders signed the National Security Act of 1947 at 3:40 a.m. on July 27, 1947. President Truman signed the bill a few moments later. The duties of the CIA are quite different from those of the KGB. The agency is responsible for gathering foreign intelligence, and since the latter part of 1981, limited domestic

surveillance. Congress has but a limited review of CIA work, which reports to the President through the National Security Council.

Compared to the KGB, the CIA is not a secret state police responsible for the domestic control of all Americans, nor does it have a purview of domestic espionage nor responsibility for the security of American leaders. Also it does not administer prisons, and America has no concentration or labour camps.

The acronym for the Central Intelligence Agency is CIA, by which it is known and referred to world wide. This acronym also serves as a mantra, a power name, numerologically totalling up to 5.

Five is the numerological symbol for Mercury, as we have seen, and is the ruler of the astrological sign which, in occult lore, rules the United State -- Gemini.

The occult idea-forces symbolized by Gemini are considerably different from either of those symbolized by Aquarius or Scorpio. The emblem of Gemini is the heavenly twins, in turn symbolic of both the divine and the mortal. But the Gemini acquire the additional significance of a characteristic phase of the overall cosmic process as symbolized in the Wheel of Transformations. That is to say, a duality (division) of pure creative forces (often symbolized by Aries and Taurus) so that one side of the dualism is elevated, but the other descends into the multiplicity characteristic of mental and material phenomena.

The Heavenly Twin, expressive of opposites, is often pictured fused together and integrated into a Oneness, represented by the spherical or perfect being. The Gemini are also often pictured as two-headed forms, two-headed eagles, etc. The concept of the idea-forces lying behind the Gemini symbol is that of alternating contradiction. positive and negative, thesis and antithesis, paradise and inferno, love and hate, peace and war, praise and insult, clarity and obscurity, etc.

If this cosmic situation were to be described and worked out in psychological terms, it would mean that the "zone of contradiction" (whatever it would be) would be worked out and again create a new whole (Oneness) that itself would become the threshold of unifying and unified mysticism.

Mercury is the symbol attributed to the ruling idea-forces inherent in Gemini. In occult mythology, he was engendered by Jupiter and Maia, in essence the messenger of heaven. His Greek name of Hermes signified "interpreter" or "mediator."

Mercury symbolizes concrete mental faculties, thought, understanding, reason and intelligence. In its lower-order attributes, Mercury symbolizes facile but not profound thought, vacillation, hesitancy to face issues, acquisition of acquiring knowledge for its own sake apart from practical application. Mercury's highest application idea-force, attributed by the ancients, appears to be in the realm of pure reason which, knowing so much about all, leads to another lower-order attribute, the difficulty of drawing a conclusion or in holding on to a conclusion once arrived at.

Since the United States is governed by a committee-government (as all nations are except monarchies),

ruling monarchies, now nearly extinct, the lower-order Gemini-Mercury axis tendencies often come to the fore.

The United States of America came into being on July 4, 1776. From this date, the following characteristics of the United States can be numerically deduced:

- 4th - 4 (Internal affairs)
- July - 7 (General and practical matters)
- 1776 - 21 - 3 (Current or Destiny)

Internal affairs, ruled by the Uranus-4 idea-forces, imply that internal affairs are erratic and probably affected greatly by other than non-governmental interests, except in times of crisis, when the Gemini-Mercury whole will pull the nation together into oneness.

General and practical matters are governed by the now-familiar Neptune-7, except that this feature is superimposed not on a Saturn-8 or Mars-7, but over the Gemini-Mercury axis, leading (at the collective level) to the lower-order attributes of Mercury.

The destiny of the United States is that of the idea-forces symbolized by the Jupiter-3 numerology, one of prosperity and expansion in its higher aspects, and waster

of optimism, order, harmony, the principle of expansion and growth as expressed in the accumulation of material wealth, -- but without the miserliness of a marked Saturnian trait. -- idealism, generosity, benevolence, peace-loving, marked religious tendencies, etc. In other words, the ideal environment for the pursuit of capitalism and individually motivated enterprises, these being, in Communist thinking, the scourge of the world.

In the lower-order attributes can be included the conviction of integrity without the necessary inspection of the basis upon which it is assumed, pride, complacency, hypocrisy, extravagance and procrastination.

Thus we can see that, according to occult interpretation, the CIA as a power name corresponding to the idea-forces of Mercury-5, the CIA fits in perfectly with the total overall idea-forces of the Gemini-Mercury axis said by occultists to be governing the United States. This is further confirmed by examining the numberological aspects of the CIA's founding date, July 27, 1947.

27th	- 9	(Internal Matters)
July	- 7	(General or practical matters)
1947 - 21	- 3	(Current of Destiny)

This numerological analysis indicates that, as far as internal matters are concerned, the CIA is governed by the Mars-9 aspects with which we are now quite familiar. At the internal level, the CIA probably suffers from factional discord perhaps inhibiting unified activities.

In general and practical matters, the CIA has the Neptune-7, sort of the prerequisite for any secret organization. But since these Neptune characteristics are in the area of general operations, the CIA may suffer from ultra-secrecy in which the right hand may not know what the left hand is doing.

The CIA's destiny number shares the attributes also of the destiny number of the United States, the Jupiter-3 -- expansion, ego, idealism.

It is of some interest to compare the basic numerology of both the KGB and the CIA. The contrasts will, perhaps, bring on a knowing smile.

- CHEKA-KGB - Neptune-7, covert, destructive
- CIA - Mercury-5, duality, intellectual

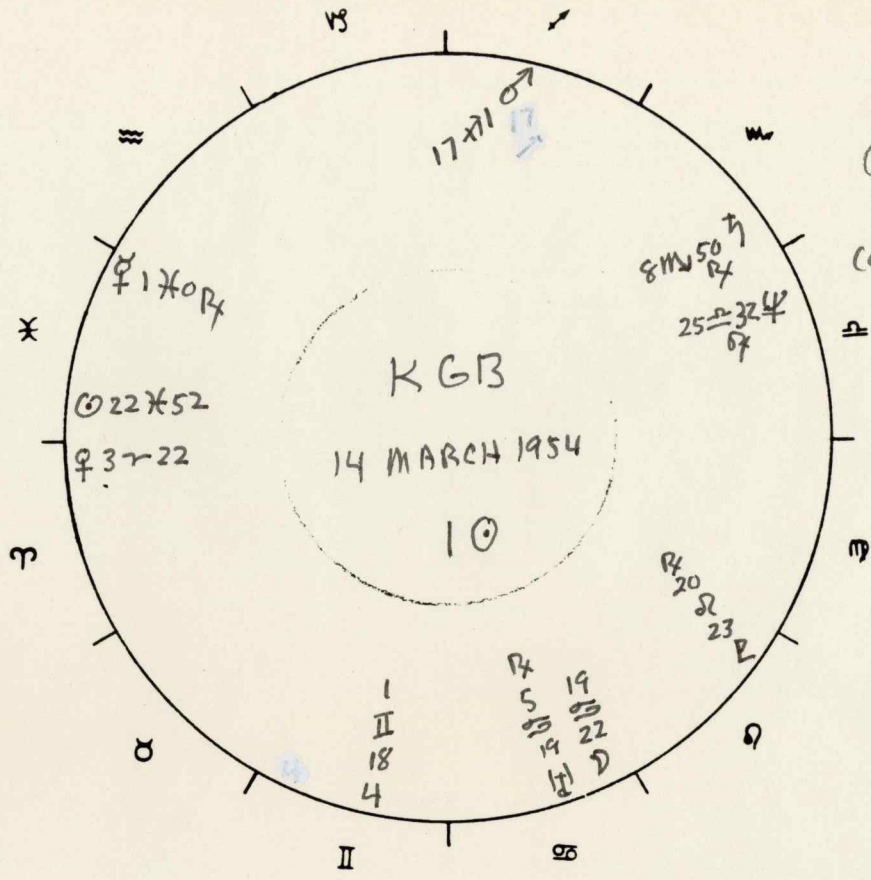

The organization will not learn quickly, but will learn thoroughly, and further Mercury in Capricorn renders the organization orderly, systematic, economical and, to some degree, diplomatic. The lower-orders of this Mercury aspect are those of suspicion and melancholy. This horoscope for the CHEKA is also the dominant horoscope for the KGB.

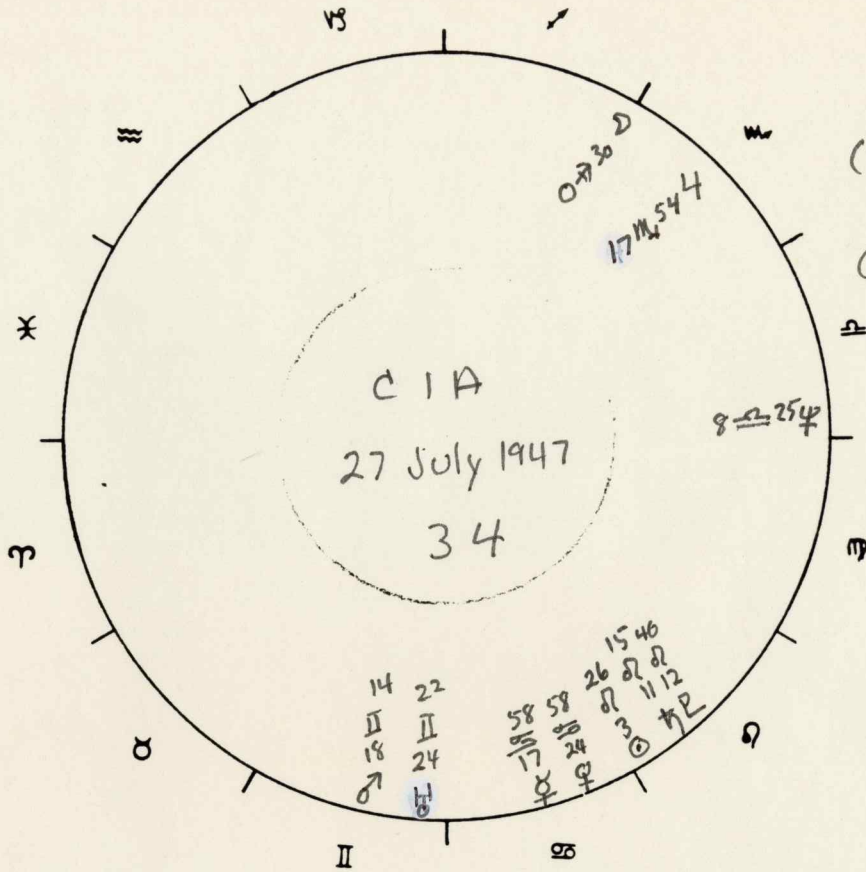

THE IMPORTANT DESTINY YEARS OF THE SOVIET
REGIME IN RUSSIA

The mysteries of numerology bring out patterns that are not explainable except through the philosophy and rules of numerology itself. As we have seen, the Soviet regime is characterized (by its numerology and astrology) predominantly by the Mars-Neptune axis, whose numbers are 9 and 7 respectively.

There is no rational explanation/that almost all for the fact of Soviet Russia's major personalities and leaders should have been born in years which total one of these two numbers. while only one personality (Gromyko)

Normally, this would be called a "coincidence."

But even if so, the result of this kind of a coincidence has had staggering meaning for the world, for these men and their ideas have created through aggression and covertness the largest empire ever known. And if, through numerology, we decode the birth years of these men we see that, according to occult interpretation, were born in years that were destined to manifest the Mars or Neptune attributes.

Is there any rationale for why the art of numerology should be a viable method of decoding the universe in which we live? There is one possibility that comes, of all places, out of the heart of the new physics. Behind the clockwork simplicity of classical physics lies the drama in quantum physics that has been called "quantum weirdness."

Quantum weirdness includes a bizarre phenomenon known as non-locality in which a completely random statistical event occurring at one location is found to match a seeming completely random physical event at another place or time without any observable connecting link. This synchronicity -- often discussed under the title of the Einstein-Podolsky-Rosen paradox named for the physicists who first drew attention to it -- implies

an underlying driving force for coincidences built into the very fabric of the universe.

Some physicists have gone so far as to argue that because of such force-synchronicities (coincidences) we must conclude that the apparent underlying randomness of quantum theory may not be random at all, but may instead constitute a "cosmic code" that simply awaits decoding by those sensitive enough to perceive the underlying patterns.*

But much the same has been said by occult numerologists since ancient times, and their art has consisted of understanding the occult idea-forces and their manifestations through numerological symbols.

At any rate, numerological books are filled with wierd numerological sequences that tie together otherwise seemingly non-related random events. The birth years of the major Soviet leaders exhibit just such an eerie relationship.

We can recall here that the occult idea-force number for any given years of destiny is arrived at by adding the numbers in the year and then reducing the sum until

a single digit number is achieved: for example, the year 1818 adds to 18, and the 1 and ~~eight~~⁸ added together give 9, the Mars-9 symbol for the idea-forces of war and aggression.

The leading individuals born under the Mars-9 destiny force are Marx himself, Kerensky, ^{Beria} and Molotov:

- 1818 - Marx born
- 1881 - Kerensky born
- 1899 - Beria born
- 1890 - Molotov born

The leading individuals born under mutually receptive but distinctly inferior numbers of Jupiter-3 and Venus-6 are Chernenko and Grishin:

- 1911 - Chernenko born (Jupiter-3)
- 1914 - Grishin born (Venus-6)

Those born under the fearsome Neptune-7 idea-forces are Lenin, Trotsky, Stalin, Bukharin, Brezhnev and Andropov:

- 1870 - Lenin born
- 1897 - Trotsky born
- 1897 - Stalin born
- 1888 - Bukharin born
- 1906 - Brezhnev born
- 1915 - Andropov born

We have seen that the Moon-2 idea-forces are associated to the Neptune-7 through their mutually shared covertness and secrecy, and also that the Uranus-4 is mutually receptive to the Neptune-7-Moon-2 idea-forces, as is the Sun-1 number:

- 1894 - Khrushchev born (Uranus-4)
- 1901 - Gromyko born (Sun-1)

It is interesting to note that none of the leaders of the Soviet regime were born under the Saturn-8 destiny number, Saturn being the natural ruler of Russia.

Turning to important events associated with the Soviet regime in each of the significant categories are:

MARS-9

- 1917 - Soviet regime instituted in Russia
- 1917 - CHEKA founded
- 1935 - Stalin purges begin
- 1953 - Khrushchev takes office

NEPTUNE-7

- 1924 - USSR founded
- 1960 - Brezhnev Chairman of the Presidium of Supreme Soviet

SATURN-8

- 1952 - Brezhnev becomes Secretary of Communist Central Committee
- 1979 - USSR invades Afghanistan
- 1888 - The year when the current of destiny numbers of both the 1917 regime and the USSR will coincide.

We have seen earlier how named reduced to numerology can be added up to achieve the numerical values and therefore resonate or not as power names (mantras).

There have, so far,

There have been, so far, only two Mars-9 power names in phase:

- RSFSR (Soviet Russia itself)
- GORBACHEV

But mutually receptive are:

- MARX - Jupiter-3
- CHERNENKO - Jupiter-3
- KHRUSHCHEV - Venus-6

Neptune-7 power names in phase:

- KERENSKY
- CHEKA
- KGB

Moon-2 power names in phase:

- BERIA
- MOLOTOV
- GRISHIN

Sun-1 power names mutually receptive:

- LENIN
- BREZHNEV

Saturn-8 power names in phase:

- SOVIET
- STALIN
- GROMYKO

Of all these names, the weakest would be Khrushchev, Chernenko and Marx; had Marx lived there would undoubtedly been strife between him and Lenin. Khrushchev has been the only Soviet leader forced into retirement and Chernenko represented only a care-taker government.

It is interesting to note that TROTSKY, as a power name, was the only major name to be totally out of phase with the other dominant numbers, being a Mercury-5 number. It was Trotsky who was exiled and who was ultimately assassinated by Stalin's henchmen.

As we shall see in the next section dealing with Russia's astrological and numerological future, although Gorbachev as a power name is in phase with the Mars-9 idea-forces, his destiny number (1931) adds up to the Mercury-5 which does not place him very well within the dominant 9-7-8 ruling destiny numbers.

RUSSIA'S OCCULT FATE

Affairs of state and government go on all the time and it is therefore hard to comprehend why certain groupings of years seem to include events that are more prominent than those that take place during other years. For Russia and Soviet Russia, the mysterious interconnections of those years and numbers that total 7, 8 and 9 are especially prominent, as we have seen.

If Russia's overall destiny number is that of Saturn-8, the destiny numbers of Soviet Russia are those

the dual destiny numbers of Mars-9 and Neptune-7, with the Mars-9 taking precedence. Yet when we talk of these prominent events, it should be realized that they have their roots in the years that preceded them. Governments plan things ahead, as do revolutionaries and dissidents. But these plans seem to culminate, blossom or manifest their dire results in relation to the sequences imposed by the destiny years.

It should be clear by now that we are talking of two Russias: the natural Russia, historically thought to be ruled by Saturn-8 and Aquarius; and Soviet Russia, set up in 1917 under the aspects and destiny attributed to Scorpio and the Mars-9 idea-forces with their great affinities to those of Neptune-7.

While we can see there are many affinities between the Saturn-8 and Mars-9 idea-forces, the results of the combination being generally dire, Mars-9 does not seem to be a "lucky" number for Russia, nore does the Neptune-7. Both these idea-forces represent rule by force, through destruction and covertness -- at least in so far as the lower-order ideaforces are dramatized by governments and the committee-collective.

But, then, the dire connections between Mars and Saturn are legendary in both astrological and numerological lore. In the combination of Saturn-Mars it is usually clear that it is the overall Saturn idea-forces that suffer, ~~and~~ even though its own innate destructiveness/exalted through the Mars relationship. This peculiar numerology can be traced throughout the history of Russia.

For example, the Romanov dynasty was founded in 1613, the destiny number for that year being the Moon-2. While the idea-forces symbolized by the Moon are themselves those of covertness and secrecy, they carry within them the creativity principle that Mars lacks, and the Saturn-Moon relationship is therefore more mutually receptive along creative lines. The first Tsar of the Romanov dynasty was Michael, whose power-name adds up to the Uranus-4, Uranus often thought to be the co-ruler with Saturn of Aquarius, Russia's ruling astrological sign. It is tempting to read too much into numerological relationships, and in this case say that the House of Romanov was characterized throughout by covert electrical eccentricities; but, in fact, the dynasty never achieved the stabilities often associated with other nations ruled by a monarchy, for example France and England, or China and Japan.

The destiny numbers and power-name numbers of the Mars-9 and Neptune-7 axis were always unlucky for the dynasty. The ninth Tsar was Ivan VI, whose power name adds up to the Sun-1, and whose destiny year was the Jupiter-3. This unfortunate became Tsar while an infant under the unpopular regency of his mother, Anna Elizabeth, Leopoldvona. The regency was overthrown by the daughter of Peter I and Catherine I. Elizabeth's birth year was 1709, giving the current of destiny as the Saturn-8, strong in the Romanov dynasty and in Russia itself. The unfortunate Tsar lived in solitary confinement under Elisabeth until he was murdered in 1764, this being a Mars-9 year.

Nicholas II was the eighteenth Tsar of the Romanov dynasty. Added together, 18 equals the Mars-9. Nicholas II abdicated the throne in 1917, the first Mars-9 destiny year of the Soviet regime. His abdication ended the three-hundred-and-four years of Romanov rule, 304 adding up to the Neptune-7. And thus the Saturn-8 Moon-2 destiny of Russia came to an end, being replaced by the Mars-9 Neptune-7 rule of the Soviet regime.
