Dear Ron, I would like to bring to your attention a situation which if it can be made to go right would be of great opportunity to scientology growth (within certain circles previously hard to crack). Dr. William Wolf (see Who's who in American Psychiatry), a good friend of mine for several years - and who was introduced to John Mac at my house - has become impressed with scientologists, their obvious contribution to the future, and also with the unfair treatment scientology has received within the psychiatric profession. His interest has extended into a wish to write and publish an article which would "be neither pro nor con, but a forthright and exact information article" (his words). The probable printing of this article would be (among other possibilities) the American Journal of Psychotherapy since, as Dr. Wolf says, from his viewpoint "the time has come that the profession and para-professionals be provided with exact information on scientology".

In spite of the shambles in which former attempts of this nature have resulted, I would wish nevertheless to be responsible for recommending Dr. Wolf in this matter since I am not without appreciation of his integrity and work for the betterment of the conditions of the planet, but in so recommending I would wish to avoid all ~~confusion~~ confusion which would result in an alloyment of either his or your affinity.

I can tell you that Dr. Wolf gave over the usual psychiatric and psychological premises quite some time ago in favour of an attempt at ~~the~~ a discovery of a soul-oriented technology of his own and that despite his eminence and respect accorded him in his several fields of endocrinology, medicine, therapy, etc., he has abandoned many of the superficial and false conditions rendered untenable by ~~scientological~~ scientological knowingness, and gone often in the face of his colleagues to defend a continuing spiritual viewpoint of existence. As with hundreds of preceding investigators he hits, as you know, level VI.

At the time I introduced John Mac and Dr. Wolf, he became increasingly impressed with the future vision and heightened responsibility levels which manifest especially in John and other scientologists. He wished at that time to be audited, but there seems to have been some question as to his auditability since he is who he is in the psychiatric world, and also because of the advent of the new Dianetics. He was not subsequently audited which I do not hesitate to point out is an invalidation of his flow. There is, I admit, the consideration that if he really wanted scientology he would get it himself and I will not argue with that.

But I believe that Dr. Wolf is honest, has a level of integrity nearly unheard of on the planet, and that this is his way of reaching. Thus, he might be granted as much beingness as would an ordinary well-intentioned preclear walking into any org.

Dr. Wolf, in attempting to be honestly effective for the future, is deeply and ~~ex~~ seriously involved with many groups who are trying to predict and prepare from statistics and trends what work might now be undertaken to alleviate the conditions arising obviously for the year 2000.


These include "Mankind 2000", the "International Japanese Group", "Futerology" (being a medical group studying the already acknowledged non-existence in the year 2000 of medicine as it is now known and what will replace it), and also groups concerned with the prevention of planetary pollution. I expect you are familiar with some of these.

I made it a point to discover some months ago Dr. Wolf's connection with the AMA, to which as he says all doctors belong indirectly at least, but which is uninteresting to him and has no constructive purpose as far as he can see.

Therefore, I would wish that Dr. Wolf be extended much the same scientology flows given other 'personalities', first for his own benefit, and secondly for the benefit scientology might accrue from his enormous prestige and comm lines should he, as a successful result of scientology communication, choose to use them on our behalf, and that this way be made clear within your specifications to provide him with data sufficient for the construction of his proposed article.

I have never had an opportunity to thank you so very much for what you have made possible for me. I should like to now.
