Dear Ron and Mary Sue,

It has been quite some time since I last sent you a note concerning my involvement in parapsychology.

During the last two years, interest in parapsychology and things "psychic" has risen extremely high both in public and scientific realms: the public sector is inundated with useless and bad books on the subject; but the scientific sector is rapidly coming to consider parapsychology a legitimate frontier as well as a meeting place of mind and matter, i.e., that thought is probably a hill in the geometries of MEST.

The work I have accomplished has placed me well within the respectable confines of this neo-science, although I have had to spend a great deal of effort to keep from being identified with the mystery of magical effects schools, having to a great degree won in this regard. The results of experimentation in which I have participated and created are constantly referred to in science symposiums on the subject and are now beginning to be reported upon with good dignity at the popular level (see for instance Supersense, a book recently published by Charles Pinati, science editor of Newsweek magazine.) So far, I have not been subjected to extensive negative attacks, which might well be expected, and may yet come.

Working separately and together with Hal Puthoff and Pat Price, we have created as Scientologists a veridical platform that holds high interest about and does attract positively for Scientology in both the public and scientific sectors.

Thanks once more for all your discoveries and what they have made possible to millions; and my best wishes to you all.
