

FRACTURED PSYCHES AND PSYCHIC RE-ALIGNMENT

Shall we think that the planet and its life-energies are being trashed because of the fractured psyches and unmoored brains of the system's technocrats in charge of trying to run things? (I hear hooray! and yea, yea, yea from the bleachers).

Yes, in part, but things are always more complicated than you might expect. For example, only those technocrats in the employ of money-makers have any real power. There are many visionary technologists whose knowledge and discoveries might help alleviate our pending woes. No, implementation would be costly, would diminish profits... This situation implies that the system is guilty: but who supports the system, makes it survive? Alas! It be each of us. You see how complicated it all gets?

Is your inner psychic self fractured? If you've made it to the top in sixty seconds or less, or are in the process of doing

so, you probably will think not. Success, position, acknowledgement for your humble self all bring conviction that whats inside you must be in order. No factured psyches here. They only show up when one retires. Then The I unravels...la-ter-da. (Technocrats call this the "retirement crisis.") Besides, as everyone knows, lunatics posing behind facades of "normalcy" can rise to the top the same as anyone can.

We've all heard of the much-touted IQ (intelligence quotient) used by the system to identify "intelligence," to select its top raw best "brains." But what about LQ (lunatic quotient), or, a la this present book, PsiQ (psychic quotient)? Or CQ (conscience quotient)? Or DQ (destructivity quotient), or the PCQ (peak creativity quotient)? Here are five additional "quotients" the system avoids isolating and dealing with, because would not a few egos be set aquivering? I think the point has been made: IQs, all by their glorious selves, mean relatively little and, in fact, are what the fates can write entire scripts around.

Let's take Hitler, for example. The top Nazis, as a whole, all had high IQs if we are to look at the fact that the whole sonambulant world had to wake up and get its ass in gear to do something about them. Hitler's Quotient Status probably read something like this:

 DQ (destructivity quotient).....tops out
 PCQ (peak creativity quotient).....plebian

Now really, don't you think that if we were versatile in isolating all these Qs we wouldn't need astrology as much as we do? You might like to amuse yourself by estimating the Q Assessments of some of our world leaders, or your friends. There are other important Qs, too: for example, FQ (fate quotient) and DQ (destiny quotient). But if your own psyche is fractured -- that is, if you are a psychic wreck -- you'd best stick to something not so challenging as trying to penetrate FQs and DQs.

A fractured psyche means that we are not in control of our destinies. The contents of our psyches are, so to speak, cross-wired, or working blindly on automatic, or confusing the past with the future -- all the malfunctions you might expect from an animated wreck that doesn't die a decent death. We have all seen fictional examples of this kind in science-fiction stories.

Frankenstein is a good example. That monster has fascinated generations of readers and viewers. In the tale 2001, the innards of the computer (named Hal) that controls the entire space ship (the vessel's own little emerald kingdom) go bonkers. Hal has no conscience quotient programmed into him. He soon terminates all but one astronaut, who soon realizes he has to try to take his own destiny in hand. In the movie, Star Wars, the situation is more completely dramatized. Destructive fate (Darth Vader) can only be conquered if the PsiQ of Luke Skywalker can be activated, setting the universe once more on a proper destiny-fulfillment course. And so on.

Well, you might now ask, whose psyches are not a wreck, or at least a little disheveled? Good question. Lets talk about "proportions." Some parts of one's psyche may be in good enough order, while other parts are a dismal sump with lots of flotsam-jetsam in it. But overall, the whole of the difference may be as great (and obvious) as the difference between Mahatma Ghandi and the Ayatollah Khomeini (both religious leaders) who dealt with their relatively similar goals in completely different ways. Almost bloodlessly, Ghandi restored India's destiny. The Ayatollah set the fates loose in Iran where they are glad enough to drink all the blood they can.

Now you might retreat to the position that, through psychotherapy, the contents of a fractured psyche can be rearranged for the better. True, somewhat true, and many have benefitted from therapy (for others it is an endless, costly procedure that

frequently never resolves life's greater issues.) So far, our modern technocratically-dominated psychological beliefs (i.e., that man is an electro-chemical machine controlled by the brain, and nothing more) have little to offer in the way of an overview of the psychic whole. As a result, our modern psychological therapies often just serve to redecorate or redesign a room or two inside the psyche, while on the outside the entire structure continues to fall to eventual ruin.

It is true that many discoveries about our human mental anatomy (i.e., psychology) have been great ones, in some cases noble and magnificent. But these have been inserted into the technocratic overview of things, into science, whose belief holds man to be only a bio-electro-chemical machine. This belief is, of course, balderdash.

The human body may be a machine (even this is not very certain), but what comes to inhabit it is not mechanical. What say you when love, understanding, conscience, forbearance, fortitude, will, creativity and foreseeing come to pervade the human frame? Mechanics? Hardly. When the indwelling inhabitant of the body can only function in a degree lesser than the whole of the body itself, it can appear that the body is not inhabited by anything save its own mechanical functions -- that is, appear a robot of some kind, vegetating away. But when the individual begins to manifest attributes above and beyond his or her merely biological workings, then a different picture begins to emerge, one that requires a different kind of overview. One that helps

lift the potential diamond consciousness above and beyond the limits of the fate-destiny patterns of the bio-organism itself.

Something like this has, of course, been the traditional role of the religions -- all of which the great modern god of technology says have "failed" (which, to some degree, is true) as its own "throne" and dogmas have risen in power and universal influence. This has also been the role of the traditional psychic sciences, the mystical and occult "arts", whose "territory" has been the workings of the psyche and its psychic attributes. But today's version of technocracy has spurned religion and the occult psychic arts much like any other invading conqueror who has always sought to obliterate any contrasting sources of inspiration it sees as insulting to its own internal beliefs and "visions."

One of the things that is most embarrassing to technocracy is that in proposing to create The New Scientific Man (thereby acting as its own "god"), it proposed that The Old "Superstitious" Man would be and should be dispensed with. Yet the new man who has released nuclear energy and who has gone to the Moon is, essentially, the same as, for example, Ghengis Khan, regardless of the outer technological marvels the new man has constructed around himself.

Psychologically, man has not changed very much, and is as busy as ever in perpetuating his traditional fate patterns into the future -- without a clue as to how to intervene in them -- and now carrying the additional burden of having suppressed

traditional accesses into man's "spirit", his psyche, that deep, beautiful inner source which alone has the power to envision and set new in destinies in motion.

The term "neo-psychic realignment" implies two things: a conscious and willful reconnection to the workings of the psyche -- at the individual level and at the collective level; and a resurrection of many venerable "occult" principles concerning the ancient psychic psyche, but recasting them in terms that make them comprehensible to us at a valuable personal level. After all, a road map or tour guide are only as good as they are understandable.

Now I think it should be said here -- although we will shortly take this up in more detail -- that such psychic road maps have never been available in the West. In the Judaeo-Christian framework, men have never wanted to understand their own psyches. That was God's concern. It is this anti-psyche tradition that has made it so easy for our present technocracy to spurn the inner psychic nature of the Western man.

The anti-psychic roots of our present culture are deeply rooted in the historical past of the West, and the present scientific-technocracy is only (unthinkingly) perpetuating them. In effect, it is saying: the emerald kingdom be damned; we now have scientific brains that will resolve everything! I dare say, from the looks of things, these "brains" will do nothing of the kind.

In our Judaeo-Christian culture, all the psychic sciences were labeled pagan: hounded down, excised, venomously destroyed, burnt at the stake, and so forth. Goodness knows, the proper Jew or Christian would not want anything pagan. Yet, our modern technocracy has unleashed the worst of any possible "paganisms" in huge and volatile quantities (just read a few newspapers) -- drugs, violence of all kinds, terrorism, murder, rape, devil worship, etc., and has not a clue as to why the outbreaks, much less what to do about them.

The West developed only three major "arts" whose goal were similar: to try, as organized forms of study, to penetrate into man's psychical processes: the Cabala (Kabbalah), Alchemy and Astrology. Alchemy was so thoroughly demolished that we have no idea at all, today, about its processes. The Kabbalah is secretly preserved in esoteric Judaism, making it generally unavailable, while, save for a few stellar personalities -- such as Evangeline Adams and Louis Hamon -- the greater forms of Astrology as a noble psychic science has fallen into the fringes of technocracy which continues to make acid puns at the expense of today's laboring astrologers.

Yet, beneath its technocratic "crown", and almost in spite of it, the West has had a constant hunger for clues that might help in achieving some understanding of man's psychic nature. To nurture this hunger -- almost in the same fashion as Prohibition "nurtured" speakeasies, bath-tub gin and illegal importation of liquor from Canada -- the West has imported Eastern mysticism and

metaphysics and seen many bath-tub psychic "sciences" come and go. Like Freud's carefully chosen terms, Eastern thought has suffered much as the West has sought to translate its delicate and specific concepts into words acceptable to the West's non-mystical and non-metaphysical mentality.

Yet, properly understood, the ancient psychic-science traditions of both the West and East have much to offer, as we shall immediately begin to see.

Now, where to start? Let's not start with the rather dizzying perspective of the whole tour book, as is usual in not a few pompous occult maps. Let's start with something very close to each of us.

Each of us, on a daily basis, and all our lives, has to deal with what the ancient and traditional psychic sciences have called -- using a variety of words -- "energies" and "forces."

Let us begin with these: and we will quickly come to understand that energies belong to the emerald talents of growth, re-birth and generation, etc., and that forces are the domains of the dark fates.
